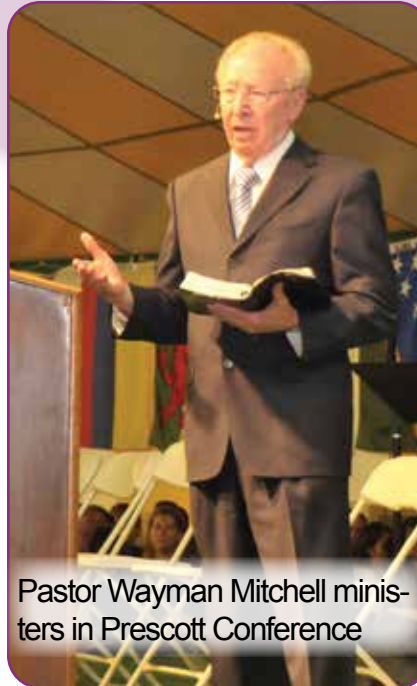
An area-wide rally at Federal Way, Washington with Pastor Chris Aulson was a great example of our Fellow-

Pittsburg, Kansas is located just 40 miles from Joplin, Missouri. In the aftermath of the devastating tornado that claimed some 160 lives this spring, the Pittsburg Church de-

voted several Saturdays to assist with debris removal, serving at relief locations as well as donating clothing and household items.

Pastor Johnson adjusted outreach times to weeknights temporarily to accommodate work parties as well as allowing our church van to shuttle another business's volunteer workers.

One family felt compelled to offer their assistance. Their efforts were initially discouraged by Emergency Responders because of the dangerous and insecure conditions. Determined God wanted them to act, they discovered an older couple attempting to load their belongings. Promptly sorting through rubble, clearing space and praying with these survivors, the grateful couple remarked, "You must be angels." They had been informed it could be days or weeks before crews could assist them.

Our "Off Your Rockers" Youth group recently raised more than \$700 to provide some assistance for the Joplin Boys and Girls Club. They are presently preparing a "Gospel Hayride" for children hard hit by the tornado.

Evening outreaches have brought exciting responses. Singing and testifying at local parks and businesses has resulted in new conversions and visitors to our church services. One business owner even welcomed our music group to return anytime. We recently baptized four into a new life in Jesus and continue working with others.

The recent Census indicates our county's population has decreased to under 40,000 souls, yet one couple's migration to Pittsburg has resulted in a new life in Jesus. Bill and Micha-

lyn Shropshire were attracted to our area's low cost of living to make their retirement benefits stretch. Their salvation has brought an unexpected benefit to their plans.

Several years ago one of our young men enlisted in this nation's military. At the time there was little interest in things spiritual. Before returning to new duties this summer, this soldier who had been raised in church returned to express appreciation for the investment made in his life. He credits his mother and her friends' prayers for his recent salvation. Having survived the brutal and devastating consequences of combat, he knows it wasn't simply "good fortune" that has preserved him alive. We are all thrilled at his new found faith and zeal for Jesus.

We saw 12 people pray out of this event.

