The New Year finds us amazed and thrilled at what God has been doing in Prescott! In October, we were blessed with the ministry of Evangelist Jerry Fussel. What a powerful time we had as God moved and many lives were touched. Many sinners and backsliders were saved during the week, and on the last night, 21 people were filled with the Holy Ghost!

On Sunday, October 31st we had a follow up fellowship for all the new converts from the Haunted House, and many were there. Many of the converts are still with us and a few have already been baptized!

The winter season has seen us continuing our Men's Discipleship classes with Lee Wilson and Paul Stephens, and men have been stirred and challenged!

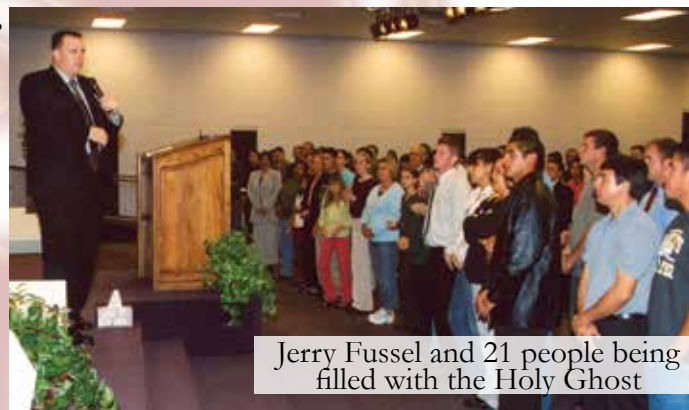

In October, Pastor Mitchell traveled to Jacksonville, North Carolina for a Southern Pioneer Rally with David Szcsepanski and Joe Campbell. The growth of that rally necessitated a larger auditorium, a great indicator of what is happening in that area where God is at work.

Pastor Mitchell attended the San Antonio Bible Conference in Pastor Richard Rubi's (who is the area leader) church. Capacity crowds in his new building foretell a need for new facilities soon as a conference venue. A number of pioneer churches out of the conference

are a good sign of spiritual health!

Pastor Mitchell spoke at the Mid-Atlantic Rally in Philadelphia Pennsylvania. Pastor John Overson who has taken that pastorate is doing a good job in leading them.

Pastor Mitchell traveled to Buenos Aires, Argentina for their national conference. John Maiolo, who is a natural leader in Argentina organized a dynamic conference! People and pastors from Chile, Uruguay and Argentina had a glorious conference. Two pioneer works

planted in Argentina and one in Chile testify to the vision of the fellowship being carried out in that area!

Pastor did rallies or Men's Discipleships in Grants, New Mexico, Redlands, California, and Seattle, Washington.

In November, Pastor Mitchell preached in the London, England conference in Walthamstow, but had to cancel a planned rally in Zwolle, Holland because of laryngitis and return early.

On one occasion, Napoleon, in his quest to rule the world, encountered unexpected resistance while attempting to capture an island in the Mediterranean. The fighting was fierce and he lost many good men in the battle, before finally overcoming the enemy.

Napoleon and his generals were to have a celebration feast when a young officer approached the great conqueror and stood waiting for an audience. Napoleon saw him, and asked abruptly, "What do you want?" The young man said, "Sir, please give me this island." The generals were deeply offended at the brashness of the young man, but suddenly, Napoleon asked for pen and ink, and promptly wrote out a deed to the island, signed it and gave it to the young officer.

The generals were astounded. They asked their leader, "How could you give away this island to that young man when so many of our men paid such a high price to obtain it?" Napoleon responded, "He honored me by the magnitude of his request."

Faith demands audacity. How else can you describe the young officer's request? His faith was so outrageous that he asked for an island! Consider what this means to us. What kind of nerve do we need to ask for a soul, a city, or even a nation? Not to mention the assortment of personal needs and challenges we face.

The Psalmist, speaking by the Holy Spirit, challenges us to be audacious in our faith when he wrote, "Ask of Me, and I will give you the nations for your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for your possession."

God, too, is honored by grand requests. "Thy kingdom come..." by its very appeal reaches into glories far beyond the grasp of our natural selves. Looking forward to great things from God, Jeremiah exclaimed, "Nothing is too difficult for thee." Our big prayers please God because they recognize his ability to deliver them.

The important thing to remember is that the focus of our grand request is not mere objects. When the Psalmist said "nations", he is referring to the people groups of the earth. The glimpse of Heaven's roll call in Rev. 5 (representatives from every nation, tongue, kindred, and people) is a fulfillment of Psalms 102:8. It challenges my faith to realize that God's work is related to the prayers of those who have the nerve to ask.

