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Pastor's Viewpoint

Dangers await in familiarity with holy things

According to the Legend of the Touchstone, if you could find the touchstone on the coast of the Black Sea and hold it in your hand, everything you touched would turn to gold. You could recognize the touchstone by its warmth. The other stones would feel cold, but when you picked up the touchstone, it would turn warm in your hand.

Once a man sold everything he had and went to the coast of the Black Sea in search of the touchstone. He began immediately to walk along the shoreline picking up one stone after another in his diligent and intentional search for the touchstone. He was consumed with this dream. He wanted desperately to find this miraculous stone. However, after several days had passed, he suddenly realized that he was picking up the same stones again and again. So he devised a plan... pick up a stone; if it's cold, throw it into the sea. This he did for weeks and weeks.

Then one morning he went out to continue his search for the touchstone. He picked up a stone; it was cold... he threw it into the sea. He picked up an-

other stone – cold! He threw it into the sea. He picked

up another stone... it turned warm in his hand, and before he

realized what he was doing... he threw it into the sea!

If we have been saved, or even in ministry for a long time, there are dangers in familiarity with holy things. For some, the fantasy of what a future blessing would be like causes them to miss what God is doing in their lives or ministries now.

For others, they have become so used to the routine of church, outreach and ministry, that they begin to forget what wonderful things God has done for them in the past, and what an awesome privilege it is that they are able to come into His presence and be a part of what God is doing.

This is displeasing to God, and dangerous for the person. Uzzah viewed the ark of God's presence as just an-

other piece of furniture and was judged by God when he touched it – treating it like any other furniture. In Malachi 1:11-13 God charges His people with profaning His name by viewing holy things as a burden instead of privilege. **Mal 1:13 (NCV)** *You say, ‘We are tired of doing this,’ and you sniff at it*

in disgust...” Not only will God refuse to bless this attitude, but it is this kind of heart that is most easily enticed away from God's will.

What is needed is a fresh vision. **Eph 1:17-19** says, *“That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,*

Paul is praying that God's people would catch a vision of who God is, what He has called them to do, and what God is able to do. It would serve us well to deliberately remember where God has brought us from, and contemplate the potential of what He can do, and is doing right now. May God help us to open our eyes, and not miss the treasures He has for us!

Leadership Forum

Our business practices have spiritual ramifications

I want to look at a facet of the ministry that at first glance looks like an aside. But in reality there's very powerful, spiritual ramifications.

Proverbs 22:29 says: "Do you see a man diligent in his business, he shall stand before kings. He shall not stand before mean men or unknown men."

Romans 12:11 "Not slothful in business, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord."

An Overlooked Issue

As a fellowship we correctly understand the weakness of the Bible schools, and the methods of training that much of the Christian world has chosen. Jesus did not remove his men from the field, he did not isolate them in a sterile classroom setting to fill them with knowledge. We know this doesn't mold character, it doesn't produce fruit or impart spirit, and overall, is a failed strategy to train men for ministry. However, I believe that it's also possible to make a mistake right here, and that is to overlook a very important aspect of character development. And that is if we fail to insist that our disciples learn how to think, or more specifically, become diligent in business.

There's a failure in this arena if we don't pay attention to this in our disciples. It's going to manifest itself painfully once a man gets sent off because sooner or later there's going to come time for him to do business, and so this can seem unspiritual, but when you look into the word of God it's really a fascinating study, Romans 12:11 again, "Not slothful in business." The word here slothful has a very powerful definition. It refers to those that are *slow, idle, destitute of prominence of mind and activity*. And the word business is the same word in Romans

12:8, which is rendered diligence, and it properly means *haste, or intensity or [ardor] of mind*. So it means to be faithful

and industrious in the discharge of all our appropriate duties.

In other words, this is an issue of character - the ability and willingness to apply your mind and your spirit to these less than exciting avenues of life are really a character issue.

