During the month of May the Prescott church saw some things that have been a part of our regular schedule of ministry end, and some new ministry opportunities.

In May we had the last area-wide men's discipleship class with Pastor Greg Mitchell, which we have been blessed to host for men from all over Arizona all winter. May also saw the final gathering of our home Bible study groups that have been going on all over the local area since last fall.

At the end of May we have the first of our concert outreaches in the heart of downtown Prescott at the courthouse plaza to kick off our busy summer outreach season. Our focus again turns outward and we begin to make preparations for all of the great opportunities of ministry that the Lord has given us.

Several exciting and fruitful events occurred in April of this year. One of the highlights of our church every year is the crusade in San Luis, Sonora, Mexico. We took eight van loads of young people south of the border to participate with other Mexican and American churches in this important outreach. Many needy folks gather in an open air amphitheater to hear Pastor Greg Mitchell and Pastor Rich Cox preach the gospel and heal the sick. Many hundreds of people are born again and scores of people are instantly healed of many different ailments. Our young people get a first hand look at evangelism in a foreign culture and the impact on them is profound. It's much more exciting to see this in person than in the best conference video!

We also had a Youth Extreme day of outreach and evangelism, with hundreds of teens from around Arizona coming to Prescott for a day of evangelism and out-

reach. Peter Ajala from Great Britain ministered to the young people and then we turned them loose on our little town. Many were saved during the day and in the concert at the Underground that evening. Pastor Ajala then commenced a revival meeting for the Prescott church with a powerful ministry to many of the faithful saints. His words cut to the heart of many issues and the Word was applied to our hearts for healing and restoration. Many felt that God was preparing us for something great in the near future.

We continue to use the opportunities available to us to spread the Gospel far and wide. We send impact teams to other cities to spend the entire days outreaching and evangelizing. We send our music groups to help in concert ministries or in shopping center parking lots or wherever an opportunity is available to preach the gospel. The Underground powers on every Saturday night and we still see people saved from this long standing ministry.

The Prescott church has been blessed in many ways over the years. We have faithful pastors, fellowship support, international expression, and a bright future. But the greatest treasure of the Prescott church is its people. Men who are faithful to their wives, families who sacrifice financial gain and career prestige to support the church's ministry, people who sacrifice their time and money to be involved in evangelism. This is not unique to us as many of you do the same things we do. But without the support of faithful people very little could be done in this or any church. People who give, who pray, who witness, who minister far from the bright lights of the platform.

People who make it possible for Pastor to travel and new pastors to be sent out. These ordinary people who have given so much and will continue to give of themselves to fulfill the work of the ministry in Prescott Arizona and around the world.

Spain, Russia, Phillippines on Pastor's travel list

Pastor Mitchell has been busy in ministry involving two-day preaching engagements in Carbondale, Illinois, El Paso, Texas, Gallup, New Mexico, and the East Coast Conference in Cape Cod, Massachusetts. He also preached the Friday night service of the Tucson, Arizona conference.

An area-wide rally in Killeen, Texas and Santa Fe, New Mexico and an area-wide Men's Discipleship in Redlands, California rounded out his preaching schedule.

Pastor Mitchell preached Friday of the Las Vegas, Nevada Pioneer Rally with Pastors Joe Campbell, Tom Payne, Mark Aulson and Scott Lamb. He joined Pastors Campbell, Rich Cox, Richard Rubi and Paul Stephens for another Pioneer Rally in Redlands, California.

Pastor and Mrs. Mitchell traveled to Almeria, Spain at the invitation of Alberto Maleno to conduct a Miracle Crusade in a large sports center. Pastors Nigel Brown and Evert Valk

conducted seminars in the mornings. Two newspapers and camera men attended on the first night and gave full page stories and photographs in local newspapers the next day. Approximately 150 new convert cards were recorded over the four nights and several visible, instantaneous miracles of healing took place.

Sermon workshops over two days took Pastor Mitchell to Raleigh, North Carolina along with Pastors Terry Haynes, Dave Szczpanski, and Paul Stephens. These workshops involved several new area pastors and was outstanding in spiritual dynamics.

