Pastor Mitchell once made the comment, "Let's bring this to where it needs to be." His ministry, along with Pastor Greg and Pastor Angel, is to make sure the Prescott church is where it needs to be.

We have been busy doing what we know to do and taking the Gospel outside the walls of our building. In April we sent four vans full of workers to San Luis to help in the big salvation/healing crusade there. They helped in the parade, the rehab centers, and the prison. They reported 3,000 in attendance, with 354 saved and 74 notable healings!

We were blessed to have Artie Aragon for revival and for a Youth Extreme ministry. The youth were challenged and they labored for a day and saw 89 saved. They had a music night at One80 with the hip-hopera "Legacy" and saw 47 saved. Alyssa Wohlwend rightly said, "We're not alone in this." The revival was excellent as pastor Artie ministered to the Prescott saints.

Our music scene, One80, continues to power on. Louie Paulino produced a new rock drama called "The Trial," which is seeing good results everywhere they do it.

Our impact teams continue to travel all over for days of intense soul winning. We have sent teams to Tempe, Glendale, Surprise, Gallup, and 29 Palms. We supported Pastor Gary Marsh in a crusade with Pastor Mitchell in Glendale which saw 117 saved and many healed.

The play, Darkness To Light, continues to perform out of town and see outstanding results. In Glendale for pastor Lopez they had 25 saved in one performance.

Recently, ONE80 has been trying an Open Mic Night. We'll see how that plays out this summer.

We continue on with regular outreach ministries such as Noel Tossing at Adobe Mountain Juvenile Detention Center. And like Isaac Cilano and the Monday Night Family Movie Night which sees visitors and people get saved. They even showed the classic The Cross And The Switchblade recently. Now they understand some of Pastor Greg's sermon comments!

We send outreach teams out locally every Saturday morning. Project 180 continues to have an

Gibson opened the service with praying for the sick, and we saw many instant and notable miracles! We are currently still in this revival as this is being typed.

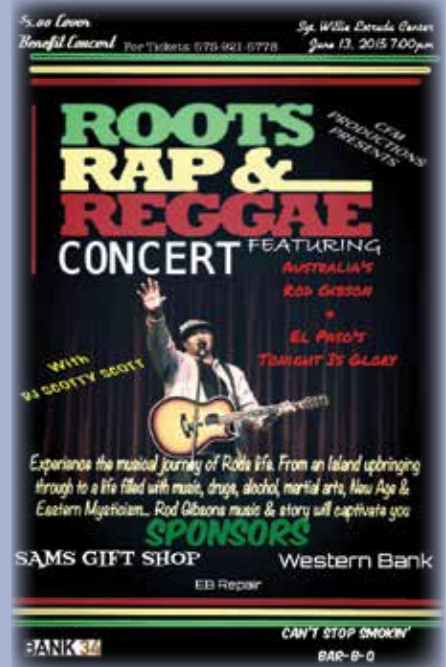
There is a stirring of Gods saints, an expectation for God to move, and many young disciples rising up and stepping

May 15 brought Artie Aragon and the Chinle Choir to our church in celebration of Native American Day. The choir ministered in English and Navajo and was sprinkled with powerful testimonies of what God has done and is doing in Navajo lives. Pastor Aragon brought God's word with power and conviction to a capacity crowd of more than 740 people. The altars were flooded with souls crying out to God in repentance. We followed this with a fry-bread feast and fellowship.

English courses are a hot commodity in Colombia so we began teaching English several nights out of the week. We started the classes in April and the attendance quickly grew to over 40 people. Through this outreach tool we have built some great relationships with people in the neighborhood and God has opened doors for us to witness to several of them, some of who have inquired about our church, have been miraculously healed and have attended our services.

Three months after we opened the church God began to challenge us as a church to pay for our own utilities, supplies and all other miscellaneous expenses. Somehow we knew that if we wanted to see breakthrough this was something that we needed to do. At the time we didn't realize the magnitude of that decision. We are privileged to live and experience a true move of God in our nation here in Cuba.

We'd been trying to evangelize and street preach for several years to see a spiritual breakthrough, but in December 2014 God finally directed us to the second largest place with the biggest idolatry practiced in our whole country, which is located in Habana.

We street preached out loud right there and this broke some spiritual walls and barriers. From that moment on we have started witnessing a number of people getting saved at every single outreach that we kept on doing. And even in the worst and marginal neighborhoods of our city people started to respond to our altar calls as we would witness about Jesus and His power to save, heal and set people free.

