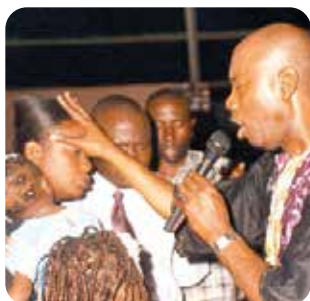

With all that's been happening in Prescott lately, it's hard to believe it's only been three months since our

last report!

We began the month of April with our Extreme Impact youth rally. We had Pastor Bob Overson come in and shake up the 300-plus young people assembled from around the southwest on a Saturday morning, and then sent the kids outreaching our communities. We met that night at the old church on Ruth St. for a concert that nearly brought the house down! When it was all said and done, 60 people had been saved in that one day!

Pastor Overson followed up with a powerful and stirring revival and the church was encouraged and strengthened.

The next week we tried a new outreach: The Family Summer Festival. We took over the downtown plaza with a bluegrass band, puppets, children's skits, and magic tricks on the center stage. Surrounding the area, we set up booths with Face Painting, Games, Sack Races, balloon animals, Quick Draw artists, and anything else you can imagine! We repeated the show every half hour and nearly 1,000 visitors came through that Saturday! We saw 31 souls saved!

In May, we revived a playdonepreviouslycalled The Dream. A powerful visual presentation of the Gospel message, we performed it three nights in the Ruth St. building, and on Memorial Day in the courthouse square. In all, more than 20 people were saved through this ministry.

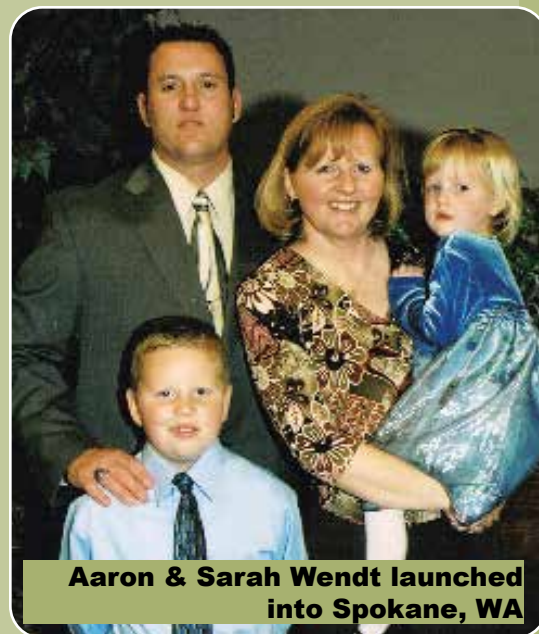
At the end of May, we repeated our Family Festival, this time in Prescott Valley at one of the central parks. This time we saw even more

people come out, because of the holiday weekend and the little league baseball games going on in the adjacent parks. We saw 40 people saved, and several families in the services the next day!

The next week we held our 'Battle of The Bands'. We rented out the Elks Opera House, a historic downtown theater, and had the band 'Sodium Chloride' from Las Vegas come play, along with our own bands, drama, and video. We had more than 100 visitors and 20 people saved that night. And to think, we were doing the same thing we do in our music scene every week, just a block down the road!

We are fishers of men, and we keep changing the bait, and it's working! The spirit of revival and the fruits of it are evident here in Prescott. We are seeing expanded fruitfulness and blessing in all areas of our ministry.

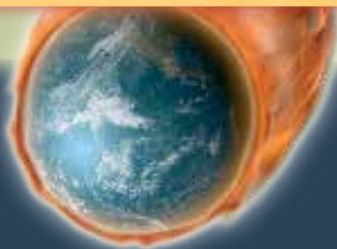

Are you kissing what's killing you?

During the time of Catherine the Great in Russia, a plague broke out that was killing thousands. Catherine commissioned a man to investigate, and he discovered that there was a religious icon that thousands of people would kiss to gain favor, which spread the deadly germs. She had the icon removed to a monastery, but the people were enraged and stormed the monastery, killing the monks, and returning the icon. The question today is: Are you kissing the thing that's killing you?