Pastor traveled to Manila, Philippine Islands to join Pastor Glen Cluck from Guam, Marianas Islands for the Philippine National Conference with overseer Alberto Desepida. The conference sent out three pioneer churches in the Philippines and a pioneer worker to Dubai in the Middle East.

Russian national leader Sergei

Golubev invited Pastor Mitchell and Pastor Scott Lamb to Russia to conduct intensive Men's Discipleship Seminars. One hundred and fifty Russian men, many of whom are pastors, came for two days and one evening of ministry.

Tent crusades in Las Cruces, New Mexico, and Albuquerque, New Mexico, and Men's Rallies in Redlands, California and San Jose, California, along with an outside Miracle Crusade in Ogden, Utah capped off the last six month's activities.

All of these events and the dramatic results were all the result of local churches and leaders investing money, time and prayer to furnish an arena for ministry and build the Kingdom of God by engaging lost souls with the Gospel, bringing salvation, healing and deliverances through Jesus Christ.

Pastor Mitchell said he is eternally grateful for the support and the opportunities people in the Fellowship provide for him to minister around the world.

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San Luis Mexico outreach is life changing

The bustling border city of San Luis, RC, Sonora, Mexico is the setting for one of the most exciting and fruitful outreaches of the year, and one of Pastor Wayman Mitchell's favorites.

For many years the San Luis church and the Prescott church have partnered together to put on an open air salvation/miracle healing crusade.

This year for the first time in recent memory Pastor Mitchell could not be there, but Pastor Greg Mitchell joined with Pastor Rich Cox from Redlands, California to preach the crusade services. God was faithful and many souls were saved and bodies instantly

healed.

The crusade services are the capstone to many different activities designed to give our American young people a taste of evangelizing in a foreign county.

Young people from Prescott, Arizona; McMinnville, Oregon; Tempe, Arizona; Redlands, California; Oceanside, California; Yuma, Arizona; and others joined the saints from northern Sonora for a day of intense evangelism.

On Saturday morning more than 400 people joined together to invade the city. There was a big Jesus parade with police escort winding its way around one section of the city preaching the Gospel as it went.

Four separate "believers marches" worked their way along city streets, with Christians preaching at every opportunity.

Bands played in four separate city parks while many Americanos tried out their Spanish in witnessing. Two groups went to drug rehab centers where they preached a gospel message and many responded.

The crusade services are held in an open air enclosed amphitheater. Each night saw from 1,200 to 1,500 in attendance. A simple gospel message is preached and the altars are packed with desperate souls being saved. A mass prayer is prayed and many come to the platform to testify that Jesus has instantly healed them..

For the three nights of crusades 500 were saved and more than 100 were notably healed. It is amazing to see what God does for these poor of the world's goods, yet rich in faith.

Pastor's Viewpoint

We must cultivate ability to 'move on'

Anyone who has a few years on them will be able to recognize this truth: Life turns out differently than you planned!

Life takes us on twists and turns that are often unpredictable – and unexpected. Whether these are our own expectations meeting reality, tragedies, personal failures, people violations or the failures of those we relate to – chances are good we didn't think we'd be in this place.

These situations are common to every person. What hurts people is when they fail to allow for negative changes, and therefore respond incorrectly. Human nature wants to focus on the loss, failure or tragedy, and make it the center of our lives.

What tragic words these are: *They never got over it.* God had to rebuke Samuel in **1 Sam 16:1** *Finally, the LORD said to Samuel, "You have mourned long enough for*

Saul. I have rejected him as king of Israel. Now fill your horn with olive oil and go to Bethlehem. Find a man named Jesse who lives there, for I have selected one of his sons to be my new king."

God is saying there comes a point when to focus on what can't be changed becomes detrimental – to us, and the purposes of God. He says there comes a point when it's time to move on. 3 things will help us to move on:

1. We must allow for loss. Make plans and believe for the best, but there must be room in our 'theology' to allow for negative circumstances. This is not pessimism, but wisdom.

2. We must have confidence in the wisdom of the unchanging God! God is never taken by surprise, and we must trust that He is still in control. People may fail, but God never fails. God always has a plan.

