Perth, Australia 35th anniversary a highlight of Pastor's travels

Pastor Mitchell has continued a busy schedule for the early part of 2013. Men's rallies in San Jose, Calif. and Albuquerque, New Mexico rounded out 2012, followed by a dynamic miracle crusade in Mexico city for Salvador Casteneda. The four night crusade saw record attendances, hundreds of people saved, and many miracles of healing.

A men's discipleship class in Redlands, Calif. in January and March in Rich Cox's enlarged auditorium was packed out with men from the Los Angeles area.

The 35th year celebration in Perth, West Australia in March was the highlight as both Pastors Wayman Mitchell and Greg Mitchell and their wives were able to reconnect with long time friends and workers in the Australian Fellowship.

Eddie and Tracy Barreto, who were launched into Argentina as missionaries from Perth, attended. They were able to see their daughter Jessica and her hus-

band Aaron Cook sent out to pioneer in the Adelaide, Australia area.

The outstanding work being done in Perth, Australia by Tom and Janice Payne has brought solidarity, growth, and vision to the Australian churches. Their conference saw two international workers announced, as well as three internal Australian churches.

Pastor Mitchell traveled through Brisbane, Australia (Strathpine) for an area wide rally under Pastor Peter Fields before going on to Perth to conduct a one night miracle crusade at an outside park and ministering in leadership seminars.

Pastor Mitchell traveled to Guam, Marianas Islands to conduct a miracle healing crusade for Pastor Glen Cluck. Many of the Island Nation pastors from all over the Pacific were in attendance from Saipan, Palau, Chuuck, Kosrae and more. Many people were saved and a record attendance on the final Sunday night was a testimony to the impact being made in those small islands.

Pioneer rallies in Las Vegas, Nevada preceded ministry in Jacksonville, North Carolina. Sermon workshops took place at Raleigh, North Carolina under Pastor David Szczepanski. Greg Mitchell, Mike Weber from Toronto, Canada, and Terry Haynes worked two days in sermon making seminars.

Pastor Mitchell was the guest speaker for two days at the Nogales, Sonora Bible Conference in Mexico for Jose Luis Gaxiola. The new building in Nogales, Sonora was packed out with overflow crowds in the upstairs video overflow with 200 people watching.

This conference, which is headquarters ministry for the Mexican arm of our Fellowship, has 250 churches at this writing in Mexico with 18 churches in other countries. This conference was a glorious testimony that what we do works in any country of the world as the discipleship, church planting, and indigenous church structure is exploding around the world.

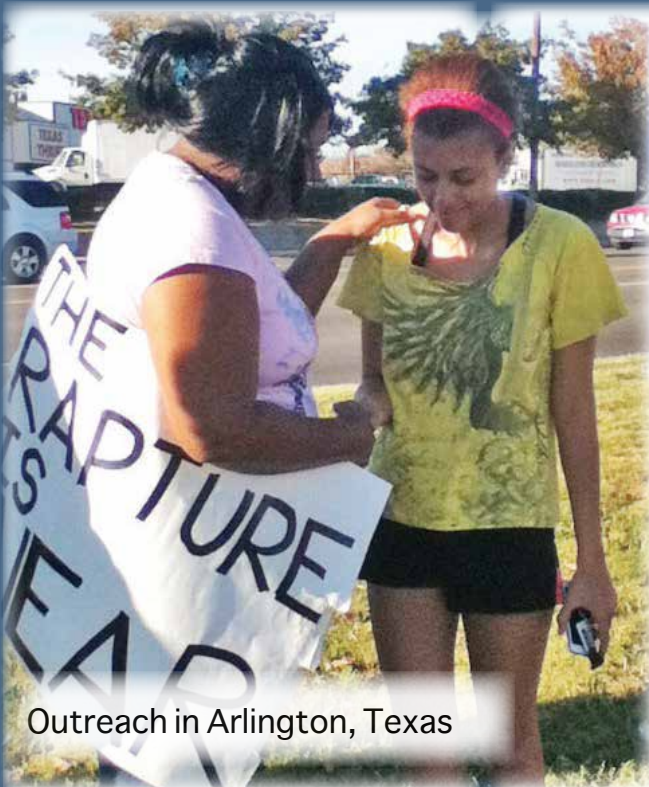

People started to come to the church and build relationships with God.