What is higher education really all about? The truth is only a fraction of what people learn in school will have a direct application to their lives in any field. What it's really about is learning how to think. In other words, people who do well in school have learned how to make themselves do things mentally that they don't feel like doing. Whether this is writing a paper, rather than going to bed; or researching rather than playing. And people who do well academically are valuable to the marketplace, not so much because of the information that they have gathered, but what they've demonstrated to the business community is that they have disciplined minds.

So if the weakness of the bible school is the neglect of moral character and spiritual dynamic, the weakness of discipleship can be the neglect of mental discipline and academic mindedness. I don't believe it ought to be this way, or that Jesus intended it to be this way. The word of God is filled with this in the gospels. Jesus told the parable of the ten servants, and he delivered unto them ten talents and said unto them, "Do business until I come." So a lot of the gospel and a lot of Jesus' teachings were aimed toward this, and the word of God is full of admonishment to this facet of character.

I Timothy 1:7 says, "For God has not given us

the spirit of fear, but power, love and a sound mind," which literally means a disciplined, balanced and controlled, or as one man put it, a well-ordered mind. What we are talking about here is the willingness and the ability to be organized. This begins to be a character issue because it's an area of personal dominion. And as we disciple men, we should not overlook the facet of development that requires men to be diligent in business. The mistake men make is because these things are small or boring, then they're not important. How you do business/take care of business reveals your character - what kind of man you are! This is beyond prayer or faithfulness or preaching skills - men who lead well, must overcome the tendency to be lazy-minded.

Chinle as well as two other Bible Studies in surrounding communities.

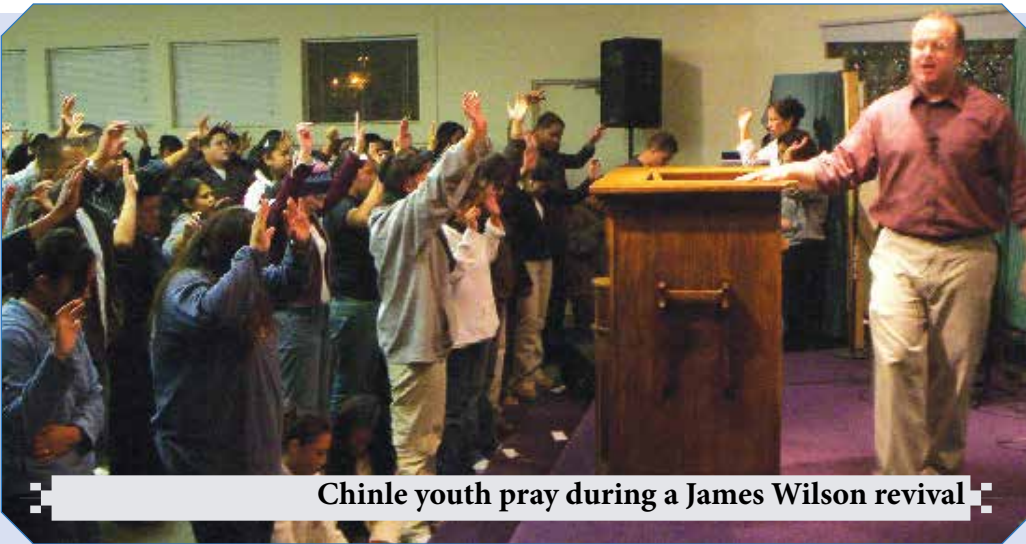
Recently Pastor Aragon started a Discipleship Class on Monday evenings and we have an average of 40 men who attend.

