"And it shall come to pass afterward that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh; your sons and daughters shall prophecy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions."

When we were new converts we were sure that these words from God were meant just for us. And now that some years have rolled by, we stand amazed to see that what God did way back then continues to reverberate across our church, our Fellowship, and our generation until this very hour.

The Prescott church, still faithful and on fire after all of these years, continues to outreach and minister as we are able and as the Holy Spirit directs. But I see something exciting happening in Prescott. Young people, some new converts, some church kids, are beginning to take up valuable areas of ministry responsibility in our church's life and outreach.

We have heard reports recently of our kids, on their own, going to the movie house in Prescott Valley on several different occasions, to witness and evangelize. They always seem to come back with great reports of scores of teens responding to the Gospel that they preach. No lights or sound board or bands. Just personal evangelism outside the four walls of our church or our concert building.

Our concert scene, ONE80, continues to bear much fruit in visitors and new converts. Kids are responding to the gospel that is preached there, and then coming back to minister to other kids who are there wondering

what it's all about. I think this is how discipleship is supposed to happen. Nevertheless, we are seeing a great spring time outpouring in our concert outreach scene with five to 10 young people saved every week.

Our impact teams continue to take the message to the streets on weekends around the state of Arizona. Once again the young people are outnumbering the older folks on these impact teams and they are making a great impact. Why are they so fruitful? Well, they're really saved and Spirit filled for one. And they aim to win souls, not just hand out flyers.

Some of our disciples are taking what they've learned and putting on neighborhood outreaches. They organize, plan, prepare, pray, and then set up in a small neighborhood to have music and testimonies and preaching and even prayer for the sick. We've heard exciting reports from the first few neighborhood outreaches done so far this year.

Our bands continue to play an important part in our outreach emphasis. We release our music groups to go to other churches in the Fellowship to play in their music scenes or, lately, to play in outside venues such as parks or parking lots. They get to play loud, preach hard, and see real people respond to the glorious gospel of Christ. Almost make me want to dust off my old guitar and play again!

As Memorial Day fades into history we've already had the first of many down town park plaza outreaches. Many people still hang around downtown Prescott after dark and we are there to throw out the life line to them. Many people have been saved already and we've just barely gotten started.

We have a vision that comes from Heaven and that is burning as brightly now as ever.

Crusades, conferences keep Pastor Wayman Mitchell on the move

Pastor Mitchell preached in Gallup, New Mexico in their conference to a vibrant church and conference delegates. From there he travelled to San Luis, Mexico for Pastor Jose Torres and joined the Prescott youth for the annual Healing Crusade at the amphitheater for Thursday and Friday services. Hundreds of souls answered the invitation for salvation, and many instant miracles gave a glorious thrust in the first night. Torrential rain forced the crusade back to the church building the second night, but Pastor Bob Mammen continued the crusade on Saturday and Sunday and a followup revival was blessed with many visible miracles and hundreds more responding for salvation.

Pastor Mitchell ministered in Cape Cod for the East Coast Bible Conference, returning to Chandler, Arizona to preach one night at their Pioneer Rally. He preached a Monday Men's Discipleship in an auditorium filled to

capacity in Redlands, California for Pastor Rich Cox. Two nights in Nogales, Sonora, Mexico and a Saturday morning Men's Discipleship for Pastor Adam Porter in San Jose, California finished the April calendar.

Two nights preaching Pastor Mark Aulson's conference in Tempe, Arizona began the May calendar. Tempe had a capacity crowd and was a testimony to the Fellowship with churches planted in Thailand and several pioneer plants in the U.S.

Pastor Mitchell travelled to the Philippine conference in Manila and enjoyed again the great work in Boyet Desepida. He preached a neighborhood miracle crusade, the regular Sunday service, and the conference, which saw record attendances Thursday and

