Praise be to the Lord Jesus Christ for all that He is doing in the Prescott church by the grace and power of the Holy Spirit.

Our pastors have brought life and immortality to light through the gospel that they preach to us. We rejoice to see new converts at the altars, then getting filled with the Holy Spirit, getting baptized in water, and finding their way into outreaches and church attendance. Thank God for lives being changed, marriages being rescued, disciples being raised up, and the gospel being preached to the poor.

We came back from San Luis tired and dirty and eager for warmer weather in Prescott. Not that we hibernate during the winter months.

We stay busy with our concert outreach, One80. We stay involved in neighborhood home fellowships.

The recovery outreach, Project 180 continues year round reaching out to and investing in addicts.

We send impact teams to warm weather locations to labor in door to door evangelism. We've sent teams to Phoenix, Glendale, Surprise, Las Vegas, Mesa, and other places.

Noel Tossing continues to spearhead our men's prison outreach. He goes weekly to Adobe Mountain Juvenile Detention Center in Phoenix as well as participating in major impacts in prisons in Texas and California.

Our musical, Darkness to Light continues to go out and they always bring back exciting reports of good responses

wherever they go. Louie Paulino produced a rock drama, Resurrection. Seven people were saved the night we did that drama in One80.

Pastor Artie Aragon came to Prescott in May and brought revival with him. We started with a Youth Extreme that had 16 Fellowship churches involved and 42 saved for the day.

Then Brother Artie ministered a week of revival services for us. He said he was nervous but he did an outstanding job ministering to the Prescott church.

In May we also kicked off a summer series of concert and drama outreaches in the Prescott Valley Entertainment District. This door opened to us last year and it is open again this year. Thirty-two people were saved at our first outreach in Prescott Valley.

We had our final men's discipleship meeting with pastor Ray Rubi and we had our first courthouse plaza outreach of the summer with 11 saved.

Along with all of the outreach ministry is a vast army of dedicated servants, those who have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints.

They work with our children, they cook meals, they visit shut-ins, they do special music, and a myriad of other unseen things that make ministry smooth. They may be unsung heroes now, but they have a reward in Heaven.

Pastor Mitchell says Christianity is a transcendent religion.

"It's more than what we are, it is what we can become."

By the faithful and timely ministry of Pastor Greg and Pastor Wayman Mitchell we are seeing Christ formed in us and in those who come to trust under the canopy of God's grace in and through the Prescott Potter's House.

San Luis, Russia crusades, rallies are highlights of past six months

In March, Pastor Wayman Mitchell ministered in Chandler, Arizona to a packed house in a Pioneer Rally with Pastors Greg Mitchell, Richard Rubi and Mark Aulson.

The San Luis, Mexico annual Healing Crusade in March was a powerful testimony to the miracle power of God as several hundred people responded for salvation and healing. Pastor Rich Cox followed up Saturday through Wednesday with the same results.

The El Paso Spring Bible Conference was the next stop. This conference continued to expand. Some four international and four U.S. churches were announced.

From there Pastor Mitchell travelled to San Antonio for a Saturday night Pastor and Wives Seminar, both Sunday services, a Monday morning

sermon making workshop with 20 area pastors, before doing a Monday night Area Wide Rally. Overflow crowds continue to attest to the impact the San Antonio church pastored by Richard Rubi is making.

The Nogales, Sonora, Mexico church Spring Bible Conference was the next stop. The new balcony in that building under the leadership of Pastor Jose Gaxiola was filled the first night. What a joy to see the indigenous works in Mexico expand.

The McMinnville, Oregon conference under Pastor Kevin Foley was Pastor Mitchell's next stop. One pioneer work was announced into Oregon.

A men's Area Wide Rally in Redlands, Oregon, the Cape Cod, Mass. Bible Conference and a Harvester's Homecoming Rally in McAllen, Tex-

as finished off the April itinerary. Pioneer rallies in Jacksonville, Florida, a Men's Discipleship in San Diego, Calif., and Pioneer Rally in Ogden, Utah completed the May calendar.

The highlight of the ministry was when Pastor Wayman and Greg Mitchell travelled into Vologda, Russia to conduct the annual Men's Rally there. Some 300 men from Russia, Ukraine, Cambodia, Cuba, Mongolia, and Armenia gathered in the Vologda, Russia building for three days of ministry. The congregation of that church joined for a Wednesday night service. The recently completed balcony there was well filled. That building now can seat 750 people and was built with Russian money as a great testimony to our indigenous principles. Some 30 churches are now under this headquarters church.