There's a lot of spiritual truth here. Many times we're kissing what is killing us. 1 Samuel 14:6. *"Then Jonathan said to the young man who bore his armor, come and let us go over to the garrison of these uncircumcised: it may be that the Lord will work for us for nothing restrains the Lord from saving by many or by few. So his armor bearer said unto him, 'Do all that is in your heart, go then here I am with you according to your heart or do all that's in your heart.'"*

The Spirit Of Revival

There's a chemistry between God and man that releases God's power and grace in the affairs of the earth. This is an issue of the heart. This text says "Come, let us go over, let us go up." Let's engage the enemy and see what God will do.

Jonathan and his armor bearer were very young. That speaks of inexperience. There were probably more qualified men. They had no master battle plan or secret weapons, no divine revelation. These are simply two young men and their hearts say, "let's go up, let's see what God will do." And the other says "Do all that is in your heart." Here's the dynamic that is going to release victory. God is going to move in a supernatural way, but it's triggered by two men who say, let's risk - let's put ourselves out there.

In the preceding chapter, Samuel speaks to Saul in 1 Samuel 13:14 *"But now your kingdom shall not continue. The Lord has sought for himself a man after his own heart."* Here we're going to see a shift in the kingdom of God.

One man will be stripped of authority, and another, David, will arise out of obscurity, and the issue is the heart.

What was in David's heart, or Jonathan's heart? Is that in my heart to release a supernatural dimension?

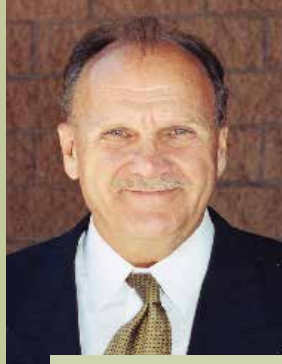
We can have mechanics, or divine revelations, or principles, but we need God to help us in the nations and in cities. Nothing restrains the Lord from saving by many or by few. Call it faith, call it the risk factor, this abandonment to the cause. Let us abandon ourselves and engage the enemy, and see what God will do.

Acts 15:26 *"Men that have hazarded (or risked) their lives for the name of our Lord Jesus Christ"* - like David running to Goliath with a few stones. This

thrill of the heart drives us into reaching beyond our ability, and common sense - beyond security. Here's the willingness to risk in faith, knowing that God can move, and this is what moves His heart.

Revival is not a never-ending outpouring from God. We began in the Jesus people movement, but revival ends, so we must contend to never become satisfied or comfortable with anything less. In the early days, at almost anything we did people would come and get saved. But we continue to evangelize. Sunday night, we probably had six or seven first-time people saved - probably four young men. I thank God for that. But we have to guard our hearts as we get older and the fellowship moves on down the road.

In the early days there was an incredible



dynamic. I remember standing at those pews and being incredibly moved. I wanted to run anywhere in the world for God. Pastor Mitchell had the mind of God to capture what God was doing. It was not our abilities or talents, but every one of us at the drop of a hat were ready to go anywhere in the world. I remember every conference I came expecting and willing that if God would just speak, to go anywhere in the world. That is the chemistry that's involved here. We were pliable in the hands of God, like clay in the Master's hands. He could shape us and direct us at His pleasure. If we ever lose this, we're dead.

The Dangers Of Leadership

"You may be in a place of ministry that you always dreamed about. But do you still have that heart and that dynamic, 'God, you can still move me, I'm still mobile?'" -

Have you ever wondered about the men who rebelled and left God's fellowship, men who at one time were powerfully used by God? You have to ask yourself, how can this happen? Let's talk about a series of land mines that destroy people.

One, rebellion is a path on which you put your foot. It's an issue of the heart.

Let's look at three things that open the door to rebellion.

One is proprietorship, or ownership. This is, "It's my possession, it's my church., it's my city." When that lays hold of us, we become territorial. I understand religious principal, but there are men out there across our fellowship who don't view it that way. *They* got a burden maybe for the Philippines or Australia or England or Mexico or these massive mega cities in the U.S. or around the world, and so what's wrong with the second wave of men going into these cities just like we went years ago? How many of you know that in every city there's no shortage of sinners? They're all over the place, there are millions of

them.

