We were blessed to have Pastor Aragon and the Chinle saints come for our annual Native American Day. Their choir sang "I'm Not Home Yet" and indeed we are not. We also were blessed to have evangelist Jerry Fussell come to Prescott for a Youth Extreme and

revival meeting. God wonderfully moved through our brother and many, young and old, were powerfully ministered to.

In October we premiered the movie "Given the Chance," written and directed by our own Joel Morrison and produced by the Prescott church. A large crowd turned up at One80 and seven were saved that night.

Our haunted house outreach was very fruitful this year. Hundreds of sinners wait a long time in line but we faithfully preach the Gospel to them. After five nights we had 273 decisions for Christ. Our play Darkness to Light, the musical, was in Tucson in October with great results there too. In two nights they had 52 people saved.

We were sad at the passing of our dear brother and long time friend Paul Heimberg. He is where we want to be but we, along with his family, will miss him in the mean time.

One unique opportunity has opened a door to us that is just amazing. Through a series of unusual events and unusual favor our outreach teams were given center stage at the Entertainment District outside Harkins Theater in Prescott Valley. They set up a stage and chairs and gave us complete liberty to preach the Gospel and have music and drama. So for the past four months we have had a variety of theme nights on a monthly basis. Hip hop night, country night, 70s night and the musical Darkness to Light. So far we have cards on 58 people saved and we still have a Christmas play and a New Year's Eve celebration coming up. As an extra plus we have the opportunity to have a band inside the Tim's Toyota Center before Sundog hockey games to play and testify. God has opened an amazing door of outreach to us.

I have many other things I wish I could write by there isn't room to highlight all that God is doing in and through the Prescott Church.

Pastor Mitchell continued his busy schedule for the Fall with a men's area wide Discipleship in Redlands, Calif. with Pastor Rich Cox. The enlarged auditorium was filled to capacity as the churches always cooperate for this gathering.

The same week, Pastor Mitchell ministered at an area wide rally in San Diego, Calif. for Joe Rice. His enlarged auditorium also was filled to capacity as the area churches always support this time of ministry.

The annual Miracle Crusade in Santa Monica, Calif. for Pastor Rob Scribner again was a powerful time of God's demonstration of healing with a good number responding for salvation and healing. This crusade was supported by a number of area churches sending impact teams and attending the event.

Pastor Mitchell then travelled to Jacksonville, North Carolina for the conference with Pastor David Szczepanski and the Southeast churches. This conference is picking up momen-

tum every year and four new churches were announced – four new pioneer works in the U.S. and a new nation with a missionary in Burma.

Valparaiso, Chili was Pastor Mitchell's next stop, along with Pastor Eddie Barreto and wife Tracy, who were missionaries there for eight years. They conducted a Miracle Crusade downtown in a Gospel tent. The tent was filled, with 200 saved the first night and 90 the second. Many people testified of instant healings as the Lord Jesus Christ answered prayers for them.

Pastor then travelled to London, England for the United Kingdom conference with Pastor Nigel Brown. Sixteen pioneer churches were announced, among them a new work in Stockholm, Sweden.

We also had another powerful revival with Evangelist Shawn Davis, locking in critical new fruit from our summer outreaches, leading new converts in the Baptism of the Holy Spirit and imparting fresh faith for the work in Ramona.

This past October we did our first haunted house outreach called, "The Dark Room: Whatever Happened to the Class of 2013?" about the issues and the outcomes of a sinful lifestyle.

We touched on the topics of the party life, suicide, cyber-bullying, abortion and joining the military to run away from problems. We had a total of 168 visitors walk through and 60 who gave their lives to Christ!

In our Conference in September, we had an awesome time. God spoke to us as a church, and individually. It was a really powerful conference for all who attended.