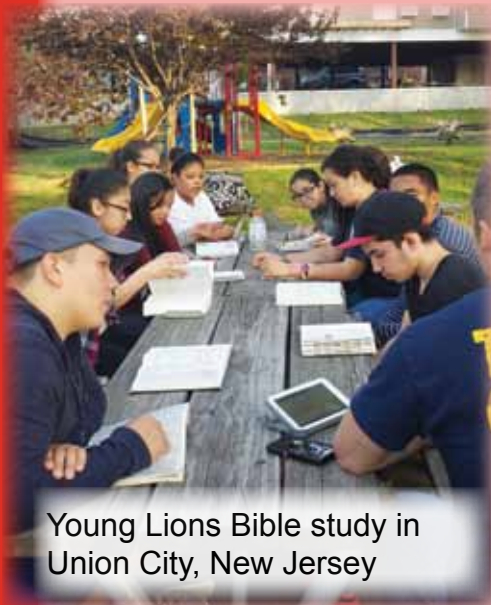
At the time, I thought I was having fun, yet I wasn't realizing that I was hurting myself and those around me. I was just thinking of myself and my own selfish desires.

While the deadly Ebola virus spread over West Africa, Lighthouse Medical Missions personnel attended to 1,500 patients in The Gambia and Guinea Bissau April 1 – 5, helping a church plant and established works in those nations.

No strangers to danger, the doctors, nurses and other volunteers, in all 45, balked before Ebola and closed down early, since 25 percent of new contagion hits health care workers. This strain of the virus kills 90 percent of infected with hemorrhagic fever. Two-thirds of the team evacuated, and the rest staged limited clinics at retreat center where we were housed in The Gambia.

"This is the first time we got beat," rued Dr. Robert Hamilton, of the Santa Monica Lighthouse Church, who has led 23 medical missions, all but one into Africa. "It was painful to me."

The medical missions have been one of Lighthouse's strongest ministries since their inception in 1998. They have supported the burst of church plants in West Africa.

A pioneer work in Guinea Bissau launched with the medical mission and immediately had people under Pastor Alusine Kpewah.

Meanwhile, the church in Tanji, The Gambia, continues to meet under a tree, as no building has been erected on the purchased property.

As quickly as it roared back onto the human scene, Ebola faded.

Lighthouse's foray into Africa began when Pastor Ralph Bowen planted a church in Kabala, Sierra Leone, in 1992, following the lead of Pastor Alvin Smith, who had planted a church earlier in Freetown, the capital city.

Pastor Bowen followed up that church with a second in The Gambia in 1996, and then a third in Senegal in 2002.

After 20 years as a missionary in Africa, Pastor Bowen is back in the

Santa Monica church as assistant pastor, inspiring everyone with his humility and intensity in the Lord's service.

Lighthouse has been experiencing a surge in salvations among internationals who visit our church. We've had baptisms of people originally from the 10-40 window, a region cited by missionary experts as being the least-evangelized in the world. It has been exciting to see people come to Christ with freedom.

Our schools are breaking through their struggles as new students come in and fill empty chairs. As the students come, the church also fills. It is a blessing to see the purpose of the school – evangelism and discipleship – being fulfilled.

Pastor Rob Scribner continues untiringly discipling. He's expanded weekly discipleship classes into daily. Prayer remains an unmoveable part of his ministry. We rejoice in all that God is doing.

With the influx of young families, we have started up our children's Sunday School program for this year.

We serve a God of increase. A man originally from Kosovo, who lives about 45 minutes from the church, heard of the church a year previous and one day, stirred by the Spirit, he turned up and has been faithfully coming to services and outreach. We

have seen God bringing in people from every walk of life and nationality but all living under the one God, with all of our services growing.

On Easter Sunday as a part of our communion service we also thought it would be a fitting time to do a water baptism. That day we saw 15 people water baptised and make a covenant with God to bury the old life and to live for Jesus.

God has been moving in Prospect, bringing precious souls to salvation and adding to the church.

