They went to Phoenix to help Gary Marsh promote for a crusade with Pastor Mitchell. Gary Basham led

the team and they prayed with 18 new converts just in passing out flyers.

This is why Louie Paulino does a Haunted House every year with the sole intention of preparing people to respond to the Gospel. We do not just give them gore or ghouls or try to scare them to death or even shock them. But we give them God and the Gospel in no uncertain terms. And this year we saw 181 people get saved on just two nights of outreach. Everything we do is centered on invitation.

We had a baby dedication service in October. Nothing new or noteworthy about that, except that pastor Mitchell gave what I felt was a prophetic word concerning our children and our future as a church and as a nation.

The Holy Spirit has a destiny for these little ones who are despised by the world but who are treasured by their families and looked on by God as the apple of His eye. Thank God for parents who choose to bear and raise children in these exciting days.

On the night of our annual Thanksgiving Ingathering service someone asked, "who is going to get all of this food?" He saw that so much was brought in by those present that they obviously didn't need any bounty to take home. I just smiled at him.

The poor of this world are rich in faith. Paul spoke of those in poverty abounding in liberality. So I wasn't surprised at all to see rich and poor alike sharing God's bountiful supply with those in need. The love of Christ constrains us to do these things.

Blessed be God who has blessed us with all spiritual blessing in Heavenly places in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Bible Conferences, Israel tour on Pastor Mitchell's fall schedule

Pastor Mitchell continued his busy schedule in 2012 with ministry in the Canadian Bible Conference in October with Pastor Dave Marks in Chilliwack, British Columbia. This conference is always an exciting demonstration of what God can accomplish from a small town and a small church.

Two Russian couples were present, and a pastor from Russia preached. This is a result of the vision of the Chilliwack congregation in sending a Canadian couple to pioneer in Vologda, Russia. That congregation has sent workers into Siberia, Vietnam, Cuba, Cambodia and the Sakhalin Islands.

Pastor Mitchell ministered in the San Antonio, Texas Bible Conference with Pastor Richard Rubi, returning to Phoenix, Arizona to conduct an area wide Miracle Crusade for Pastor Gary Marsh. Several instantaneous, outstanding miracles

were the confirmation of our Lord Jesus Christ's resurrection.

An October Miracle Crusade was conducted in a tent in Valparaiso, Chili. Interpreting this crusade was Pastor Eddie Barreto, who was a missionary there for some nine years.

Some 195 new convert cards and so many miracle healings too numerous to detail was God's testimony to that city. A hundred new visitors were in attendance at the church the morning after the crusade.

Rallies and Men's Discipleship classes in Redlands, Calif., San Diego, Calif., El Paso, Texas, and Las Vegas, Nevada finished out the October schedule.

November brought Pastor Mitchell to the San Luis, Mexico Bible Conference, as well as Jacksonville, North Carolina and a rallies area-wide in Espanola, New Mexico, and

McMinnville, Oregon.

A Miracle Healing Crusade in the city center auditorium at Santa Monica, Calif. for Pastor Rob Scribner saw a record attendance, many responding for salvation and visible and instantaneous miracles.

Pastor and Mrs. Mitchell led 76 people on a Bible Lands Tour of Israel in November. During the tour, Hamas began a rocket attack from the Gaza Strip against Israel, which brought a troop mobilization of 75,000 Israeli defense forces to the border to invade. The tour group was never affected and at no time was it in danger, contrary to the television news. The tour went on as scheduled and experienced perfect weather. Everyone was profoundly blessed. Pastor Mitchell worked with some 15-18 Fellowship pastors in teaching sermon preparation, making the tour a doubly rewarding experience for pastors.

The Chandler congregation has taken this scripture to heart. Saints, understanding the connection between travailing before God and the bearing of precious seed have taken upon themselves to fast and pray.

There is a weekly prayer meeting, initiated by the saints, where dozens gather to cry out to God for miracles of salvation and healing. There are believers fasting every day around the clock all month long on a continuing basis. Some in the congregation have fasted two to three weeks repeatedly. Their intent is to break down the devil's strongholds in Chandler.

These prayers are accompanied with a sincere desire to preach the word with believers meeting every Monday night to street preach. This is bearing fruit each time they take the gospel to our city's streets with lost souls coming to Christ right there on the street corners.. As a result, the follow-up ministry is currently working with over 150 new converts!

