Travels to Mexico and Guam fill Pastor Mitchell's schedule

Pastor Mitchell traveled into Mexico City and met Pastor Jose Torres and travelled to an Aztec village above Puebla, Mexico named San Jose.

This church was pioneered from a former illegal who had gotten saved in Oregon and then returned to Mexico and began evangelizing his village. Unable to get a pastor sent from Mexico City churches, he became the pastor himself, eventually coming under the El Paso church.

His congregation has built a 10,000 square foot auditorium and planted eight more works, some of which can only be reached by a four and a half hour walk into the mountains by foot. Five hundred people came together for a miracle crusade as a Pastor Mitchell and Jose Torres preached and prayed for the sick.

Pastor Mitchell returned to Mexico City for a crusade for Pastor Sal-

vador Castaneda. Between 200 and 300 convert cards and many miracles demonstrated that God still is faithful to hear our prayers.

Pastor Greg Mitchell and Pastor

Wayman Mitchell travelled to Mexicali, Mexico for a Men's Rally. Some 500-600 men gathered. Jonathan Heimberg also preached to an enthusiastic Men's Rally hosted by Jose Torres.

Pastor Mitchell conducted a Miracle Crusade in Guam, Marianas Islands for a record breaking attendance for Pastor Glen Cluck. Four nights at Ipao Beach ended with more than 3,000 in attendance Sunday night with 186 convert cards. A Sunday morning service at the church saw some 800 people in attendance.

An area wide Men's Rally in Killeen, Texas saw a full house for James Rosario. A sermon workshop Friday morning followed and was enthusiastically attended. Two new sermons were created from scratch. It was a teaching blessing for new and older pastors alike.

Prescott Church announces exciting expansion

Artist's rendering of new Prescott expansion



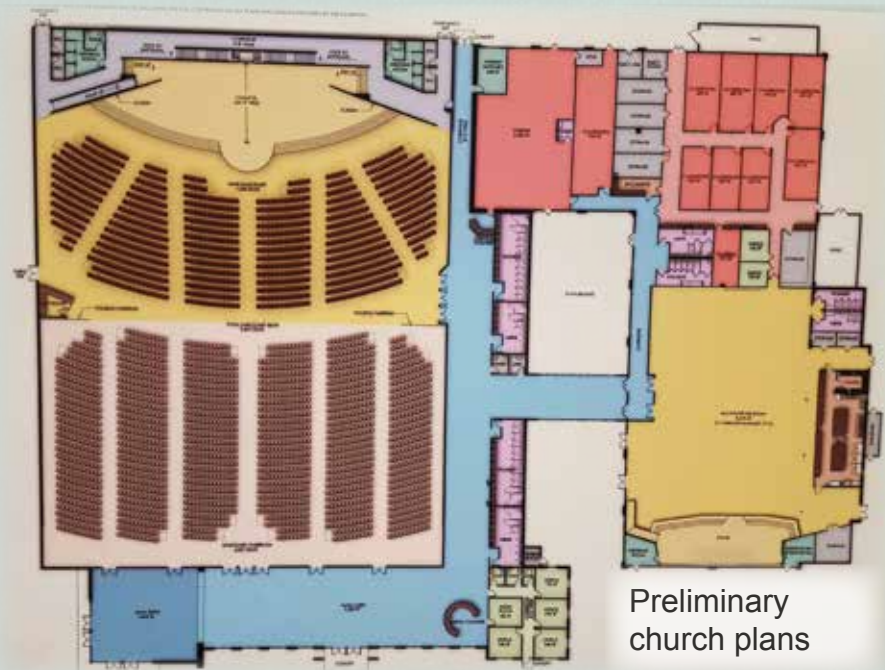
The Prescott Church body was thrilled during its February business meeting to hear the announcement that we would be moving forward with building a new auditorium and remodeling our existing church to accommodate all God will do in the coming days until Jesus returns.

Pastor Greg Mitchell said God had been moving on him for some time about the expansion. Senior Pastor Wayman Mitchell and other senior leaders in the Fellowship concurred.

