“God makes no small plans” said Pastor Mitchell in a recent sermon to us.

No one could imagine how great our Fellowship has become from the small beginnings in small town Prescott, Ariz. And now after all of the years gone by the Prescott Potter's House church is still powering on and staying faithful to the Heavenly vision and calling shared by our Pastor and this congregation.

Our pastors are constantly busy traveling literally all over the civilized world to minister in crusades and conferences and discipleship gatherings. And while they do their part the Prescott church does it's part both in support of a world-wide outreach and on the local level.

Every Saturday morning our young disciples follow Jesse Morales out to the local areas for door-to-door and public area outreaches. They regularly report numbers of people saved. As the weather warms up disciples start conducting neighborhood outreaches - everything from bands with hot dogs to mini-healing crusades in someone's front yard. People get saved and healed out there on the front lines of our local area.

Noel Tossing has been involved in prison ministry for many years and he continues to minister at a juvenile corrections facility in Phoenix as well as joining with another group for major outreaches within prison walls in Arizona, California, and Texas.

Our church also conducts downtown Prescott park outreaches of witnessing, music, a film, and preaching with many saved out in the public arena.

Our teens have begun to go witnessing at the entertainment district in Prescott Valley and every time they go they report praying with 30 or 40 kids outside the movie theater. Our long running music scene, One80, continues to be a venue for ministry and evangelism.

In our church services we see many things happen as well. We were blessed to have evangelist Jerry Fussell for revival and a Youth Extreme. Many kids were saved and Spirit filled and our church was stirred by the messages and personal ministry words that were given to many. Our children's church workers put on an Easter play called Risen that was written by Bear Montgomery.

We had a change of personnel in our Spanish language ministry as we bid farewell to Eddie and Tracy Baretto and welcomed in their place Juan and Giselle Fiffield from Nogales, Ariz. The Spanish speaking folks are a true part of our church and do a great job reaching out to and winning the non-English speakers who live in our area.

Pastor Mitchell has for years put an emphasis on marriage and family and goes out of his way to minister to us married folks and to challenge the young men in our church to get on the ball and get married. Pastor preaches on marriage at every wedding and it is such a rich time of ministry. It's amazing that he can minister on marriage and people respond to be saved. On Mother's Day we held a banquet for mothers and were blessed to hear testimony from four generations of ladies still faithfully serving the Lord in the Prescott church.

We firmly believe the Lord Jesus still has great plans for us in Prescott, to enlarge us and to prosper us and to give us a future and a living hope.

### Pastor Mitchell ministers in conferences, rallies and in Russia

Pastor Wayman Mitchell has again been privileged to represent the Fellowship, ministering in the Northwest Conference in McMinnville, Oregon where one pioneer church was planted in Milwaukee, Oregon near Portland.

A Pioneer Rally in Redlands, California had near record attendances under the area leader Pastor Rich Cox.

The San Luis, Mexico Healing Crusade was held in the city square. A youth impact team from Prescott is always a highlight. The first night some 200 people responded for salvation and many miracle healings were demonstrated as the Lord Jesus Christ was present to heal. The second night brought even more under perfect weather. The third night Pastor Jonathan Heimberg followed up to preach the

crusade and did an outstanding job. God showed He is no respecter of persons as 200 or so were saved and outstanding miracles were seen to confirm this young man's ministry.

Pastor Mitchell preached two days in the Nogales, Sonora Conference. Some 1,400 people and 120 pastors filled the buildings April 2-6, 2012. Eight new pioneer churches were planted.

In May Pastor Mitchell preached in the Tempe, Arizona Conference, the Redlands Area Wide Men's Discipleship, and the Jacksonville, Florida Pioneer Rally with Pastor Ron Meyer accompanied by Pastor Joe Campbell.

The highlight of the spring was Pastor Wayman Mitchell and Pastor Greg Mitchell traveling to Moscow, Russia for a National Men's Rally.

sian ministry, Sergei Golubev, is doing an outstanding job. About 90 of the men who attended are recovered drug addicts. God has given the Vologda church favor in reaching these desperate men.

More pastors from Mongolia, the Sakalin Islands, and all over Russia made up the attendance.

Last Sunday altars were full, we then baptized 10 souls, and we reached a new record for a regular Sunday service- 87!

We have about 25-30 new converts that love Jesus and are excited to live for Him and bring others! One lady has already brought 23 family members with her and four of them were baptized!

And what a joy to report that God showed Himself faithful as we once again experienced His healing power and numbers of miracles took place to the glory of God!

