The Prescott church seems to hit its stride during the summer months as we gear up our outreach efforts to take advantage of the outdoor opportunities that are peculiar to Prescott.

For many years the Prescott church has taken the Gospel to the courthouse plaza in downtown Prescott. Monday nights throughout the summer find us downtown witnessing, playing music, testifying, showing a Gospel movie, and preaching a clear Gospel message.

This summer has been especially fruitful as many people have responded and gotten saved. Even Pastor Mitchell gets out there witnessing and inviting folks to stay for the presentation. Young and old take advantage of this opportunity to take the Gospel outside the four walls of our church building.

We also continue to press ahead in our concert outreach, One80. We're a couple blocks from the square now, but we still see people bring their friends and visitors drop in and we preach the Gospel to them. We've had a steady stream of new converts being saved.

We have tried some different things with our One80 building: a custom hot rod car show for example. Yes it brings new people to our building. And yes we witness to them. But nothing works like getting people to come to our concert, sit through the live music and drama, stay through the altar call while a disciple gets up on stage and preaches the Gospel to them. The emphasis is on Preach! That's when we see God move and people are born again.

Our summer season seems to

peak in early July. We have thousands of visitors come to Prescott for the Fourth of July and we have for years reached out to this throng with the Gospel of Christ.

We put on a magnificent God and Country presentation in the Courthouse Plaza called Celebrate America. History, tradition, and faith are all woven together to move the hearts of unsuspecting tourists.

Pastor Mitchell steps out at the end to preach the Gospel to the thousands of people sitting in rapt attention and many respond, raise their hands, and come forward to pray. It is an enormous undertaking but we thank God and the public officials who let us use these facilities year after year.

In July we had more than 2,000 Fellowship saints gather under the big Gospel Tent to experience one of the most powerful times of ministry to be found anywhere in America. The Prescott Conference featured good preaching, solid doctrine, and heart searching revelation in a life changing week of ministry. We are so blessed to join with our pastor to welcome and host all of those who come to Prescott for conference.

By the time we take down the tents it seems like summer is over. But it isn't. We power on in the Monday night outreaches and the Saturday night concert outreach. And we find time to send a group of people to Oceanside California to support their annual Miracle Healing Crusade with our own Pastor Mitchell. Many are saved and healed as the Gospel is preached in the band shell under the Oceanside pier.

We may not do everything exactly right and we may not be the most talented church in the world. But we are committed to outreach and evangelism and preaching the Gospel to our city and to the regions beyond Prescott.



Gospel Jetstream

Pastor and Mrs. Mitchell returned from their adventure in Australia June 26, 2009, just in time to challenge the Prescott church to the three-day fasting and prayer observed by our Fellowship around the world.

During the fast, the building in Prescott is open with saints praying around the clock, concluding with the Wednesday night service.

Pastor Greg Mitchell preached that service with great presence of God.

This led up to our annual God and Country patriotic rally at the Courthouse Plaza in downtown Prescott following the big 4th of July parade.

The presentation was attended by the largest crowd we have ever had.

An interesting part of the presentation this year was United States Senator and recent presidential candidate John McCain, who had asked to take part in our program to honor our military living and dead. Sen. McCain spoke for a few minutes and interestingly, his testimony from his Viet Nam imprisonment and about the American flag was already part of the program.

A tremendous presence of God was evident and many lifted their hands in conviction to ask for freedom from sin through the blood of Jesus Christ. Not all came to answer the altar call given by Pastor Wayman Mitchell, but 14 precious souls did come and pray and sign cards.

Pastor Mitchell has spoken in the Amarillo, Texas area-wide rally, the Oceanside, California Healing Crusade, a Miracle Crusade in Norfolk, Virginia and a tent crusade in Breda, Holland where television and newspapers gave positive coverage.

Pastor Mitchell also preached in Chinle, Arizona at a Navajo Nation rally for Pastor Artie Aragon, where a Native American sang two Christian hymns acapella in the Navajo tongue.

Pastors Wayman and Greg Mitchell made a quick trip to Walthamstow, England for United Kingdom two-night rallies with Pastor and U.K. leader Nigel Brown. The crowd overflowed the auditorium and watched services on video in the auditorium prayer room.

Daily back-to-back Men's Discipleship services with father and son in the

Walthamstow church were followed by question and answer sessions.