We are grateful that old does not mean cold. Older saints rose up in an over-40 ministry night in our Extreme concert scene. In excess of 600 persons were crammed into the

As a leadership church, we were honored to host a valley-wide teen rally. The theme was "Addicted 2 Jesus." Almost 350 teens and young adults filled the Extreme hall as Pastor Stacy Dillard of Chula Vista ministered. At the end of the night, 27 young people surrendered their lives to God.

Starting in August on a regular Saturday morning outreach, a couple of the men and myself went outreaching to Chimayo, New Mexico, which is where 80 percent of the heroin that comes into the USA goes through. We met a man named Hector Martinez. After witnessing to him, Hector prayed with us, weeping and thanking us that we would come take time to share the good news of the gospel with him. Four days later on a Wednesday morning I got a phone call that Hector had been shot and killed.

I went to Hector's home where just four days prior he had given his life to Jesus!

I shared this testimony with his grieving family and prayed with 15 of his family members right there in their home! They asked me to speak at his funeral service and officiate the graveside service.

At the funeral were hundreds of Hector's fellow 18th Street gang members and tons of unsaved family. I was able to bring the good news that Hector made Heaven his home. At the grave side service over 100 people prayed the sinner's prayer with me in tears and many came to me afterwards, wanting me to pray with them directly.

My wife and I met Derick Voight and Mandie Chavez at the graveside and led them in the sinner's prayer. Leaving with the victory, we were excited to see all that God was going to do. After three months we still didn't have any fruit coming from this funeral service where we had seen so many souls saved. Contending that Hector's testimony would bear fruit, we were overjoyed when his four aunties and grandmother walked into the front doors of our church one Sunday morning service. They've been faithful ever since!

In September we hosted our first car show. Impact teams from all over came to help with over 100 people helping us with one-on-one witness and reaching this city. We had 23 people saved and many more seeds planted! We had our 6th annual Graffiti Contest with nine saved.

In October we ran into Derick and Mandie again and invited them to church. After multiple contacts they finally came one Sunday night. That same week Derick approached me saying that they needed to get married and make things right as they were living together and already had a family. We started making plans for a Jesus people wedding!

In October the Santa Fe church and our baby church in Las Alamos had a revival with Evangelist Richard Brooks, with very timely messages on the basics of salvation for many of our new converts. We had 14 of our new converts filled with the Holy Ghost and stirred to stay on fire for God!

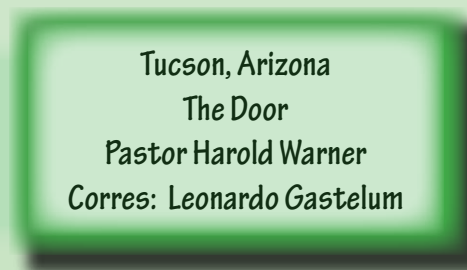

My name is Sovanthoeun Phim. I'm 29 years old. My nationality is Cambodian but I was raised in the U.S. for 28 years. My current address now is in Takhmao, Cambodia.

I was deported from the states, banished because I wasn't deemed fit anymore to live in its society. I have a criminal past that involves drugs, theft, and violence. I had a drug habit since the age of 13 and I have gotten myself in trouble with the law a few times and ended up in jail. I found myself heading down a path of self destruction, but I couldn't find the strength within me to break free.

I felt I was shackled down to everything that was evil. In my heart I wanted to change and I yearned for spiritual guidance. I was raised in a devout Buddhist family that would give offerings, burn incense, and pray.

I am very blessed to have a family that loved me and supported me but none of them could offer me any spiritual advice. I felt maybe it was my karma and that I would have to pay for my sins in this life and the next. I was miserable. I didn't feel like living anymore. Every time I wake up and I am usually going through a horrible heroin withdrawal I would ask myself, why? Why has God forsaken me? I was full of self pity and doubt.

My last run in with the law I got detained by immigration custom agents. They told me I was getting deported for a felony I committed 10 years ago. I was shocked. I had to break the news to my mother and it was the hardest thing I had to do. If I was to collect all her tears that she'd ever cried for me I would drown in them.

I arrived in Cambodia Jan. 24, 2012. I was broken and didn't know where to start. I tried to cope with my situation but I was depressed and felt empty inside. I went from one pack of cigarettes to two packs a day.

