The Prescott congregation is eagerly awaiting the first service, and the first conference, in our new building and conference center!

We so appreciate the contributions of Pastor Jonathan Heimberg of Gallup who came to help install the sound system, and Artie Aragon and crew from Chinle who helped with installing and hanging speakers and more.

Pastor Keith Sullivan and church member Dennis Halverson worked in tandem for countless hours and weeks on the new partition tracking system that separates the church and conference center. This system alone is made up of 48 panels weighing 320 lbs. each.

The existing church has been remodeled with larger nurseries, classrooms, kitchen and fellowship hall and children's church.

During construction, we were amazed as huge cranes lifted the heating and cooling units on to the roof, and at one point, we had nine different trades working at once with 15 manlifts working inside the sanctuary building.

Even during all of this construction, it was important for us to "keep the main thing the main thing," as Pastor Mitchell would say. That meant continuing with outreaches, theme nights, neighborhood outreaches and evangelism.

We are having a continued breakthrough in the music scene in part due to impact teams coming into Prescott to hit the streets and pass out flyers. In total we've had 10 impact teams on Saturdays to evangelize for the music scenes.

In the music scene, One80, we've had seven theme nights. These are large scale produc-

tions using different decades and subjects that people will interact with, including skits, music and testimonies. These events have included music genre nights such as blues, country, rock and hip hop.

Pastor Scott Lamb has sent two large Holy Ghost-filled teams to help in this effort. We appreciate all who have come to help in our labors

On April 27, we put on our first Veterans outreach at the One89. This was an appreciation event orchestrated by veteran Pete Walter.

The event included music by the "Andrews Sisters," and a meal.

Pastor Wayman Mitchell, who was an Air Force Staff Sergeant, spoke and pulled the altar call. We saw a total of 203 first time visitors and 27 saved!

During the call to respond to the sacrifice of Christ, one 92-year-old WWII veteran who had never heard a call to respond to the Gospel prayed for the first time that night!

Our annual San Luis crusade at the end of April, in which many of our teens participate, saw great fruit and changed lives,

A Nogales, Sonora outreach with Pastor Jonathan Heimberg from Gallup preaching saw 1800 plus visitors with 239 decisions for Jesus.

In the past last three months we have seen 143 new decisions for Jesus and many rededicating their lives.

New converts are coming in and staying to serve God. We have had weekly new convert fellowships or lunches to help converts lock in, with 10 to 20 converts at each.

We're looking forward to our first baptism in the new building!

God is fulfilling His promises to the Prescott church and giving great revival. Please continue to pray for us as we pray for you!

Greetings from the Chandler Church! These past months, we have been continually laboring for the God's Kingdom and remain focused on reaching the world for Jesus.

At the same time, we are also experiencing times of refreshment through encouraging words, and refinement by challenges from the pulpit to be more effective in the harvest field.

Every February we have a Black

History Celebration Week. This year we were privileged to have a revival with Pastor Stacey Dillard. Pastor Dillard preached words of encouragement and words that stirred us to persistently pursue Jesus. During the revival, we had more than 30 visitors and 20 people gave their lives to Jesus.

Another reason for excitement is that our Disciples are rising up! Every Friday, Disciples are leading an outdoor concert by setting up bands in the park, and are serving free food to draw a crowd. The event always ends with the Gospel being preached and altar call given. Not only are we seeing souls saved, but this has been a great training ground for our men.

In March, we had our annual Pioneer's Rally. We heard powerful preaching from Pastor Greg Mitchell, Pastor Wayman Mitchell, Pastor Mark Aulson, and Pastor Campbell. The sermons encourage us to continually seek God and daily surrender to his will.

In our desire to see revival, Pastor Campbell gave a challenge to the Church to meet at 5 a.m. for morning prayer. Every morning from 5 a.m. to 7 a.m. the Church was packed with hundreds of people praying and contending for revival.

Our teens are also being moved to press in for God. The Chandler Church united with our Phoenix valley sister churches to host a local area Teen Rally. Pastor Andy Cota preached on rejection and many teens responded to the messages during this rally with fresh commitment. During the altar call, 11 people gave their lives to Jesus. After the service, more than 100 teens hit the streets of Chandler proclaiming the Gospel.

In the month of April, we were blessed to have the Prescott Church minister their superhero play for us. The play is set in the City of Chicago, where the city is plagued by crime. Although there are superheroes in the city, nothing seems to be working to stop the crime. It was determined they did not need a hero, they needed a Savior. As a result of the play, more than 70 visitors were in attendance and 20 people gave their lives to Jesus.