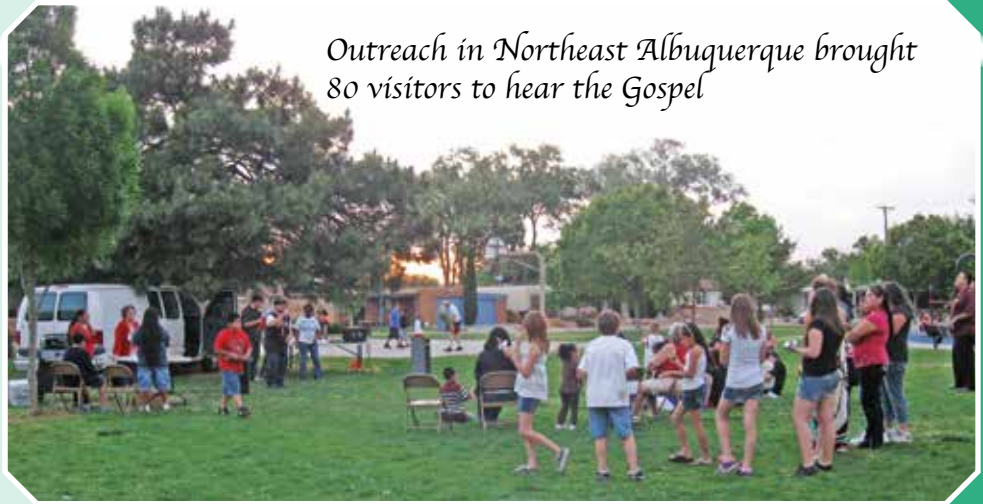
Greetings from the Potters House, NE Albuquerque!

Earlier this past year, we were excited and very blessed to move into a much larger building with approximately 2,700 square feet of space. We had been waiting on this building for the last two years. As soon as it came available, the owner made sure to call us and it was a quick move. It is on the corner of two main streets with lots of visibility and plenty of parking. It easily accommodates 100 people in the sanctuary, with separate office, nursery, kitchen and children's Sunday school area. We are believing that God gave us this building to fill it to capacity.

Since the move, we had a revival with Evangelist Leonard Williams, who gave a word to many of the folks in the congregation, and preached on the necessity of the Holy Spirit working in our lives and through the church. We have also profited greatly from the ministry of Pastor Rosario Perez, Evangelist Robert Polaco and Evangelist Scott Snellen. Pastor Mel Montoya recently did a revival for us with a sermon on deliverance that brought healing to many in the congregation. There were also words of knowledge for many of the people there.

We had a ladies dinner at the end of last year, with a couple of the other churches in the area. There were testimonies and ministry for those women who have experienced violence or sexual abuse in their lives. There were first time visitors and almost every one in the room was at the altar at the end of the night.

We just had our first outdoor concert in the park for the summer with the group Urban Renewal from The Door,

Greetings from the North Valley Potters House in Albuquerque, NM!

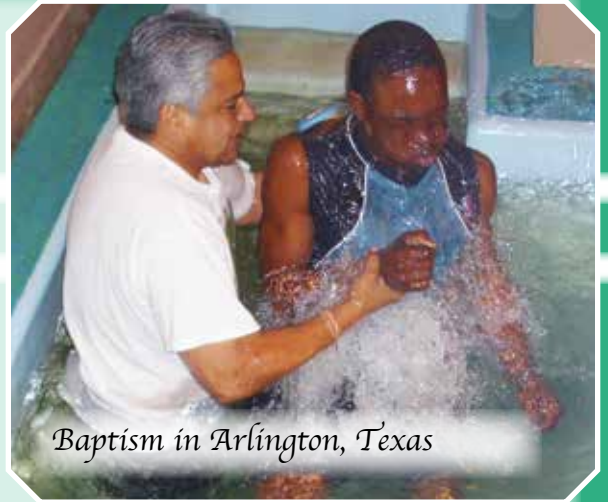

As always it is a blessing to be able to inspire other area churches and to help maintain focus on the purpose of God in the earth and the Phoenix valley.

This came in the form of our annual Pioneer Rally where congregations and pastors gathered to hear God's word from some of the most outstanding preachers from our fellowship. Pastor Campbell was influential in bringing these rallies to reality. Pastor Mitchell and he decided to bring conference level ministry into churches for members that could not attend a full-fledged conference. What an opportunity these have been in providing direction and inspiring vision in the valley and across the Fellowship.

Cinco de Mayo provided the congregation with the opportunity to reach into the Hispanic community. We fired up the grill and lined up the bands for a celebration in the park adjacent to the church. Food was served and the gospel was preached with power and anointing.

More than 85 visitors were in attendance with 12 saved. We followed this with a revival with Serafico Savaadra, in which five additional souls were added to the community.

In our efforts to reach all people we hosted a healing crusade in Sacaton in the Gila River Indian Community. Our precious brother, Artie Aragon, preached in Ira Hayes Memorial Park, a park dedicated to the Native Americans

involved with raising the flag over Iwo Jima in WWII. Just as liberty was declared in that act, Pastor Aragon declared freedom from sin and curses through Jesus Christ. Four members of the Indian community came to know Christ. During prayer for the sick a native woman with a crushed foot hobbled forward on a walker.