I was getting urges but I didn't know the area well enough to go asking people where to score dope. I found myself becoming dependent on alcohol. Every night it would be the same thing carousing with girls and drinking. I was very aware of my self destructive path but still I couldn't stop. I became a drunken fool and I was very ashamed of myself.

Early one morning I overheard my relatives talking about my shameful deeds. I started to feel very uncomfortable and decided to leave. I decided to go to an immigration support center. I was in desperate need of help. That night a man came by passing out church flyers. He introduced himself as Pastor Perry. He told me about the church in Takhmao and he asked me if I was interested in attending. I really didn't care what he had to say, I was smoking a cigarette and was trying to figure out how my life got so screwed up. Then he said something about people choosing the wrong path in life is walking in darkness that they should repent and walk within the light. What he said got into my head but I just couldn't make sense of it until later.

A couple of weeks went by. He visited again and ask me if I wanted a cup of coffee. We drank some coffee and got to talking and I sensed that he is very intelligent and speaks very openly about his faith. I

had to hear more so I attended the church to hear him preach. I was amazed I felt somehow God had given me a second chance. That night I got down on my knees and repented. I was saved.

I am now addicted to the Lord Jesus Christ and my future is full of hope. I want to someday be a man of God and give the message of hopeful inspiration. I had the chance to attend Bible conference in Manila. It was an amazing experience and journey. I felt that God had blessed me in every aspect of my life.

I have completely surrendered myself to the Lord and I am now filled with his Holy Spirit. I would like to thank God first and foremost for having mercy on my soul. Pastor Perry you are a great teacher and good friend, thank you for your guidance. I would also like to thank the mother church in Jacksonville, North Carolina for funding my trip. From October 1-5 we had the privilege to host the first Chinese conference in Guangzhou with Pastors Evert Valk and Joe Campbell as main guest speakers.

Our conference theme was “Enlarging the Kingdom.” It was a great week with tremendous preaching, and the

our church building and we were able to baptize 32 new converts. All our baby churches had brought new converts to be baptized.

When pastor Campbell pulled the offering on Thursday evening, more than enough money came in on just that one evening to pay for all the expenses of our conference.

Following from that we had a revival with Pastor Marty Carnegie, who came and stirred the congregation, through a week long revival greatly encouraged the saints with a number of people getting saved.

In September we had our first baptism in our new building and we baptised 19 people. We were also challenged as a congregation to “break the 500 barrier.” We had been hovering in the 400-plus for much of the year. We had a preaching series to challenge the congregation break our church into the next dimension of evangelism and personal witnessing. We had back to back “Back to Church Sundays” events seeing over 60 first time guests with a peak attendance of 470.

In October we had another revival with Evangelist Patrick Johnson, where God’s presence was truly felt and the Gospel was ministered effectively. At the end of October we had our Halloween drama called “Nightmares,” shown over two days. We saw over 30 decisions for Jesus, which is amazing. We also had the grand opening of our new baby church in Clapham Junction, South London. We had over 150 saints in attendance and that evening we saw 200-plus people attend the concert. Pastor Ashley Harris and his wife Sarah have been open now for two months and had 17 people recently.

But the crème da la crème of 2012 was the British Bible conference. We were able to launch six new couples into six new areas to pioneer. These new churches will be in Bournemouth, Oldham, Uxbridge, Manchester, Ste-

On the first evening we had the highest attendance of 250 people. The conference was attended by delegates from the fellowship churches in Guangzhou, Dongguan, Macao, Zhuhai and even KL Malaysia, nine churches in total.

In total we saw about 42 people respond to the altar calls to get saved. Fourteen people were filled with the Holy Spirit.

On the last evening about 60-plus men responded to the altar call to give their lives in discipleship and church planting.

We sent out one Chinese couple from the Dongguan church: Michael and Jing. They will pioneer in another area of Dongguan city. They are the first baby church of the Dongguan church of missionary Frans Smits and they are our first grandbaby church of Guangzhou!

our setup, young new bands stepping up bringing with them some cutting edge music (like dub step) and by the grace and anointing of God we have seen our concert scene go to a whole new level.