Pastor Mitchell told the church that research shows a congregation will only grow to 80 percent of available space. Prescott has been over that capacity for several years, and lack of space would inhibit future growth of the congregation and the conference.

The new addition will be approximately 55,000 square feet, added to the existing building of about 26,000 square feet. There will be seating for regular services for 1,000 people in the front portion of the sanctuary, and a center divider will be added, which can be moved to enable seating another 2,000 in the rear portion. This will be used to accommodate conferences, and will enable the church to host those gatherings without putting up tents.

The existing church will become

classrooms, nursery, Children's Church, media area, and fellowship hall. A large foyer will welcome congregation and visitors, and the church will have an attractive facade facing the adjacent highway.

Planning for the building started in early December, and the church already has undergone a pre-application meeting with the City of Prescott. A contractor is on board, and permitting is now

underway.

Construction is expected go quickly as the expansion is mostly the large auditorium. Plans are for the Prescott conference to remain in the tent for two more conferences before moving into the new building.

Please pray for the Prescott congregation as this exciting new project moves forward to accommodate all God wants to do in the coming days!

The Prescott Church has been seeing the power of God demonstrated through a faith-based recovery home. Life Transformation Recovery is exactly what it sounds like; it's an addiction treatment center that, through the power of Jesus Christ, sees lives transformed. Men and women who are completely lost, hurting, and without purpose are given a chance for true change.

The desire of the program, and those involved in it, is to show love and compassion to those who once believed that they were unlovable. The change that is brought about in their lives is only due to the work of the Holy Spirit in them!

Everyone in the program is brought to a choice about God and their situation. For those who make the choice to change and surrender, they then start down the path of growth and recovery. They are guided and challenged to make right decisions, and through the process they learn to make decisions and live responsibly. Those who, at one time in their life, had no purpose or hope, and no desire to live anymore, are given purpose and destiny in Christ Jesus.

Two men, Anthony Luka and Giovanni Dugi, recently graduated the program. It was such an exciting time, not only for Life Transformation Recovery, but also

for our entire congregation. Both men have come into our church, and even chose to be baptized! It is amazing to see the decisions they made for Christ, and the miracle God has done in them.

The team at Life Transformation Recovery had the privilege of seeing and being a part of the process and growth in them. There is a definite excitement and hope when we see men stand up in a graduation, telling who they use to be, but are no longer. Men who couldn't hold a job or support a family; or they couldn't stay out of jail or prison, or off drugs. These men now have a purpose, they have a future that never would have been theirs without the power of Jesus Christ.

Every life that is changed by God is a miracle, and Life Transformation Recovery is privileged to play a part in seeing those miracles. We do not rely on a program to change lives, it's all in the power of Jesus Christ.

Every man and woman who comes into the program finds a safe haven. They are brought into a place where they can know and see God work and move in miracles, and they can see the miracle God is doing in themselves. They are given the support and the direction they need to live a life free from drugs and alcohol.

Through counseling, and team

buildings, and trials and correction, they are guided. Every day there are new experiences, and new teaching lessons for these men and women to grow and change. As the men and women in the program catch the vision, they too want to see lives changed! What a powerful testimony it is when they want to go on outreach and be a part of someone else's conversion.

There is a great expectancy in the program as we see more and more people with this need in our generation. We are expecting God to fill the houses with broken people who need answers, because we want to see lives changed! Even though the recovery home is separate from the church, they still carry on the same vision that we as a Fellowship have. They are reaching out to the lost, and sharing love to the broken hearted, and being the hands and feet of Jesus.

We are so grateful to see God move in this recovery home. If He wasn't involved, men like Anthony and Giovanni wouldn't have the hope and purpose they do now. And we look forward to having many more "Anthonys" and "Giovannies" come through the program, so that we can tell them about the miracle power available to them! I don't know any other way to express it, except it is a miracle to see a life transformed.

Greetings from the Church in Chandler, Arizona! We have been laboring these past winter months and as promised by God, we are seeing the fruits of our evangelism events.

