Pastor Mitchell continues busy ministry schedule into March

(Pastor Wayman Mitchell now travels with Pastor Steven Ciaccio, who assists him as well as assisting in the Prescott church. At 90, Pastor Mitchell hasn't slowed down much! Please continue to lift him up in prayer).

Since the most recent January Bible Conference Pastor Mitchell has been busy traveling and preaching the Gospel. We landed in Mexico City and the following day drove four hours to the San Jose Church where we were greeted by an excited and energized church already in prayer for the crusade that night.

The crowd size was around 500 people, many of them visitors and the majority walking to church from the surrounding villages.

Pastor Mitchell preached a simple

message from Matthew 10:1-8 entitled "Miracle Healing." Many responded to the call for salvation and then an invitation for specific needs of healing was given where many more were powerfully healed.

The powerful thing about the church in San Jose is that these people with their own money decided to build their own church building, which has a capacity for around 1,000 people. It's amazing what God can do when people are willing to obey the heavenly vision.

What an incredible time we had in Mexico City with Pastor Salvador Castillo and the Mexico City congregation. This church used to be home of a Mexican wrestling ring. More than 600 people met there to hear the Word of God preached by Pastor Mitchell and to receive healing in their bodies.

"Guam will always hold a very special place in my heart." These were the closing words of the first night of our healing crusade in Guam. Pastor Mitchell was stationed in the military here in the 1950s where he was a flight line electrician for B-17 bombers. Now at 90 years old he is declaring once again that Jesus Christ is risen from the dead. In between international trips to Guam and the Perth, West Australia Conference, he also ministered in the Killeen, Texas Harvesters Homecoming. Finishing up the heavy schedule of traveling in February and into March Pastor Mitchell was able to preach a healing crusade in Perth, West Australia and follow that up with ministering in their Annual Bible Conference.

We in Prescott have stayed busy doing what we know to do. Our con-

ference in January was powerful and we saw God move in church planting. We said farewell to the Sawyers and the Sullivans and the Pepiches. We also recently welcomed Jesse and Bethany Morales to assist in Prescott. We are helping the Maiolos begin their new adventure in South America.

Our regular ministry of outreach continues year round. One80, which is our primary outreach venue, continues to be effective. They seem willing to try anything to attract this generation; from ugly sweater contests to dramas to Muppets Christmas to doing the whole thing in Spanish. And people still get saved in One80.

We continue to send bands and impact teams to as many places as we are asked to come help. We have

gone to Phoenix and Flagstaff and to 29 Palms and to Surprise and to Mesa and to Las Vegas and to Casa Grande and to Cottonwood. People who have been saved longer than you have been alive still go on these impact teams to witness for Jesus Christ!

In March, we had an unusual opportunity to hold funeral services in our church for a popular long-time high school teacher and coach in Prescott Valley. The family allowed us to conduct the service. More than 500 attended the service, most of them not from our congregation. There were mockers and scoffers, but still 18 people responded to be saved.

In February Pastor Morales did the annual couples marriage retreat to minister to the marriages in our church. Marriage is a foundation that is under attack in the world but is supported and strengthened and encouraged in our church.

In March we held our annual Children's Church Workers conference for those who minister to our young children from around the world.

Please continue to pray for us and for our pastors in Prescott.

Testimony - Kristian Gaines

My name is Kristian. I am 30 years old.

When I arrived at the Potter's House, Austin (in the summer of 2019), I was nearing three months of

sobriety after a long year of addiction to methamphetamines that caused my children to be removed from my custody. I was homeless, irrational, and very emotional.

As a child, I was exposed to rape, incest, lesbianism, promiscuity, bestiality, neglect, bullying, and other forms of abuse and sexual immorality. As a result, my teenage rebellion consisted mainly of "dating" pedophiles, sneaking into clubs, and piercings and tattoos. My grades remained good. I knew of God and went to church here and there. However, I did not really believe anyone could love me, not even God.

When I reached adulthood, I joined the Navy. It took only a few deployments, an abusive marriage, and a suicide attempt to end my career. I quickly transitioned into eight years of battling with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), drug abuse and mental illness, and carried out at least 12 unsuccessful suicide attempts.

