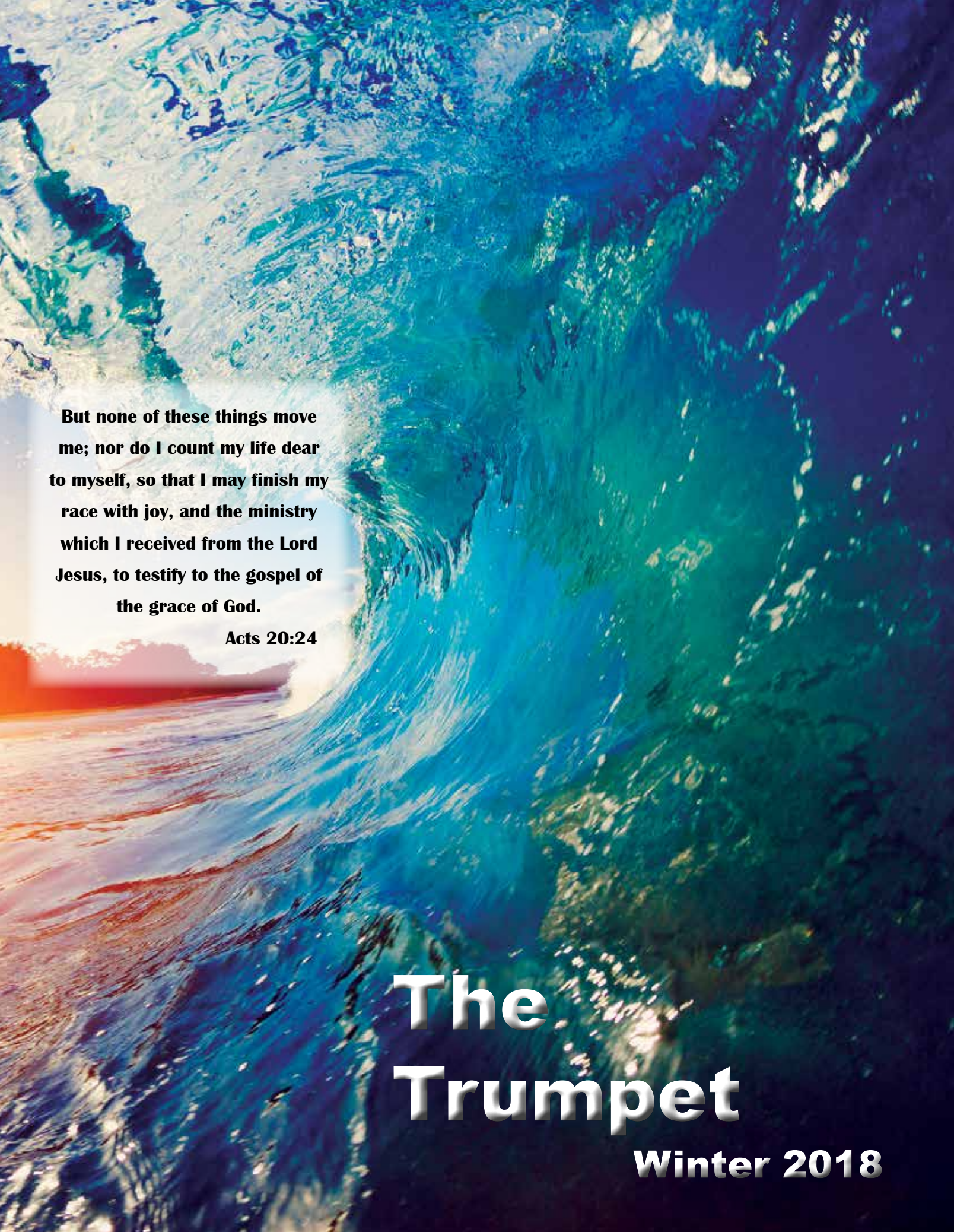

We continued to hold Monday Night Movie outreaches in the park and Friday night concerts throughout the summer, with impact being made in our city.

We have also been trying new outreaches to reach the community.

Pastor Diego Galvan, our Spanish Pastor, has been seeing breakthrough in our Spanish-speaking community. He was recently able to preach a Spanish healing crusade in Chino Valley. It was a fruitful time, and we saw several divine appointments.

One of those was a young man who was riding his motorcycle past the park, and felt the urge to stop but didn't know why. So he stopped and came over and stayed through the crusade. That man gave his life to Christ, and was also healed from back pain and a leg which was one and a half inches short! At the end of the night there were three decisions made for God!

This year we tried something new and held a Veterans Day outreach. Pete Walter headed it up, putting on a breakfast in the morning for all Veterans and then a show in the afternoon following the Veterans Day parade.

During the show we had booths set up with pictures, memorabilia and weapons from different wars. We had a group of women who sang and did a tribute to the "Andrews Sisters," and we had a BBQ lunch to go along with it.

Throughout the day we had more than 300 people come through and stay for the food, music and testimonies. There were many personal contacts made, and more than 20 people gave their lives to Christ!

One lady in our church, Ronnalyn DeBlois, prayed with an elderly veteran for salvation. When they were finished the gentleman told her that

he had always been afraid to die, but now he wasn't afraid anymore! It was an exciting new outreach for us, and we look forward to trying it again next year!