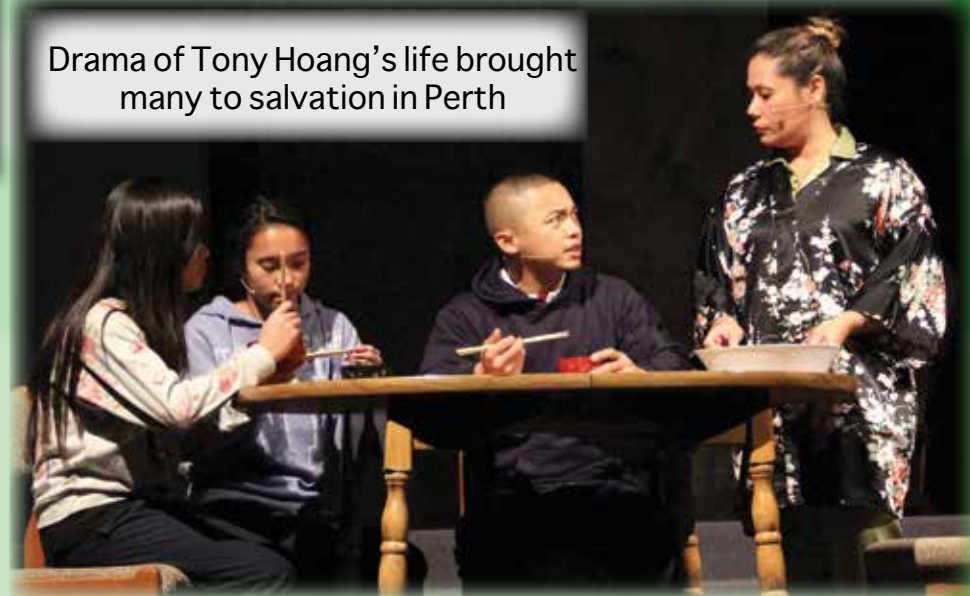
Two weeks after the Coldplay Paramore night, we had one Holy Ghost concert! From the first song

Lenwo, from the island of Kosrae. God has been doing a tremendous work out here. Who ever said that “being a Christian is boring” needs to get saved and get out into to HARVEST FIELD! There is nothing like preaching the gospel and seeing Jesus transform them. The testimonies of some of our members being so radically changed are causing the religious leaders loss of sleep and frequent visits to the hospital.

February, the gift from the mother church, Evangelist Alex Lorkin, was a hit out of the park. There were record crowds the largest being 112! A total of 62 were saved and 52 healed. Many miracles have happened, from blind eyes to stroke victims having major mobility of limbs right after prayer. People who were in pain for decades were instantly healed.

When the local congregational churches got wind of what was happening, their leaders told them not to go anymore, but it was a testimony of a woman that got healed of blindness that shut them up. These are her words “I can see because of that church, you should go there. It feels good there.”

Also, one of their pastors who had a stroke came up for prayer, dropped his crutches and walked out. He now drives around the island.

Rev 12:11 “...And they overcame him by the Blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony...” This was a vital blow to the religious yoke that has a hold on these people.

In May we had a timely revival with Pastor Marewibuel of Chuuk. It was an awesome time with 25 saved, 10 healed, and 22 visitors coming through. Some notable miracles, a man who had nine years of severe arthritis that not even four doctors from Hawaii could fix, got totally healed. He was jumping and running in church after prayer. His parents were in awe to see their son pain free and moving without any hindrance. Another

was a stroke victim whose right side was shut down. He was instantly healed and was able to lift his right arm straight in the air and walk straight out the door normally. Glory to God! God had truly spoken to this church and brought a needed boost going into conference.

Getting another Holy Ghost injection at conference, God just totally blew us away with another blessing and an answer to prayer. We were able to move to a new building that is stand-alone, has twice the size of the previous one, and with cheaper rent. We estimate we are able to fit 100 comfortably and desire nothing less. In the midst of renovations we had our first service August 1.

In October, we took a step of faith and had a Miracle Crusade/Revival and God did not disappoint. There were a total of 12 healed, 42 saved, and two filled with the Holy Ghost! On the last night of the Revival there were 20 brand new visitors. The new visitors were sent by their grandfather who told them to come down and check out our service.

