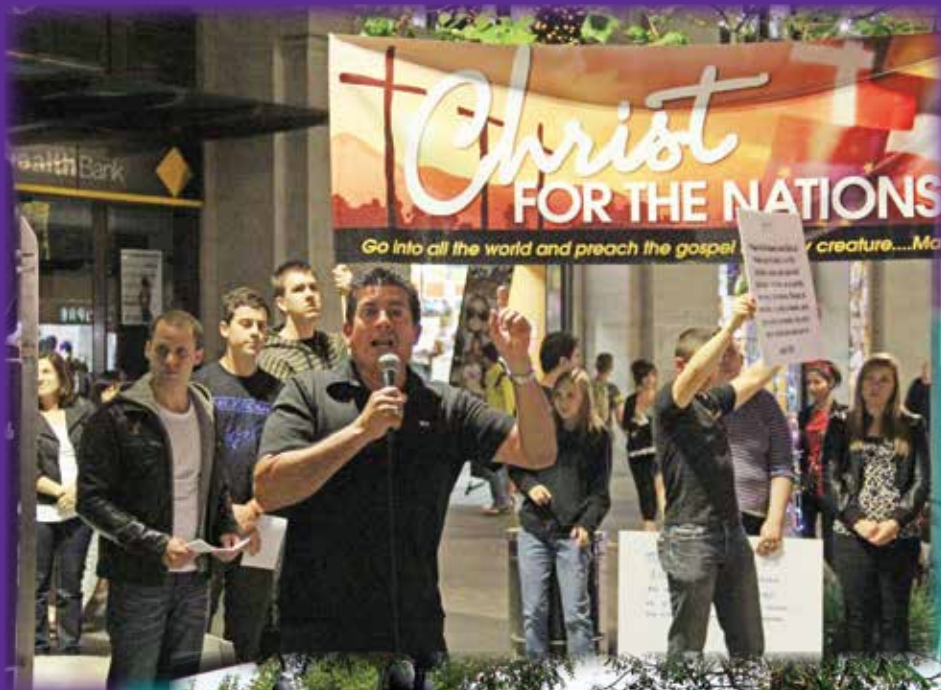

The Potter's House in Prescott is a church filled with saved, sanctified, and Spirit-filled disciples of all ages, cultures, and economic backgrounds who have been joined together by Jesus himself to be His body on planet Earth.

We therefore, knowing that this is a work of God and not of a man, do all we can to discover and obey our Father's will. No one person among us can do everything, but we all find something that we can do.

On a typical Sunday morning we might hear a series of outreach reports such as: Impact team went out and saw 10 saved in another city, or One80 saw five saved, or our Saturday outreach team prayed with five souls, or a disciple-led neighborhood outreach saw seven saved and one healed.

Most, if not all, of our outreach teams and ministries are all done by disciples or common people who are trying their best to do something to reach lost souls.

In September the state of Arizona began a centennial celebration called Arizona Best Fest, which kicked off in Prescott.

We used our One80 facility to host an all day outside concert outreach the same day and saw 21 souls saved. Later that month we hosted a statewide Youth Extreme to coincide with a Roman Gutierrez revival. That saw 250 kids assemble and 18 saved.

Twice Dead, brother Roman's life story play attracted standing room only

crowds and saw 39 saved. Roman Gutierrez brought powerful ministry to our church and we saw many visitors and many saved and filled with the Holy Spirit during the week.

The Yavapai County Fair was canceled this year because of a facility bankruptcy, which took away a great outreach opportunity. But the local powers that be got their act together and put on a smaller fair.

Our disciples put up their witness booth in a prime location and prayed with 92 souls.

Every year the Chinle church invades Prescott with their youth choir and pastor Artie preaching, along with an authentic fry bread feast.

The Chinle choir sang a song that said: "Greater things have yet to come, Greater things are still to be done ...". This theme seems to be being emphasized by the Holy Spirit to the Prescott church over and over again.

We recently finished our annual Haunted House presentation. This year was The Haunted Cafe. People stand out in the cold, some for over an hour, waiting to get in. But they come out the other side saying "it was worth it."

A total of 117 people responded for salvation, mostly teens and young people this year.