But proprietorship is where we begin to view that city or that church as mine, and we begin to protect it from our own. This does strange things to the human heart. It becomes *your* kingdom now, instead of God's kingdom. It becomes *your* church; it's no longer a fellowship church. That may not happen in a moment, but that's where you're headed. King Nebuchadnezzar said, "Look at this great Babylon which I have built," and God made him crazy for seven years. That's what happens. There is pride and arrogance. You will become manipulative and controlling. Now the decision you make concerning ministry is made from a heart that's flawed with proprietorship. It's no longer the fellowship, and what we can do together. It's no longer the dynamics in which we interlink ourselves around the world for the advancement of the kingdom of God. Behind all the scenes is "How's this going to compute out for me and my corner or my statement or what I am?"

Proprietorship is deadly. It makes your heart a target for the thing [we hate], and what's hindered us is rebellion. *I* built this. *I* sacrificed. *I* deserve this. Now God Himself can't move you, and eventually you'll hate Thursday night at conference.

You have no right to take these churches. They're not yours to do whatever you want with them. That's proprietorship, you see, and it's so hard to detect because you can cover it.

The second land mine is position. This has to do with place, function and title - leadership church, mother church, area leader, national leader, fellowship elder. This gives you dignity, makes you feel good. People look up to you. There's a respect that comes with that. Most of the time you'll host the fellowship events. Other pastors are responsible to you. But the danger is that men get in a position and they've never paid a price of sacrifice for it.

The issue is a shifting of the heart, and what it boils down to is you begin to think you're in the position you're in because you're more qualified, because you're smarter, you're slick, you merit this, or because of your ability. The Bible says these words in Psalms 75:6: "*Promotion comes neither from the east or the west nor from the south, but God, He exalts one, puts down another.*" *Except the Lord build the house... Except the Lord*

keep the city, the watchman watches in vain." Jesus said, "any power, any ministry I have I received from God."

God put you in that position because there was a need in the kingdom at the time, and you were a part of the vision or our fellowship, and what God is doing through our fellowship. God put you there not because you're the sharpest tool in the shed, but because of the dynamic of the home, and the home blesses you. That's why when you see these men (who have left the fellowship), and I've tracked them some here and there, I have not seen one of them continue to do what we do. Ninety percent of them totally detonate, they made a fatal mistake. They thought, "I'm in this position because of my ministry skills, my intelligence, my gifting. And so when I leave the fellowship, I'm going to fly like an eagle."

You are placed in a position because of what God is doing. It's bigger than you and I. We're there to serve, to advance what God's doing and to partner together in the common vision of our fellowship. But when your position begins to be a detriment to the will of God, you're in trouble.

The third landmine is prosperity. There's wealth, you're living good, you have a nice home, you're comfortable. There's security in that, but if you're not careful, this wealth becomes the deciding factor to the will of God. Perks, entitlements - you're hooked on the lifestyle. The food you eat, the clothes you wear, how you travel, where you stay and again, it's "I deserve this." This will begin to influence how you use church finances and resources. Nothing's ever good enough for you. Now your life is measured by money. You begin to shut down spiritually, and lose vision, and begin to compromise. You'll become institutionalized, and that's the picture of the religious world.

You'll begin to lose vision, and no longer come to conference saying, "God speak to me, here am I." The bottom line of all this is self-interest. When you get into self-interest, your will will always be frustrated, and you'll breed bitterness, which will become rebellion.

When this gets hold of your own heart, men begin to cry out. Over years, your own men see the shifting in your heart. The men rising up become a threat to you. 1 Samuel 14:1 is an interesting statement. Jonathan and his armor bearer are going to go up, it says, and

he did not tell his father. Why wouldn't he tell Saul? I believe because he knew that Saul's heart had shifted. Here's Jonathan who has been the instrument of revival and victory and Saul wants to kill him because he ate some honey. And that begins to happen in a heart that has lost vision, and where God has placed you simply becomes a title for your own benefit.