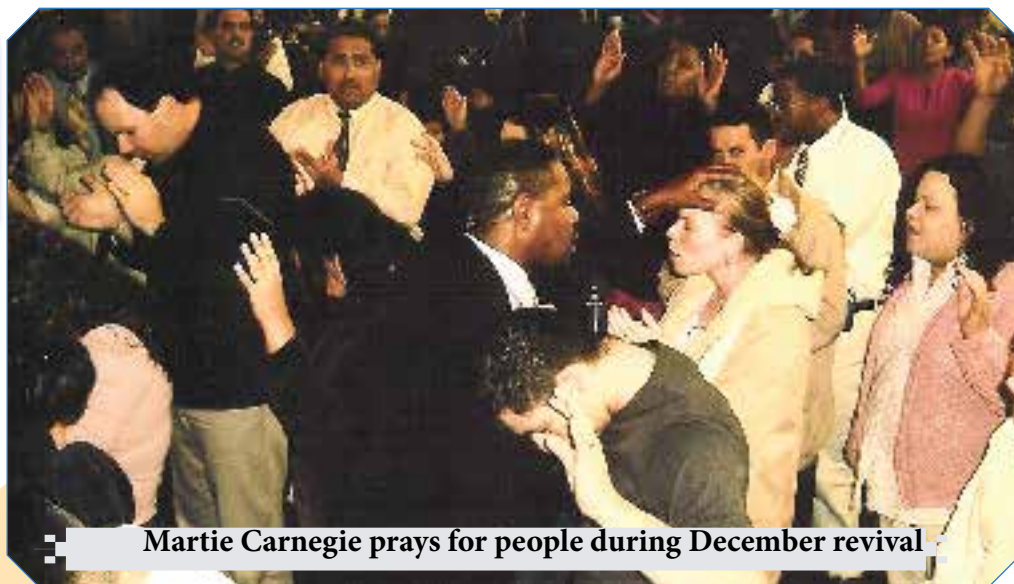

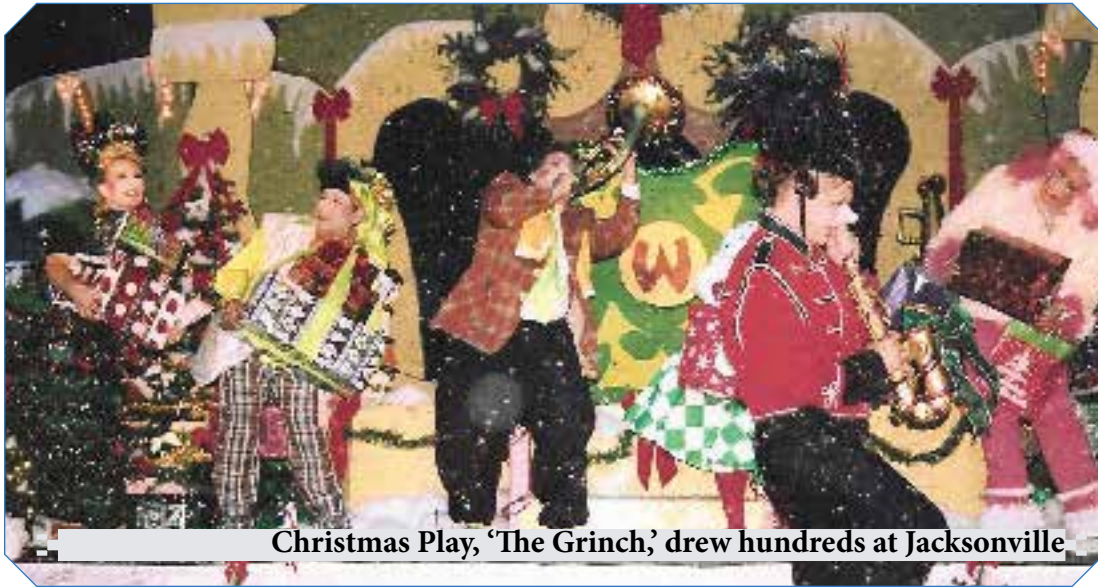

new convert got filled and all the saints were challenged into make a greater commitment to Christ.