As the preacher began to pray for her she started to shout and jump, declaring that the pain was gone and her foot was healed. Further proof of this miracle was evident as Brother Aragon and the healed woman did a Navajo two-step dance across the area in front of the stage. The crusade was followed with a revival that touched the congregation's hearts in the arena of disappointment and forgiveness. The revival yielded nine more souls for the Kingdom of Heaven.

As part of our congregation's response to the great commission, we were able to release Pastor Campbell to preach for the Asian Rally in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. There were more than 240 delegates in attendance from such nations as India, Pakistan, China and Myanmar. There were even 20 born-again Iranian Nationals in attendance, a testimony of God's power to reach into the heart the Islamic stronghold with the light of the gospel of Jesus Christ!

Ya't'eeh from Chinle, Arizona. As we labor faithfully on the Navajo Nation, God is using our lives to impact other native tribes beyond the borders of our own reservation.

In March, we sent an impact team of 31 Navajo Indians into the nation of Canada to assist Pastor Dave Marks, in Chilliwack, British

Columbia. Because Canadian Native reservations are, in many ways, similar to our reservations, we were able to make a connection and still preach the gospel of Jesus Christ!

God opened doors while we were there, and even allowed us to set up a booth at the entrance of Wal-Mart,

and "The Righteous Ones," along with our Navajo Choir, were able to demonstrate that Jesus Christ is still changing lives, even in Indian Country!

In addition to our Canadian outreach, we also had Pastor Richard Romero do a timely End Times Revival here in Chinle.

In April, Elvis Presley and an impact team from the Desert Hot Springs church came to the reservation. During the outreach, we had "Elvis" drive around this dusty, one traffic light, community in a classic 1973 convertible with the top down; even the cows and horses had to look twice. During the Friday night performance, we had more than 425 people in attendance and about 30 Navajos got saved, because the "real King" was in the house!

At the Gallup Bible Conference, in April, we launched Chris and Erica Morgan, from the Chinle Church, into Rapid City, South Dakota, to start a new pioneer work. What a privilege it is to labor in these last days. God has enlarged our borders and is taking us into other Native nations to make an impact and proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Greetings from Hesperia California. This year the church withstood numerous physical attacks as we continued to preach the Gospel to the people of the High Desert.

At the end of the fall, and early winter we had four of the six infants of our congregation, hospitalized and then released as the enemy tried to take out some of our littlest disciples at the start of their lives. However, this has not thwarted the fruitfulness of the brethren, and we are expecting another five more newborns this year, and it's only May.

As the year has progressed more and more of the faithful men of the church have been blessed with full time employment and no longer need to rely on government assistance. God's faithfulness to provide has restored dignity and purpose to their lives spiritually and physically.

Another exciting thing has been the growth in our children's church. Every Sunday morning a group of 9-14 year olds lead song service for the children 12 and under. These young men play the drums, keyboard, and guitar while one of them leads the singing. On a typical Sunday morning we have between 60 and 80 children having the Gospel ministered to them in four classes.

With the help of children's workers, these youngsters have also been able to minister to the congregation through puppets and by performing special songs.

We're excited that the Lord has been and continues to be with us, helping us, and maturing this group of saints in preparation for His calling.

May God's blessing and favor remain on us all as we work until His return.