When I had my daughter, I gave my life to Jesus for about a month. Shortly after, I started another new relationship, backslid, and became pregnant with my son eight months later. Having children seemed to solve my issues temporarily. I worked various jobs and focused on my children. For their sake, I lived a double life. I would stuff down all my PTSD symptoms for lengths of time.

Eventually, family would have to watch my children for me to go on a

"mental break." This cycle went on for years, and my abuse of alcohol and marijuana, and promiscuity increased. I would flip out on my childrens' dads for not helping me and provoke violence in anyone I dated. Also, I became more aggressive to other family members, who would take my children when I knew I could not pretend to be ok. I was depressed, angry, stubborn, and prideful.

After Hurricane Harvey, I lost my job, and entered the exotic dancer life. This is the time when I started mixing prescription medication with methamphetamines. Within five months, I lost custody of both children, my home, and what was left of my sanity.

The next four months, I stayed in a Galveston, TX meth house, snorting my life away. I had come to terms with never seeing my children again. I just wanted to die, but for some reason, I could not bring myself to make another suicide attempt. It was at this time that God drew on me intensely.

Over the course of four days, I kept hearing a voice telling me, "Go to Austin." On the last day, I left Galveston for Austin. I knew absolutely no one here. Upon arrival, my meth bag disappeared, and withdrawals began. For three months, I thought I had scabies, and began tearing up my skin. Despite doctors telling me I did not have it, I remained in a cycle of scrubbing my skin off, dumping saltwater all over, and plastering on neem oil. I was living in excruciating self-inflicted pain. Still,

I worked, prayed, began to read the Bible, and listen to sermons on the radio.

One day in particular, I could not move. The pain was too overwhelming. So, I asked God to move me or kill me. Well, instead of God killing me, He told me to go to church. I googled "church," and the Potter's House came up on a list of names. Ironically, every time I have looked up a church any place I have lived (to not go to), the Potter's House seemed to be on the list. I did not take time to research further. I knew where I was going.

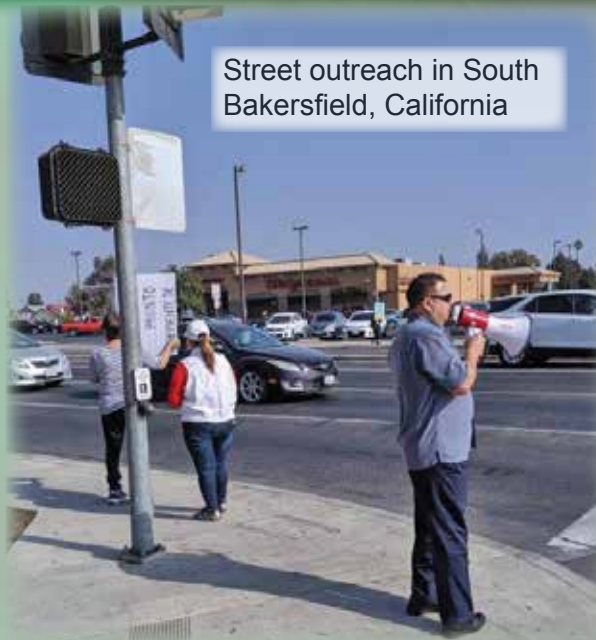
I arrived at the Potter's House after everyone was gone, except one person. Her name is Cathy. Cathy actually attends another Potters House in our Fellowship and was just passing through town. We talked for hours outside the church, prayed, and she shared some scriptures with me.

My next visit, I made it to service. I remember telling myself that Pastor Terry Wakefield looked like he used to be a gangster, and that I was meant to be there. I gave my life to Jesus at the next altar call.

After giving my life to Christ, my life improved dramatically. The psychosis began to go away. All my sores started closing, and the pain reduced. In addition to spiritual, mental, and physical healing, I gained a family I never had before. I could not get away from the love God was leading me to. I could not understand why everyone was talking to me, inviting me to their homes, and offering to help me, when I never asked to be helped. The God-inspired love from the Potter's House was so overwhelming, that I literally ran away into the woods for a few days.