Finally, God has to break it off for it to live. When men enter into rebellion it's not just these guys going their own way, it's God saying, "I can't let it live without me. I've got to break this off, it's killing it from the head down." The Bible says King Saul was torn from the kingdom.

One of the things we deal with is in our Saturday night scenes. We have these people who have been in the church for years. Sometimes they've been out, they fail the ministry and come back or they've been around forever, they're gifted. They have everything down, but they don't have a heart. But they control the Saturday night scene and we wonder why the thing doesn't live. If we don't break it off, that's why a lot of these Saturday night scenes aren't God. And God says, "I don't go anymore." It doesn't have that vibrance, that risk, going up and saying, "Hey, lets try something for God."

I want to close with a thought about our fathers of the Faith. Abraham is the example of the fathers of the Faith today. There's two identifying factors here with God and his life. One is the tent, the other is the altar. Both of these have powerful, spiritual significance. The altar of course is a place of repentance and sacrifice. But the tent, in Hebrews 11:9&10: "*By faith he dwelled in the land of promise as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise. He waited for the city which has foundation whose builder and maker is God.*"

Abraham was always mobile for God. Even after he was in his inheritance, even after he was in the promised land, he still was mobile. You may be in a place of ministry that you always dreamed about. But do you still have that heart and that dynamic, "God, you can still move me, I'm still mobile?"

The sons of Jonadab, Jeremiah 35 v. 7: "*You shall not build a house, sow seed, have a vineyard, nor have any of these,*

Pastor's Viewpoint

Your 'interruption' may be God's plan

The old saying goes "Life is what happens while we have other plans."

One of the frustrating and irritating aspects of life has to do with interruptions. We have things

planned out, or are heading towards a known purpose, when suddenly people or circumstances crash into, and seemingly derail our plans and progress. It is easy to become rigid like the Priest and Levite in Luke 10 who refused to be interrupted from their "godly" plans to make a difference in someone who was hurting.

It is interesting to consider how often in the Bible the purposes of God were accomplished in the manner of interruptions. The pregnancy and birth of Jesus, the calling of Moses, the salvation of the Ethiopian eunuch, and many of the healings Jesus performed (like the paralytic let down through the roof,



Bartimaeus and the woman with the issue of blood) came while people were on

their way to carry out other plans! This thought is so common in the Bible that we need to consider three aspects:

1. **Interruptions can be a test of our heart:** God always demands we recognize His Lordship. Some interruptions are from Him; He wants to know which is more important – His will or our plans? God deliberately presents

some opportunities in an inconvenient way or time for this purpose.

2. **Interruptions can be the means of other people's blessing:** In the feeding of the 5,000, someone's lunch plans had to be interrupted so that thousands could be fed and blessed. Opportunities rarely can conveniently be booked in advance. Which are more important to us; People, or our plans?

3. **Interruptions can be God's manner of directing us into fruitfulness and His will:** Jesus interrupted the disciples' career plans to become what He wanted them to be – "fishers of men." It's amazing how many men of God who say they had no intention of being in the ministry, or going to that city or nation; yet their response triggered blessings for many.

Overall, it is obedience that releases miracles and blessing. Therefore, may God help us to have hearts that obey when His opportunities come in the form of an interruption: Money we weren't planning to give, people we weren't planning on speaking to, churches, cities, or nations that weren't on the agenda, or a calling we didn't have in mind. **John 2:5** says, ... "Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it!"

but all your days you shall dwell in tents that you may live many days in the land where you are sojourners. Thus we've obeyed the voice of Jonadab the son of our father in all that he charged us to drink no wine all our days, nor our wives, our sons, our daughters, nor to build ourselves houses or to dwell in, nor do we have vineyards, fields, or seed. We have dwelt in tents, and will obey you then according to that Jonadab our father commanded us." Verse 18: "And Jeremiah said to the house of Rechabites, thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel; because you've obeyed the commandment of Jonadab your father, and kept his precepts, and done according to all

that he commanded you, therefore thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel, Jonadab shall not lack a man to stand before me forever."