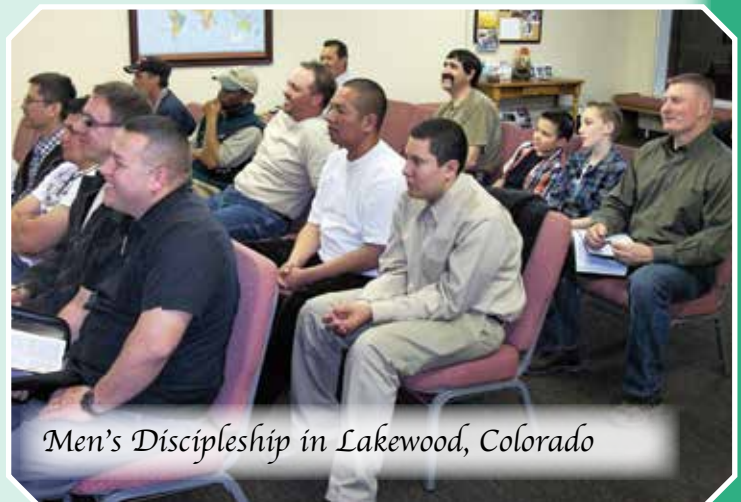

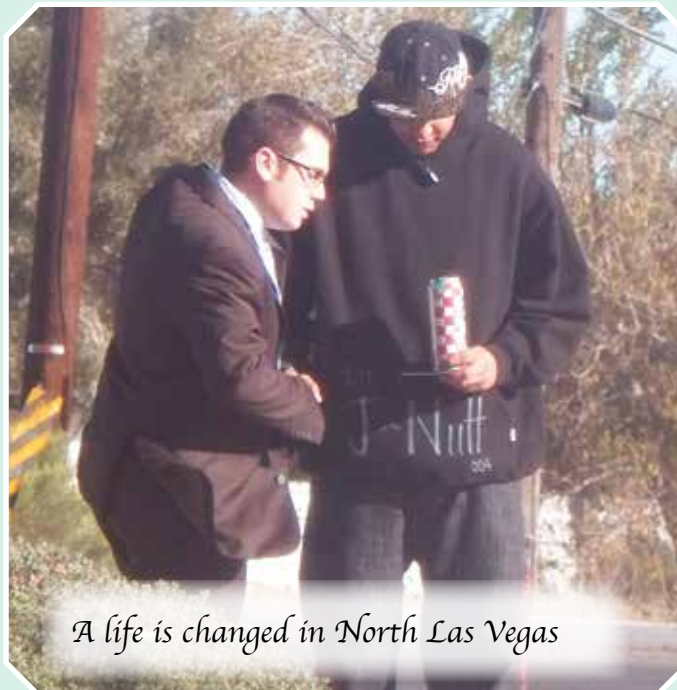
Praise God for a wonderful start this New Year. God is moving here in our city and still blessing our efforts to advance His Kingdom.

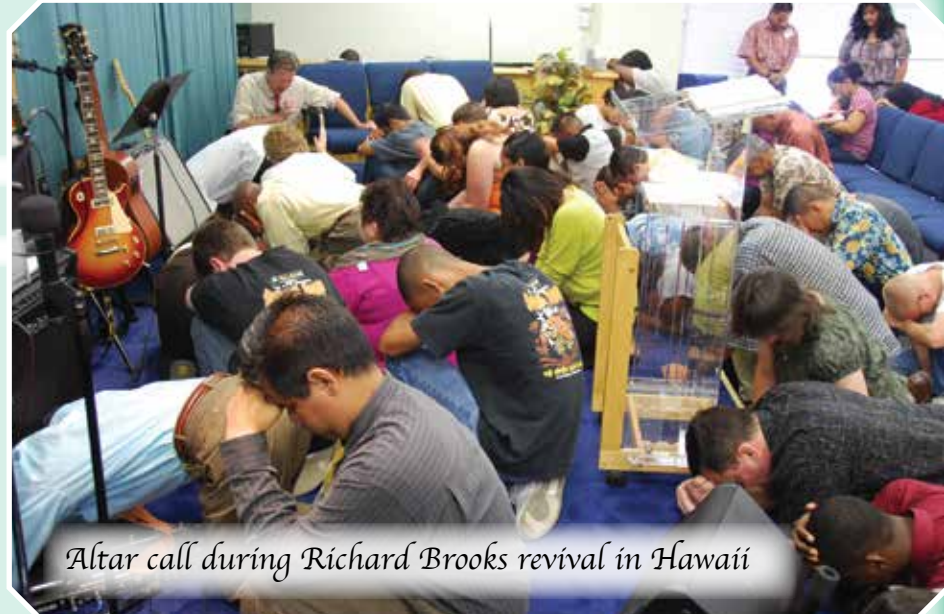

Taking to the streets with evangelism we have been recharged for all that God is doing and continues to do. In a recent park outreach we put on a rap concert followed by a



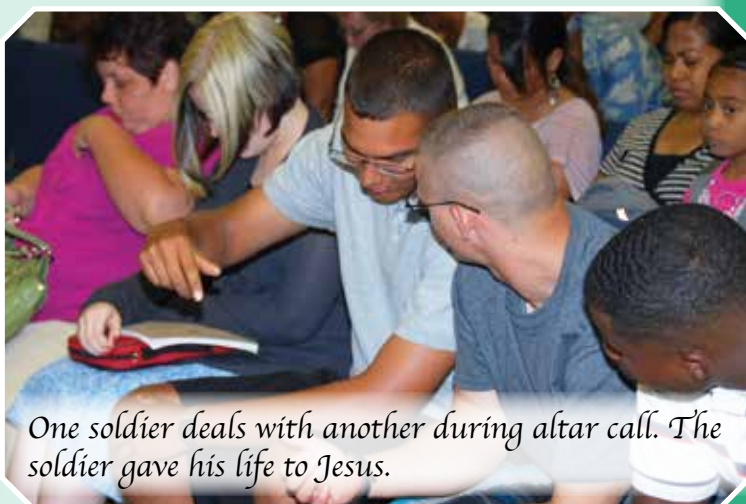
Altar call during Richard Brooks revival in Hawaii