In everything we do we are constrained by the love of God and the challenge to contend for the foolishness of preaching instead of the wisdom of the world.

God faithfully helps us and encourages us to continue in the faith once delivered to the saints.

Thank God for all of you who partner with us in this great adventure of redemption.

Pastor Mitchell conducted an outdoor Miracle Crusade in Farmington, New Mexico for pastor David Maldonado with a good response and people saved and healed. He then preached at the Navajo Nation's Rally in Chinle, Ariz. for Pastor Artie Aragon in their completed, remodeled building. The new workers in South Dakota among the Sioux tribe were present and brought delegates. The new building at Chinle was packed out.

A Miracle Healing Crusade in Redlands, Calif. always brings out a crowd. The Redlands Bowl in Central Redlands furnishes a great forum for God to save and heal.

Pastor Mitchell traveled to Jacksonville, North

Carolina for a marriage retreat and Men's Discipleship and Rally for Dave Szczepanski. Their new building furnishes an excellent forum for that area.

Pastor Mitchell traveled to Almaria, Spain along with teams and pastors from Holland and England for a Miracle Healing Crusade in a tent. Many people responded, were powerfully healed and one night a regional television team filmed the service. Jesus Christ was present to heal and a great testimony went out for the Lord.

A well-attended conference in Chilliwack, B.C., Canada for Pastor David Marks, and the San Antonio, Texas Bible Conference for Pastor Richard Rubi were the next stops for

Pastor Mitchell.

Crusades in Las Vegas, Nevada and Santa Monica, Calif. were very well attended and saw many people saved and healed.

Men's Discipleships in Redlands, Calif., Hobbs, New Mexico and McMinnville, Oregon, and the Walthamstow, England Bible Conference rounded out the year for Pastor Mitchell.

Some 94 people from the Fellowship made the Israel Bible Lands Tour Nov. 15-24. The highlight for pastors was gathering at 5 a.m. with Pastor Mitchell for lessons and hands-on sermon crafting. These were followed by touring in the day's itinerary, then returning after dinner to again share in sermon building. Some 10-15 pastors were

blessed by these sessions that are always frosting on the cake for the tour.

Pastor Mitchell traveled to Australia in December for an Area-Wide Rally in Melbourne for Pastor Anthony Tilli. He went on to Launceston, Tasmania to conduct a rally and Miracle Healing Crusade for Pastor Mike White.

The Southwest Men's Rally in Phoenix was packed out on Dec. 2 and 3. Pastors Wayman Mitchell, Mark Aulson, Greg Mitchell, and Joe Campbell brought life changing ministry and many remarked that this was the best Men's Rally ever. The year 2012 promises to be a watershed moment for our Fellowship as we see signs of an "abundance of rain."

in our church and had a packed house with 44 souls saved. During Halloween we did our "Faces of Meth" play and saw 26 souls saved.

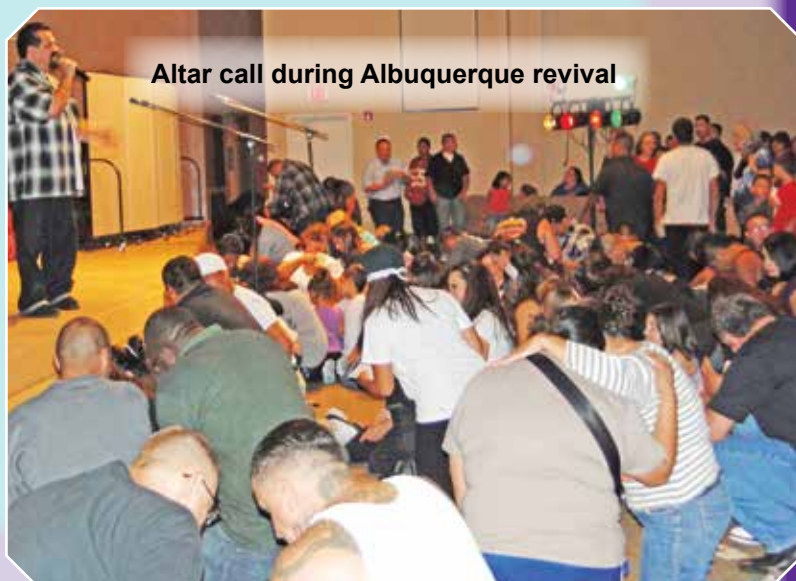
We have had some timely revivals since July conference with Neil McCann, Kris Hart and Paul Stevens. Each one of them brought timely messages that helped our church.