3. We must keep going and moving on. During the time-frame of processing loss, there are right actions that are critical to our survival. A great mistake is when people stop doing all they know is right, because they are hurting or confused. God grace is available to those who need help in time of need.

Greetings from Corpus Christi, TX where Jesus is changing lives.

I was 19 years old and in the U.S. Navy when I first got saved and baptized in the Thames River in Groton, CT. I experienced true peace and happiness for three months. Then the Navy sent me out to sea for the first time in my military career.

Leaving my godly support behind, I left God's grace and backslid for 13 years! During this time I fell deep into various sins: animal abuse/murder, fornication, idolatry, false religions, and deceptions. I then experienced some family curses: schizophrenia (a severe mental illness), perversion, and pride.

Because of my mental disorder, the doctors prescribed psychological drugs, anti-depressants, and other medications, but they only gave me an artificial high and did not help me. I was still full of anger, bitterness and hatred.

In 2004 God was still reaching out to me, and a seed of hope, love, and compassion was replanted in my life through

a young lady who went to The Door CFC in Corpus Christi, Texas.

I went to church half-heartedly for a couple of months, but continued doing illegal drugs, drinking and fornicating. Then finally, in July 2006 I left my life of sin behind!

I went back to The Door CFC in Corpus Christi, Texas (which is my current home) and I repented and asked God for forgiveness of my sins and I was welcomed back into his kingdom and his church. I put all my faith in God, believing that he would heal me of my mental disorder (extreme paranoia and suicidal thoughts), my depression, and diabetes. I stopped taking the medicines for these symptoms and to this day, I'm still healed!

I just want to thank GOD for what he has done for me.

God moved. One of the men that I had talked to had forgotten to remove his for rent sign off the front lawn. He said he already had the house rented but would be willing to show it to us on Friday at noon. We showed up and we immediately loved the house. He mentioned that the woman who had rented the house had backed out and asked if we were interested. We of course were.

We filled out paper work for a background check that he said would take about three to five days to get the results. That was at 12:30. We went back to the hotel and right when we walked into our room, the man called and said, "You know what, if you want the house you can come get the keys right now, don't worry about the background check." We were able to get out of the hotel without having to pay and drove our Budget truck right over to the house, signed the lease, gave him the rent and deposit and started moving in at 3 p.m.!

We had our first church services on December 2, 2007 at the hotel conference room. Since then we have seen God move continuously. I witnessed to a family at Wal-mart, and Billy showed up in our Sunday night service right when we had finished service (we had no visitors that night) and were putting everything up. Immediately my family and I ran around putting everything back in order and had service all over again. Billy got saved that night!

The following Wednesday he showed up with his wife and kids, they all got saved that night also! The amazing thing is that this family keeps bringing others to church with them, especially the teenagers that are getting gloriously saved; we have more teenagers than adults; and the majority

of these coming in are from Texas!

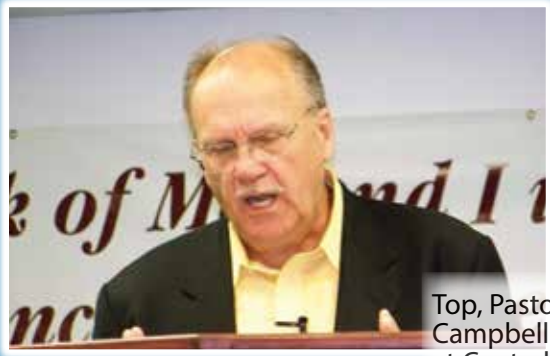

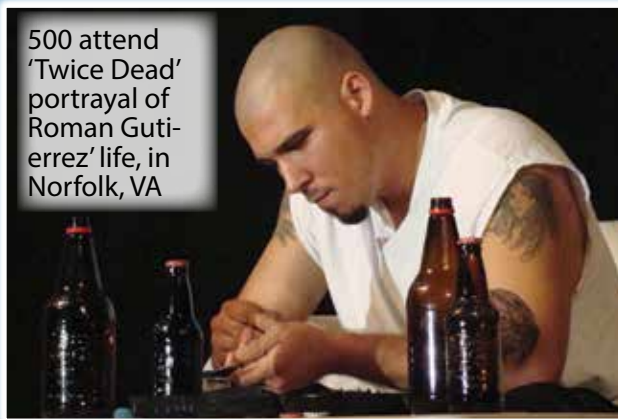
The last night of the play we saw more than 500 people in attendance and the altars were packed with brand new souls!