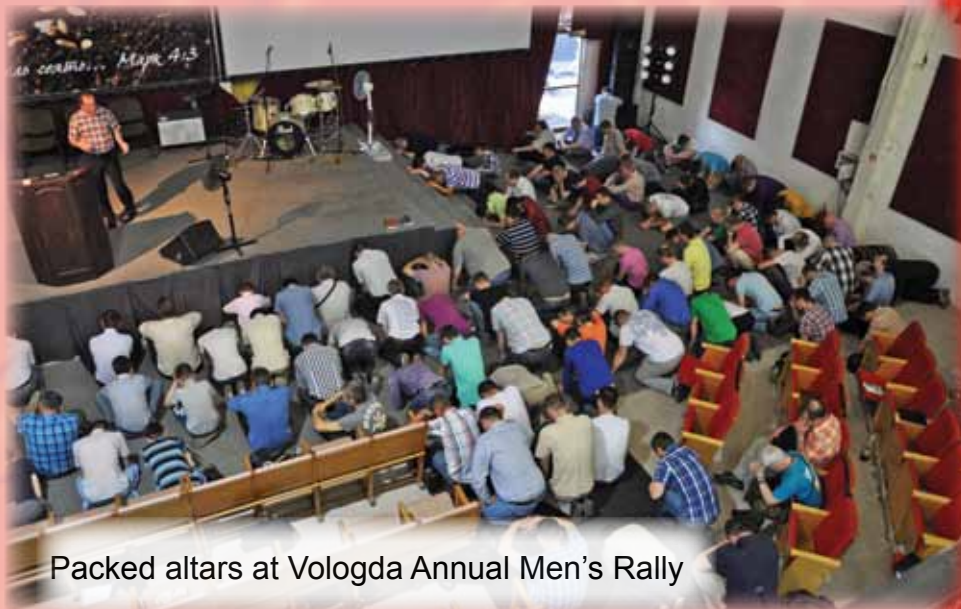

Many words of knowledge were given out. It was incredible to see people visibly shaken at the preciseness and accuracy of the words.

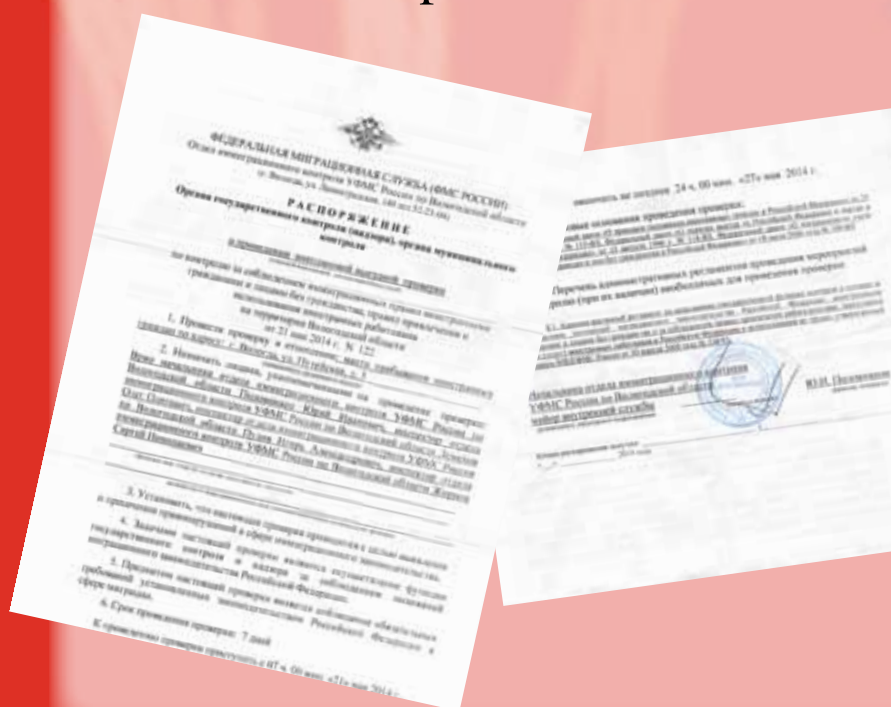

KGB shows up over visa issue during Vologda Men's Rally



Pastors Wayman and Greg Mitchell had an unscheduled meeting with the Russian KGB during the recent Annual Men's Rally in Vologda, Russia. Pastor Mitchell was finishing ministering to the men when someone told Pastor Greg the KGB were there to see them. He was so tired from jet lag, he said, that he didn't have the energy to worry about the summons. The issue was their visas that were issued as other than "religious" visas. The officers did not shut the meeting down, and waited for Pastor Mitchell to finish ministering before the two were summoned to visit the local station.

Russian saints translated the documents presented to the Mitchells, and after visiting the station, they signed a "confession," paid a fine and were able to leave without incident.

Pastor Mitchell is known for leading tours and ministering in countries that are at unrest. Despite outbreak of war or other threats, he and Pastor Greg continue to power on in worldwide evangelism.

"You just have to live life," he said.

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