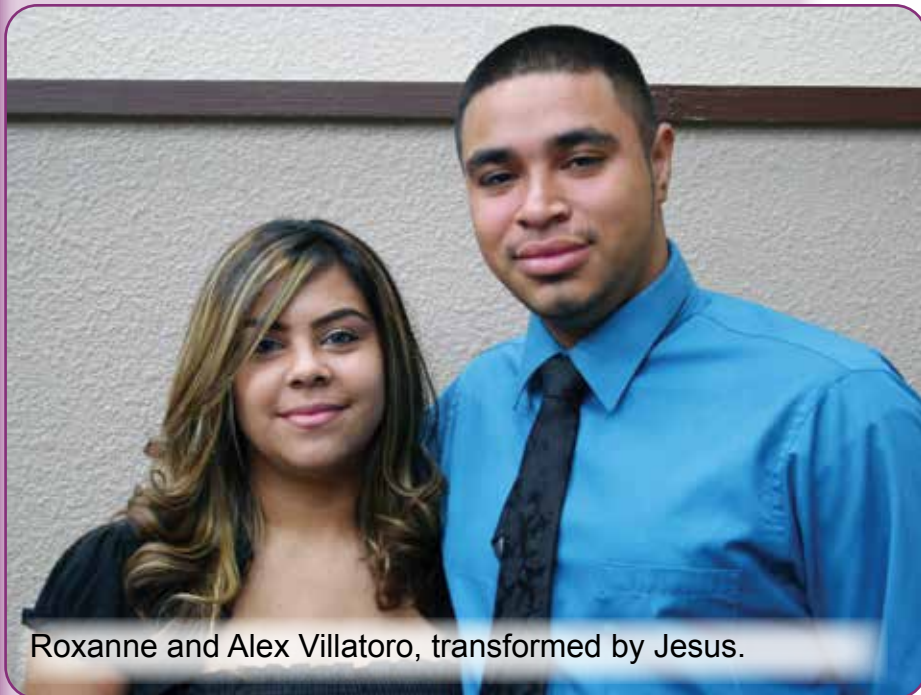

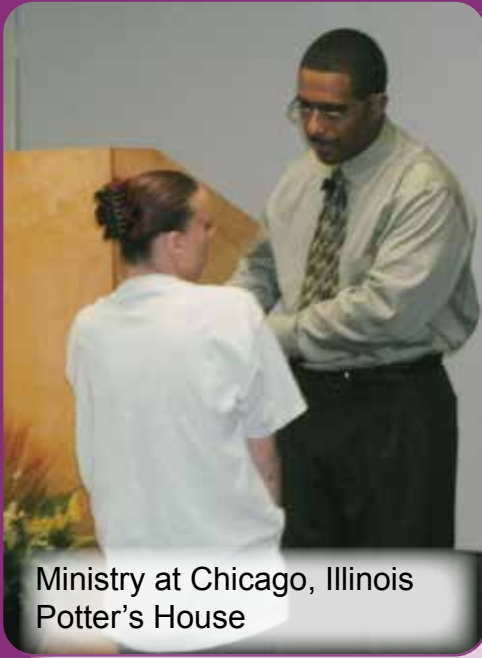


more than 100 fresh convert cards. We're still continuing to see first time visitors come to the church and the people of God are remaining steadfast and faithful to continue to plow on for God.

Until now, the church is still growing. New people are coming in: young men and women, couples and also whole families, while the saints still remain faithful.

