I grew up in a Hindu family in Trinidad and moved to Canada on my own for University when I was 18. This



move was the beginning of destruction in my life.

Shortly after migrating, I found myself in an abusive relationship and at the same time my family back home fell apart due to infidelity, alcoholism, drugs and sexual abuse.

Over the next 10 years, I became a "successful" engineer working for a leading engineering firm, travelling the world and chasing what I thought would bring me happiness. But I couldn't shake the trauma of my past which tormented me daily. I would try in every way to 'forget the world' - alcohol, drugs, partying. I found myself depressed and having regular panic attacks.

My boyfriend at the time knew the truth and would share the Gospel with me, but he was still struggling to turn away from a sinful life and I continued to believe that there were multiple paths to the same God. When he finally made the decision to give his life completely to Jesus, we broke up. He tried to explain that Jesus was the only way, but I "knew" God was bigger than religion and I could never believe in a narrow-minded religion that would send me and my family to Hell for our beliefs and culture.

I began trying to heal myself with different types of therapy, exercise, and self-medicating...but nothing I tried helped for long enough. I became desperate, confused, and started questioning my identity, beliefs, and purpose.