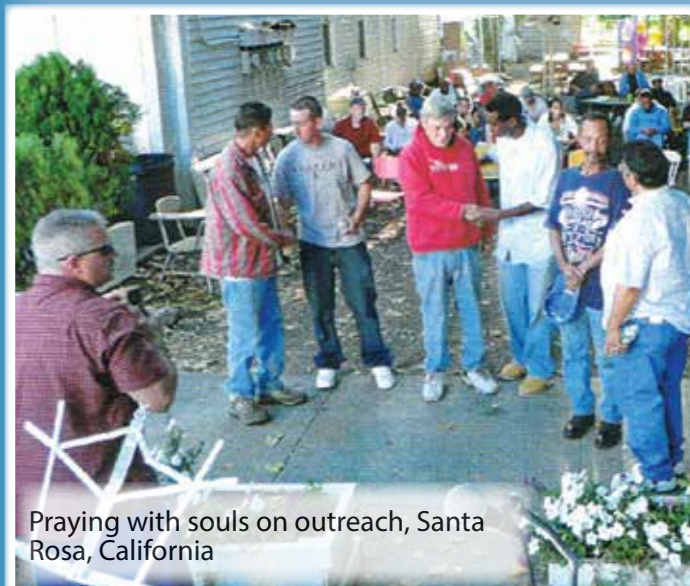
We are currently in the process of renovating our Saturday Night Xtreme. We took a trip to Prescott's Underground, and are stirred with a renewed vision.

