We have been seeing growth here in Prescott Arizona, not only in the church but also in the city.

Prescott has seen a steady stream of people of all ages and walks of life moving into the city and surrounding

We also had the opportunity to send an impact team and our new play "Out Of Darkness" to Casa Grande, pastored by Angel Morales.

The impact team hit the streets, outreaching and evangelizing throughout the day. Twenty-two people gave their lives to Christ during the outreaching alone, and those who went on the impact team came home with fresh excitement. There is such a testimony when saints set aside their time to be a part of the work of God, and God is faithful to move on their behalf with lives changed for eternity.

To end the day in Casa Grande, the play was performed with a powerful presentation of the Gospel, and another 13 souls gave their lives to Christ.

We then held a two-night showing of the new play "Out of Darkness" in our Fellowship hall here in Prescott. It was a packed house as more than 300 people showed up for the Saturday evening performance.

This was preceded during the day by an impact team from Gallup, NM. The Gallup church sent a group of 30 people that was met with a group of 50 people from our congregation, and together they were able to hit the streets of Prescott in evangelism and outreach. During the day there were many key witnesses and divine appointments and we saw 14 people give their lives to Christ during the outreach.

We're so excited about what God is doing, and we have an expectation for greater things to come in the time ahead!

God is moving mightily here, strengthening and encouraging His people. The year 2020 held tremendous ups and downs. With the loss of

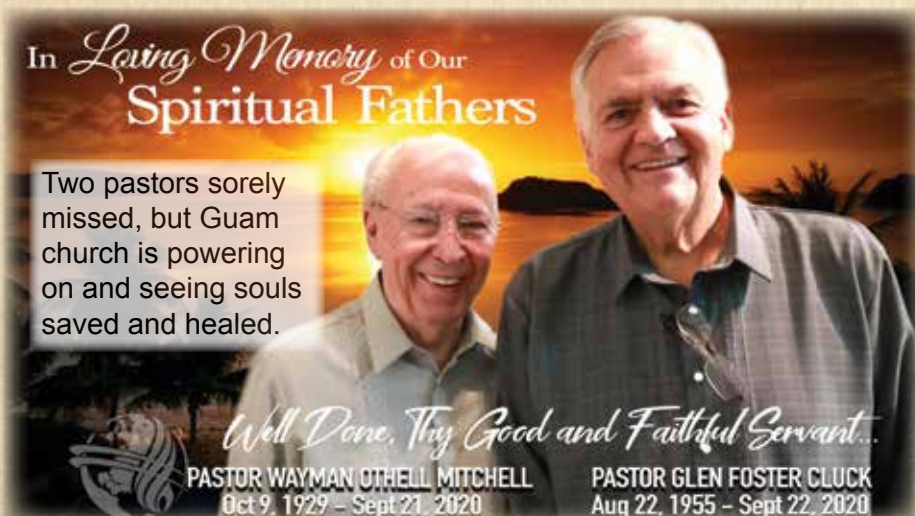

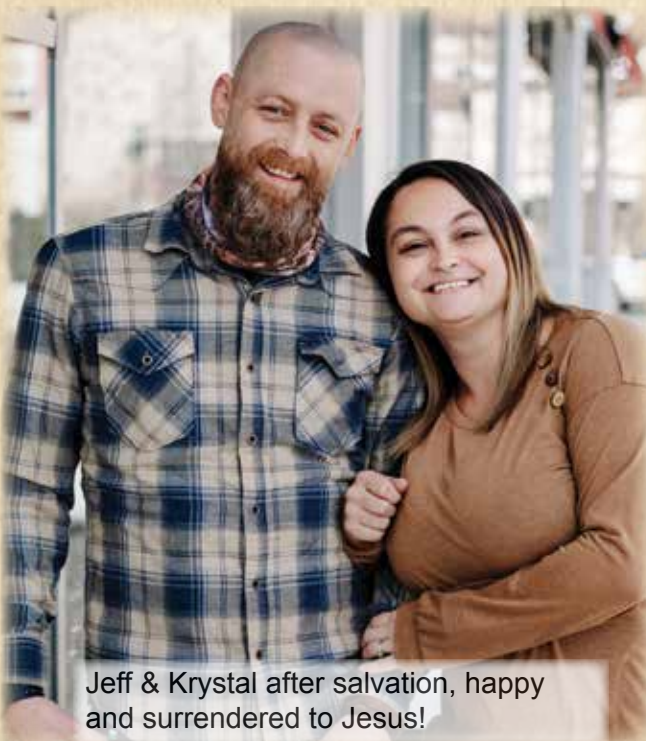

Our church feels refreshed and is so excited to see what God has in store for us this summer!