For Easter, we ministered a play called "The Board Room." This play tells the story of a bitter, hurting man who wants nothing to do with Jesus. Inside of him there is a board meeting between his heart, mind, emotions, and conscience trying to decide what to do about Jesus. At the end of the play, Pastor Williams preached the altar call, putting the question to the audience - "What will they do about Jesus?" Several people surrendered and rededicated their lives to Jesus.

At the end of April, we hosted our annual Missions Rally. Our Missions Rally is our second biggest

event next to our Bible Conference. The Chandler Church is dedicated to reach the world for Jesus. Between us and our baby churches, we have given over \$1 million for World Evangelism.

During the Missions Rally we heard preaching from Pastor Gutierrez, Pastor Andy Cota, Pastor Martinez, and Pastor Gil Cota. We were convicted to remove anything that would hinder us from the Fellowship's vision. At the end of the Rally, the altar was packed with men and couples pledging their lives to the mission field.

In May, the Chandler Church hosted a Cinco de Mayo Celebration. Sublime Gracia, a band from Los Mochis, Mexico came and ministered to the Chandler Church. The following service, Pastor James Martinez preached and encouraged the church to continually labor and to cast off anything that would hinder our walk with God.

We remain committed to the great commission. Please join us in prayer that 2019 would be a year of fruitfulness for us as a church and as a Fellowship. And as always we will continually pray for you.

Testimony
Michelle Martinez

My name is Michelle Martinez, I am 28 years old and I'm serving Jesus in Espanola, NM!

I am Persian/ Hispanic, from Santa Fe, NM. I moved to Espanola almost four years ago and my life before Christ was a mess.

I started drinking and smoking weed when I was only 10 years old. At 13 years old I was doing coke and taking pain pills on a regular basis. Shortly after I turned 16 I was smoking crack, which quickly lead to shooting up heroine and meth. I also was taking 130 milligrams of methadone daily, while on medication for depression and anxiety. I lived for the high.

I was so extremely broken that life felt hopeless. I had ruined every relationship I had with my family, I didn't have friends, and the people that were around me weren't any better than I was. I got pregnant with my daughter at 19 years old and that didn't change me, I still did drugs for most of my pregnancy. I had quit for a few months but as soon as I had gotten the test results that my baby girl didn't have Down Syndrome I started using drugs again.

The day I got discharged from the hospital, after I had my healthy little girl, I smoked crack and was still partying. I couldn't even be a mother, I only cared about myself and how I was feeling. I thought that the way I was living was normal. That life was all I knew.

When I was younger I did all of the typical Catholic religious traditions. I was baptized, and made my first holy communion, but I still didn't know who Jesus was. My life was incredibly broken. I tried doing the

AA/NA meetings, and I went to jail a few times, but I couldn't change.

On Friday, October 14, 2016 I had gotten so drunk that I couldn't tell you where my daughter was, or what she was doing (I'm sure I put her in front of our TV which was her frequent baby sitter). That night I fell asleep thinking that tomorrow I would get up and do the same thing.

On October 15, 2016, my boyfriend and I were talking about trying to stay sober, because he was worried he had pancreatitis. That morning I was spending time with my daughter and we heard a knock at our door (it was a Saturday morning). When I answered it a woman, Tina Ocana (the Door director's wife at that time), was standing there and invited me to their 180 concert in Española. She briefly talked about her testimony, but all I remember was she said "I haven't had a drink in 10 years." Part of me thought she was lying, but the other part wondered if it was true. So, that evening my boyfriend, daughter and I went to the 180 Concert and little did I know that day was going to completely change my life.

God got ahold of my heart, it was a divine appointment from the beginning. During the altar call that night Jaime Ocana (the Door director at that time) was talking about his dad having pancreatitis and how God had healed him. He talked about repentance, and Jesus Christ dying for our sins. I remember my boyfriend looking at me during the altar call and he asked me if I had told the 180 preacher about our conversation about pancreatitis. While I was completely in shock I told him "no." I was so confused.

Although I was raised Catholic I didn't believe in God, I believed in karma, so I didn't know how to explain it. At first I didn't raise my hand during the altar call, but then Tina came to me and asked me if I wanted to give my life to Jesus and I said yes.

At that moment I didn't truly understand what that meant, but I felt like it was something I had to do, so I did. During our ride home that night my boyfriend and I were sitting there

in complete silence, no music, and not a word spoken. Then right before we got home, we turned to each other and asked each other "What just happened?" We had no explanation, other than maybe there really was a God.

The next morning we attended church service, and I answered the altar call again, and that time I meant it. I continued to go to every service, twice on Sunday and then again on Wednesday (and I haven't stopped). I also made it a point to go to everything that the church was doing, from fellowships to outreaches (even though I had no clue what I was doing). I felt myself changing, I immediately stopped doing drugs and I no longer needed to take my medication for depression and anxiety. Less than a month after I got saved I stopped drinking.

