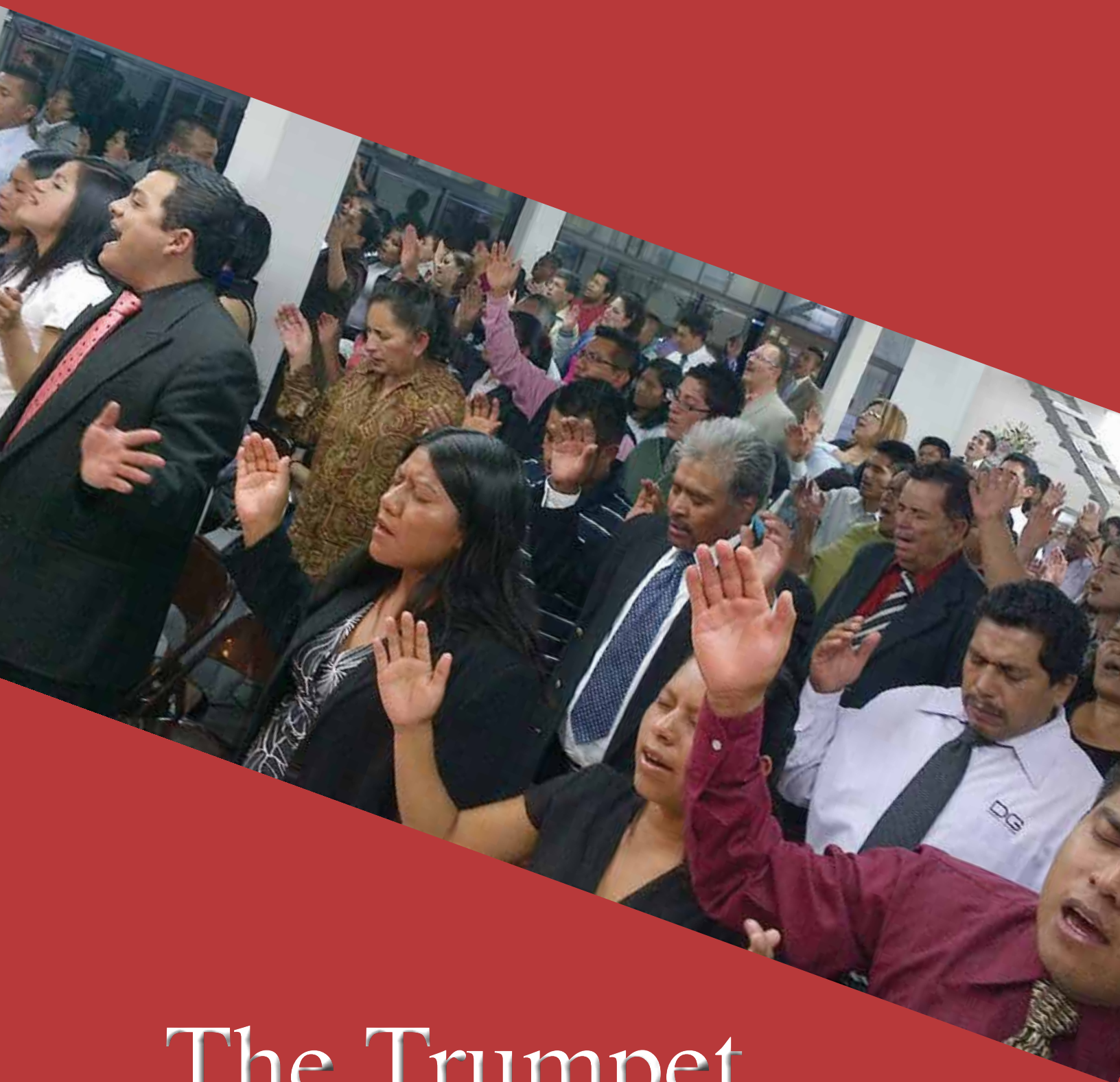

“Is the best of the free life behind us now? Are the good times really over for good?”

These words, written in a song by Merle Haggard, were the opening lines of a sermon Pastor Mitchell recently preached to the Prescott saints. The text was the familiar 2 Chronicles 7:14. “If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and heal their land.”

We, the Prescott Potters House church, along with many of you, are the people of God upon whom the balance of power in the world rests.

The only thing usual or ordinary about life in the Prescott church is how extraordinary it becomes when God moves in blessing and power and fruitfulness.

Every Sunday morning we hear reports from our various outreach ministries and hear how the Lord is working with our faithful laborers by saving those who believe in the risen Son of God.

We send impact teams to cities around Arizona and they pray with scores of new converts out on the streets. We saw more than 40 saved in Glendale, helping Pastor Gary Marsh.

Our outreach play, Darkness to Light, has traveled to many different place with dramatic responses. In Glendale for Pastor Martinez, the drama saw more than 50 saved in one performance.

Our local saints go out faithfully every Saturday and they almost always lead people to Jesus – 1, 2, 6, 10 or more in just a few hours of labor.

This summer we ramped up our Friday Night Outreaches (FNO) where the disciples set up a neighborhood healing mini crusade and see people saved and healed.

Project 180 continues to reach out to addicts in recovery. One80 continues to power on in our concert outreach. Our young people continue to reach out at the entertainment district in Prescott Valley with dozens of desperate kids getting saved.

In April we were blessed to have Pastor Aaron Saavedra in Prescott. He ministered to the kids in a Youth Extreme service with kids saved and filled with the Holy Ghost. He continued on in revival in the Prescott church with outstanding ministry in word and in deed.