Pastor Wayman Mitchell conducted a Miracle Healing Crusade in Almeria, Spain for Alberto Maleno in a downtown movie theater rented for the occasion. A hundred people filled out decision cards for salvation, and there were many instantaneous and notable miracles of healing.

Pastor Evert Valk, Holland overseer and Pastor Nigel Brown, U.K. overseer, brought seminars in the morning that were very inspiring to all. The Sunday following, the Almeria church saw 40 first time visitors from the Crusade. Both television and newspapers gave positive coverage to the event.

The annual Redlands Crusade with Pastor Waymna Mitchell was conducted by Pastor Rich Cox, who coordinated an area-wide effort that saw 51 decision cards in the altar call and some outstanding instant healings.

A Pastors and Wives Seminar and rally in Jacksonville, North Carolina with Pastor and leader David Szczepanski in charge capped off a busy season.

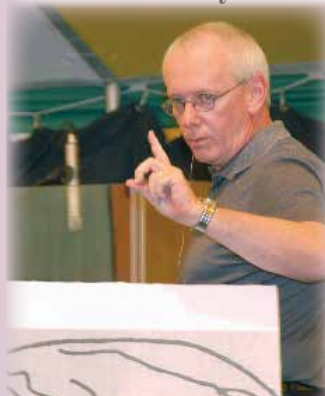

and outreach in the morning or afternoon. It is usually for an early evening concert or movie. We serve free hot dogs right through the concert or movie and then have an altar call. Some people come every movie or concert and have begun to invite family and friends. So we are able to establish relationship with some

new people in the area.

Instead of heading out to the local hotel for baptisms, we use a horse trough, set it out in front of the church building and baptize on a Friday evening. After the baptism we have a pot luck fellowship. This works out much better than the hotel.

More people come out for the baptism and invite friends and family. Just since May

through July we have baptized 14 people!

Once a month Pastor calls for an all day fasting and prayer. We get together in the evening to pray for church and personal needs and then break the fast together. This has brought the church folks closer, praying for each other's needs.

In May we were able to send an outreach team to Pastor Balingers church in

Las Cruces, NM for the healing crusade.

In August we sent two recruits and one counselor to the Youth Boot Camp in Las Vegas, NM. Also in August, the church sent Pastor and his wife to Trinidad and Tobago for Pastor Mel Montoya. In September we planned to expand our building space.

We are so grateful for the opportunity to be here and for the people that God has entrusted to this church. They are rising up to the challenge. We extend our gratitude to Pastor and Sister Mitchell and the Prescott church, Pastor Lee Wilson and Beckie and church, and the surrounding churches that have partnered with us, prayed for us, and labored alongside us this past year.