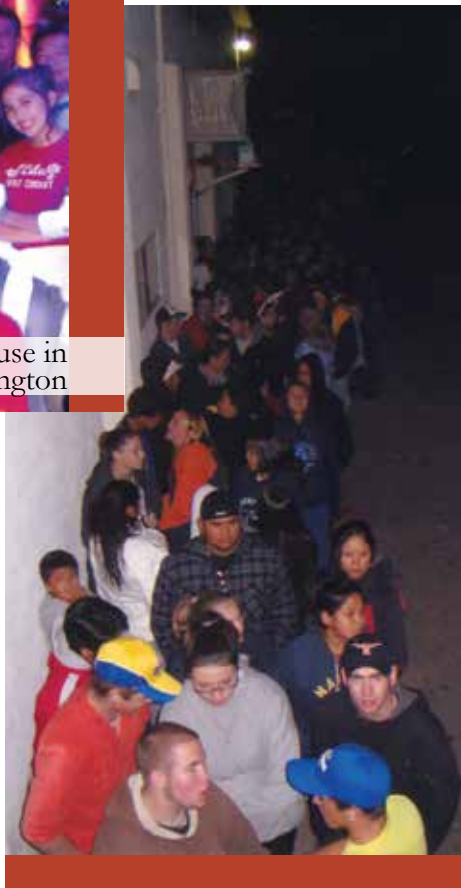

The ACLJ promptly wrote a letter to Hanover's solicitor, who wisely realized that they spoke truth and advised the police to rescind their demand. When Pastor visited the chief of police as a follow-up to the letter, the chief treated him with respect -the spirit of intimidation he had previously exhibited had departed. Chief said that no permits were required and that the police would afford us any necessary protection at Dutch Days.

As more than 50 Holy Ghost-filled street preachers took turns proclaiming the gospel, event organizers tried to

shut us down. They called police, who listened to their complaints, explained that it's our constitutional right to preach the gospel, and walked away, leaving the organizers frustrated and fuming. Breakthrough! And three precious souls were saved during the preaching - glory to God!

That was in July. In October, we had our first Haunted House - "Your Worst Nightmare." Visitors numbered 218, and 88 surrendered their hearts to Jesus Christ as they were confronted with the reality of judgment and eternity. Again, breakthrough!

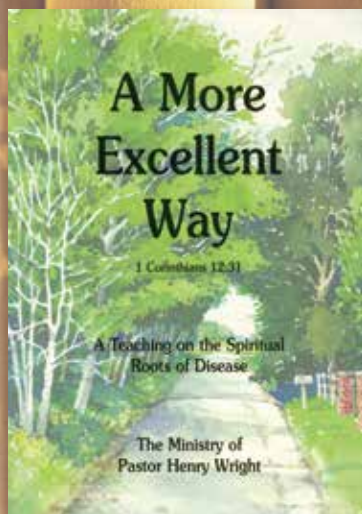

Since we first started the youth scene, we have seen it grow from 30, to over 100 constant young disciples!

The concert scene is also exploding, with over 50 people saved in only 5 concerts in the past month and a half! Another fantastic movement we are having is that of the older generation! In the last 8 months we have seen couples in their 40's locking in, and it is amazing to see a solid core of ex-drinking buddies all now in the same church worshipping God!

In May 2003 a young man was saved. His parents were divorced and he was living with his mum. His mum became concerned of his sudden commitment to Christ and sent his father to go and check out the church. He did, and first service gave his life to Christ. Not long after, the mother also came out and got saved. God has done such a wonderful miracle, and now they are re-married and are both in church living for God.

The King Williams Town church has now been self-supporting since June 03, and this year, the church was able to make a financial investment internationally, by sending Pastor McCann to Zimbabwe and sponsoring their Pioneer Shepherds for 18 pastors and their wives! We also fully support our 2 pioneer works, which are continuing to grow and mature.

The last year really has been a real season of reaping, as we are seeing over 200 people faithfully coming out each Sunday morning. The church has also been through some renovations inside, with the new balcony being restructured, and an all-round renovation to our building being done. At the moment we are believing God for another vehicle, as it is getting harder and harder to transport people home after night services due to

amazing thing it is to see what God has done in the last ten years, the lives changed, churches planted and nations impacted. What a privilege to be a part of God's work on the earth today.

