New converts are coming in and older saints are staying by the stuff. Thank God for the ministry of our pastors to us and for those who have addicted themselves to the work of the ministry whether in public or in private.

One of the bright new things happening here is our success and fruitfulness among those in the addiction recovery community. We have been reaching into this burgeoning segment of Prescott's society and seeing a steady influx of people saved from lives of cruel addiction.

This is an outreach that is bigger than just music and drama and the youth. Many behind-the-scenes saints of all ages have joined up to minister to these needy folks who live among us.

Another emphasis we have been doing is reaching out to backsliders in our community. If everyone who had been saved and at one time coming to church was still coming our building would not hold them all. But pastor led us to contend in this area and sure enough we have already seen some familiar, but now older, former saints in service. And we have only just begun. God is moving and it is marvelous in my eyes.

Our summer outreach season has been very fruitful. Regular movies in the park have seen scores of people saved. FNO, our Friday night disciple-led forays into neighborhood evangelism have seen needy people saved and healed. Our out of town impact teams continue to win souls beyond our local harvest field, go-

ing to places like Phoenix and Glendale and Mesa and Las Vegas and Gallup and Surprise and Nogales.

One80, our youth oriented music outreach is still powering on for Jesus with live music and drama and video and real testimonies. The music changes, the faces change, but it still works in winning the lost.

Greetings from the Navajo Nation here in Chinle, Arizona.

Very excited to bring a good report in these last few months, God has been moving upon the Navajo People.

In June we had our annual Campmeeting with Serafico Saavedra with an average attendance of 350 nightly. We ended the Campmeeting with 500, which included the president and vice president of the Navajo Nation! We also had 120 saved for the week. Many people were healed and set free from addiction.

Also in June we sent into Browning, Montana, Dempsey and Cheryl Deswood to reach the Blackfeet Nation. In September they were able to find a building and opened with 22 people in attendance with four saved.

All summer long we had door-to-door outreaches and outdoor concerts in a downtown parking lot with movie outreaches in the church parking lot. One water baptism in the local river had two people get baptized.

Just recently we had a young man come home from San Anto-

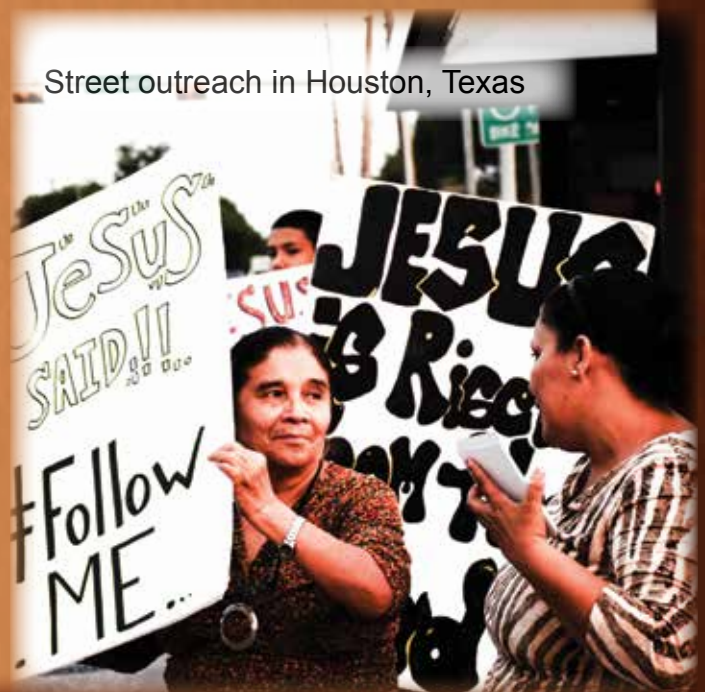
rection.

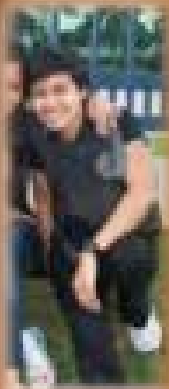

When I was five years old, I already knew I was different from the other girls, that I was a lesbian.

At the early age of 15 I got a girlfriend. Because I couldn't feel the love from my family, I decided to run away from home. I even tried to commit suicide several times.

I left our place together with my girlfriend. Even if all things got worse and every day had been going wrong, we didn't leave each other's company because we thought it would be hard to live if we didn't have each other. But God used our landlady to reach us.

We had a Bible study in our place. I knew Christ literally but I didn't know Him deeply. As our Bible study leader wanted the two of us to separate ways, we left that place and started anew at another. But problems overtook us. We fought every day and even if we wanted peace we can't find it.