Right there is a powerful truth. If we bury the tent, we kill the disciples. Something begins to be off. The Bible says, "because you've done this." There's a spiritual dynamic when we keep that kind of heart. There's something that's in the spirit realm - a favor, an anointing, a transcendence if you will, that we're able to move from generation to generation. But the moment we bury the tent, we're no longer qualified to be a father in the faith. Once you do that, your disciples will begin to die because there's

dynamics that are passed down.

It is critical that we stay mobile for God no matter where God wants to place us. And so I want to propose by July conference everyone here prepares to (move). Can you imagine the impact and the explosion that it would have? Can you imagine what God might do? So what just went through your head? Or should I say your heart? Did you immediately begin to build your case? "I'm too old." I walked away from Chandler, 300 people. I waited years to be where I'm at. I built this church, pulled down the house with my wife, my kids. I'll never have again what I had.

Did you resent that I made that statement? Or did your heart weep? Are you kissing what's killing you?

view it as God giving us more people who will get saved and take the gospel further into the world.

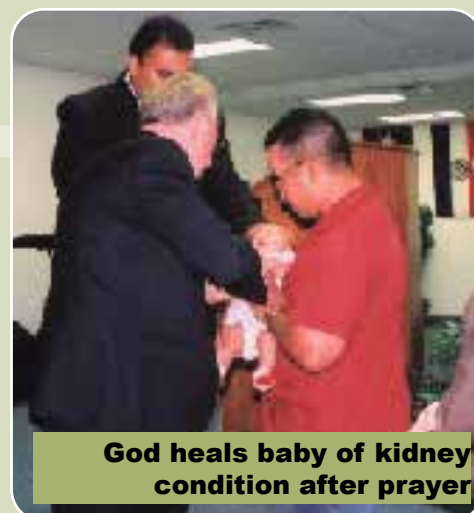

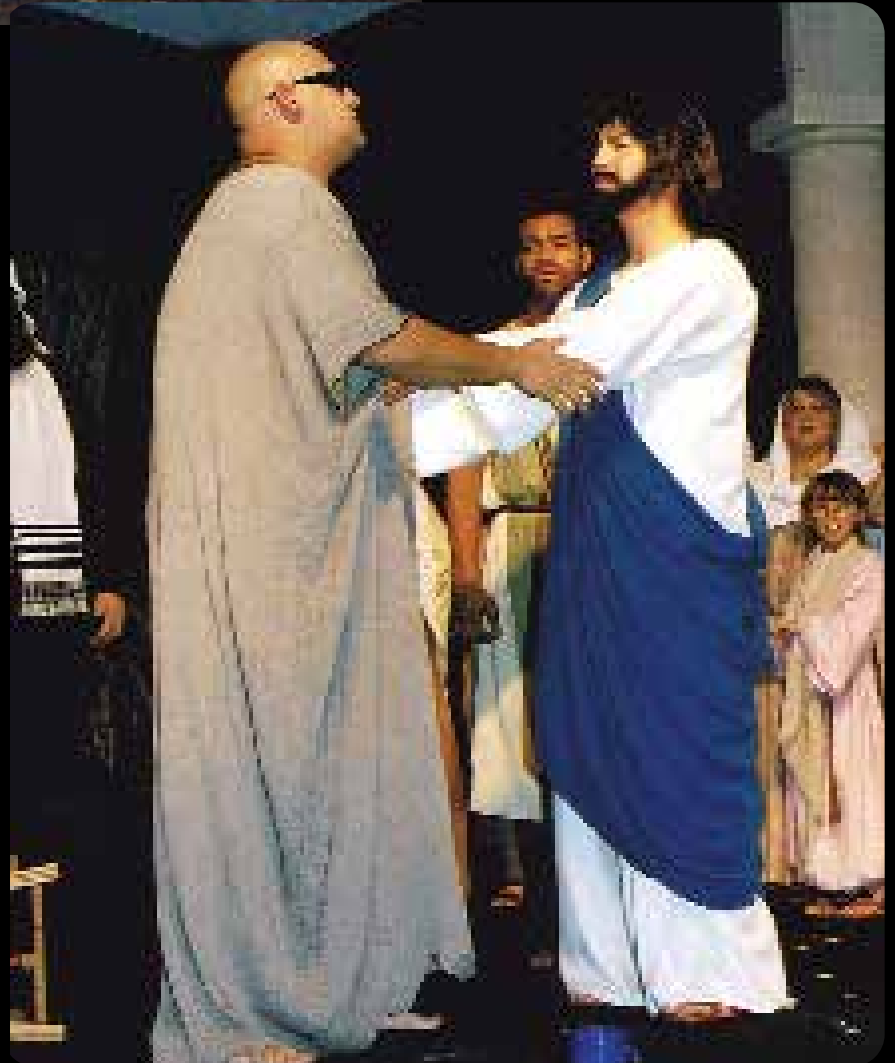