Our saints have been faithful to witness on the local scene and on our military bases here in Hawaii and God has brought forth the rain in due



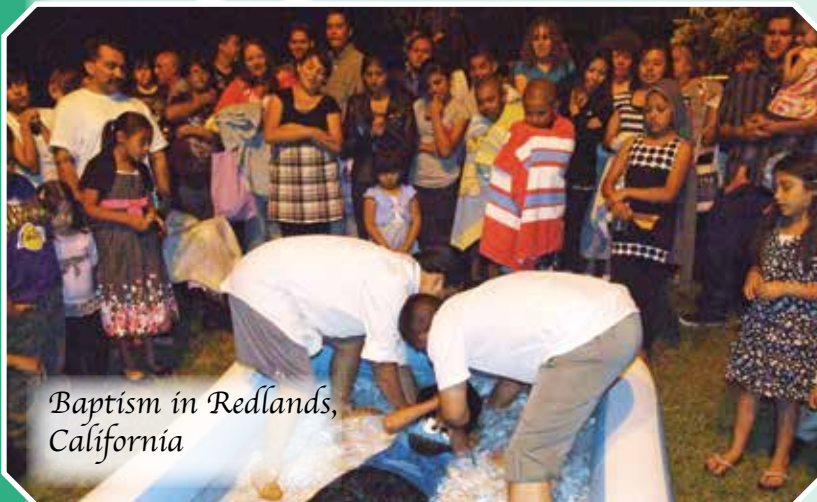
One soldier deals with another during altar call. The soldier gave his life to Jesus.

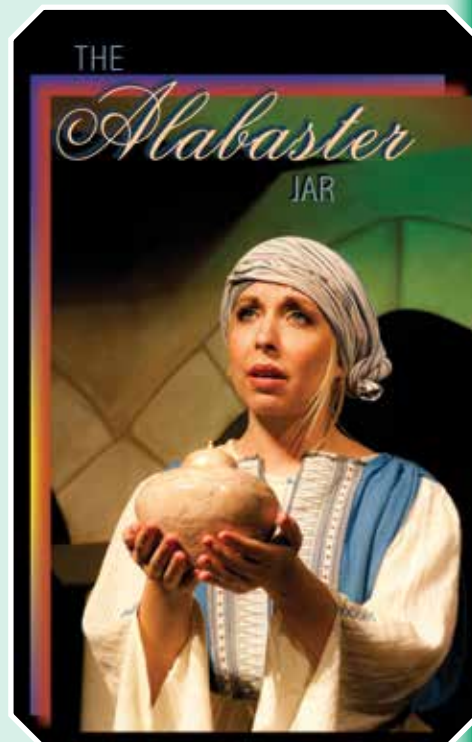

Hello everybody from Cuba! We were launched out from Vologda, Russia and landed on the island of Cuba a year ago. In fact we started praying to be able to come here six years ago and only a year ago God opened the door. We were planning to use the good relations between Russia and Cuba.

During the first two weeks of our stay on the island I was able to get acquainted with different people and local pastors who helped me to write a letter to the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba asking them to give me a religious visa for five years to have a legal right to start a church.

Though we had been told that there are no laws in Cuba regulating the church and the state, and that such a visa does not exist, we were hopeful for a miracle of God, because in a very short time we found out how great and open were the hearts of the Cubans for the Gospel.

The government never gave us any official reply. We knew that we would be obligated to leave the country in two months – which is the maximum time for Russians to stay in Cuba. We started fasting just three weeks before we were to go back to Russia.

In this time God literally stepped in and through a series of different events I found a Russian company officially working in Cuba for 10 years. The owner was a Russian lady whose parents were Protestant Christians living in Russia. She helped us

to get a work permit from the Cuban government, which automatically gave us a year long visa that can be prolonged annually up to 10 years. So this was how we got to stay in the country.

We have many places and potential people to whom we have been witnessing for many months and who are waiting for us to start Bible Studies in different neighborhoods of the city.

Right now we have three Bible studies a week with the attendance of 13-20 people each time. A month ago some people started tithing to God, believing for salvation of many souls in their country.