We kicked it off with Hector Ortiz preaching an awesome sermon

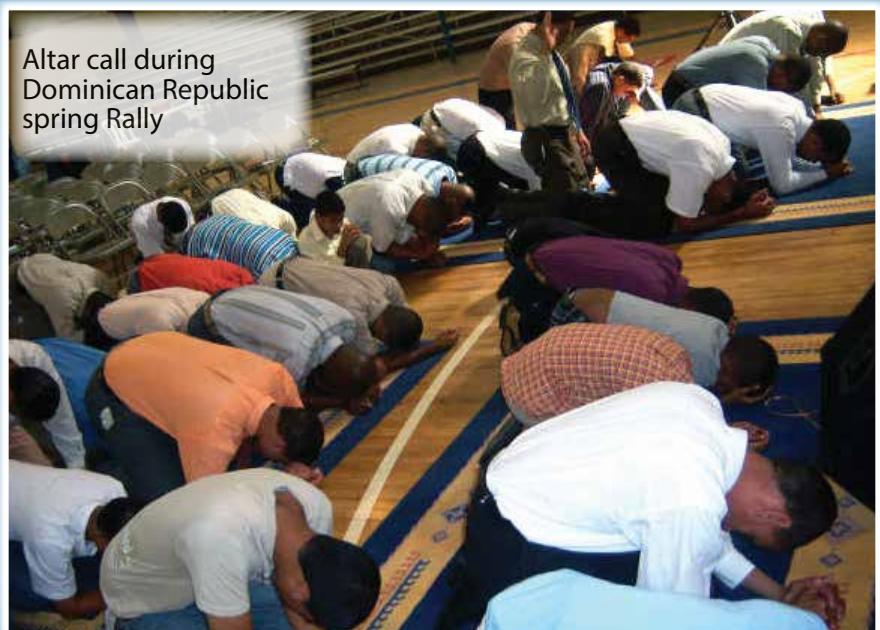

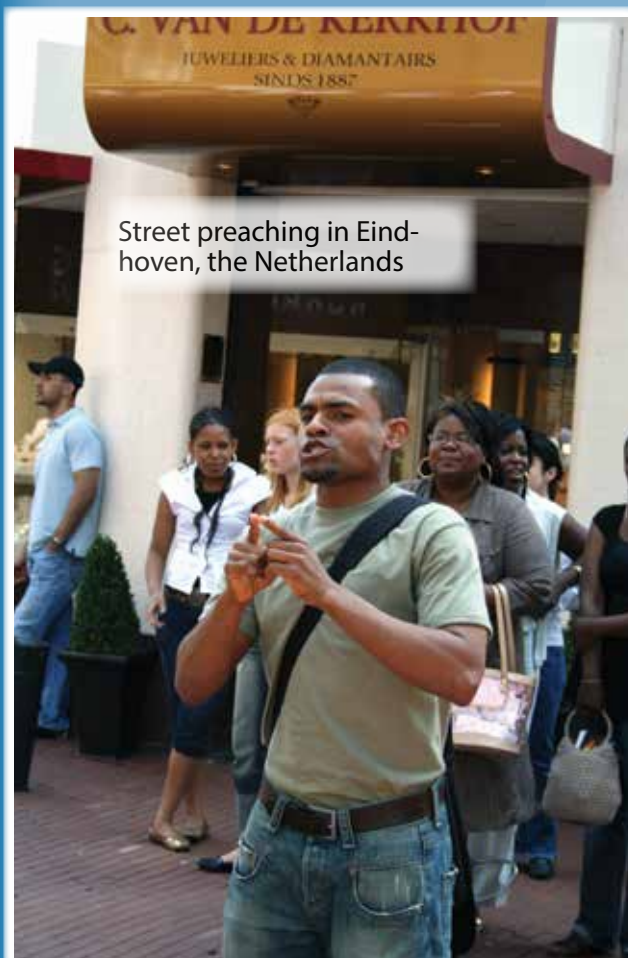

Every Tuesday and Thursday evening we open the building for those who want to learn and practice English. We have a constant flow of new people and we are able to build new friendships. They soon get to know us and become curious about the Church. Eventually, most of them would visit some services. It's been a successful outreach and we have prayed with many to receive Christ.

For the past four months we have been having Saturday night movies. Because Turkish people have no concept of going to church, this gives them another opportunity to come through the doors and hear the gospel.

Once a year we hold a Christmas Party at the building. We roast American marshmallows, drink American hot chocolate and have our English group perform a simple gospel drama. This year at the end of the event, I was able to preach Jesus to more than 70 visitors.

Revivals have been exceptionally useful in helping us to establish a core. Many fellowship Pastors from America and Europe have spoken timely messages. In March, Evangelist Jerry Fussell came and we saw 27 folks attend throughout the week. Six new people prayed and one family has returned.

The website we recently started

has had a surprising amount of activity. Besides general information about the church, people can also listen to foundational messages in Turkish.

The greatest reward of our labor is when God's truth is finally caught by the people. One man, Erturgul, had future plans to move to America with his family. I suggested that he visit San Diego and my son and his wife opened their home to him. 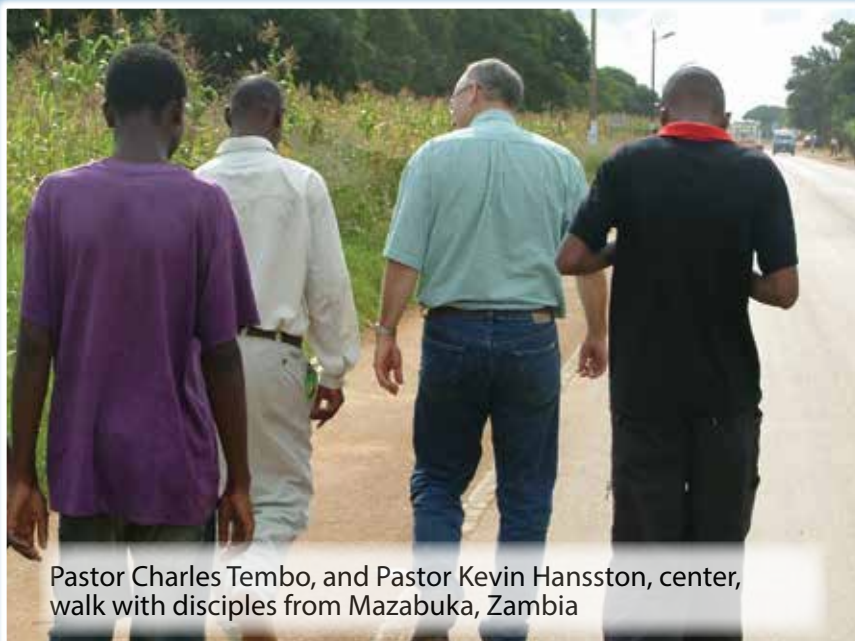