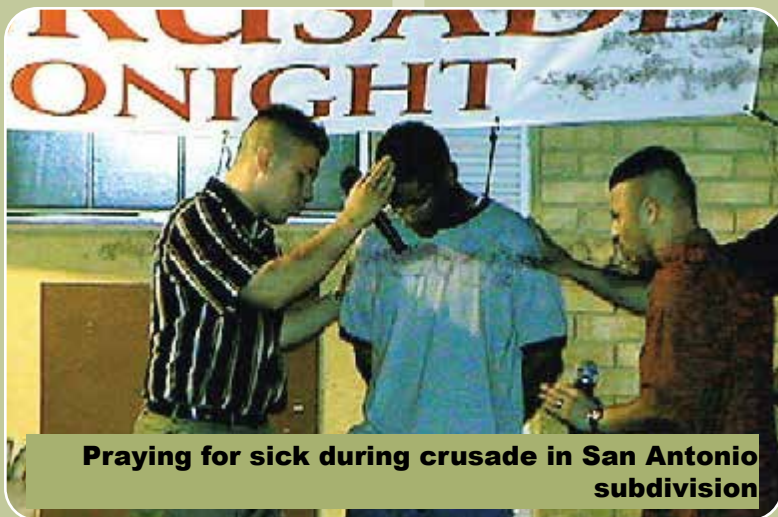

The Rapture: Who Will Face the Tribulation?

by Tim LaHaye – Harvest House Publishers

While Tim LaHaye has ventured heavily into the end-times fiction market, this doctrinal book is very worthwhile.

The Pre-Tribulation Rapture is increasingly coming under attack (as the Bible predicted it would) in Christian circles. Dominion theology (essentially Christians become more powerful and eventually take over government and the earth, bringing in Christ's rule) is pervading the church more and more, and the new doctrinal emphasis is Preterism (The belief that all end-times prophecies were fulfilled in 70 A.D.) Add to that the shrill attacks by Mid-and-Post Tribbers, and it becomes necessary for us to clearly understand and be able to articulate correct doctrine concerning the Rapture.

Many Christians (and some Pastors!) shy away from prophecy as it can be complicated. LaHaye writes a comprehensive, but understandable book that answers the key question as it relates to the question of Rapture timing: *Who will be in the Tribulation?* LaHaye covers the issue in 3 sections:

1. The Blessed hope of all Christians
2. The scriptural basis of the Pre-Tribulation Rapture view
3. Answering attacks on the Pre-Tribulation Rapture view. In

While Tim LaHaye has ventured heavily into the end-times fiction market, this doctrinal book is