In May the church participated in a youth rally which brought hundreds



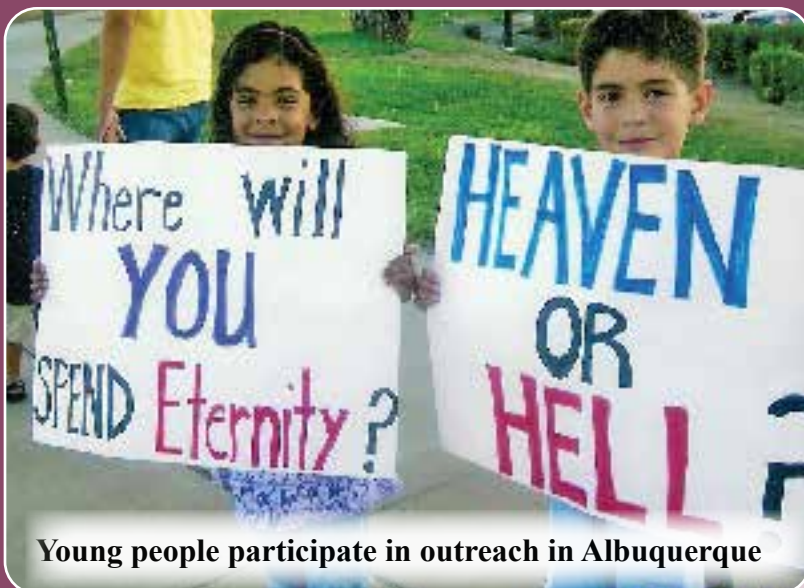

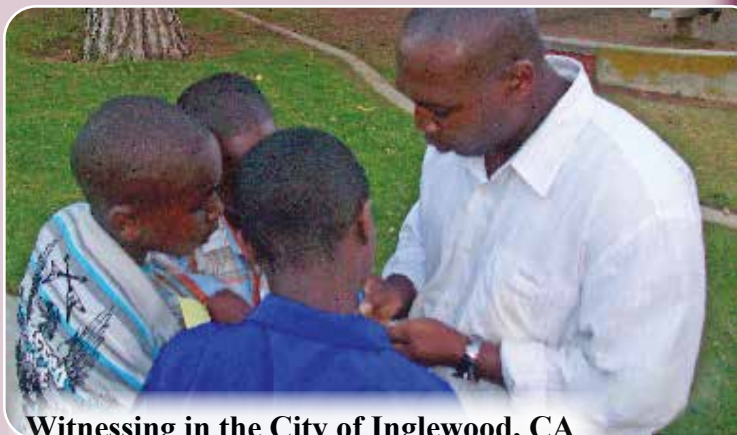
In the month of May we were blessed to have the play Louisiana Luis. From that, we witnessed 28 visitors and nine saved.

Right before I went into my boss's office I remember staring out of a window into the tops of the trees and the sky. Inside I was calling out to God. I was wondering if he could hear me and in my mind I was asking Him if this was the same broken path my life was going to continue to tumble along on.

As I was driving home tears streaming down my face, I felt broken and empty inside. I couldn't understand what I had done wrong to be treated with such contempt by my coworkers. Not even a half an hour later while I was standing in my kitchen I saw out the window a young couple walking up my driveway to the front door.

Normally I don't open the door for solicitors but something inside of me was telling me to open that door. I did in fact open it, before the young woman even had a chance to knock. She greeted me with such kindness and a genuine smile, something that I felt I hadn't experienced in such a long time.

She began telling me about a new church with a young pastor and she was inviting me to come to a service the next morning. I looked at her and said really? I told her I had been look-

ing for a church for quite some time and that I would love to come and check it out. For some reason I felt compelled to tell her how I had to quit my job a half hour earlier and that I just finished crying my

eyes out. Even though we just met I felt that I could just open up on a personal level. After they left that whole entire day I could not stop thinking about going to church the next morning. It gave me such hope that things would start to get better. My desperate plea was answered and God sent that wonderful couple to my door to rescue me. He had heard my cry and summoned me to Victory Chapel. On Sunday, April 26 I gave my life to Jesus Christ. For the first time in my life I feel at peace. I no longer need any of my medication or therapy because God has set me free from my depression. He has taken away all my pain and sadness and has blessed me with joy and hope for my future.

I now look forward to every day and am thanking the Lord and living for Him every step of the way.

We just finished a revival with Evangelist Shawn Davis. The presence of God was very powerful in every service; many words were given and the sick were prayed for and healed.

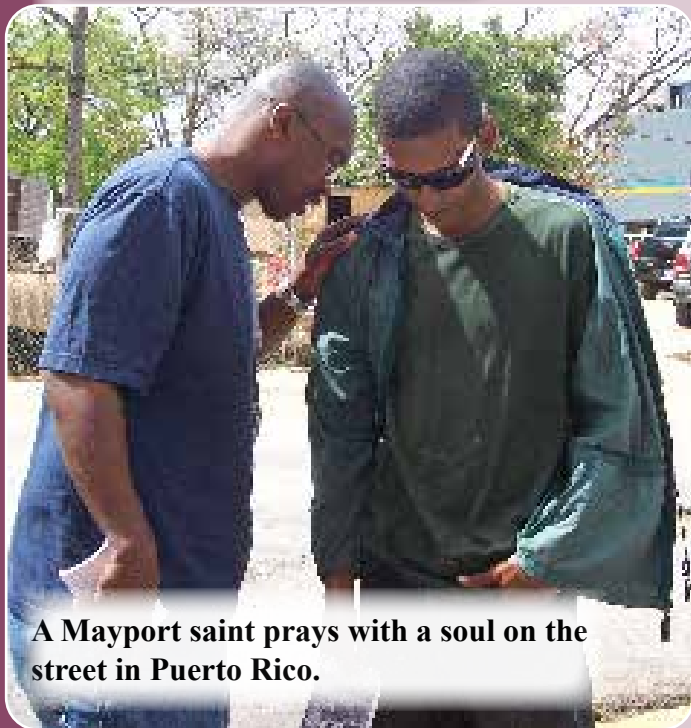
By the end of the revival five people gave their lives to Jesus Christ, and one backslidden family came back to Jesus.