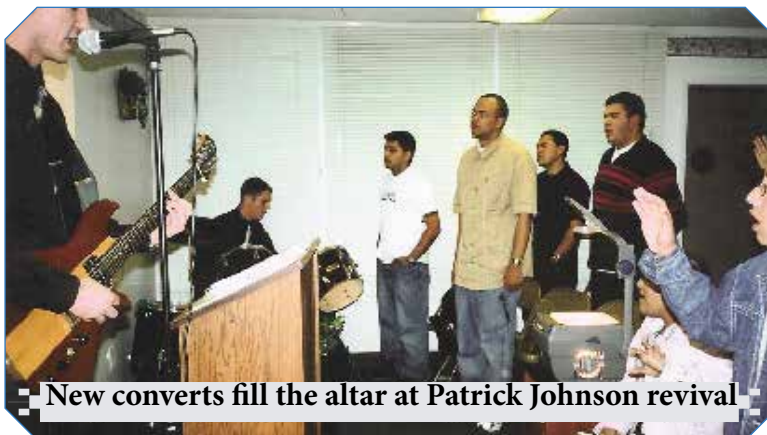
In October, Pastor James Schulze came to do a revival for us. We saw several saved and two new con-

These biblical principles are being imparted into the men God has given us in National City. Pray for us - we’ll pray for you.