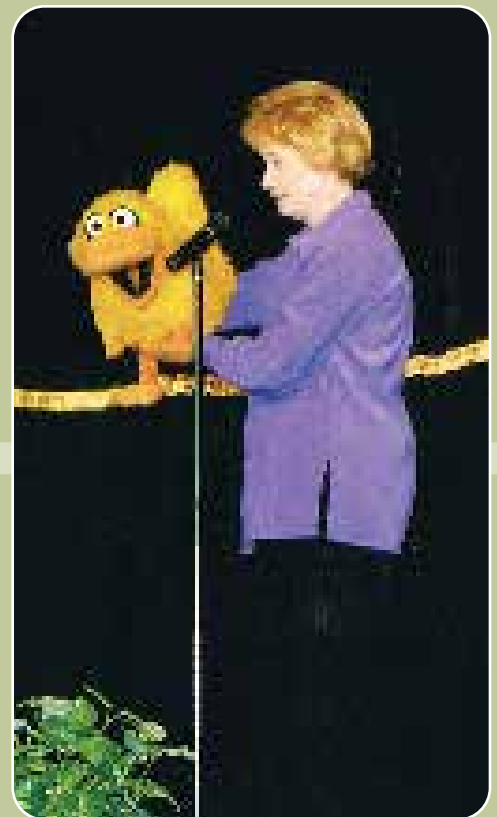
this section he deals with the current wave of attacks on the Rapture – that it is a recent phenomenon propagated from essentially one man (Darby) who supposedly got his views from a teenaged girl's vision.

LaHaye also includes several appendices that are very helpful to understanding prophecy in general. These include a basic rule of interpretation, and the crucial understanding that Israel and the church are not the same. The Bible does instruct us to *...be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you... 1 Pet 3:15*, and I believe that one issue that will increasingly need an answer for attacks against it, is the Rapture. This book will help to understand one of the most important issues of the Christian faith.

Sister Leony Baterzal who handed over to us this church with lots of potential in the kingdom of God.

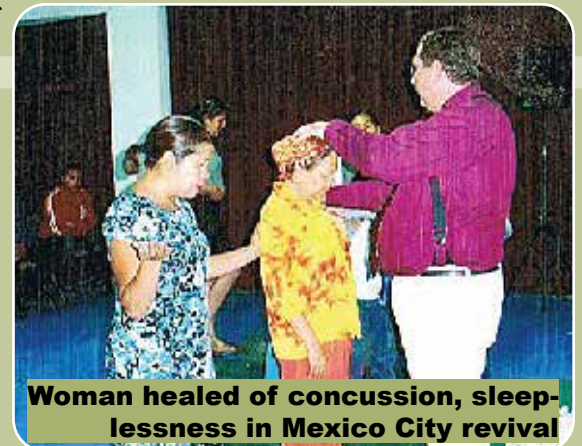

Just as we were preparing for the movie the chief of the area came and told us to shut down, so we did, with the crowd calling to us to stay. That Sunday we had 15 people come to church and they reported to us that after we left the crowd went to the chief's house and beat him and tore the roof off his house. The government secretary of the area came to church and got saved, and told us that we will never be stopped from doing whatever we want in the entire area (barrio) again. In classic Potter's House style we were back the

next Saturday, minus the chief this time. God gave a double portion - we had more than 500 people, with 350-plus responding to salvation.

We started revival with Pastor Bart Kooijker that Sunday and 45 people from the outreach came to church. This took our attendance to 106 with 42 people saved and 15 healed of various infirmities. Pastor Kooijker's preaching reminded us to "be sober and vigilant." He ministered great encouragement to the saints. We have been greatly helped and revived.

Some disciples did a healing outreach in another area, walking house to house and using bullhorns to announce "prayer for the sick." They saw 50 salvations, prayed for about 15 people with pain and sickness, and all testified of being completely healed.

We now have two growing home bible studies, with 20-25 people in each who regularly outreach their neighbors. At a recent concert scene, a visitor got saved and was in church every service of revival Sunday through Wednesday, at outreach Friday and Saturday night, and was baptized on Sunday morning, baptized in the Holy Spirit Sunday night, and at outreach on Monday night! What's so amazing? She is 60 years old. All Glory to God for His abundance and grace.

Always our love and thanks to Pastor Tilli and Carolyn, the Footscray church. We are truly grateful for the investment and impartation of vision, example,

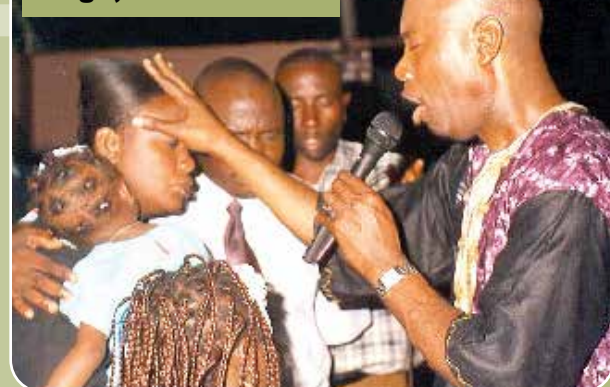

As I close our greatest prayer is that God will prosper our Church here in Lubumbashi so we can be self supported and subsequently open doors to take the very vast nation before Christ returns.