From those marginal neighborhoods we now have people who are saved and serving our Lord Jesus in our church. These key converts opened us doors to many other outreach possibilities, strategies and new people who also started getting saved.

We preached in the buses and bus

stops, taking advantage of any place with large concentrations of people.

We would use rap on the streets, skits and our testimonies to create a platform that would draw people to listen to us.

After that we had our first church wedding with some great converts recently saved and yet who were willing to stop living together for a couple of months before their wedding. It is something unheard of in our culture and is a great testimony of the Power of God transforming and genuinely saving people who start willing to live clean. At their wedding five people got saved.

In the next three outreaches that we had had in three other marginal neighborhoods filled with criminals, idolatry and witchcraft, we saw 24 people saved with alcoholics and young people among them.

We also see great healings. A young boy had had a tumor in his head that was causing him to lose his vision. After a simple prayer the doctors checked him and announced that his tumor was seriously reduced.

We prayed for a lady with a horrible back pain, one of her legs was shorter than the other one and after the prayer she was healed and without pain.

(Editor's Note: Sister Nancy Mazon was able to send this report while fleeing from their home as another major earthquake hit Kathmandu, Nepal in April. "We had so many offers of free flights out of KTM after the earthquakes began!" Nancy said. "Almost every day, the American Embassy sent a new email with a new deal, encouraging evacuation. We decided long ago (before ever experiencing an earthquake) that the safest place to be is always in the will of God!"

Namaste! **EARTHQUAKE NEWS COMING!** But first, we have some other victory reports to share. Last December, out of the India Conference, we sent Bibachu and Annie Kunwar into Chabahil, Kathmandu, Nepal and Pradip and Sonika Magar into Bhaktapur, Nepal. We now have five Potter's House churches in this nation!

We were able to quickly find build-

ings for the Kunwars and Magars, good locations and affordable rents. (Neither building sustained serious damage from the earthquakes). We helped the

Chabahil church with a concert in February and the Bhaktapur church with a Healing Crusade this month. Both saw souls saved. We are excited to see what God will do, as He builds these new works!

EARTHQUAKE! On April 25, we experienced the first of three major earthquakes. We have our regular weekend services on Saturdays.

We had just finished our Saturday morning altar call. We were getting ready to do a baptism. People were talking, waiting. I was praying with four other women. One had expressed a prayer need, so we were standing in a circle, with eyes closed, holding hands and agreeing in prayer. Others in church saw the building begin to move, so were more "ready" (holding onto door frames, diving under a desk, etc.). We did not notice, probably because our eyes were closed. About the time we said, "Amen," things began flying around the room, including all five of us, as the building was swaying and twisting violently. We landed in a group hug, with various pieces of furniture and equipment landing on top of us. The quake lasted about

five to six minutes! Pastor Mazon had mentioned in his sermon that morning that we were all going to die someday. Many of us thought that today would

be that day.

Miraculously, we were protected! The building was severely damaged, but did not collapse. We were all able to make it down the eight flights of stairs to safety, with only



minor injuries (cuts, bruises). We found a nearby field outside where we waited for hours, as the earthquakes continued.

Our song leader, Pratik, lead us in worship songs, beginning with "Alive, Alive"! We were praising God in the midst of utter confusion, panic and devastation. With massive amounts of people outside, avoiding collapsing buildings, we saw the opportunity for outreach. Pastor Mazon preached to the crowd, with a young disciple translating. We had fliers in our van, with the sinner's prayer on them, so others in our group passed them out and witnessed to the terrified people.

As sunset approached and the shaking seemed to be subsiding, we all went to our separate neighborhoods. Many slept in tents for days. We "slept" on our van, parked in a safe location, with nine other people from church. It was not safe to return to homes or be in buildings while the earthquakes continued.

God provided the food, water, and protection we needed. There were earthquakes throughout the nation of Nepal. The first earthquake on Saturday measured 7.9. The second one

on Sunday was at 6.8. The third major earthquake on Monday was at 6.7. Three major earthquakes in three days! Jesus is coming soon!

Then the following Wednesday night, we had seven more visitors from the neighborhood who all got saved. And, then the next Saturday, an additional four visitors gave their hearts to Jesus. Namaste! The Church of Lalitpur of Nepal is labouring together with other fellow churches here in Nepal. I took over this church from my Pastor Gordon Porter and Mary Porter in January 2015.