In November, we hosted our annual Harvest Homecoming for our new converts. We served them BBQ food, ministered music and drama, and gave testimonies. We also introduced them to the different ministries of our church such as Children's Church, Sunday School, Cross-Fire (teen ministry), and our New Convert's class. At the end of the night, Pastor Williams shared his powerful testimony and gave an altar call. Several people gave their lives to Jesus!

We are also seeing a growth in people attending our New Convert's Class. This class teaches foundational truths from God's word. Everyone from the old saint to the new convert is welcomed to attend the classes. This past session we had a total of 18 graduates!

In mid-December our Children's Church ministered a Christmas play called "Arrest these Merry Gentleman." The setting takes place in Bethlehem right before the birth of Jesus. The church was packed with visiting parents, grandparents, family relatives, and friends with a total of 35 visitors. Best of all 12 people gave their lives to Jesus.

Behind the scenes at a Prescott Conference

Prescott Conference is always an exciting time to see the will of God accomplished, but it is only made possible by all who labor and serve and sacrifice their time to keep things running smoothly behind the scenes.

Several of these workers take vacation time from their jobs to work at conference.

From the beginning raising the main tent and the nursery and Children's Church tents, until it is taken down on Friday night, the work is never ending. Pastor Artie Aragon brings his crew from Chinle, AZ and they labor faithfully to set up and take down the tents for the conference.

The setup is done well before the Conference starts to allow for carpet to be laid, chairs set up, flags hung, stage and instruments placed, and bleachers, water stands and heating and cooling to be set up. Community members who pass the busy corner on which the church property stands have often commented on



driving by Friday night and seeing the tents, and then passing Saturday with everything taken down and packed away overnight.

Before a sermon is ever preached, workers spend hours behind the scenes to arrange room accommodations, and on check-in day, a group of ladies comes to help direct the delegates to their hotels.

Many men volunteer through the week in the parking lot to see that traffic moves safely. It's a long cold, or hot, job, depending on the season, but hundreds of vehicles are moved in, parked, and moved out before and after serv-

es.

Worship service includes a team of musicians and vocalists who help set the tone and atmosphere for God to move! Ushers help with seating people and gathering the offering, and many stay to help count the offering.

Early each day our donut crew arrives to start the morning coffee and assembling the donuts. This team consists of many workers doing a variety of tasks - serving donuts, juice and coffee, emptying trash, and delivering donuts to the ministry workers who are busy at their stations.

We have men and women who faithfully serve in both our book trailer and our media trailer; which are open for anyone to purchase sermons, CDs, Sunday school series and countless books to help their ministries. Other workers spend the week in the media room in the church building, recording and duplicating sermons and producing the messages and videos in various formats.

Women volunteer in our nursery to help care for the infants, as well as other workers' children, during each day and evening.

Our Children's Church workers

are hard at work as well, preparing games and messages to teach the children the word of God.

Throughout the week our sound and lighting crews minister faithfully so we can hear and see the word of God proclaimed! It is a huge task with a lot of set up involved.

Men come each service to help translate the message into Spanish for Spanish-speaking attendees. The photography and video crews work hard to capture each and every moment of the conference.

In addition, videographers provide a livestream for all those who can't be present and to produce all the sermons sold in the media trailer.

At the end of every night you'll find the cleaning crew hard at work to put the tent back in order for the next day's seminars!

From morning 'til night, every day of the week during conference, people labor behind the scenes so pastors and their wives, along with delegates from countries all over the world, can focus on what God is saying to them during the week, a week that could change the course of their lives.

On Sunday 27th August, we held our first service in downtown Cayenne, under the shade of a tree near the seashore. If Paul, Lydia and the others had an outside church service in Philippi in the first century, why not us in Cayenne in the twenty-first century?

God has blessed us tremendously because on that first service we had a visitor, and since then we've always had people at our services - two to eight people, outside our family.

We have seen seven men answer the altar call and pray a sinner's prayer. One man, Emmanuel, is particularly faithful and is a great encouragement to us. He has been delivered from sleeplessness and nightmares. We thank God for that!