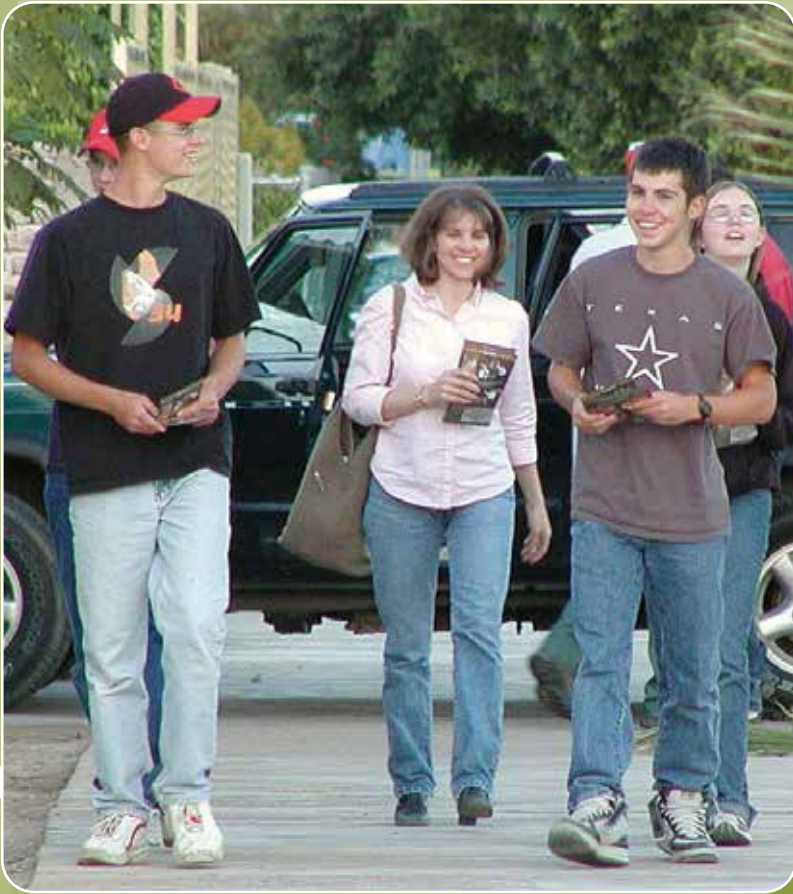

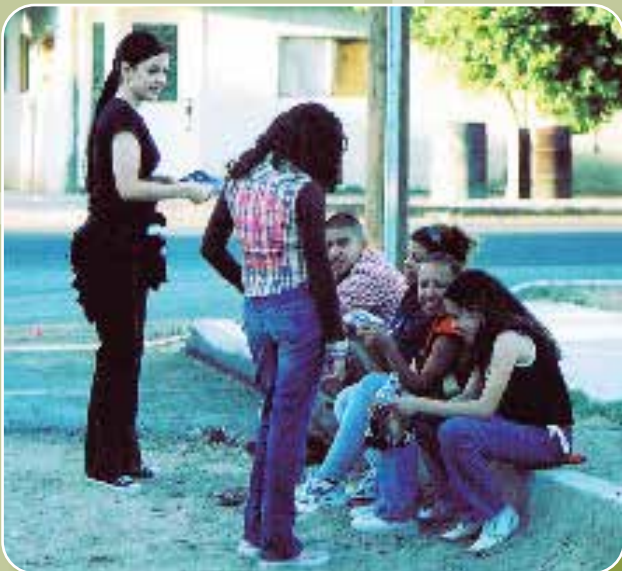