Testimony: Jeff & Krystal

Jeff's story: I was beaten badly from an early age. My mother was a coke dealer and I was surrounded by violent people.

Around age 13, I became very violent and ended up hanging around with a lot of dangerous and violent people.

As the years went on, I tried basically every drug under the sun. About 13 years ago I went to a rehab and they put me on the Suboxone to get me off heroin. Back then they didn't know much about it, but basically

once you are on it, you can't get off it.

I soon realized that when I wouldn't take Suboxone for a day or two I would be rolling in the bed in pain. The withdrawal symptoms from it are excruciating.

The first time I tried to stop taking the Suboxone, I had withdrawal symptoms for a year. The second time I tried it was 11 months. I'd have to drink half a bottle of vodka just to be able to get up and out of bed and get through the day.

I started taking the Suboxone again and honestly I was really scared that I'd never be able to get off it. Last month I was at a Kris Hart revival and God dealt with my wife and I to give a large offering. We agreed to give it and then that same night I got a word and I realized that God was dealing with me and that He wanted me to get off the Suboxone.

So I decided to see what would happen.

The next morning I woke up and I felt totally fine. It's been over a month and I feel great. This is absolutely impossible according to the doctors. I'm just so happy and grateful. I think it's just so amazing because of what a mess our situation was and God is doing things that are just not possible.

Krystal's story: I was born and raised Catholic but there was always some-

thing missing. Both my parents were doing drugs and my mom was a severe alcoholic.

At a very young age, I knew I didn't want to be like them. I was a good kid but I kept all the bad things that happened to me inside. I started to drink and at 17 couldn't handle anything that was going on in my life and I left home.

Eventually I met my kids' father and moved in with him. Things just got worse. I tried to make everything work for the kids but I just couldn't do it anymore. I was so lost and hurt and upset and alone.

Eventually I met Jeff and we started our life together but things were still really bad. One evening a couple years ago, we went to the park and the church was doing a concert. Pastor was preaching and he was naming everything that we were going through. We couldn't believe it and we both knew we needed to get saved.

We didn't really surrender to God at that point but last fall I was having back surgery the next day and I was really scared. I texted my pastor's wife and she told me that revival was starting the next night. I knew then and there that God was dealing with me that I needed to get back to church.

I went to revival service that night and got my heart right with God and I haven't missed a service since! I stopped drinking immediately and smoking about a month after.

Since we've both completely committed and completely 100 percent handed our lives over to God, He is just changing everything before our eyes. Prayers are being answered in front of my face. The kids are com-

There is a real assault of Hell against churches here with fear and apathy causing many churches to still remain closed up until now, almost a year later, with the sheep scattered for the wolves of Islam to devour. We are gathering the lost sheep.

In September we then moved buildings to a more strategic area for local outreach in the greater Jakarta area. The building was an absolute hand of God as buildings are very expensive

alike as we heard the word of God and had the opportunity to ask questions afterwards. It was very well attended by many of the men in the Victorian churches.

Also around the same time on a Sunday night Pastor prayed for a number of people who were baptised in the Holy Ghost and just last weekend we saw a group of converts water baptised in our Sunday morning service, just a couple of the many exciting things that we are seeing God do throughout this season of fruitfulness.

We are looking forward to our Melbourne Conference this year in the new time slot of early November, and we're also believing God for the international borders to open once again.

Thank you for your prayers. Please

now. During those years we (and two other pastor couples) have seen the hand of God upon our church. This is our first and fifth church at the same time.

In spite of the Corona pandemic we see growth, especially among young people. Several people bring friends and inmates to church and people are getting saved on the streets. It's a great joy to see what God is doing and has done.

During the first weeks of February we had two baptism services.

Our baby churches are doing good as well. They're seeing growth and God has supplied in buildings.

As former missionaries in Perú we're still involved in the great work there. Right now there are 12 churches

in Jakarta and we have always been priced out.

It is prime location for souls, surrounded by ghettos and gangsters. Before we had even finished renovating the building for services, we jumped straight into a month of corporate fasting for God to bring fruitfulness and revival to our church.

We spent weekend after weekend pounding the streets, knocking on doors, handing out flyers, witnessing one-on-one to anyone who would listen. At first we were faced with a lot of opposition, fear and standoffish behaviour from people. Many people flat out refused to come to church because of the pandemic and rather watching church online.

However, I continued to press forward and believe that God will bring the people, we just need to be in place and ready when they come.

In early December we began to see a supernatural move of God. People just started walking off the street into our church meetings, getting saved and locking in.

This then snowballed as new converts started bringing their families and neighbours. In the space of two months our church congregation has doubled!

