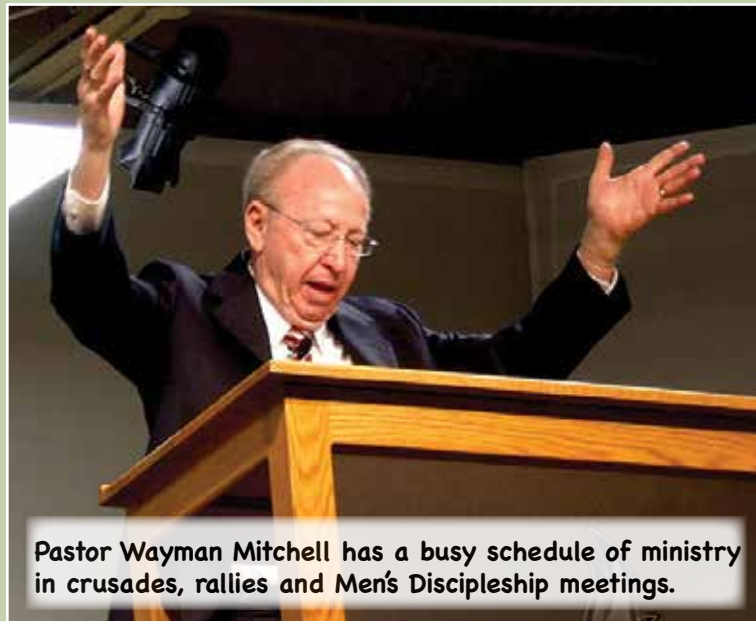
Crusades, Discipleship classes fill Pastor Wayman Mitchell's schedule

The youth of Prescott once again had the opportunity to reach out to the city of San Luís, Rio Colorado, Sonora, Mexico.

Pastor José Torres welcomed five vans full of people from Prescott excited to help him reach the city for Christ and promote the miracle healing crusade with Pastor Wayman Mitchell on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, March 18-20.

Other outreach teams from Redlands, CA and Yuma, AZ as well as the Mexican congregations surrounding the area joined us in preaching the gospel to all who would listen.

The teams went all over this city of 180,000 people passing out flyers and witnessing. A parade on Saturday included a live band and testimonies as well as many young people running beside the vehicles and buses to pass out flyers.

Our teams also visited two drug rehabilitation centers that were filled with desperate people needing to hear the Gospel. Evangelist John Pratt spoke at one center about the

love and power of Jesus Christ, and then prayed for the sick. As they were praying for one man who had been coughing up blood, another woman started frantically waving her hands around to let them know she had been healed from internal pain instantly! There were 54 people saved and many healings at the rehabilitation centers, and another 47 conversions through street preaching and individual outreaching.

During the healing crusades, there were 298 cards to record decisions for Christ all three nights, with many more praying the sinner's prayer but not filling out the contact cards.

The miracles were just as wonderful, with deaf ears opened, pain from injuries healed, and people being able to walk strongly again. One tiny, elderly woman from Oaxaca, Mexico came with her daughter for healing of deafness, head pain, and an inability to move her arms much. As Pastor Mitchell's words were translated from English to Spanish to Oaxacan and back, God moved

miraculously to heal this dear woman of her pain. She was beaming and chattering happily as she swung her arms all the way over her head, heard Pastor's words clearly, and had no more pain.

That healing and many others over these three nights brought tears to the eyes of those healed. What an incredible opportunity to reach out and tell the world about the saving and healing power of Jesus Christ!

Most teenagers have no direction and no hope to become anything else but one of the many con artists. Daily one-on-one evangelism, house-to-house witnessing, and street preaching is employed to reach the masses.

The church has been open for seven months as of Feb 7, 2010. Our average church services are 15 Sundays morn-

ings and 15 Sunday nights. On any given Sunday, anywhere from 20-30 saints have heard the gospel at Centro Cristiano La Puerta. Hallelujah! God is building His church.

Many seeds have been planted. We are following up on about 40 people. Seeds that have been planted almost a year ago are beginning to bear fruit.

ship service our church is characterized by fasting and prayer. Outside of morning prayer, as a congregation we have begun a church fast every Tuesday and Tuesday night prayer, and Friday night Bible studies. We have baptized as of date only one saint, but

We had our first revival with Pastor Juan Uribe. Saints were greatly encouraged and our congregation of new believers began to take steps of faith. We had 19 new visitors, six souls were added to the kingdom, and two saints were filled with the Holy Ghost.

We have one sister who has begun to sing praise and worship with us and two brothers who are helping to usher.

God is giving us true conversions. One sister in our church made the comment that she has been to almost every church in Limon and all they preach about is about prosperity. However, for the first time in her life she has felt that her decision to serve God is real and that she is enthusiastic about serving God now that she has begun to attend Centro Cristiano La Puerta.

"Most" people here live in free union (fornication) but God is dealing with the hearts of men and women. Two couples have told me that they desire to get married.

Lastly, here is a plug to all pastors. If you want to come and preach for us here in Costa Rica, please do come to bring a refreshing to my wife and I and to also bring the gospel message of hope to our congregation. May God continue to bless you all and all of our churches. Maranatha.

Every Friday night we are faithful to witness rain or shine, and God has been faithful giving favour in the weather and drawing people to our services.

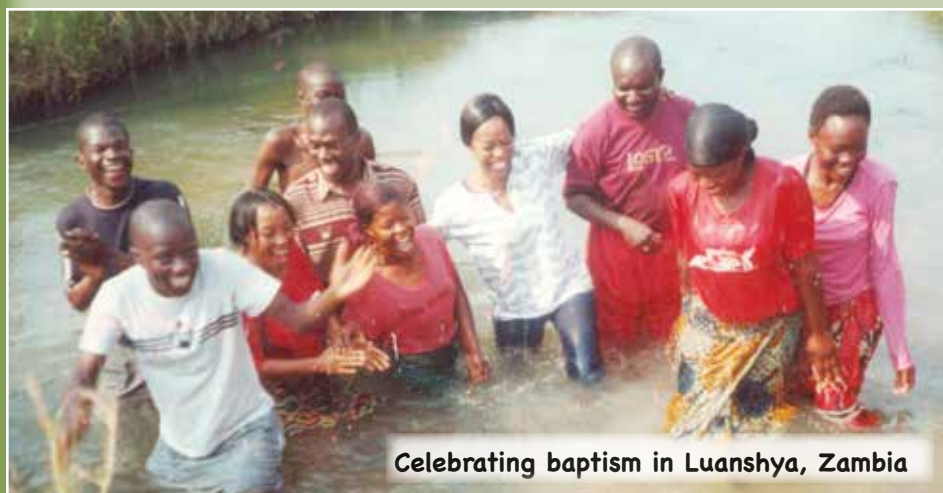

Speakers and young servants alike wore uniforms or military gear to reflect the conference theme to the some 380 people in attendance.

All of these offerings will buy puppets, CDs, and other supplies, as well as paying to ship it all to Romania. What a blessing it is to have kids with tender hearts and a spirit of generosity.