Pastor Miguel Martinez from north San Antonio and saw nearly 50 attend from five area churches.

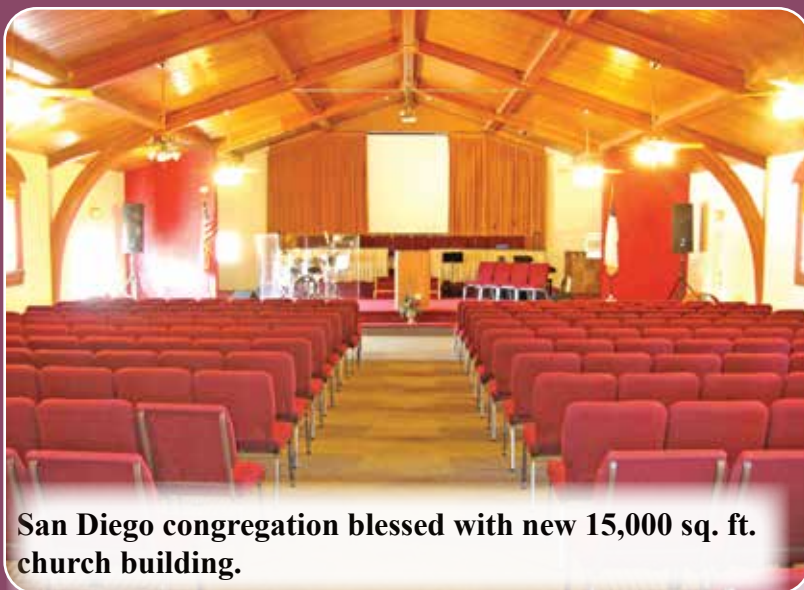
We followed all this up with baptizing two precious new converts! We sent our pastor to Belize City in August for Pastor Mat Spachek.

I want to start by thanking everyone for their prayers and support since we have been here in Greece.

We arrived in Greece in April of 2007. We were in a small village named Megara, which is between Athens and Corinth for the first two years. During that time we had very limited results. The time was well spent in getting all our immigration paperwork, official church license, as well as learning the Greek culture and mindset.

When we arrived back in Greece after the El Paso conference of this year we felt that we needed to make a move, but still felt very strongly that God wanted us here in Greece.

We relocated to Thessaloniki in May and set ourselves to finding a building as well learning a new city. Thessaloniki is in Northern Greece, very close to the borders of Turkey, Bulgaria, and Albania.

Right from the beginning we saw God opening doors for us. We met a local businessman who owns a chain of car rental stores here in Greece, and he immediately began to help us. He came to our building regularly to help translate to workers, as well as constantly telling people about our church. Through him we have met many people that have been a great blessing to us since arriving here.

Last Friday Evangelist Mike Nicholaou, out of the Walthamstow congregation, arrived here in Greece to preach our Grand Opening. We worked many hours to finish getting the building ready, as well as prepare for the revival.

On Sunday morning, July 26, a team of eight people from Walthamstow arrived to help us. They outreached for two hours before the service that night and we had three visitors. One of them is an Indian man working as a scientist at a University here, my son had met him at a skateboard park a few weeks earlier. He told me that

my son was the first person who had smiled at him and talked to him since arriving in Greece a few months ago. He was raised as a Christian in India and was excited about the church opening. He helped us worked on the building and came every night during the revival, at the end saying that he felt like he was part of a family by being in our church.

On the first night I saw a 45-year-old Romanian man sitting alone by the boardwalk on the ocean. I sat down with him, and in my very limited Greek told him about the church and invited him to the service that night. He came to the service, raised his hand, and came down to the altar to give his life to Christ! He was a Captain in the Romanian Army and had seen many atrocities. He has scars on his face from his time in the military and began to weep as he talked about seeing his friends die in front of him. He said he was bound by fear, anger and rage.

As we prayed for him for deliverance he began to tense up in anger. We continued to pray until we saw breakthrough, suddenly the spirits that were tormenting him left and immediately his entire countenance changed. He went home that night to throw away his gun. He came the next two nights, clean shaven and looking like a different man.

The next night, Monday, we had the Romanian man, the Indian man, as well as one Greek visitor. Pastor Nicholaou had struggled the night before, and did a great job, of preaching in Greek and English. On the Monday night as he started to preach he asked if anyone could translate. The young Greek man raised his hand and came to the front to translate. He translated like he had been doing it for years!