People get rid of their witchcraft objects and get healed. They witness to their friends and families.

For seven months we have had regular morning prayers with four to five people each time. God has given us six families that have been healed and restored.

We have three good guys who have responded to the calling of God to be disciples and to preach the Gospel. Most of the things we see are just in their beginning state, but still show us an incredible potential of this great nation for the Gospel.

During all this time we never

stopped seeking for the way to get legalized and stimulate the changes of the local laws in favour of Christianity. And God has given us a chance to meet with one local deputy of the National Parliament, a Baptist pastor and a friend of the president of the country. I met with him twice and he seemed to be impressed with what we were doing. He promised to help us to be legalized. So in one to two weeks we are waiting for a third meeting with him to find out about our next steps.

Please keep praying about this nation. These 12 million souls are very hungry for the Gospel that works and saves. As soon as we get a right to invite foreign preachers we will need the help of many of our Fellowship pastors to build a powerful fellowship of churches in this great nation.

We want to express our special thanks to the congregations in Vologda, Russia and Chilliwack, Canada, and Pastors Sergei Golubev and Dave Marks for their financial support. We thank Pastor Jose Torres and the many churches of the Mexican Fellowship for their help with papers and documents that will help us to get established here as legal missionaries for the fruit and the Glory of God.

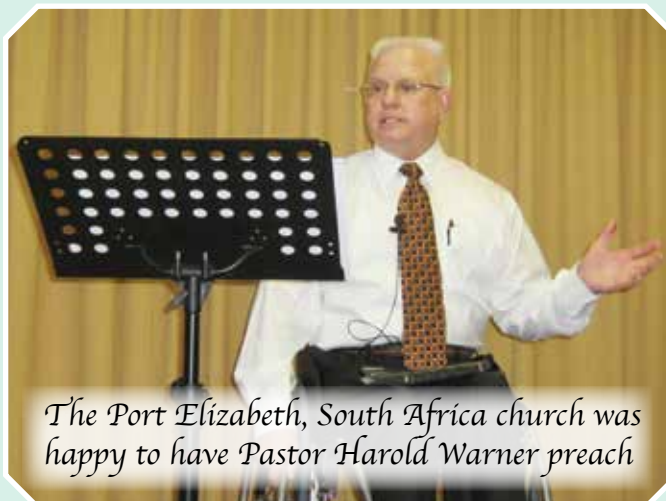
For Easter we had a live play, Toy Story 4. We had the largest crowd we ever saw at Sunday night - 250 people, with almost 40 saved!

God is moving in Perth, Western Australia!

We have had a very fruitful summer outreach season. God has been helping us as we go out of the four walls of the building and declare the gospel.

In January, we sent an Impact Team to the new work in Dili, East Timor for Pastor Stephen Kennaway. Evangelist Steve Zapata headed up the team and held a series of healing meetings. Through the week they saw many people healed, people who were demon-possessed delivered and a total of over 500 decisions made.

One notable area where God has really been helping us is in our City Outreaches. We have routinely been going into the CBD of Perth city and street preaching and witnessing. God has been giving us dominion and favour. When we pull an altar call in the middle of the city people are publicly responding to receive Christ right on the main street of our city.

Disciple Outreaches have had a great impact this summer also. Men in the church were rising up and organising their own outreaches by showing a movie in a local park. Many of these saw up to 100 visitors come out and one in particular had 19 people respond.

In February, we had the strongest evangelist in our fellowship, Pastor Mark Woods, come and hold a state-wide Youth Extreme. Youths from fellowship churches across the state were invited to be a part of a full day of evangelism where they were sent out to door knock, witness and street preach. In the evening, Pastor Woods did his Strongman Show at one of the local parks. We saw more than 400 visitors come to see the show and at the end of the night 40 people had given their lives to Christ!

In March, we held our annual Perth Bible Conference. There was such an air of expectancy as we came together and we experienced a real supernatural visitation of the Holy Ghost.

There was powerful ministry all through the week with our key speakers being Pastor Wayman Mitchell and Pastor Mark Aulson. There were many exciting new works announced.

Pastor Tom Payne gave the challenge at the start of the week that we needed a work in Christchurch, New Zealand. He highlighted that the recent disaster they had experienced would give great open-

ness to the gospel. Praise God we now have a church in Christchurch!

Over Easter, we did an Easter Parade through the city. It was amazing to see how people were so intrigued by the presentation of Christ being beaten and marched through the city. Then when we strategically showed Jesus dying on the cross and then being raised from the dead we were able to preach about our risen Savior. Saints testified of the power of Jesus Christ that changed their lives.