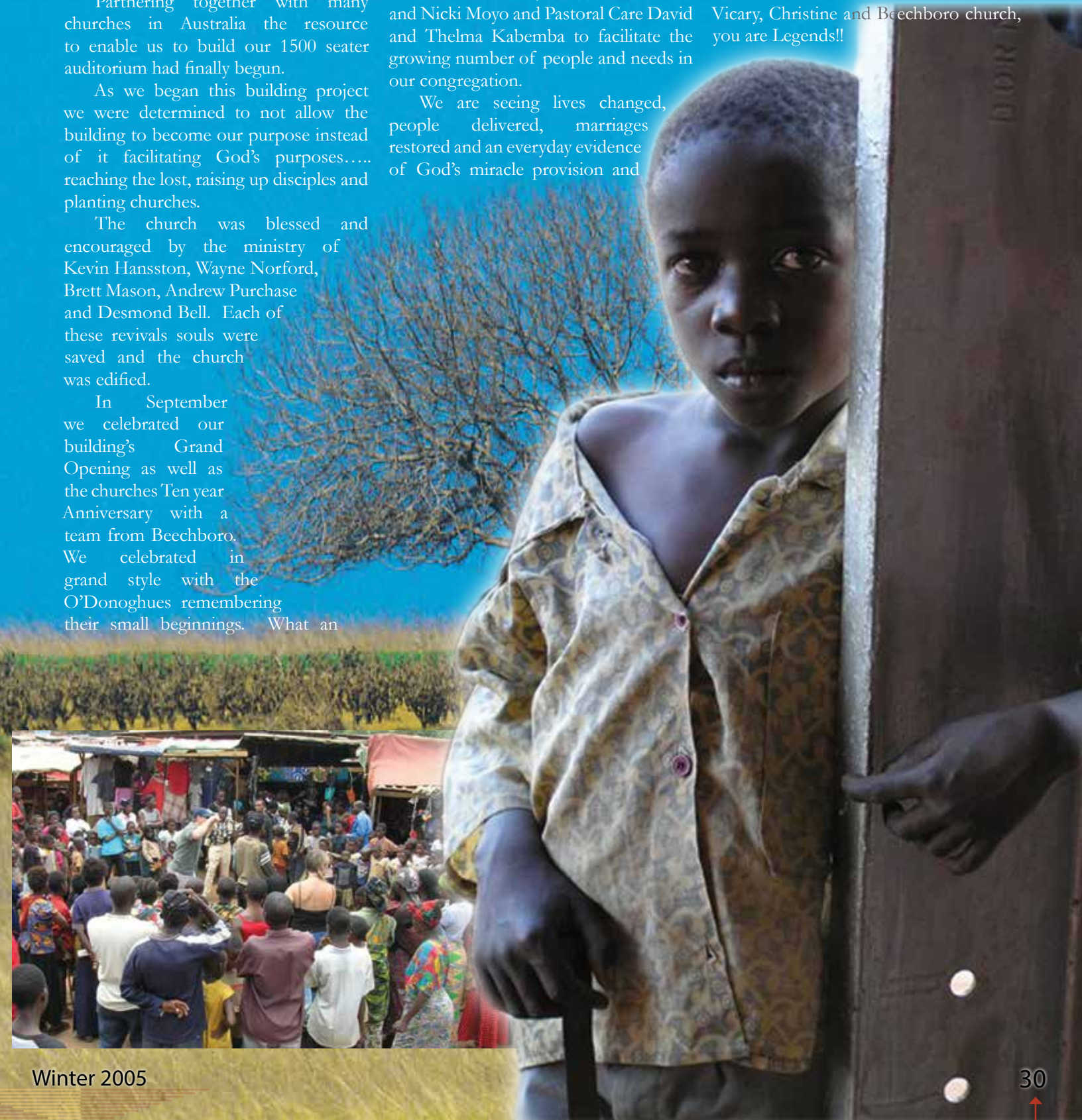

Greetings from Kitwe, Zambia! So many things are happening here, it's hard to know where to start!