Pastor Nicholaou talked about deliverance from addictions during the service. At the altar call he asked if anyone wanted prayer. Our new translator raised his hand and said he was had been addicted to cigarettes for two years, smoking between 10 and 20 a day. We prayed for him and God really touched him. He asked in front of everyone if he could go outside and "test" to see if he was delivered. Not knowing what he meant

we said yes, he walked outside and tried to smoke a cigarette. He came back in immediately to tell us that it didn't taste the same and said he had to throw them away!

At the end of the service I asked him, Philip, if he had ever asked Christ into his heart. He lowered his head and said, "I think I did tonight." I then proceeded to lead him in a prayer of repentance.

During that same service we also had two young men from Cameroon who gave their lives to Christ. They had moved to Greece years before, not interested in church, but both came when invited by the team just minutes before the service. They both came back throughout the revival, excited about what God was doing in their lives and were talking about how excited they were to come back to church next Sunday.

The Tuesday and Wednesday services were much the same with more visitors from Bulgaria, Hungary and of course Greece. All in all it was breakthrough like we've been praying for since coming to Greece.

I would like to take this opportunity to ask every pastor to consider coming here to preach for me, and especially to send a team here. People are completely wide open to the Gospel on the streets, many of them saying they are atheists, but only because they have been so let down by religion here.

Once you begin to talk about having a personal life-changing relationship with Jesus Christ you can see the hope returning to them, they really do want to believe in God, they just don't know how.

I only have two revivals scheduled for this year, and none confirmed yet for 2010. If there is anything you can do to support us in taking Greece for Jesus we would greatly appreciate it. I would thank Pastor Brown and the Walthamstow church for their support in our Grand Opening revival, as well as the El Paso church for continuing to believe in us even when it didn't look like much was happening!

Keep us in your prayers and I look forward to what God has for us here in the future.

My name is Henk Brusse and my wife Soenita and I, with our two children, are Dutch missionaries in southern China and are leading the churches in Guangzhou and Dongguan.

Guangzhou is a very modern city with more than 12 million registered inhabitants. The last half year we've seen an enormous breakthrough. In June there was an average of 58 people in the Sunday morning services. There are a number of newly added young men that are exceptionally enthusiastic for God. They gladly evangelize and help with all kinds of things in the church.

One of them read the book "Word and Spirit" in one sitting. Afterward he took part in a 3-day fast and 24-hour prayer meeting. He was spontaneously filled with the Holy Spirit while praying, and began speaking in tongues. He feels a strong calling to preach the gospel in Muslim countries.

The city Dongguan is about an hour's drive from Guangzhou and has more than 7 million inhabitants. The church in Dongguan is nearly 5 years old and was originally pioneered by Rene and Angele Brabants. The church continues to grow and has services on Tuesday and Thursday evenings.

We have had a lot of special activities in both churches.

In March we had revival meetings with Pastor Nomdo Schuitema from Leeuwarden, Holland. We saw a total of 15 people come to repentance. His marriage class was a real 'eye-opener' for many new converts.

In May we had our semi-annual rally with Pastor Sergei Golubev and Alexander Shevelyov from Russia. As usual the churches spent several days together in a hotel. This time our focus was much on discipleship. After a sermon from Pastor Golubev about the call of God at least 11 men responded to the altar call to be sent out in the future. In the swimming pool of the hotel we baptized 19 new converts from our churches in Guangzhou and Dongguan.

Like last year, we went with a team to the Pioneers Rally with Joe Campbell in Malaysia. This time 26 people went along. For many this was their first time outside the country. We want to thank pastor Alan Asir for his invitation, his financial support and hearty welcome.

This annual rally in Malaysia is an important opportunity for the Chinese disciples to pick up the world-evangelism vision of our fellowship.

In July evangelist Edwin Jonkhout from Zwolle Holland held revival services. Already in the first service we saw 3 new young men get saved. Many people were also healed through prayer. The whole church came forward to see legs and arms grow longer. Evangelist Jonkhout gave several words of knowledge that were all exceptionally accurate. The people were very encouraged by everything.

We are very thankful to pastor Valk and the Zwolle church for all the support and encouragement. We are very excited and encouraged to hear that Pastor Frans and Diana Smiths will come to China to support us. They will take over the Dongguan church.

Before I finish, allow me to remark the following.