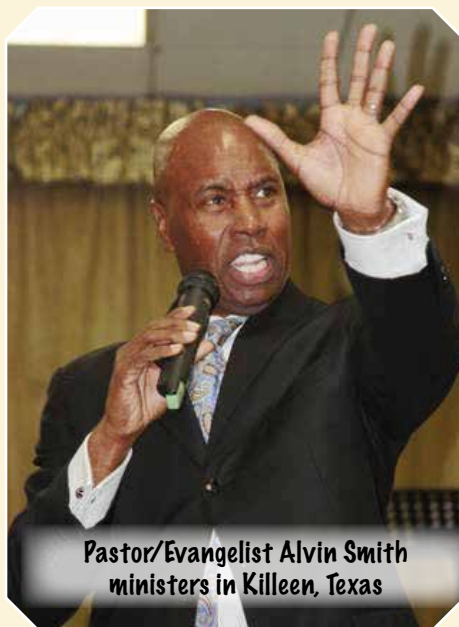
This June 16 thru the help of the church in Alexandria, Virginia we have secured a key location very near to the National Mall in Washington DC for our first "God

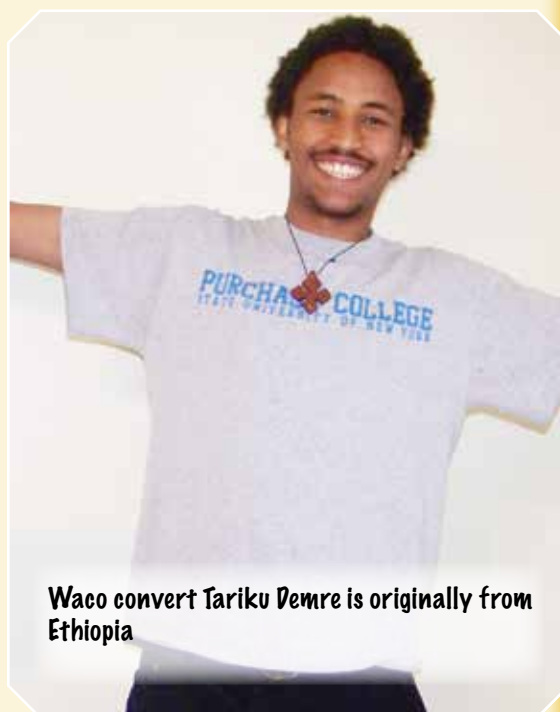
First church service in Waco, Texas with Pastor Wayne Nickerson

We are busy doing what we always do in Amersfoort and suddenly we celebrate our 25th anniversary.

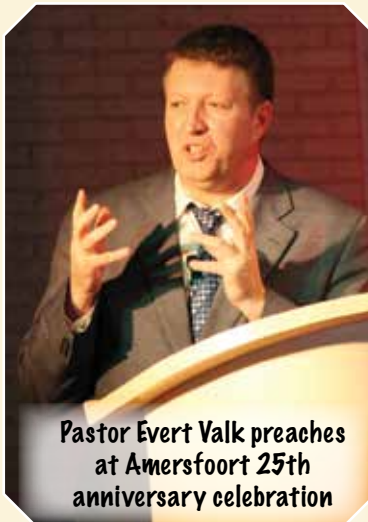

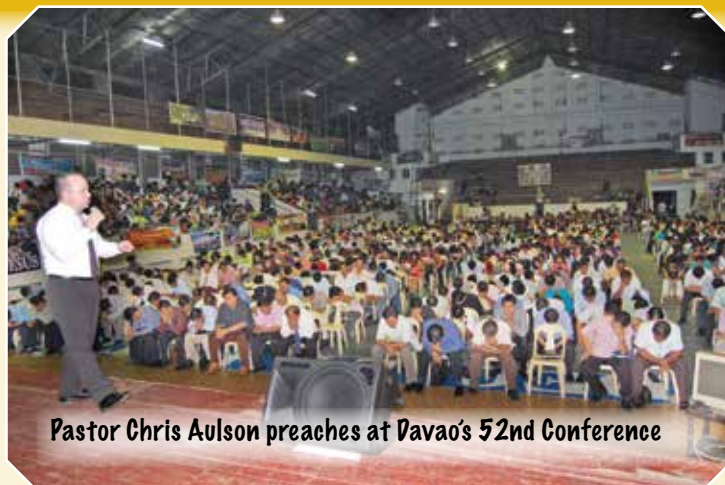

During the first outreach with an impact team, we decided to sing and preach on the street in front of many Muslims, the majority group in the society.