Before I knew it I was free from all the bondages that held me hostage for most of my life, all the cravings stopped!

The whole time God was showing me that there were things that I had to deal with. I got married, and I started tithing. At that time I didn't have anything to give, but I still gave 10 percent of whatever I had. I was living off unemployment but continued to pay my tithes.

God started to move in my life even more, as if salvation and sobriety weren't enough, he started to bless my finances. I got a job that I loved, as a long-term substitute. I was not qualified for that job AT ALL, but God gave me a tremendous amount of favor. I then decided to go back to school so that I can better myself and to be able to bless others the way that I was blessed, as a new convert.

Shortly after I started going to school I was given the opportunity to be an advocate for domestic violence victims, another job that I had no experience in, but God continued to give me favor.

I was going through some difficult things with my family but God continued to show me that he was there, and in less than a year I got a \$2.60 per hour raise. While working, I was still going to school, then an-

other opportunity opened up. I was offered a position working for Los Alamos National Laboratory. This is an amazing opportunity, so I am now working there as a paid intern while I'm going to school to pursue my Bachelor's degree in Business Management. My yearly income has doubled this year, than what I made last year!

God is still doing amazing things in my life, in my family, and in Española! Jesus has totally had redemption on my life and has lifted me up from a life of sin! I just want to thank God for all he's done, and all that he's still doing.

I went from a life that had no hope to a life that has been filled with joy and blessings. God has helped me to be a better person, wife and mother. I'm in ministry at church, I play the piano on stage and I'm in drama! I can't begin to explain how grateful I am for the vision that our fellowship has of reaching the lost!

If Tina never would have come to my door that day, I would still be going down a dark path. I now have hope for my future!

When I was only two years old my life began to fall apart.

My biological mother took drugs behind my father's back and would sleep around. One night she came home from a party drunk and on drugs. She jumped on the bed my father was in and killed my three-month-old brother. My mom and dad took him to the hospital and later he died. The police arrested both of them and neither were willing to admit to the crime. Then my dad who was only 23 at the time took the blame and served 16 years in prison, basically until I was 18.

With nowhere to go I was taken in by my aunt and uncle. Being a hyper kid I would get in trouble. My punishments were physically and psychologically abusive. It was rough at school and I was bullied.

I became rebellious in my thinking. I didn't care about my life. My hatred for the world grew as did my lust. I gave in to hatred as it was my greatest weakness. I attempted to end my life more times than I could count. Death and misery were a big part of my life.

Hello my name is Sadie Burgess I'm 24 years old. I did not grow up in church. My

family and I would go to a church but only for so long.

Growing up, I always just felt so empty and sad. I was a liar and a thief. I lied about who I was because I hated who I was. I stole things because I never had things! It might sound funny but I turned to food when I was young because food never disappointed me, I even remember saying to my 10-year-old self "Eating makes me feel good." When someone put me down, made me cry, or even made fun of me, food was there. It was a better comforter then any of my parents ever were!

In 2014 about two months after I completed high school in Tampa, Florida where I resided at the time I met my husband John, who was my boyfriend at the time. He was a backslider from The Door Church that was located in Tampa, Florida. We met on a dating website, and found out that we live right around the corner from each other. We started dating, and then a month into our relationship John dumped me to go back to church. I was heartbroken of course and did not understand why he would leave me for a church!

John was the only good thing I had at the time. My mother was threatening to kick me out of the house and make me homeless as well as talking to me like she never gave birth to me. So that night I told myself "I'm going to end my life." I wrote a suicide note bashing my mother and every other person that hurt me.

I sat on my bed and popped 40 pills. A minute or two later I fell out. I woke up in the middle of the night to use the bathroom. I could barely walk so I just laid back in bed. I woke up in the morning and felt completely normal, all I said to myself was "it didn't work." So I threw the suicide note away and then went on about my day. I didn't almost commit suicide because I got dumped! I almost committed suicide because I was broken, empty, and lost. I felt like I couldn't handle life anymore, so I wanted to disappear from it.

Shortly after my husband backslid again, we dated for a year, then he told me "either you're coming to

church with me or I'm leaving you." So I went and gave my life to Christ and I got touched miraculously! A week and six days later we got married.

Thinking back on what had happened I could have lost my life and my soul probably would've been cast into Hell!

I THANK GOD for giving me another chance at life to be changed, delivered, and set free from generational curses and sin. I thank God that he selected me, a nobody, and a disappointment in the eyes of the world to be a part of his will.