One sister who has had constant repairs on her car, got a FREE Jeep, we were able to start a Bible study in Kyle, new converts came in who were radically converted and de-

challenged the church to a 40-day fast. The first three days we fasted together as a church and fasting continued every day as different saints fasted each day. In this fast there were many needs and prayers that were lifted up,

livered, and we are still seeing visitors and backsliders come through.

The Door at Texas State University is another great victory through our prayers and fasting. There are more than 30,000 students who attend this university. This is a city in itself. For years we have tried to reach this area in San Marcos and finally the truth will be available to these students. God has opened the door to go in and deliver the gospel to the four corners of the university.

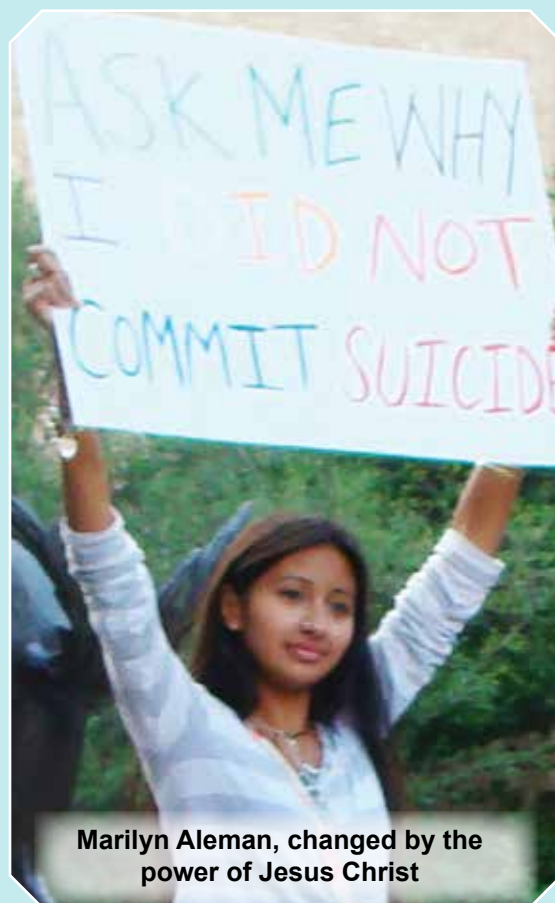

"I grew up with my sister Julieta who had an immense

love for me. It was me and her against the world.

Unfortunately, she inherited a neurological dis-



ease and passed away at the beautiful age of 21. Through the whole two years of her dying process I believe I cut myself off from the world.

I no longer wanted to be with the living, and engaged in self-destructive patterns. At the age of 14 I had my life-changing encounter with cocaine. Fast forward, years later and I've burned so many bridges with people over my drug abuse. It was an easy process of not being present in everyday life.

I experimented with every new idea that came along, acting impulsively without giving a single thought as to how that might affect me in the future. I lived in the now.

Sex, drugs and alcohol, the same story that every drug addict has, the only

difference is that some of us make it out and some of us don't.

I faintly remember some

clips of the last year I was abusing drugs. It was a spiral downward that was soon coming to its stopping point. I chose drugs over my responsibilities. I selected my addictions and decided to live on the streets with people I couldn't recognize days later. I woke up in the random alleys

of the night, knowing only that I had done many things wrong.

Take a deep breath and get high all over again was my model, because it was fun, because I loved it, because my body craved for it, I lived for it, the taste, the smell, obsession, I WAS A SLAVE.

I remember the day that Jesus touched my heart. It was a morning that I returned to my parent's house and was completely incoherent. My mother, having seen me like this before took initiative and took me to the hospital. Days later I was at their home covered by a cloud of withdrawal. Everything hurt, including my dignity.