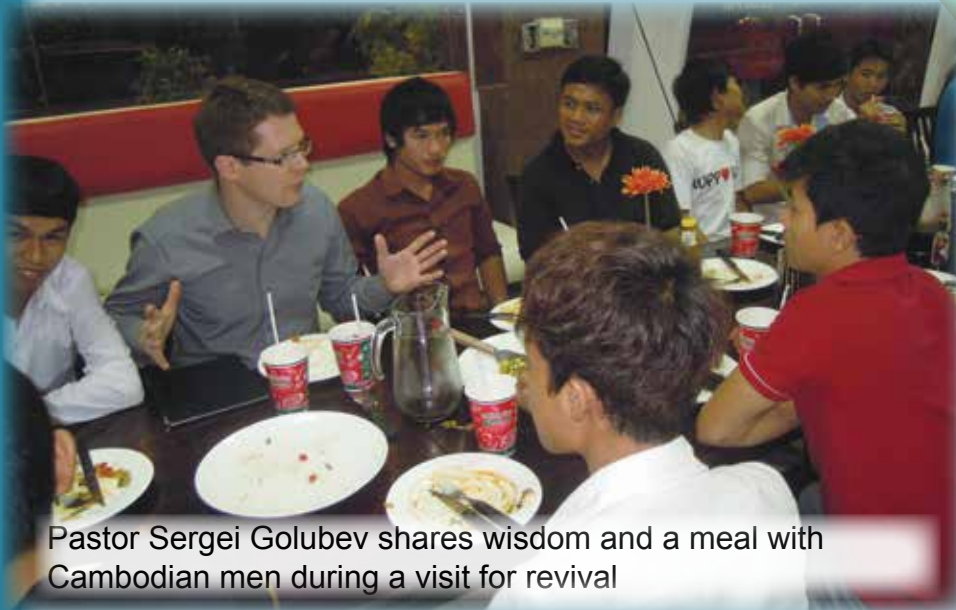

Another powerful change that I've seen during these crucial last six months was the personal growth of Pastor Alejandro as a leader and a preacher. I preach to Dutch, Italians, Mexicans, etc., learn languages, work as a landscape designer for the prison supervisor and preach the gospel to all nations!

I am trying to get used to ant and spider bites, sleep while my inmates watch newest blockbusters and creepier movies. I want to thank my wife Oksana for sticking with me all this time! Please pray for us and come to Cuba, the folks here need you!

Since 2012 September Bible Conference, we have been working hard as ever in reaching souls for Jesus. Thursday morning outreach straight after morning prayer is famously known to us as "Padres Outreach." This is a

an incredible amount of people getting saved because at 8.30 in the morning most people are sober!

Friday nights, the disciples meet for another outreach, going out door knocking, witnessing in the markets and on streets. And for the last three months we have concluded this outreach on Friday night with a "God's Men," where we have studied 1st and 2nd letters to Timothy and the letter to Titus. These studies were incredible and really brought us all closer together with a common purpose.

On Saturday morning it is off to the woman's prison, with some girls from the church and our wives to do a Bible study there. Every service we have been averaging 15-20 woman with two or three ladies getting saved each time.

Late Saturday afternoons is our regular church outreach. We meet for prayer and then go in different places around Maputo, witnessing and preaching to the lost masses in this city.

Monday morning it's back to work, with a visit to the men's prison. We do

full bore rap music outreach where we will target two or three markets or bus stops within an hour and a half.

One particular Thursday morning a Catholic Priest dressed in his priestly garments came storming out through the mud and rubbish of Xiappnine market to tell Pastor to shut his music down, "You're making too much noise!" We just moved to another place and kept preaching, and we are seeing

a full service in this maximum security prison and we have baptized seven in water in the prison and have seen many filled with the Holy Ghost. Literally hundreds of men have made decisions to receive Christ. One man released from the prison has locked into the church. He has been with us 11 months and is doing great.

In our church services the older saints are being helped through the un-

relenting preaching of Pastor Anderson. We are seeing new converts locking in and growing spiritually and the church feels refreshed and vibrant.

In the last 12 months we have had seven revivals. Pastor Isaac Madzirviri from Zimbabwe has come twice; Pastor Dave Kennedy from South Africa; Pastor Vinod Kumar from India; Pastor Duane Rens from South Africa; Pastor John McCarthy from South Africa and finally for the year, Pastor Randal VanStaden from George, South Africa. Each of these men have helped all of us. The church is reaping the last days harvest.