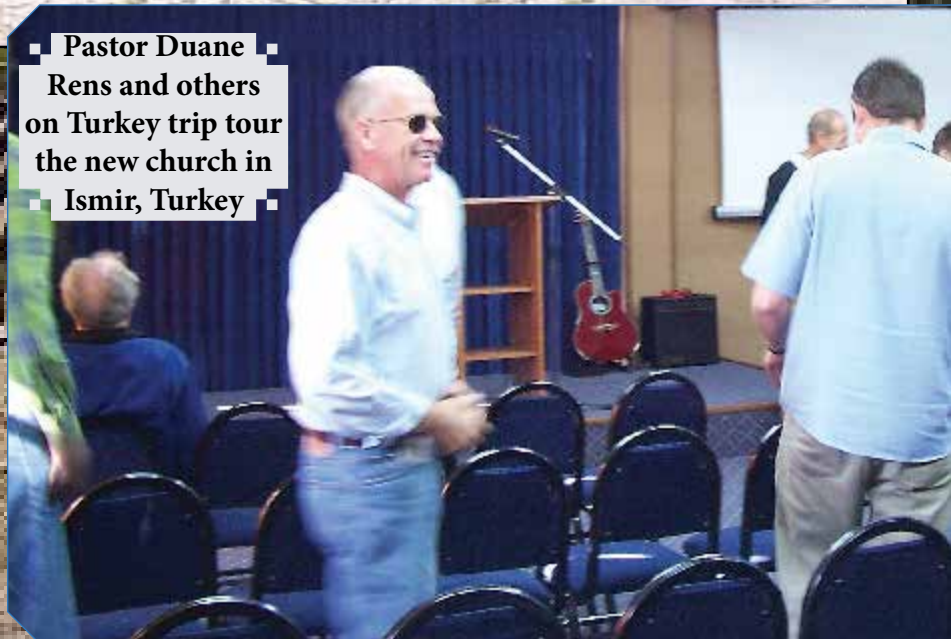

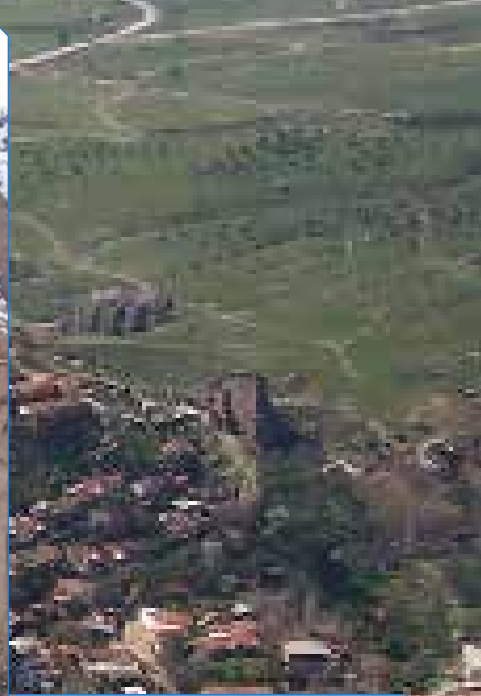

For the second time, a group of Fellowship saints made the trip to Turkey, retracing the footsteps of the Apostle Paul. The trip made the Bible come alive as tourers viewed ancient places, learned Bible history, and studied the seven churches of Revelation. The group experienced a special joy during this trip, as they visited the building of the new Fellowship church, The Potter's House, in Ismir, Turkey, which is being pioneered by Pastor Rick and Kathy Buchholz.



The Weakest Link

The devil will use anything we give him, we've seen this clearly over the years. We have numerous examples of pastors who have not been disciplined in business: We've had men who failed to sign leases and either lost the money their mother church invested, or got kicked out and had to find another building and raise money for it all over again. We've had men who failed to insure vehicles and they either got stolen or wrecked and the investment was lost. Others have failed to check building ordinances or sign codes and run into problems with councils – not because the councils were devils, but because the man didn't do his homework.

The devil will use whatever he can to destroy the work or the worker. There are several reasons this will affect you in ministry: 1) **You lose credibility with people:** People begin to lose respect for a pastor who can't take care of simple business issues. They either eventually won't follow or they won't be willing to keep giving.

2) **Rebels or wicked people will seize upon these areas to use against you.** A rebel may have a wicked heart, but what he will use as a weapon to influence others against you may well be your own failings in business areas.

3) **Unsaved businesses will refuse to help or to work with you.** It's a sad fact that it is very hard for churches to get loans because churches are the worst risk on earth for banks – pastors are often not diligent in business!

This issue is important because it will cripple a man's destiny: God's looking for men he can trust with lots of money!

After winning the big prize in a state lottery a young couple suddenly found they had more money than they know what to do with, \$300,000