The grandfather was a man that I prayed for last month at the hospital. When this man came to the hospital, the doctors told him point blank that his blood pressure was so high, there was no hope, there was nothing they could do, and that he was going to die. They said that after I prayed for him, his blood pressure came down and his vision was restored.

The doctors came in a few hours later after I had left and even they said it was a miracle. His blood pressure went from scraping the moon all the way down to submarine levels. With his blood pressure, the doctor was saying it should

have killed him already and now it was not just lower, it had dropped down to normal numbers. He was discharged a few days later and now is home with his family. They were sent to spy out the church and bring back a report to him. They not only have a report of the church but they also can declare how they all ended up getting saved!

We are grateful to Pastor Cluck and the Guam church for their support and undying prayers. We also thank Pastor Mitchell and the Prescott church for all that they do for us. Being able to preach the gospel out in the middle of the ocean on an island is an absolute joy. Because its not being out in the middle of an ocean, its being out in the middle of God’s harvest field. Jesus cometh.

Greetings from Nepal. The work continues as we enter fall/winter season here. Temperatures are in the mid-30's at night and 60's during the day. Not bad but no heat in the homes, so the average temperature in our home and church is mid-50's. Power is restricted again apparently due to "lack of rain," so 12 hours or so.

Met the new Ambassador and had a good discussion about the political situation here and their plans for disaster and evacuation of Americans. Nice guy. He was very adamant about protecting American citizens and invited us to call him about most anything. This is his third time here in Nepal - he was here in the 80s, a second time in the 90s. He said the biggest change is the amount of wealth and consumption here in Kathmandu.

I wanted to know his take on where the government is heading. He's very favorable toward mission work here and will go to bat for us if needed. Given Jack Miller's situation in Rwanda I thought it might be a good idea to get to know him.

People continue to grow and wit-

ness, and we're seeing growth again. The multiple festivals kill us as people go home or visit relatives. The battles they face are hard for us to imagine as everything they do revolves around some god or ritual or tradition. Our numbers took a hit during the highest Hindu holy days dipping to about 18. We're beginning to see them filter back into the church and bringing visitors. Our highest totals for the year were 42. We spent the summer doing our concerts and we're overwhelmed by the crowds, often five to six deep surrounding us as we played and preached on the street corners.

We gather every Thursday for a time of fellowship, and question/answer period and have had as many as 18 show up. The men's discipleships are a great time with the men and the attendance has always been over 20.

We had an American-style Thanksgiving with the Porters and people from three churches - Patan, Sora-Khotte, and Biratnagar, attend, 18 people in all. We sang songs, preached on the meaning of Thanksgiving and gave them a short history lesson as it is an exclusively American holiday. We had a great response.

We're preparing for the India Bible Conference and have a total of 20 people from three churches going. The band from Sora Khotte has been asked to do a special song again. They're excited about that. We've been introduc-

ing new songs on a regular basis and now have close to 75 that have been translated into Nepali. We have plans to translate various sermons and essays dealing with a multitude of biblical subjects because there is almost nothing available in the Nepali language.

There is a great hunger here for correct information. While the populace has a high literacy rate it is in Nepali. Only the young are being taught English which will be good for the next generation.

There's obviously so much going on that we can't write about all of it. We're grateful to the congregations helping to support the work here. It is having a great effect. Thank you.

This year's Haunted House in Prescott was entitled The Mortuary. We conducted the outreach from 7 p.m. to midnight for two nights, Friday and Saturday, Oct. 26 and 27.

We had excellent crowds both nights and to entertain the people waiting in line, (for sometimes hours!) we had a live band playing outside in the parking lot.

Our story was about a girl who was at a party that night out in the woods. When she and her friends left to go get more beer, they were in a terrible accident and some of them died. Before her friend died, she tried to tell her something.

Convinced she needs to hear what her friend was trying to tell her, the girl breaks into the mortuary that night to find her.

A night security officer is asleep at his desk when awakened by the young girl looking for her friend. As she re-tells the story of what happened that night - a party, a ride in the car, the crash, she convinces the security guard to take her to the room in the morgue to find her friend.

To his horror, the security guard watches as the young girl begins a séance to contact her dead friend . . . but when the dead walk, the living run . . . worse, when the dead talk, the living scream!

The annual Haunted House takes countless hours of makeup, and rehearsal, and requires a large support group behind the scenes, not to mention the commitment of the actors!