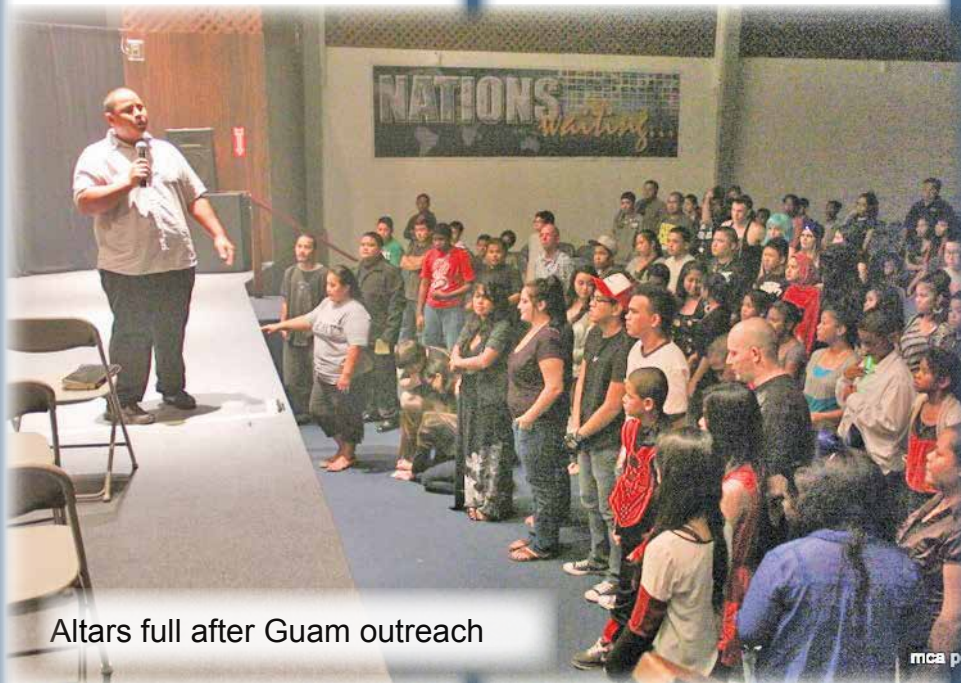

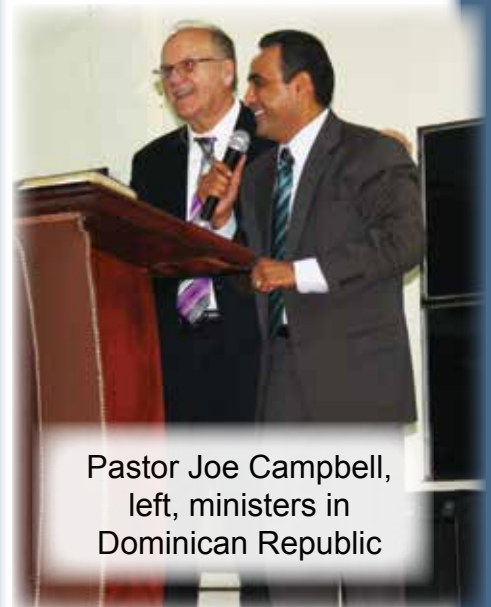
There are not enough words to say how powerfully God has been moving in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, people are getting saved and locking in, in every service.

This group has its own dramas and music ministry and has already been out to a few churches in Portsmouth and Slough, leaving a powerful work of God in those places.

We are doing a Serious Men's class every Sunday just before the morning service, for those men that would go out and pioneer one day. Men have been coming to that, being stirred and learning about the harvest field every morning.

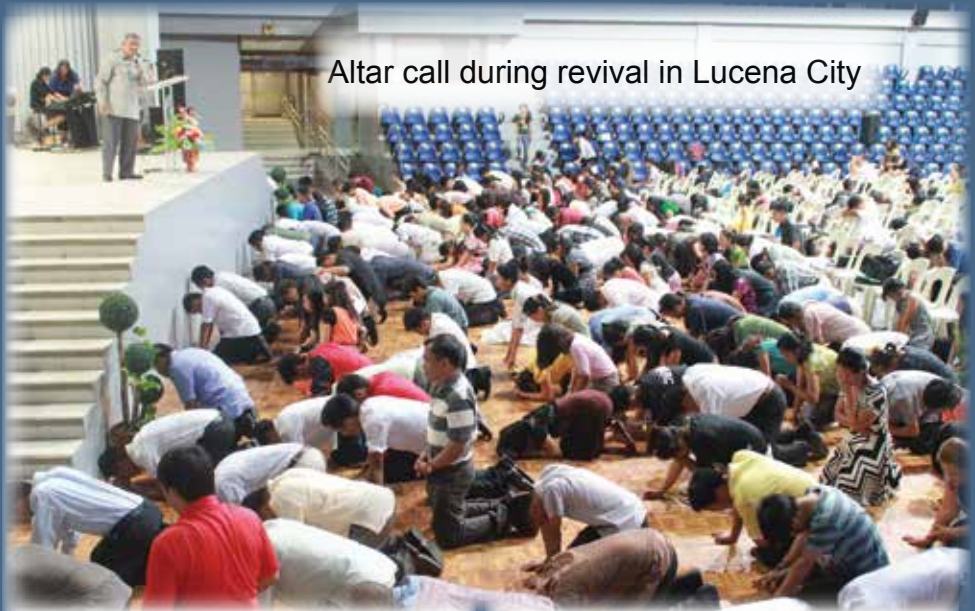
We are looking forward to having revival with Pastor Steve Gabriel at the end of February and waiting to see what God is going to do.