Since October 2020 until January 2021 we have seen many miracles of people being healed, financial breakthroughs, young disciples with a desire for the things of God and many testimonies of changed lives through the power of Jesus Christ. This is purely a hand of God in the midst of a full blown pandemic!

Greetings, everyone! I am Pastor Julius Setiar of Tainan City, Taiwan (R.O.C.). I want to testify to God’s goodness and miracles in our church and our lives.

On August 30th, 2020, my wife and my son came back to Taiwan from the Philippines. As a protocol, they needed to be quarantined for 14 days. My wife was pregnant. On

September 10th, she gave birth to our daughter. Before the operation, she was swabbed for COVID-19 testing. We found out that she was COVID-19 positive. We were shocked because before she left the Philippines she was tested negative and when she came to Taiwan another test was conducted and she was negative. God is great because she was asymptomatic. My son, who was with her full time, was tested negative and our baby was also negative. Her situation was broadcasted all over Taiwan.

When my wife was tested positive for COVID-19, she had to stay in the hospital, and my son and I needed to be quarantined for 14 days (because my son had direct contact with her and I had direct contact with my son) and my baby had to be separated from us. I am very grateful to Pastor Clayton and Sis. Michelle Reed because they took good care of our baby.

After our quarantine period and while my wife was in the hospital, we didn't stop sharing the Word of God and made disciples. On October 18 we baptized three men.

On October 30, 2020, the hospital called me and said that my wife was ready for discharge, but her hospital bill was almost NTD 400,000 or almost \$14,300 US dollars. On that day, God did a miracle because we didn't pay the whole NTD400,000. We just paid almost \$3,600 US dollars and the rest was paid by the Taiwan government.

We celebrated our Christmas and Family Celebration last December 20. We had 46 attendees and eight accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.

During the Chinese New Year 2021, we conducted a Street Concert and our Church Tour. Both activities were successful by the grace of God.

Truly, God is faithful because even though we encountered and still encounter problems, He is always there to help, strengthen, encourage and guide us.

Konnichiwa from the Land of the Rising Sun!

Pastor Victor and Debra Alonso were launched to Tokyo (Japan's capital with a population of 37.4 million people) at the end of 2018 to continue the work started by Pastor Gary and Lisa Case out of Las Vegas, New Mexico.

We began outreaching on the street corners and train stations but we saw little fruit from that. Pastor Victor then began advertising English Bible Study and free guitar lessons on Meetup (an app used to advertise events).

What we've learned is that while the Japanese may not take a flyer or stop to listen to music unless others are listening, they will sign up for events online. Many came either out of curiosity or to learn a new skill, but all left hearing the Gospel (some for the first time) and some even gave their lives to Jesus.

We, like everyone else, looked forward with expectation for a breakthrough in 2020, with impact teams and local outreaches scheduled, but the pandemic threw us for a loop, and we had to pivot to online services.

At first, the saints tuned in and we would follow up virtually, but slowly we lost touch with some of them. It was a discouraging time, but we pressed in and continued to pray and fast during that time for the restrictions to be lifted; against fear, loneliness, depression and suicide and for God to draw souls to Himself.

In May, the lockdown was lifted and in-person church services began once more. Since then, God answered our prayers by drawing people of different backgrounds, creating an unlikely family in an unlikely time and place. In Psalm 68:6, the psalmist writes, "God

sets the solitary in families" and that is what He is exactly doing here in Tokyo. This pandemic has caused many to cry out to "the unknown God" and while searching to learn more about Him, God has led them to us.

In December, the church as a whole created a Youtube video about the true meaning of Christmas in both English and Japanese, because the Japanese have no understanding of what Christmas is about. Many in our church shared it with friends and family as a way to open the door to share the gospel.

At the beginning of 2021, Pastor Alonso challenged the church to a month of fasting and prayer for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit, for more souls to be saved, an open door for a church space (we've outgrown the living room) and finally to get off financial support.

Because of the faithfulness of the saints, more souls have gotten saved. A young woman who had never before learned about Jesus or heard anything about the Gospel found us on the Meetup app and came to church. That night, she got gloriously saved! She has not missed a service ever since.

Another lady came in tormented by the Spirit of suicide, but when she repented and gave her life to Jesus, Pastor laid hands on her and prayed, and God delivered her. Those thoughts are gone and so is anxiety and fear.

Others feel stirred by Holy Ghost to continue to contend in fasting and prayer for the miraculous.

We hope to see God move in an undeniably supernatural way here in Japan. The need is great and the harvest is ripe.

We want to thank Pastor Greg Mitchell and the Prescott congregation for their investment in sending the Cases as well as Pastor Ray Rubi and the Las Vegas Christian Center for undergirding this incredible opportunity. Please continue to pray for this nation as we reap what God has prepared.