a year. In their early 30's, with two small children, they quit their jobs and started spending and spending. Four years later, this couple was a half a million dollars in debt. There it is right there. If you were a loving God you wouldn't do that to your children if you knew that they were gonna do. They're a half a million dollars in debt, they knocked on the door of a financial planner, who tells this story. The financial planner showed them how they could spend only \$120,000 a year or \$10,000 a month for a family of four in an affordable area of the country. Unfortunately, the couple could not stick to the plan - each year they spend \$330,000. Finally after years of having his advice ignored, the financial planner gave up on them.

Here is a classic character that cannot handle prosperity. Financial responsibility is a critical part of character: a. Paying bills on time b. Do you know how much is in your account right now? c. Keeping and filing receipts d. Filling out and sending reports in business or school (Gold sheets/financial reports for pastors!) e. Debt f. Equipment

When I was in Kenya, I knew of several missionaries who gave many years of their lives, but because they didn't have their by-laws or business side in order, wicked men were able to steal their years of investment. While I was in Kenya we had several situations with the government because rebels either told lies about us, or they tried to maneuver to steal the corporation. It was solely by God's grace that I had taken care of the business side of things that we have a work there at all today. The devil is a strategist, and though we may live righteous lives, he will use our laziness in business to damage our churches and ministries.

Contending for Excellence

You know, I've always liked where it says in Acts that they marvel that

these disciples were ignorant and unlearned men, and there's a period in which that gave glory to God, but I don't believe it's God's will forever!

There's a Dimension of God on this – an anointing. **Rom 12:11** links not slothful in business to being fervent in spirit! **Gen 47:6** if thou knowest any men of activity among them, then make them rulers over my cattle. God watches our business to see our hearts so He can bless our ministries! I remember hearing one man say, "I'm not paid to preach, I'm paid to administrate." I'm not totally sure that's 100% true or not, but the truth is administration is part of our responsibility. We are called to take care of this as men of God.