My husband John Burgess and I are still together five years later serving God wholeheartedly in Louisville, Kentucky with our wonderful Pastor Bill Cox and his amazing wife Alison Cox. We are truly excited to see what God has in store for us!

When my Pastor asked me if I would want to give my testimony for the Trumpet, I jumped at the chance.

What I have to share with you is not an easy topic to talk about but this is all meant for God's glory to shine through, not mine.

I was adopted by a well-known hand surgeon and his wife, probably

right at the time of my birth in August of 1958. The very people who were supposed to love and protect me turned out to be the very ones that almost destroyed me!

My earliest memory was when I was about four years old. I was locked up in either a furnace or closet hidden away from everyone else. I suffered horrific abuse; my hair had been pulled out, there were beatings with either a wooden ruler or a belt buckle. The thing I remember most was the time I was standing in front of them, screaming because of the hot boiling water they had just thrown at me. No one ever deserves to go through any of this.

But God had his hand on me! About a year later I was found and rescued. I remember seeing the closet door being pulled open and looking out from within, I saw a lot of newspaper reporters taking pictures with big flashing lights going off in front of me. At the time I didn't know who they were.

I was placed in a local hospital to recover from a broken arm and other injuries. Once I had recovered enough, I was placed into a foster home where I lived until about the age of twelve.

I had always wanted to know who my real parents were and why had this all happened to me. Little did I know my life was going to be drastically changed again!

One day, just out of the blue, a

At the age of 18, I began fornicating with my girlfriend. I got her pregnant and I became a dad at the age of 21. I was irresponsible and a bad reference to my son as I still wanted to party and drink.

In 2006, someone witnessed to us and we got saved. We were not married at that time. Secret sin and other issues had led us to backsliding within a year of us being saved.

I never wanted to be like my father, an alcoholic and abusive towards my mum, but I became that very same

I did not believe in God. I was a Hindu, and I was really bad.

I used to smoke and have gangs, and had done lots of criminal works. I used to be happy when I did crime. I had hit someone with a sword and he got a big injury. After that my parents sent me to India from the police.

After shifting to India I got in a relationship with a girl named Puja. We were involved for one year and we both decided to get married by our own selves. We both decided to go to my house from India, back to Kathmandu.

When I reached back home, my parents were not happy with this marriage, and so we lived separate from my parents for six to seven months. My mom called me after eight months, when Puja was six months pregnant, and my parents told me to go to India for good jobs. They told me "you should earn money for your coming baby and future."

After that I thought they were agreed with me, so I went to India for work. When I reached India I joined a job and worked there alone. I thought everything was going well. I used to talk with my

family via phone. When I asked for Puja, they used to say she is doing this or that, or she had gone somewhere or to market. I was not getting any contact with Puja.

After a few weeks I came back to Kathmandu. When I returned Puja was not at my house. My family said she had an affair with someone and went away.

I was frustrated, angry and depressed after that. I was dying inside my heart. I had decided to commit suicide. I fixed to do the suicide the next day at a building near my house. Suddenly I shared all these things with my friend Kamal Bhandari. He said "let me do something for you," and he took me to the church. That day was Sunday. We went to the church and played guitar, but still I was remembering those incidents. I shared these things with Pastor Paul, and then he prayed with me.

That day when I returned home I felt really different. I ate dinner and slept and I had a dream that I went back to India and met with Puja. The next morning I decided to go to India. I went back to India and met with Puja. The things my parents had told me were wrong. Puja cried a lot that we had lost our first baby. Don't go out of here unless you buy your own house or you give me the money and this becomes yours."

Praise the Lord, we still we still needed to give her \$720. Then she told us that this house has been empty for over a year and it has been attracting gangsters. She needed to fix the place, which is going to cost her all the deposit money. We told her we can fix the place while we are occupying it. She agreed, and we just gave her \$100 and another \$100 to the agents. This money came from the church people. This is a miracle for us because we used to pay \$150 for my rent and \$100 for the church rent. Now I pay \$100 for the church and my rent included and we live in same plot.

I thank my wife for her willingness to get behind me and the vision of our Fellowship to win souls for Jesus. So we are now fixing it one step at a time as money comes in.

Since we are here now a month.

we are seeing visitors coming every service. Last Sunday, we had 10 visitors walk in and the backsliders who left for over a year are coming back home.

Many people are being saved weekly and others restored financially.

Nearly 100 people showed up in the farewell service and many were touched.

We welcomed our new Pastor, Garrett and Monica Berry and their family, into the congregation and things started clicking and flowing immediately.

We had a revival meeting with Pastor Patrick Johnson in December.

Many people came out to the services and heard the Gospel. The church was ministered to and strengthened. Several people were healed and two people got filled with the Holy Ghost.