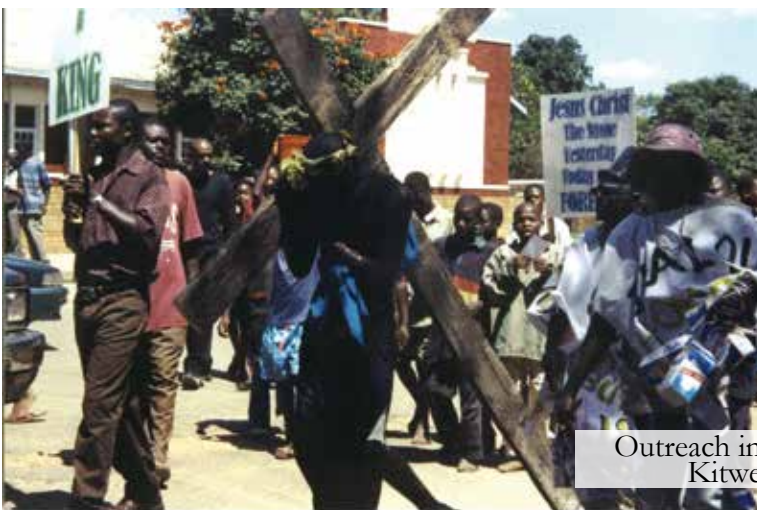

We have had some great revivals this year with Jeff Baker, Rob Walsh, John

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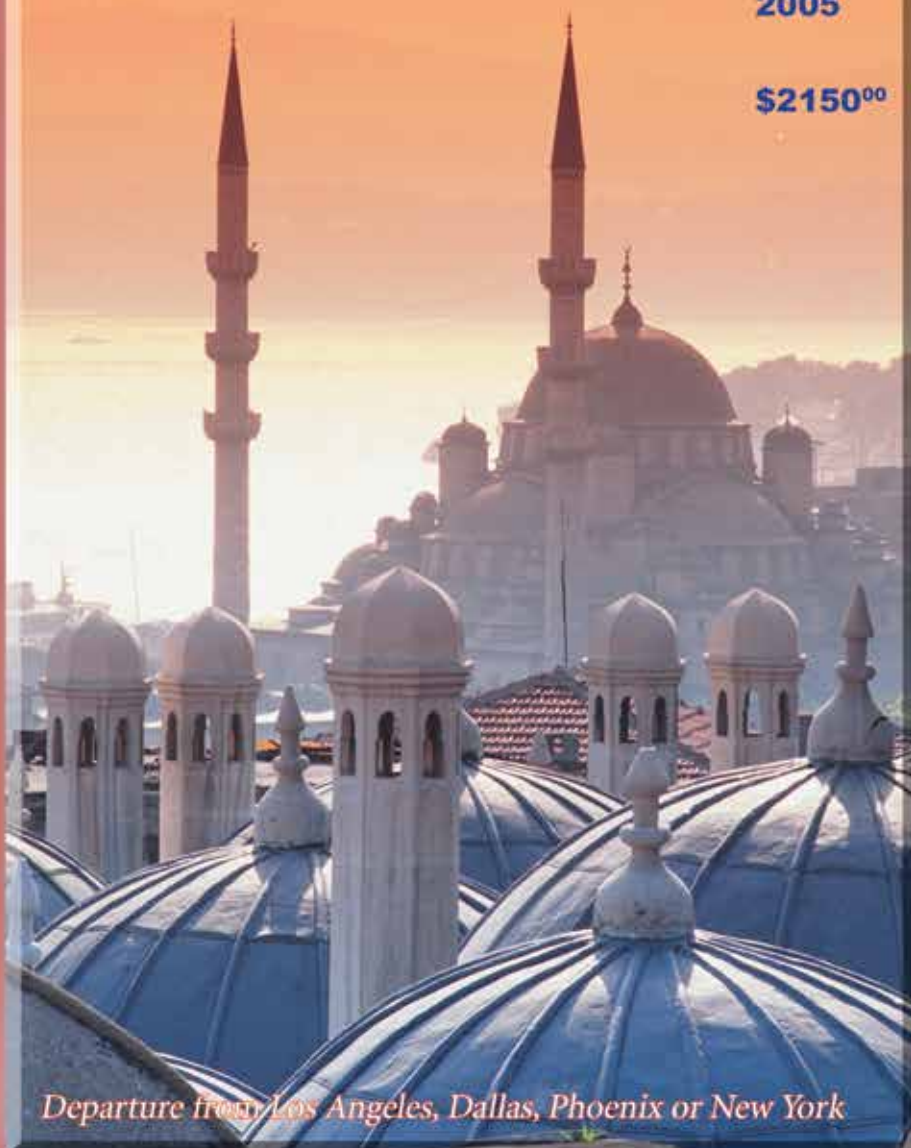
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