We want to take this opportunity to thank our Mother church in Footscray, Australia for sending us Pastor and Sister Anderson and their six beautiful children to Maputo. We thank God for this family and your faithfulness to the Nation of Mozambique. We love our leaders, we love our headship, we love this fellowship. We thank you for remembering us in your prayers. 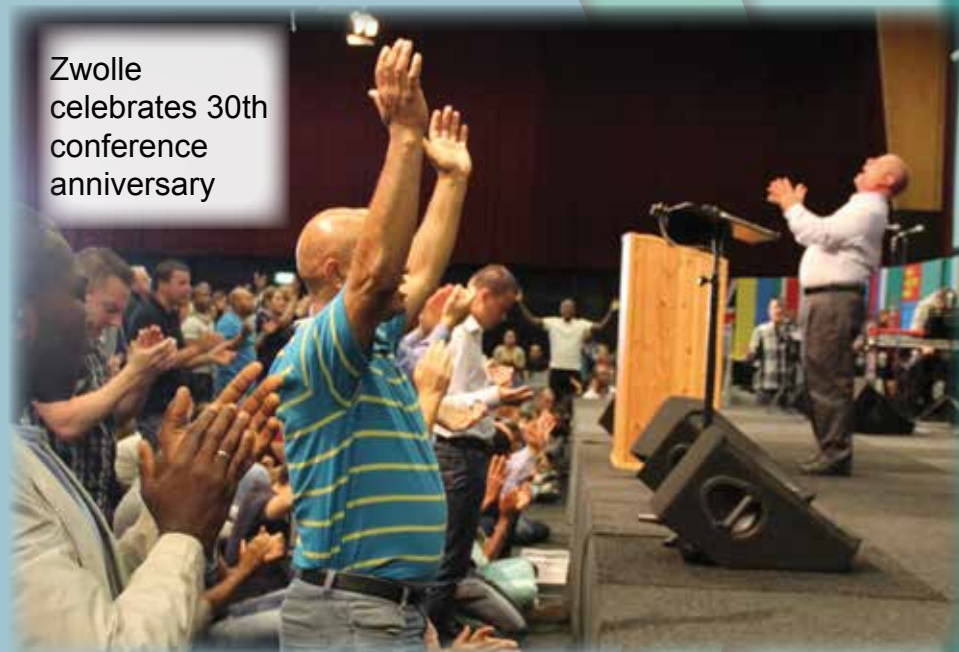

After struggling for years to be able to outreach in the Harkins Plaza, God gave us amazing favor and an open door to preach the Gospel in the heart of Prescott Valley, a community of nearly 40,000 eight miles east of Prescott.

In June, before conference, I approached then Outreach Director Paul Arps with the idea to do a band/outreach in the parking lot of Tim's Toyota Center, a sports arena in Prescott Valley. He thought it would be a cool idea, so I then approached Lucas Cilano, who works there.

After conversations with the assistant manager, we were told that the Center belongs to a local family business group, so we would need to talk to them. We contacted them and requested permission to use the parking lot. After about a month, we received word from the events coordinator that they would allow us to have the outreach, complete with a request to use their logo on all advertising.

Upon review of our request to use the parking lot, the suggestion was made by another board member that using

the parking lot of the Center would not be a very nice place to set up, and that it would be better to set up in the plaza area in front of Harkins, the heart of Prescott Valley activities.

After submitting more paperwork to get permission for our bands to play one event, they asked if I would meet with the board to discuss further details. In the course of the meeting, after describing One80 and the different bands we have, I was asked point blank, "What's your purpose in doing all this for free, what are you guys really trying to do?" My response was, "We want to make a positive impact in the lives of young people in our community by preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ, we want to bring them hope." Their response was, "Great, when can you guys start?"

We locked down dates for outdoor concerts once a month for the rest of the year. Our first concert was with It Was



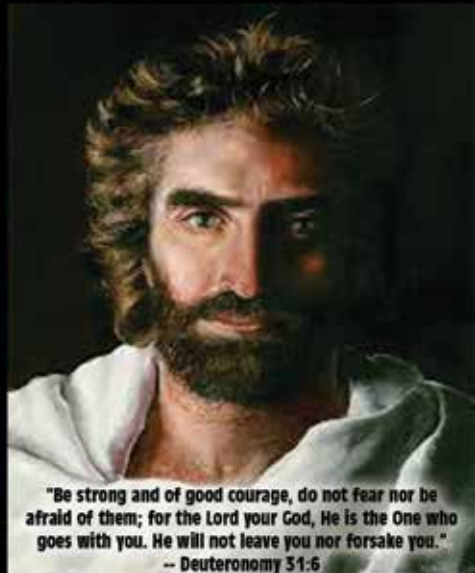