I hadn't been sober in

so long, and now I began to slowly think again. It all hurt so much on the inside. I didn't shower. I didn't eat. I didn't move. I would continuously look at myself in the mirror and muster all my hatred towards the reflection. I hated what I had become.

The mess I called my life was no longer an option, yet being on earth again with the rest of the world was a definite no. Suicide. I had no fear and was going into it with no regrets. Overdose was my choice. Hands down, all I had was surrender, when a guy named Saul spoke to me about a man named Jesus. A man I had turned away from my entire life, never having faith in his presence.

My sorrow consumed me at this point and seeing no other choice besides death I decided to try my luck at church when I was invited.

I don't remember the day I got saved, because I can't remember much about this point in my life even though it has only been about four months.

In all honesty I don't believe the day truly matters. What matters is that Jesus spoke to me that day. He was bringing me back to life after being dead for so long. My life has taken on the shape of a spiral, but now it moves in a different direction. I don't know where it goes, but it seems to be working out just fine.

I don't know what kind of things my future might bring, but I do know that staying on the path I am taking is the only decision. My life is starting the next chapter, and I'm happy to say that I only welcome it with open arms. Jesus Christ is the greatest impulsive idea I have ever had."

God has allowed us to have a fruitful Bible study on the air force base inside the base chapel.

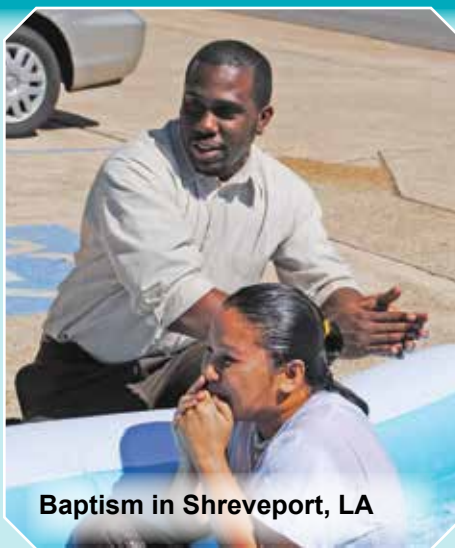
We recently married a couple and had several baby dedications and baptisms.

Another man who was totally blind in one eye was prayed for but it seemed nothing had happened, but God had begun to heal him so that two weeks out from the revival he had 70% sight in the eye!

The Hamilton saints have been hitting the streets, knocking on doors, holding picnics, playing touch rugby games, fellowshiping up a storm, imbibing caffeine, street preaching, inviting people out to our services and generally believing God to have His way in our city and nation.

We have seen a genuine desire in young men to rise up to the challenge of preaching through pulpit practice sessions, and more young saints are beginning to serve in church ministry.

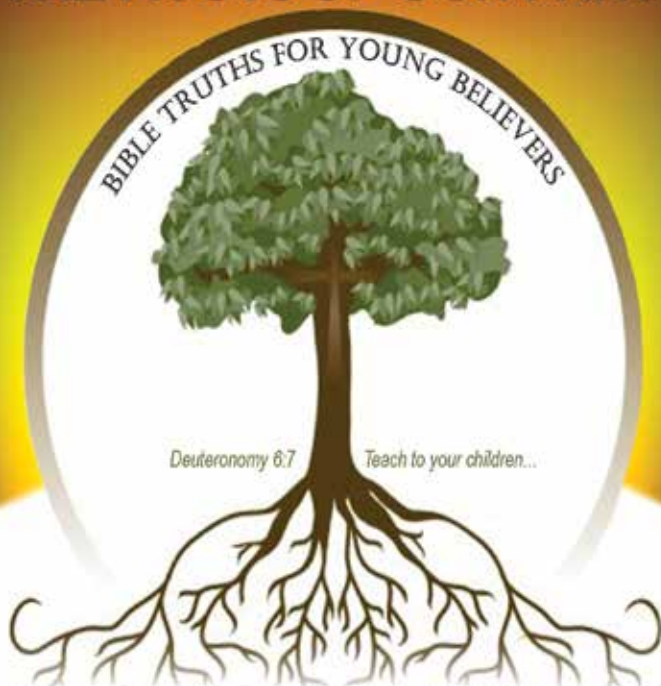