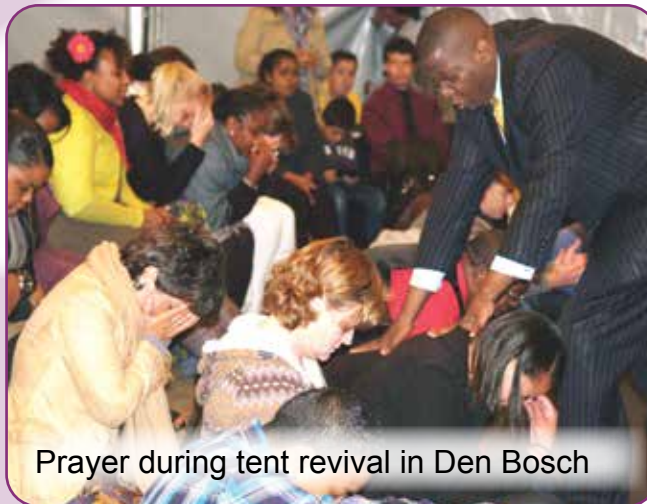

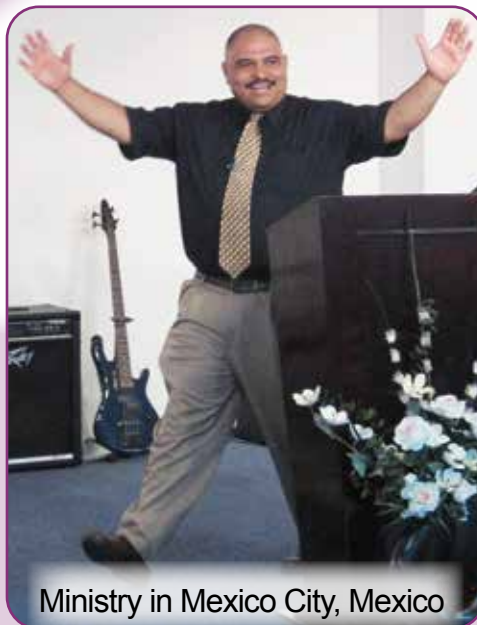

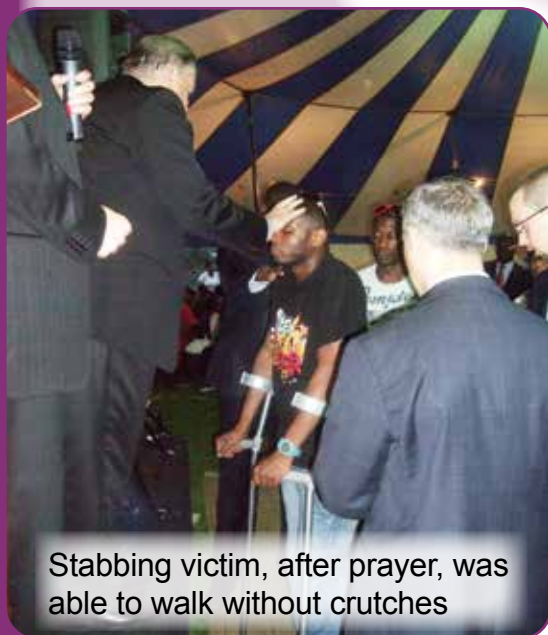

The following evening was electric! We saw a young man come in on crutches who Pastor Cluck said had a streak of aggression in his life. He had been stabbed in the leg, damaging his nerves, but as we prayed for him the power of God spread through his leg and he was able to walk without the crutches! This sent a ripple of excitement throughout the whole tent.

At the end of each night we saw many healed as our Bible study leaders prayed for the sick and God worked through them. The crusade not only created a platform to see miracles and converts (many returned to our regular services and some even got baptised) but additionally, the saints of God were inspired to stir up the gift of God that is in them.

Some who beforehand may have hesitated to pray for the sick in an everyday

scenario or an outreach are now boldly stepping out. Numerous testimonies have arisen from this. Dormant faith in God's healing power has been awakened and is being exercised by many!

Pastor Cluck ended the crusade with a message for the youth, reminding us that these were our future leaders and they were under attack by the enemy. As he called the youth up for prayer we saw almost half of the audience, all under 21, go up! Pastor Cluck encouraged them to be zealous for God because we are living in crucial times, therefore admonishing them to stay strong

It's no coincidence that exactly a week after this prayer riots broke out all over the country after the death of a young man in North London during a police altercation. The nation's youth were the main perpetrators. Many were involved in criminality and public disorder where we saw looting, arson and vandalism on a scale that this country hasn't seen for decades.

However, our church was ready to pounce! On the Wednesday of the riots, members young and old met for an outdoor service in the very heart of Walthamstow to take dominion in our borough and seize it from the hands of those seeking to destroy it. Prominent figures in the community were able to hear Jesus preached and His authority was truly established.

We ask that you continue to pray for us here, as we do for you.

We've constantly taken the Gospel outside the four walls by way of neighborhood outreaches, open air crusades, and street witnessing. It has been encouraging seeing God working with us.