When Pastor Daryl Elliott pulled the final altar call, we saw nine people lift their hands and give their lives to Christ. From this, we went straight into a concert and revival with Evangelist Patrick Johnson. Many of the people who had responded at the Easter Parade came out to the revival and we saw numbers saved and filled with the Holy Ghost.

God is really moving and we are so thankful for the vision of our fellowship and for Pastor Mitchell and the Prescott church! Recent world events are shaking people and they are desperately searching for an answer. Thank God that we can be a part of the solution and all that He is doing in these last days.

Privet vsem! What a privilege it is to have Pastor Mitchell come every year for the Men's Rally in Moscow.

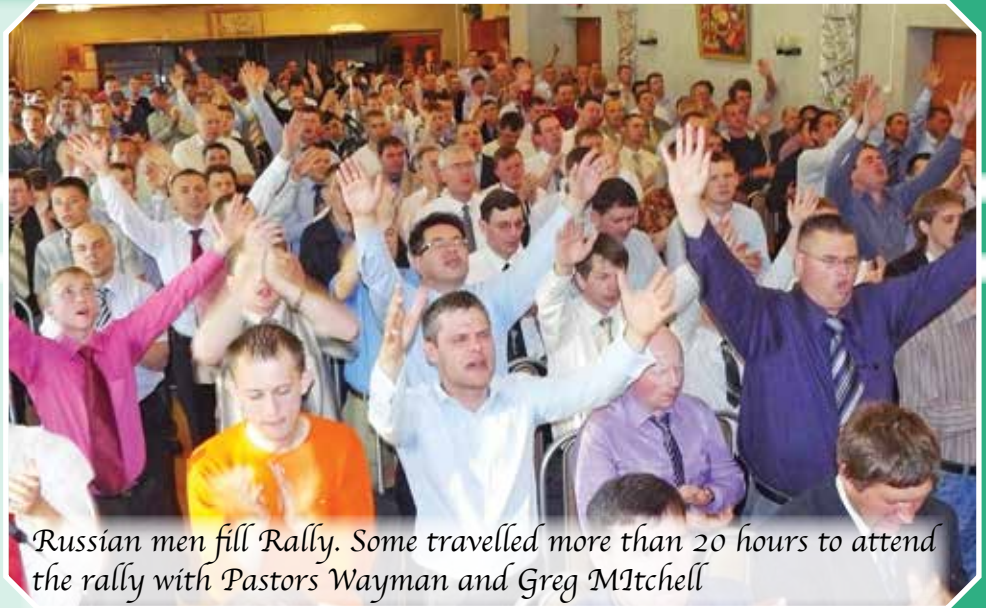

Prescott church says goodbye to a special man

The Prescott Potter's House in June said goodbye to Phil Payson, a longtime member who made great impact in his years in the church. Phil died on June 5, 2011.

After he and his wife Pat were saved in 1970, they set out to do all they could to further the Gospel. They worked together founding the Potter's House tape ministry, and Phil started a weekly radio show highlighting salvation testimonies, started Men's Breakfasts at the church, and founded The Trumpet, which has for years encouraged people all over the world.

Following are excerpts from Phil's testimony, which he wrote a year before he went home to be with the Lord.

"Why would a happily married man, at 49, need God? I was blessed with a loving, caring wife, a lovely home, two sons attending the University of Arizona, and a teenaged daughter who was a joy and a pleasure. My job with the State of Arizona as a manager was enjoyable and secure.

My spiritual life was dutifully attended to, in regular attendance by our whole family in a mainline denominational church. Social activities were stressed and some financial support was given to missionaries. I taught adult Bible classes and my wife, Pat, taught third and fourth grade Bible classes. I was satisfied to some extent, but there seemed to be a voice within me that said, "Is this all there is to Christianity?"

Revelations 3:20 gives us a promise from Jesus, Who tells us, "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If any man hears my voice and opens the door, I will come into him and sup with him, and he with Me." This refers to a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, the Son of the Living God.

I needed spiritual reality in my life!

In 1967, our daughter Janet began a disruption to our tranquil lifestyle. We began to notice a problem with her discipline, lack of trust and spells of turmoil and hostility. There was a radical change in her behavior. We tried to find answers to account for it.