One man said, "There are certain things leaders do every day: Leaders pray every day. Leaders read their Bible every day. And leaders file every day. You don't have to be a genius, you just have to not be lazy. Some simple keys to organization: a. Write it down b. Organize or file it c. Do it immediately.

Dan 6:3 *Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes, because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm.*

Here is a man that was a captive and the king wanted to put him in charge – that's an anointing! Think about Joseph: Men saw the Lord was with him – they promoted him and put him over Potiphar's house, over the prison, then over the kingdom!

Prov 22:29 *Seest thou a man diligent in his business? he shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before mean men.*

So it's upon us to develop it in ourselves and insist and impart this to our men. So here are examples of our text, the fruit, the power and the impact, and if we can achieve this in our men, then I think that God can open doors for them, God can bless them.

We must contend to not be slothful in business.

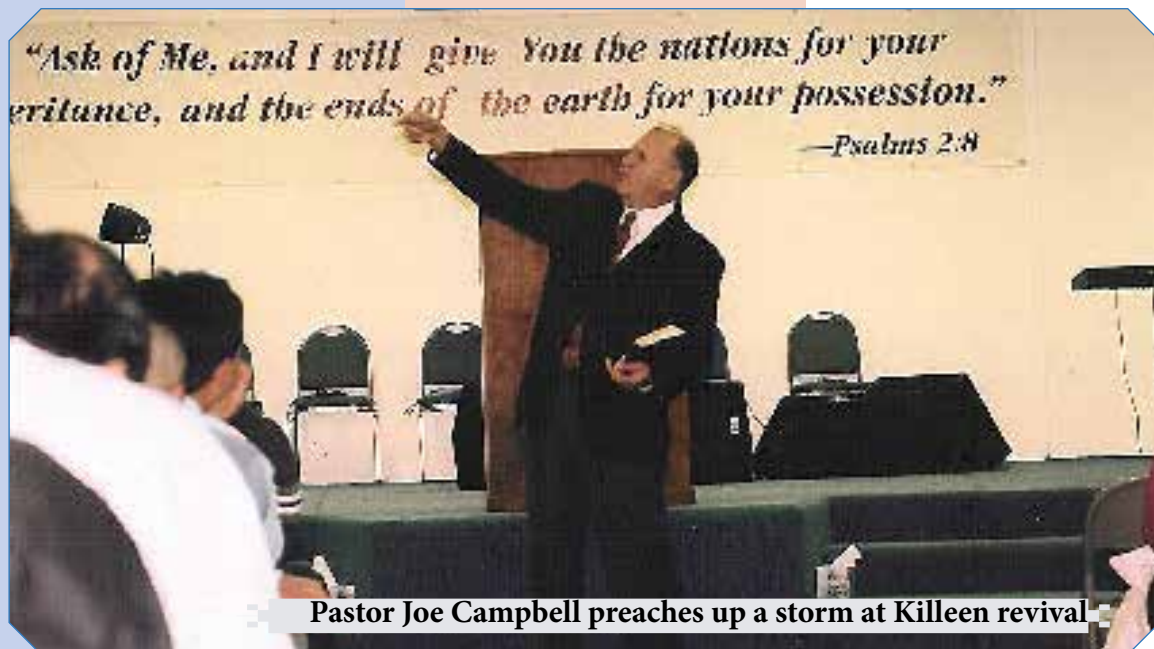

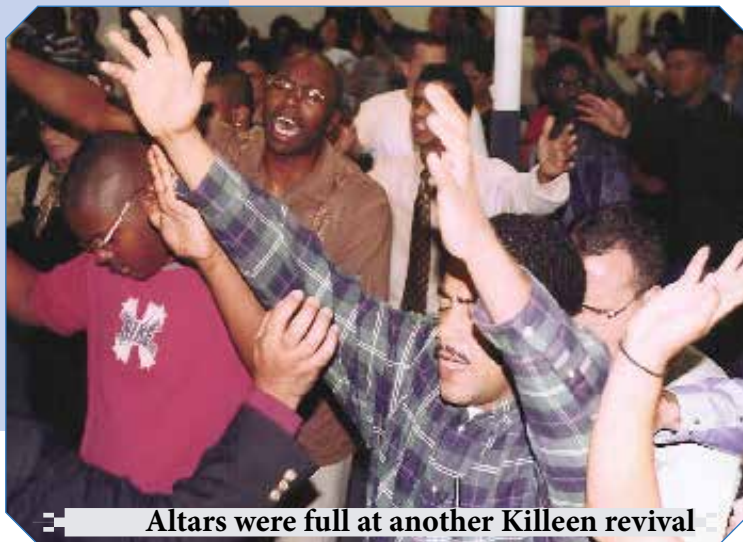

One Thing You Can't Do In Heaven

Mark Cahill - Genesis Press

Mark Cahill writes an inspiring book on evangelism titled "One Thing You Can't Do In Heaven" (win a soul to Jesus!). The premise of the book is that 300 million years from now, the only thing that will be important is who is in heaven, and who is in hell; therefore, that is what should be our major concern now. The book is interesting for several reasons:

- It's written by someone who is passionate and involved in personal evangelism who is not in our fellowship (anyone who goes on the streets knows – we don't have much competition).
- It is not merely a book of vague theory – he is actively involved in personal evangelism, and takes people on the streets himself.
- 3. It has some good inspiration and motivation for witnessing, including poems, illustrations and stories.
- He has some practical tips for novice witnesses, including some suggested answers for common objections people raise.
- He has a good challenge for our heart attitudes that we show sinners as we witness.