We put on our annual Haunted House this year, with more than 109 people involved, from actors, to costumed, to make up artists, the sound and light crews, the altar call preachers and the witnessing room workers. We had a great turnout this year, partly due to the fact that we were the only Haunted House in Prescott.

We had hundreds come through in groups of 20 or so, and we had whole groups raise their hands and pray in the altar call. When it was all finished there were 122 total decisions for Christ.

We did a follow up outreach the weekend after, and several people came out, including whole families who gave their lives to Christ!

In October we had the privilege of having Pastor Martin Klok, from Holland, preach a revival for us. He started on Saturday Morning ministering to the youth in our annual Youth extreme. He preached on the anointing of God before sending them out to evangelize on the streets! There was great impact made in the city through one-on-one evangelism. We were also excited to have the opportunity to Street preach on a corner downtown, across from a local festival going on. Many young people stood up and proclaimed what Jesus had done for them for the very first time! The day was wrapped up with a special concert, and at the end of the day there were 34 decisions for Christ.

Pastor Klok continued ministering throughout the week, and God was faithful to meet with us every night. It was an encouraging and strengthening time for the church as Pastor Klok ministered with a word of knowledge and spoke into the lives of many in the congregation. The revival has finished but as a congregation we are revived, refreshed and excited as we push ahead into a new season of outreach.

Our Trunk or Treat blew our minds. God moved and brought more than 200 visitors through our church parking lot. There were several testimonies, and live music, resulting in 15 souls giving their lives to Jesus Christ.

On Halloween night, we tried something new...we took the Haunted House to the people. Our drama team

performed a Halloween skit on a large flatbed trailer in a nearby empty lot by one of the popular trick or treating neighborhoods. Hundreds of bystanders got to hear the Gospel, and nine souls gave their lives to Jesus Christ.

Prescott, AZ sent a crew who came and performed their wonderful "Malice in Wonderland" play in our local High School. We had more than 130 people in attendance and 30 souls got saved that night. Some attended service the following day.

As we close our busy 2017, we continue to see enlargement in our congregation spiritually and in souls. Many are stepping into ministry and learning instruments to serve God. Many believers are receiving miracles in heal-

The highlight of the year was the celebration of our 10 years anniversary revival by Pastor Pakia Raj, the leadership pastor of the Indian Fellowship,

Pastor Jonathan Heimberg from the U.S. on his first visit to India as a visitor to the India Bible Conference in 2006 was impacted and consequently came to India as a missionary along with his family.

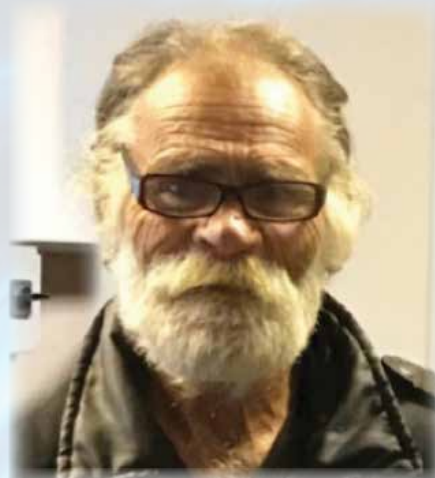
My name is Fergus Knott Craig, born in Klerksdorp, Northwest South Africa in 1956. Three months later I was adopted by a family, who took me in after for a reason unkown to me, my biological parents gave me up for adoption.

Growing up, I attended a Catholic boarding school, worked in the gold

mines and later was called to serve in the South African Defense Force for two years. At 22 years old, I got married. We had three children, and were divorced after eight years.

I left my job and moved to Cape Town. My life began to unravel even more as I got into the party life, drinking and sleeping around. I got involved in another relationship, and we had a son together. Because of alcohol, we separated, and I raised our son by myself. My ex later died of AIDS.

My life was getting worse. I tried to find answers, in and out of churches, but finding no hope. I got arrested and locked up for fighting.

I drank alcohol but it left me empty, so I stopped and replaced it with something worse. I had a friend who was smoking Meth, (South Africa calls it "Tik") and I thought, maybe that's what I need. I asked him to buy me a packet of Tik, and I started smoking it, thinking I was in control, but it was instead controlling me. Addicted, I smoked every day. I didn't want to stop, it was the only thing that gave my life meaning.

All my money was going to buy Meth/Tik, I had my car stolen, and my life just hit bottom. I ended up in an area called Grassy Park, where I knew nobody.

I was offered a job at a scrap yard, which funded my drug addiction. One day while standing outside of our scrapyard, on the sidewalk, I heard church

music. I looked across the street, and saw the big signs, The Potters House Church.

One Sunday, I was listening to the music as I was standing right outside the church, downstairs. One of the men in the church, Edwin Stevens, asked me if I was coming up to the church. I didn't answer the altar call right away to get saved. I came a few more services. Then on Easter Morning, April 16, 2017, I asked Jesus to come into my life.

Even though I was still on Tik/Meth, I kept going to church. God started convicting me, dealing with me about my addiction, and I responded. God broke the chains of a 15 year addiction, I stopped immediately, with no withdrawals or any cravings.

Jesus said, "You are free indeed," and I am to this day clean from Tik. Seven months later, I have no desire to work for Satan.