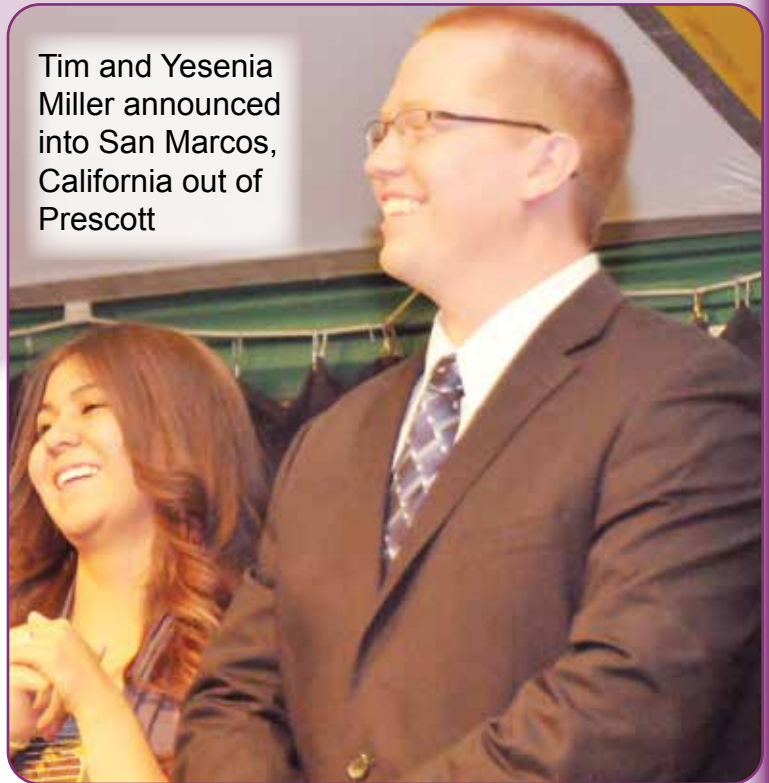

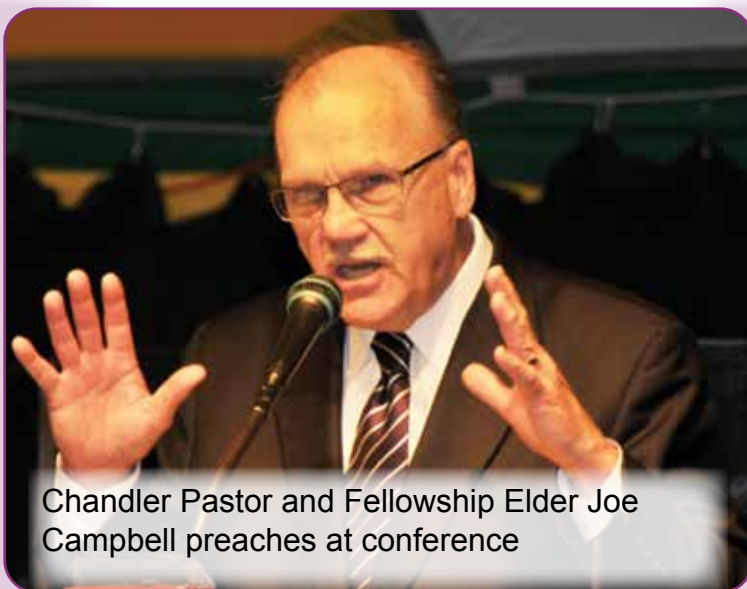

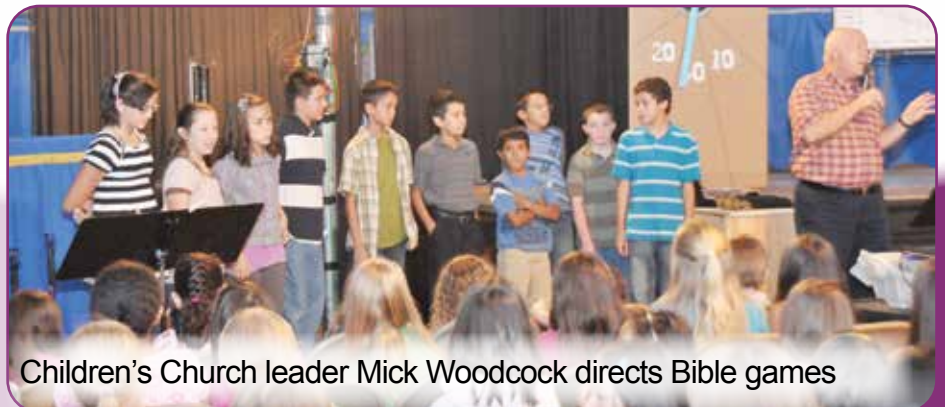