Word began to get around that Prescott High School students were becoming

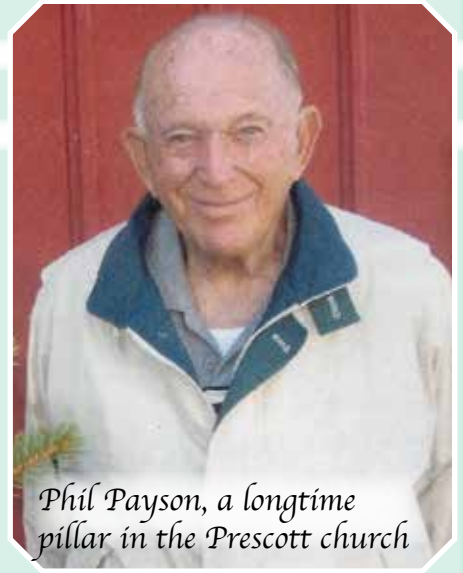
increasingly involved in drug dealing. We had reason to believe Janet was part of the trend. We began to focus our attention on her associations and hidden activities. The situation did not improve. We heard of students defying their parents and attending school in a "stoned" condition. Threats of jail or expulsion from school had little effect on their conduct. We needed God to take over. Could He, or would He? We spent three years dealing with this heartbreak!

One night, Janet was on her way with friends to a forbidden party. But enroute to this party, her boyfriend explained that he had a family obligation to attend to first, and asked them to come along. A cousin had called for a meeting of all his relations to his home in Chino Valley, to declare to them how he had become a "Jesus Freak." They all laughed about it and thought it would be an interesting diversion. It turned out that the young man speaking at this family meeting was Jack, a drug pusher from Janet's group of friends. He shared with the gathering about his life-changing event and how they, too, could get "high" on Jesus, rather than on drugs, breaking their sinful lifestyles and turning to Him for forgiveness and peace of mind.

Janet, her boyfriend Mike, best friend Emily, and friend Roger were moved to attend a small Pentecostal church where God was truly moving and touching lives. These friends all received Jesus Christ into their hearts that morning of August 1970. They went back again to church that evening. Janet came home afterwards claiming to have had a "born again experience!" She was ecstatic and sat my wife and I down to tell us all about her exciting experience of salvation. The change in her was obvious. This was not the acceptance of some church doctrine or creed, but repenting of her sins and receiving Jesus into her heart.

Janet's conversion was proved by a changed life, a new respect and love for us, her parents, as well as a desire to fulfill God's commandment: "Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel...(Mark 6:15).

Janet reached out to her party friends and shared her story at school, later in a

singing ministry "Living Waters" that played in our church's coffeehouse "The Door" as well as outreaching throughout the state. She later became the wife of Pastor Kevin Foley and has been faithfully at his side for 31 years in solid ministry of their church.

Pat and I finally realized that despite our religious pretensions, we too needed to swallow our pride and make a heartfelt commitment publically to Christ. We also needed to have the "born again experience" that Jesus says one must have in order to have eternal life. (John 3:1-16).

After hearing a number of sermons and resisting altar calls by Pastor Mitchell, we went to the altar on Dec. 28, 1970 and invited Jesus Christ into our hearts. We felt compelled to share what had happened to us with our friends, family and acquaintances. Our home and marriage became transformed. I have never regretted becoming a Christian. Jesus has made Himself known to me in a personal way and has been a wonderful comfort to me through the loss of my wife Pat, and through major illnesses and surgeries.

God has given me a quiet peace and calm, as well as blessing me with financial reward beyond anything I ever believed possible. God has never let me down. God bless Pastor Mitchell for his excellent Bible teaching, preaching, vision for the world and attention to my spiritual needs for nearly 40 years.

Prescott's Monday night outreaches still fruitful

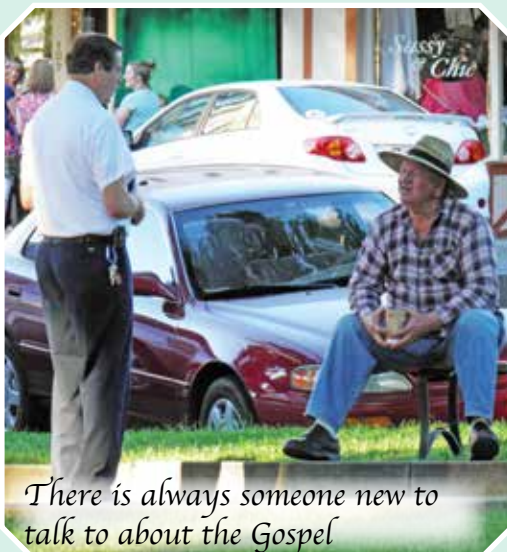


Setting up for Monday night outreach in courthouse plaza, downtown Prescott