I left my first girlfriend of 12 years for another relationship, thinking it would bring me peace and happiness, but still, it couldn't satisfy me. There was a hole in my heart that no one could fill. I still felt incomplete. And things just got worse. I was really really tired, lost, in much pain,

no peace, full of regrets, full of troubles, worries, fears, anxiety, exhausted and so hopeless.

I was about to end my life with a knife at that moment but I remembered the Bible. I opened it up and then the words struck me. "Do not be wise by your own eyes, depart from evil!" I prayed at that moment, it was 2 a.m.

I wanted a change overnight but God didn't give it to me. I hated God again. I challenged Him that if He couldn't change me within a year I would be doing what my heart says, to be a lesbian. But God is so gracious, the moment I stepped out in faith, He did change the

What a privilege it is to preach the gospel where people have never heard of Christ!

The Japanese are not antagonistic toward the gospel at all. If any-

thing, they seem mildly avoidant and politely skittish. It's exactly like it says in 2 Corinthians - *"The god of this world has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. They can't see the light of the good news that makes Christ's glory clear."* And those principalities have been blinding minds here for millennia, totally unchallenged... Until now, that is!

On Wednesdays we've been teaching the Gospel of Matthew, one verse at a time, to new converts and to those who have never read it before. Coming from a Christian nation, we don't often think about how the gospels proclaim a worldview that's radically alien to what people really live and believe. Try teaching the Beatitudes in Japan, and you'll realize how everything Jesus said was extremely unorthodox and shockingly unconventional!

On Fridays we invite the community over to play board games (ok, UNO mostly) and to "practice their English." It gives people a chance to set foot in a church for the first time

in their lives, and get to know the people of God. And eat snacks.

On Sunday mornings we've started bilingual services, Japanese/English (with a little Spanish tossed in by accident sometimes). We're singing several worship songs in Japanese now. Almost half of our people travel 90 minutes to two hours

to get to church, so we'll outreach right after service sometimes (especially if there's a parade or festival going on nearby). Then on Sunday nights we're preaching mostly to the disciples (I

call them "The Salvation Marines.")

Please continue to join us in prayer, to pull down strongholds, and to break ancient curses that bind this land. There's still time here for us to get hired to work that last shift, and to get paid the same as those who have labored in the vineyard since the beginning! It's Japan's hour.

I want to tell you that God gives us incredible favor with the authorities municipal and city quartermaster to evangelize.

The cumbia group “Los Adoradores” also visited us and we did a concert in the central square of the city. It was tremendous blessing.

Many people in the neighborhood know us because we are the only church in the area investing in souls and evangelism.

In August we had a marriage seminar in a local restaurant. We rented the restaurant just for us and it was a tremendous blessing to church marriages.

We are having street evangelism on Saturday mornings, Sunday school for preteens Sunday mornings, Adult Sunday School, and prayer every morning.

We also have Men’s Discipleship twice a month. It is a tremendous success and men are rising to preach.

We have a ministry at hospitals twice a month. We entered the guard medical facilities in the area where many people with different diseases crowd together. Each evangelism, between 16 and 25 people receive the message and pray the prayer of faith.

House-to-house meetings are a

success and now we opened another in the City Cañuelas (continue praying for this city).

We also had healing miracles: a woman had to undergo surgery for cancer in her ovaries. The doctors gave her close to no hope, telling her that when they opened her up it was probable that she wouldn’t be so well.

She came to church and believed. We prayed and she went in for surgery. When doctors opened they found that there was nothing wrong in her ovaries, she was healthy due to God’s glory!

As we have reported before, every couple of months groups of Syrian men flee to Holland where refugee camps offer them food and shelter. Most of these men’s testimonies are heartbreaking. Not only do they confirm we are living in the End Times, they also give us a better appreciation of the freedom and liberty we enjoy.

Again a young disciple organised an evening for these men and invited them to come and watch an Arabic-spoken evangelical movie. This brought about 17 converts and three miraculously healed individuals. These men will eventually be relocated to camps elsewhere and hope to go back to Syria one day.

New converts are being added to our congregation, teenagers as well as older people, and we see a number of backsliders that have left church in the past return.

The One80 evenings that we’ve recently began organizing turn out to be fruitful as well. God is compassionate, He provides and has been helping us tremendously. We can honestly say that He digs the well before we are thirsty.

Last but not least we thank Pastor Houtman for being an outstanding assistant pastor and we welcome Pastor De Sain from Schiedam.