I am very grateful to my pastor and Pastor Greg for trusting me and my wife Anita for this great work and responsibility. We are the first nationalized couple from Prescott in Nepal.

Recently a month ago we had a big tragedy in our Nation of Nepal. A big earthquake of 7.8 magnitude and other many big and small aftershakes. After that incident, our lives here are miserable. About 9,000 people lost their lives and other thousands got injured.

On April 25, we were just finishing our Saturday service and ready to get out from the church building on the sixth floor. Suddenly we felt bad shakes. We had two pregnant ladies (including my wife) and one another lady, some kids and other church members. Everybody start falling down and speakers falling over them. All of us were thinking this

is our last day in this world. Then I told everyone to be safe and pray to our Lord Jesus Christ. We were praying hard, and God heard our prayers. Though our building was badly damaged and cracked, all of us are safe. Some of our church people saw from the church roof other buildings falling down. Some of the other local church buildings, not our Fellowship churches, collapsed,

and many Christians died.

Many of our church people lost their houses and apartments. We tried hard to gather many of our church members together. We stayed together in one place inside tents, praying. Until now I am helping one of our church families with food and shelter in my house. Apartments in good condition are very hard to find. Daily necessary stuffs are short and hard to get. Even to get drinking water we are having problems. Everywhere is chaos and confusion. It's been almost a month now, but still we are feeling aftershocks. People are still scared of going inside their houses, but we are trying hard to be back in normal life.

Praise God. He has always fulfilled our needs and necessities as the Word of God says in Philippians 4:19.

In the midst of this chaos and confusion, we haven't stop serving God and sharing the Good News of Salvation to

people. We are doing church services outside in tents where we are staying and sometimes in our church members' houses. We are seeing souls saved and people hearing the Gospel.

We recently found a good building for our new church. It is better than the first one and also in a prime location. I believe God showed us this place. Though people are still scared of big buildings

(our new church is on the fourth floor) in time everything will be back to normal and we will have revival here.

Now we are believing for a breakthrough for our Nation of Nepal. As the Bible prophesizes about end times, we are seeing the evidence of Jesus Coming back again. We will stand strong in His word. God is going to build this nation with his people through grace and mercy.

Though the Devil is mad at us and we are facing lots of hard times, we believe in our Lord Jesus Christ. He is going to be with us to save the lost souls and give hope for new

In April we also had a three-day revival with the Evangelist Edwin Jonkhout of Zwolle, The Netherlands. He came to Vologda after holding meetings in Murmansk, a city above the arctic circle. Edwin was the first foreign preacher to hold a revival in that city.

In less than 10 days we saw 130 people saved in both churches. Edwin spent hours daily on the streets praying for the sick and witnessing. In both churches men and women were staggered to see him in action. Many got excited to witness and pray for the sick also.

We witnessed many miracles. In Vologda church. A young woman was healed of a breast tumour of the size of a tennis ball or bigger. She could not move her left arm without pain and had to wear a larger bra. She had endured pain for many weeks and just before the revival scheduled an appointment with an oncologist. She did not realise she was healed until she came home and started to take off her

sweater. Other girls she lives with heard her weeping in another room and rushed to help only to find her crying for joy and telling everyone she was completely healed, the pain gone and tumour disappeared.

There were other notable miracles as legs and arms grew out and pain left bodies.

Also Edwin gave 15-25 words of knowledge nightly that were very precise. Powerful words given in his non-charismatic manner left many silently weeping as he quickly moved on to another person.

I must say this was an incredibly reviving revival and the outpouring of God's power with lasting effects. In Murmansk he preached in a drug rehab hospital. He saw everybody there pray a sinner's prayer and also prayed with a nurse.

I myself had five people pray a sinner's prayer on the street during the revival. I haven't seen that for at least a year. I witness regularly and preach on the streets weekly but I just could not break through in my witness to get to pray with people.

Many disciples of Vologda church weeks later are still going out daily to pray for the sick and witness to people. We are seeing people saved every day.

All this happened in Vologda without prior advertisement because due to the bureaucracy complications, we failed to obtain a religious visa for Edwin and the meetings could not be advertised.

We prepared our church for the revival in several ways. I challenged the church to support the meetings with their participation and prayer and expectant faith.

Also we started a "school of evangelists" a few weeks prior to the revival. Men gather daily for an hour or two to preach on the streets and witness. Also classes take place right after the morning prayer on the work days.