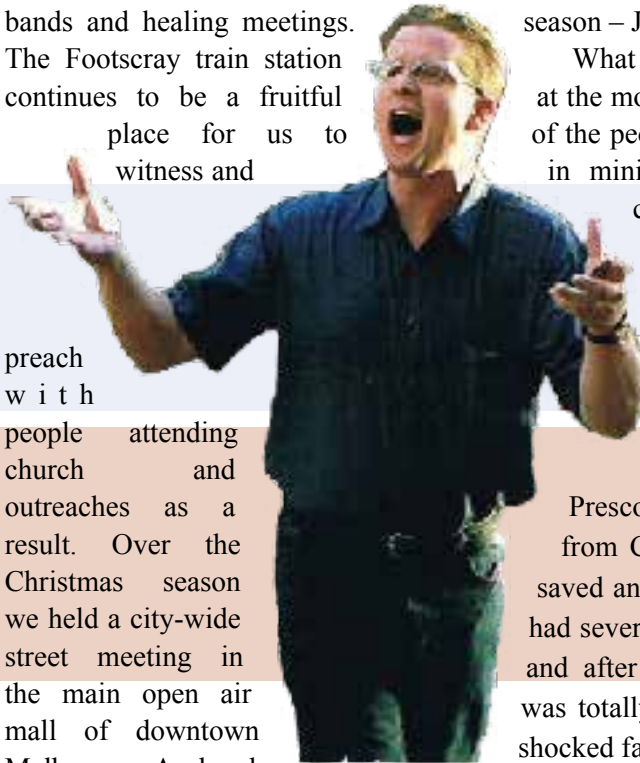

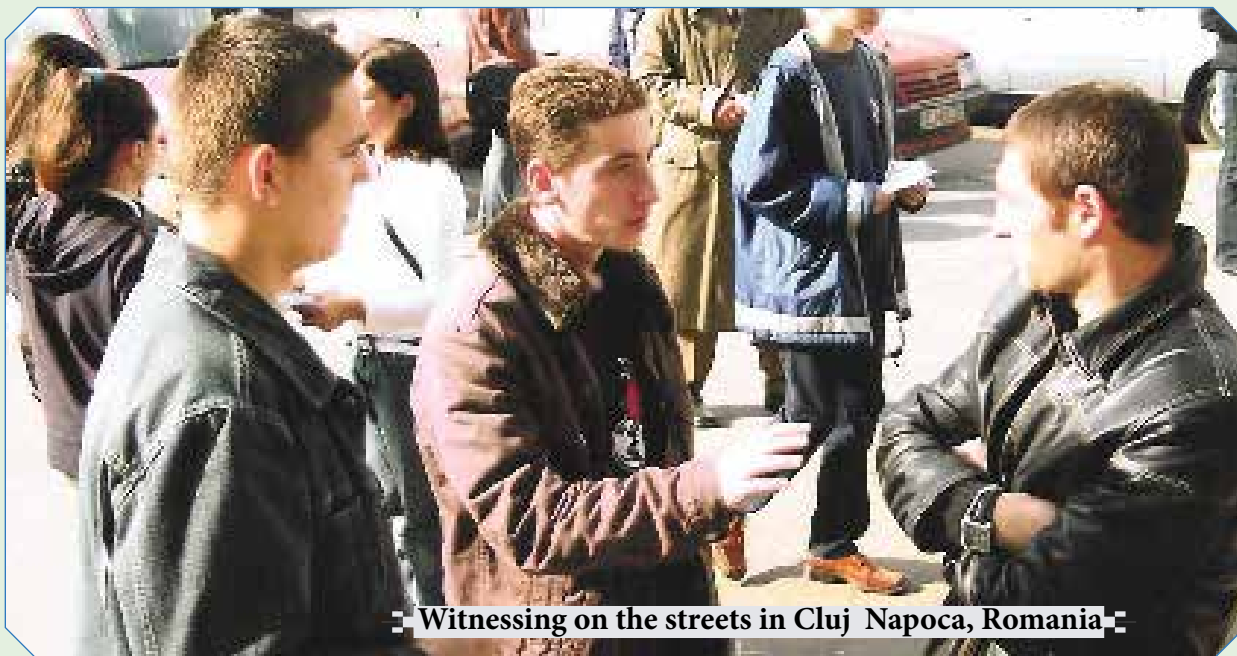

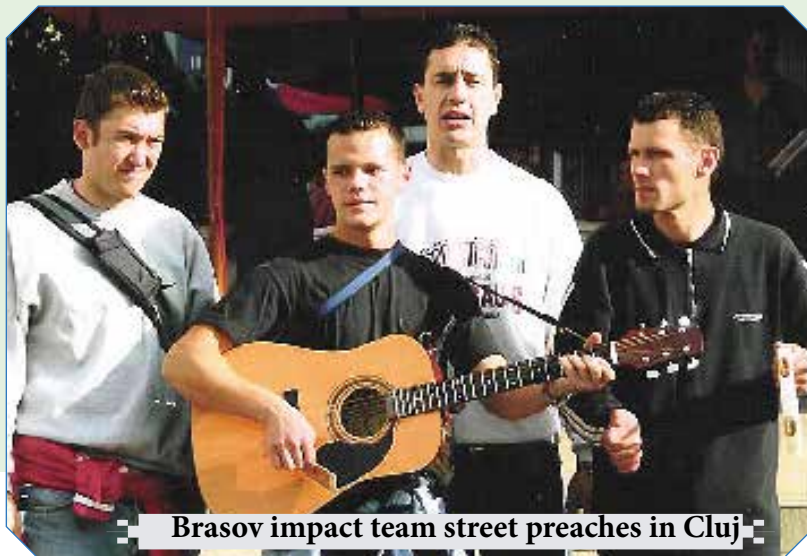