Also in April our church sponsored and participated in the annual San Luis, Mexico Miracle Crusade. Over three nights there were 556 saved, 81 healings, and over 3000 total attendance.

In May we were blessed by the anointed ministry of Evangelist Steve Bowman. “Its not over!” is how he put it. I say Amen!

We also started up our summer outreach season on Memorial Day in the courthouse plaza with live music and a Gospel film. God continues to bless evangelism in the public arena.

So, pastor asked, which song are we going to sing? The gloom and doom of Mr. Haggard and the radio talk show kool aid drinkers? Or are we going to humble ourselves, pray, and repent so that God can heal our land?

The choice is up to us.

Healing crusades, conferences, more demonstrate power of Jesus Christ

Pastor Mitchell preached in the Gallup, New Mexico Bible Conference to a packed out attendance in the vision being carried on by Pastor Bob Mammen and the area churches in New Mexico.

The El Paso, Texas Spring Bible Conference was his next stop and Pastor Paul Stephens' vision and thrust in the Mexican churches out of El Paso was a highlight.

Pastor continued from El Paso to San Antonio, Texas for Pastor Richard Rubi. A Saturday night seminar for pastors and wives was widely attended as a special session for questions and answers was appreciated by more than 30 pastoral couples.

Sunday morning services were well attended. Then Sunday night most of the area churches came together for

Monday night area wide men's discipleship class as well as a Monday morning sermon making session with Pastor Mitchell and 20 of the area pastors was very encouraging to all.

Men's discipleship classes in Redland, San Diego and Las Vegas, Nevada all were well attended in April as well as the Northwest Bible Conference in McMinnville, Oregon organized by Pastor Kevin Foley.

Cape Cod, Massachusetts was the scene of the East Coast Bible Conference with Pastor Paul Campo. The beautiful facility of the Cape

Cod church is a wonderful testimony to the faithfulness and wisdom of Paul Campo's leadership and a great congregation with a world vision.

The annual San Luis, Mexico Crusade and invasion team of youth from Prescott saw a wonderful response as over 1,000 to 1,200 people were in attendance each night. Several hundred cards were registered as new converts responded and more wonderful and instantaneous miracles were demonstrated nightly. Pastor Jonathan Heimberg conducted the final night and the follow-up revival with the same power as our Lord Jesus Christ was present to heal.

A one night crusade in Las Vegas, Nevada with Pastor Scott Lamb organizing and

the Las Vegas area churches participating on Sunday night produced around 15-20 new converts and several visible miracles.

Pastor Greg Mitchell and Pastor Wayman Mitchell traveled to Moscow, Russia for the annual Men's Rally. Back to back seminars Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday night with Thursday and Friday back to back daytime seminars brought a great dimension to some 250 men.

One Cambodian pastor and two men from Cambodia, two pastors from Mongolia accompanied by three men from Mongolia, a delegation of men from Lithuania and a total of 28 pastors under the direction of Pastor Sergei Golubev is a great testimony that what we do works.

Greetings from the "Land of Enchantment."

Praise God for all He is doing here in the city of Alamogordo. God is on the throne and has been moving and helping us tremendously as we have been laboring and contending.

Recently the church has been under a demonic assault not only spiritually but also physically, on church members. Our Wednesday night services were being attacked, members were weary and counts were low. However, a recent revival with Kris Hart catapulted the church to a new dimension and level, and we have broken the strategies of Hell!

We just held a two night healing crusade in one of the city's main parks and saw a great turnout, over 200 people in attendance, eight saved and many powerful miracles. This crusade took us right into a revival with Evangelist Scott Snellen. It has been a visitation of God, with many timely words and miracles.

In one notable miracle a young girl who had a female sickness, a disease that doctors can only treat but not cure. She was in pain. We prayed for her in the name of Jesus and her pain disappeared. She went to the doctor and was given a clean bill of health. The doctor said there was no trace of the disease ever being there.

I spent most of my adult life behind bars, drinking, doing drugs and running the streets. It seemed that I would only find the Lord when I was in jail. As soon as I was out and hit the streets, I was back on the wrong path.

My personal relationships were just terrible and mismanaged, just all around empty!

Everything changed when I got saved. I found a new path, a new beginning, a new joy and a new life in Jesus Christ. My eyes were finally opened.

I used to be the one talking bad about the church and making fun of it

but now I'm the guy that just can't shut up about it! Being saved was and is the best thing that has ever happened to me and my family.

I am blessed to be a part of something so positive for a change, instead of so much negative. I am so grateful to be a part of a great family, the Christian Fellowship Ministries. I am grateful to serve the Lord.

Yokwe! From the Island of Marshall, it's exciting!

It's always a privilege to be a part of what God is still doing in these last days, and Jesus gets the glory and praise for all that have transpired. We were launched out from the Guam church under the leadership of Pastor Glen Cluck in July of 2012.

God is powerfully moving here as we're seeing an acceleration of the work that He is doing. In just a couple of months we've seen a lot of new converts added to His kingdom, and disciples rising up to do something for God.

We're seeing an unprecedented move of God even among the Marshallese people, as God is faithful in confirming His word with signs, wonders and miracles following.

We started the hospital ministry in the month of August with many people saved and healed from various sickness, infirmities and diseases such as diabetes, stroke, cancer, tumors, skin infection, blindness, asthma, pains and etc., also deliverance from demon possession and breaking of family curses.