I learned quickly, that salvation does not stop old problems from surfacing. God really touched the hearts of my newfound family in a supernatural way. People do not just welcome a crazy ex junkie into their homes. No one takes time to listen to crazy ranting, without judgement. No one just takes someone in off the streets. No one ever had the patience to deal with my madness before. Not one person in the Potter's House gave up on me, even after I went to jail. Only the spirit of our living God could do this.

In conclusion, I am now working

six jobs, nearing the end of my CPS case, clearing up debt, and working my way into ministry. I'm just amazed at all God has done for me in such a short time. I am excited to begin bringing my children to church very soon.

A few months ago, I was cleared of all heightened PTSD symptoms. I am in my right mind, and able to handle any situation, because I lean on God, and not my own understanding.

I still see God as the ultimate gangster, and I am beyond grateful that He has allowed me into His mafia. Thank you Jesus and thank you to my amazing new family.

I was born in Orange, Texas during World War II. My daddy welded wounded battleships that came back to harbor in the Gulf of Mexico. After the war we traveled all over the U.S. following pipelines.

Mother had to wash our clothes on a rub board. She nor daddy knew of the chemicals and radiation that he brought back on his clothes while she was pregnant with me. I was born albino, with club feet and hip dysplasia. My ribs and spine were caved in a concave chest. I was a very sickly child and always had terrible ear and leg aches.

I didn't walk until I was around three years old, but the ear aches would make me go deaf. As an adult I would usually go completely deaf once a year and stay deaf all winter until spring. I have been deaf so much I learned to read lips pretty well. I just lived with it.

A couple of weeks ago, the "thing" came on me, like something swirled

lies in Corpus Christi since 2011. In the Faith Rally, we were blessed with testimonies from our area churches and the impact that they are making in their respective towns.

During our Faith Rally, there was a challenge to give to a one-time offering to a pioneering work in Berlin, Germany. We also have an ongoing world evangelism pledge in partnering with a new church in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam.

In May 2019, we set up a Jesus float for our city's annual Buc Days Night Parade, complete with live Christian Rap music and testimonies.

In addition to that, the summer has been a great time for our neighborhood outreaches. Our problems worsened when my wife's uncle died in a car accident. We were set free, delivered from drugs, alcohol and tobacco. We walked from the altar feeling clean and in our right minds. For the first time in our lives, we felt peace and rest.

Everything was going well, and the church was almost complete. One minor detail - we had done the construction on our own.

One day as I was setting a door the fire inspector came and demanded that we get a general contractor and plans approved by the city. We were forced to tear down all work involved (thousands of dollars lost).

As we were getting the plans and details set up, we got into another suite. This was a great miracle at face value, until the city decided we had to do a complete demo of all non-compliant walls and construction (which was all done by someone else).

After \$5,000 and two sets of plans we couldn't use we began a fast and prayed for a miracle.

It came! At the same property a local bar was completely burned by a fire. This location was completely gutted and rebuilt.

This space was 2100 sq. ft. and all code compliant. The construction was even set up with two restrooms, a nursery/prayer room (they call it an office), and located on a major road with great visibility!

I called the agent and we were able to negotiate and get it for \$1.32 per sq. ft. including fees.

To give you an idea of how much of a miracle this is, the same building would be in the ballpark of around \$5,000 a month in a lease. Currently Vegas real estate is on average \$2.50 sq. ft. before fees due to the new Raiders team coming to Las Vegas.

More than just the building, we are gaining momentum towards revival! The drought of lacking fruit has begun to break! We have regular salvation and visitors. I went from

In 2017, only 100 metres from my house, a new church was planted in my community. It was called The Potter's House. I was invited by my cousin and I started attending.

I never planned to stay but I heard the full Gospel, was told about Heaven and Hell. I came to a cross road in my life.

I made a decision and told Pastor Dax Veazey that I'm fine with going to Hell. His reply was "okay that's fine, but make sure you come to our next event." It was a Tony Hoang Testimony night - From Gangs to Salvation.

I attended that service thinking it was just to please the pastor, but when I heard the testimony I tried to ignore the conviction. I refused to bow my head at the altar call, but then... somehow I ended up at the front during the call.