The devil hates China. The Chinese and their culture are often being mocked and ridiculed in the Western world. And many Western Christians believe that it is very difficult and dangerous to pioneer a church in China. They hear a constant flow of negative news reports about the controlling communistic government. I believe this is all part of the devil's tactic to discourage missionaries from reaching this country with the largest population of unreached souls in the world.

The truth is that right now China is very open for Western missionaries. We have been experiencing that for ourselves in the last two years. So many people in China have never heard about Jesus and are very interested and curious to come to the church with a Western pastor. In nearly every service or coffee house we see visitors.

Therefore, keep praying for China. Pray especially for more missionaries to come to China. Pray for more men in church and also pray for good marriages in the future.

Our major outreach – The Christmas Family Big Night Out – capitalizes on the Australian summer time and the traditional family get together at this time of year.

We set up a huge jumping castle and had a variety of games and prizes, but also we had two altar calls inviting people to get their hearts right with God. The bands played, the saints testified and even Santa made a guest appearance in the local police car! Unashamed we preached and as people sat on the lawns and were entertained they heard a presentation of the gospel of salvation. During the course of the event we saw a conservative estimate of over 300 people in attendance.

39 saved and many healed and touched by the power of God. Pastor Gibson is Fijian and was able to relate to the Melanesian culture.

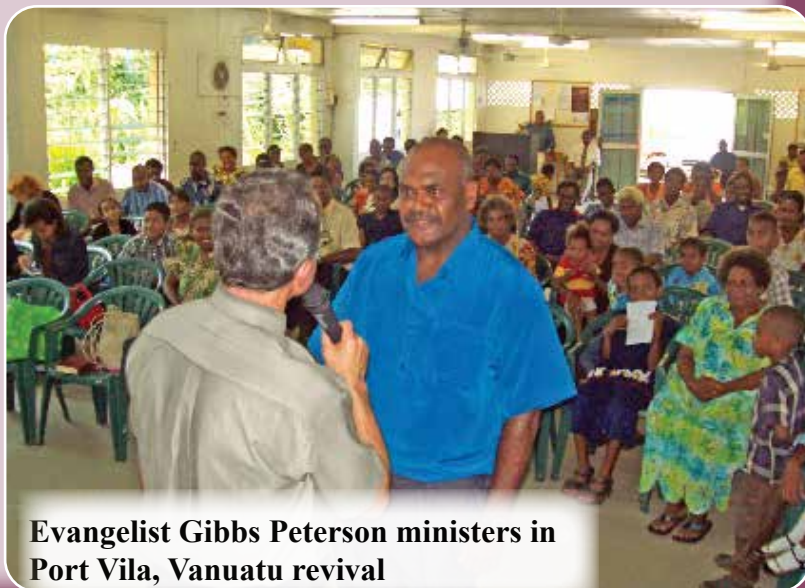

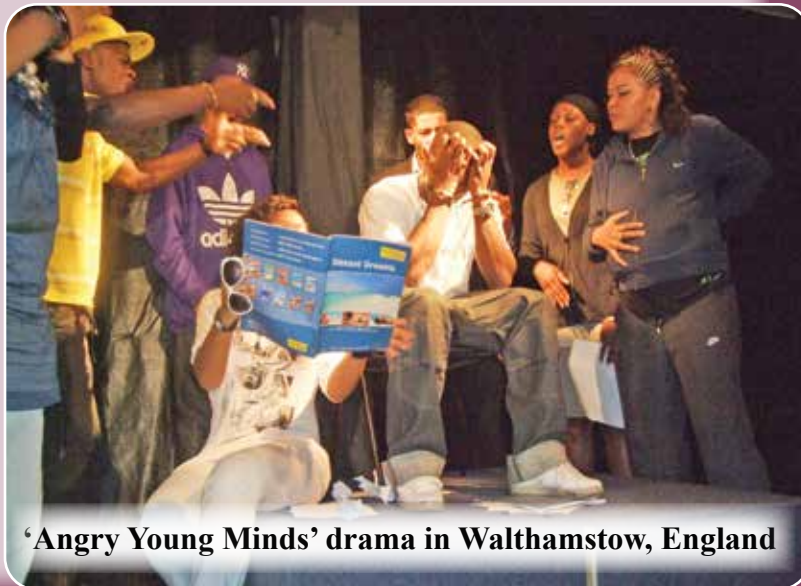
many people got saved and healed.