Most of you are aware we had very bad post election violence due to dis-

puted election results. More than 1000 people lost their lives and 350,000 were left either displaced from their homes or totally homeless.

This was a very discouraging and trying time for us as we saw the country sinking into civil war each day. However I believe because of the many prayers that people prayed for us from all over the world God intervened and the leaders agreed on a Coalition Government. Right now as I write this report there is relative peace in the country and most of the people who were staying in camps have been able to go back to their homes. One of our pastors lost all his property and also the church which was about nine years old was closed down.

In spite of all these happenings we are still contending for the vision and God's move not only in Nairobi but Kenya and East Africa as a whole.

Immediately as we had some peace we went back to the streets, doing outreaches, showing movies and having crusades. People were very apathetic and non-responsive at first but in the process of time they have opened up and are now responding to the gospel.

During Easter we gathered courage and did a procession which was a big step of faith. God honored this as we had total liberty and no violence in the three days that we did the procession. Hundreds of people came to church to watch our drama entitled "The Cross Or Religion?" Every day we saw an

increase in attendance and by Sunday night there were 815 people in the church! In all the three days we saw around 360 people praying for salvation.

Immediately after Easter in the beginning of April, we went to do a grand opening of a new work we launched out into Mombasa where we lost a leadership church in the Year 2000 Rebellion.

The devil opposed this launch in a big way as we sent out the couple in November but as we were planning to go and do the opening,

we had elections and the violence that followed. This couple could do nothing for three months in the city but just prayed and waited on God. However, doors opened and they got a hall and we were able to take an impact team there to do door-to-door outreaches and crusades for five days. God honored us in a big way as we had total dominion and favor.

By the end of the crusade we had over 200 people praying for salvation and around 15 getting healed. One very old woman of over 80 years was having pains all over her body. After we prayed for her she was totally pain free. This miracle amazed her so much that all she could do was just to whistle because of lack of words to explain what had happened to her body! In the opening service of this new work, they had 28 people in the Sunday morning service. Jesus Christ is risen from the dead indeed!

On June 10, 2006 our church officially opened in a good-sized colored township called Bonteheuwel. (pronounced: bon-tee-a-vul) We began with a Saturday night healing crusade with Pastor Duane Rens – our rented community center was filled (200+) with many saved and healed. More than 50 people came out Sunday morning and even more that Sunday evening, with many responding at the altar call.

It was certainly an exciting start, and there have been many outstanding services and outreaches since then and leading up to this present day.

One of the great miracles God has given us pertains to our church building. Simply put, buildings for assembly

can be scarce in the townships, yet we have received great favor. In September of 2006, a free standing building on one of the main roads in Bonteheuwel was made available for our use. A children's nursery uses it Monday through Friday during the days, but we've encountered no hindrances as it pertains to our schedule. It's spacious, has a good location and we have tremendous favor with the ownership paying three to four times less than comparable rates - we thank God for His provision there!

We've seen many religious inquisitors come and go in the past two years, but I'm very grateful to report that God has touched the hearts of many precious converts and we're seeing a good foundation being laid.

One family, Chris and Bernice September, responded to our first altar call on our opening weekend and they have been faithful to the work ever since. (Their 16-year-old son is also now in ministry.)

One of the pillars in the congregation is a man named John. He runs a small "tuck" shop from his home near the church. Upon getting saved, he was delivered from a decades-long cigarette addiction, and has brought his wife, son and daughter-in-law to Christ

and into the church. He stopped selling cigarettes and "all sin items" at his shop, and he closed down on Sundays to honor the Lord's Day. It has been an inspiring testimony to those who know his family here in our community.