God has also helped us in many ways to get settled here in Cayenne. When we arrived with our three children, we had a place to sleep for four days, but during that time we found a well-located house that we could rent under very good conditions. Both my wife and I found a job, and that was providential in this country which is an expensive country, actually a little piece of France in South America with the Euro as currency.

Even though French Guiana is a part of France, a country generally

hostile to the God of the Bible, we have here great liberty to proclaim the name of Jesus. In the school where I work as a math teacher, I could share

my testimony at lunch time, and one of the ladies said her hair was standing up as I was telling it, because she was so touched by it.

Also during a meeting at school with the foster mother of a very difficult child, I had all liberty to pray out loud for this child and everyone (foster mother and school staff) was united in prayer.

The foster mother was wiping her tears because she was touched.

God even cares about small details, like the banner that we had made in Holland, not knowing where our church services would take place. Well, the length of the banner matches exactly the distance between the posts of the kiosk where we now hold our services (see the picture with this article).

In short, we find a great openness to the Gospel in this peculiar land of French Guiana which is a piece of the European community in South America, and one of the three non-Spanish and non-Portuguese speaking countries of the continent.

We now need a building to house the people God wants to gather, but the French bureaucracy makes it dif-

ficult to rent one. Please pray for the church in French Guiana, especially for a building, as we pray for you.

My name is Lepani, I was born in the island of Fiji, in 1988.

At a very young age, I never knew my father. My mother took custody of me, and she cared for me through her side of the family.

I was raised in a good family home but at the age of nine I was told that I would be leaving Fiji to go over to Australia and to live with my stepdad.

At the age of 15 I got into trouble with the law for the first time, charged with assault, and was sentenced to 12 months in a juvenile detention centre.

Shortly after being released from juvenile prison, I started working and at the age of 16, two years down the track, life began to look like it was going to be alright. Then suddenly I began to fall back into the drinking smoking, doing drugs, and this time it became worse. At the age of 18, I landed myself in prison once again.

For the next seven years, I would go in and out of prison. Life was a big mess. I became an angry,

violent liar and thief and a slave to lust.

Forty times I'd been in trouble with the law. I was in a deep cycle and I couldn't escape it, and I needed change. I looked to friends, relationship, family but nothing fulfilled me.

In 2013 I got released from prison and my mother invited me out to church. My first reaction was that I didn't want to go because I knew about church and who God was even from a very young age. But I didn't know that he sacrificed his Son Jesus Christ to die on the cross for my sin and that I could be forgiven.

Shortly after, I ended up coming to church. I sat at the back while my pastor was preaching, and throughout the message I felt guilty in my heart. I recognised that I was a sinner, and the only way to get right with the creator was to repent of my sin.

A special call was made after the preaching and God was calling out to me, I felt it in my heart and in my spirit, in a moment of time, I lifted my hand and responded to the call.

On the 2nd of August 2013, I gave my life to Jesus Christ, which was the change that I was searching so badly for. God began to move in my situation and changed my life. I stopped drinking, smok-

ing and doing drugs. God opened up opportunities, gave me a job, and began to give me Godly Christian friends, and life became very different.

Just as life was looking brighter for me, I didn't guard my heart and one year down the track, I backslid, went back to drugs and made bad decisions and went to prison again.

I fell backwards into the very mess that God got me out of and it was a big disappointment to me and everyone that tried to help me.

I ended up in prison again this time serving 16 months in Long Bay jail for an armed robbery, using a firearm.

While in prison I prayed and asked God to forgive me. Just a few months into my time inside, my pastor came to visit me and it was like my prayer was answered. I finally got released and immediately returned to church.

In 2016 I recommitted my life to Jesus. I'm now working full time, paying off my debts and staying on track. I had the privilege to go on an impact team to Fiji and I'm

serving God in the Potter's House Hurstville, my local church.

God has blessed me more than I can imagine, I'm currently an usher and in song service ministry.

One key thing that always resonates in my heart is, no matter how big or small our problems may be, always trust in God, no matter how difficult life may be, trust in Jesus and wait on His time. He really will never leave us nor forsake us. If God can save a wretch like me, he can do the same for anyone.
