Hello From Prescott! We have been busy with both outreach and evangelizing in our city.

In early spring we had the awesome experience of holding a good old-fashioned tent healing crusade in the center of Prescott Valley.

Pastor Artie Aragon brought his crew from Chinle, Arizona and set up a tent for the crusade, and Pastor Kris Hart was able to minister for three nights and proclaim that Jesus Christ has risen from the dead!

From the first service we began to see visitors come out, and God met with them in tangible ways. One notable miracle was a gentleman who went up for prayer for back pain, and as Pastor Hart prayed for him and the pain left his body you could see the expression on his face change as he realized that the pain he came into the tent with was no longer with him.

He took off a back brace and was able to move and bend over for the first time in a long time, free and healed by the Power of Jesus.

It was awesome to see visitors who came out on the first night of the crusade return on the next night, bringing with them family and friends so that they could experience the power of God for themselves. One lady who got healed on the first night of the healing crusade came back the next night stating "God did a miracle in my upper body, now I am back to get a miracle in my lower body."

It was so refreshing to watch the raw faith and openness of those who came seeking miracles and deliverance as God met with them personally in powerful ways.



God moved in an amazing Healing Crusade in a tent next to the highway in Prescott Valley during March. Now, the church's new One80 ministry building will be built there in the growing Town. We expect much fruit!

Through the three-night healing crusade we saw 912 people attend, with 27 souls saved and 36 confirmed miracles.

Our annual Spring Youth Extreme was held the same weekend as the healing crusade. This event kicked off our week of revival with Pastor Martin Klok from the Netherlands. In this event we send invitations to the surrounding churches to meet with us in outreach and evangelism to reach our city in preparation for the upcoming revival. In this Youth Extreme we had eight surrounding churches join with us, and more than 225 young people in attendance.

The day started off with a challenging sermon for the young people from Pastor Klok, in which 12 young people made decisions to give their lives to Christ.

Following this we hit the streets of our city and evangelized and spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ. To end the day, we all joined back together in the tent to be a part of the healing crusade that evening. All in all, it was a day marked with the presence of God and his power at work in our city.

We were blessed and very excited to have Pastor Martin Klok minister in revival services for us. During this revival there were many decisions

made for salvation, people healed in their bodies, and timely words spoken into the lives of individuals. We followed this week up with a baptismal service, and we saw 14 new converts make the decision to go on record before the congregation and get baptized.

The group contained brand new converts who had just recently come into the church and given their lives to God, along with both backsliders who had returned home, and some of our young church kids making the decision to serve God. This was an exciting experience for us to be a part of.

Finally, we held a large family fun festival in the heart of Prescott Valley on Easter weekend. Games, jumping castles, food trucks and even pictures with the Easter Bunny were included. While families were walking through, we had bands playing and people testifying about Jesus Christ, along with altar calls given.

We saw more than 150 visitors come out and enjoy the festival, and ultimately we had 19 people pray to give their lives to Christ.

We are continuing to hold weekly concert scenes and outreach, and through this upcoming summer season we are excited for all the good things God has in store.

We bring a great report from Espanola, New Mexico!

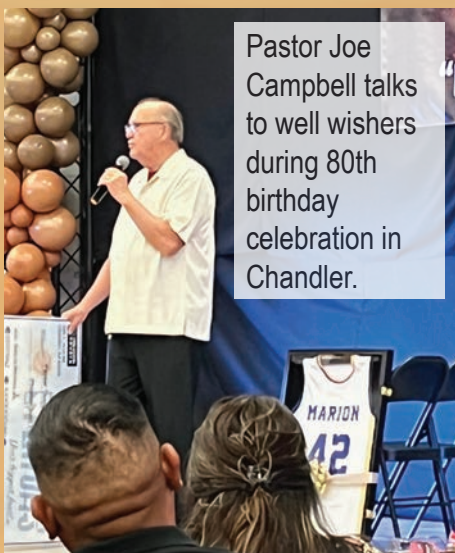

Hello from Great Falls, Montana. Over the past year we have seen God move tremendously here in Great Falls. We have seen an increase financially as well as in fruitfulness some of the key converts that have come into the church.

In August 2021 I had made a career change from being a carpenter for 19 years at a rate of pay of \$32 an hour, to taking an entry position in the local hospital for \$15 an hour.

During this time God challenged me to give \$10,000 and I wrote the check and gave it.

God gave me immediate favor in the heart and vascular department has another job opportunity opened up for nearly \$20 an hour, which is a \$10,000

a year increase.

The heart and vascular department then chose my family to buy gifts for our children as many doctors don't have children in the home. They showed up on Christmas morning with thousands of dollars of gifts filling my living room with gifts for myself my wife and my four children!

One miracle conversion has been my supervisor in the heart and vascular department. He is a heart doctor (cardiologist) originally from Nigeria. I began to speak with him on a regular basis as I work the front desk, and one day I just begin to witness to him. After my supervisor was converted, he came by the church and he said it reminded him of a church he grew up in, in Nigeria. He said he loves all we're doing and continues to come.

A practicing physician who was considered a Muslim had been hearing the testimonies of people being converted by Jesus Christ, especially my supervisor, which caught his curiosity. He began asking questions to learn more about Christ, and has since come into a service and repented.

We have also had open doors and complete favor on the job with the director of the heart and vascular Institute as well. She has come over to our house for dinners and is on the brink of salvation!

A notable miracle conversion is a woman that we have been witnessing to for the past three years. She came in to the church and got 100 percent in for Jesus Christ, bringing in many family and friends.

She was a 20-year meth addict who had lost all of her kids, house, everything. She was homeless when she came into the church. And now God has restored her. She is clean and sober and has her children back in her home. She is raising her grandchildren and has recently gotten a job at a local recovery center, a three bedroom home, and a car.

We have had revivals with my Pastor Timothy Miller, Jack Miller and Jon Gash. All were powerful and very timely. Words were given and a core was established

A Power Weekend with Fino Baca was also inspirational to the congregation!

Recent outreaches have included a Skate Jam, which was an idea that was unfamiliar to me as I am not a skateboarder. But I figured I had nothing to lose so I worked with a guy in our church to come up with a general layout. We saw 87 people come out with many people giving their lives to Jesus Christ.

We recently did a three-on-three competition. The morning of the competition the weather was horrible and I had six cancellations for teams. I began to pray and believe God that the weather would pass. We ended up seeing 56 people come out!

Upon signing up, team members had to put their name and numbers on the sign-up sheet, giving us the contact information for every player. Many were saved during the event as well as five answering the altar call during the handing out of the awards.

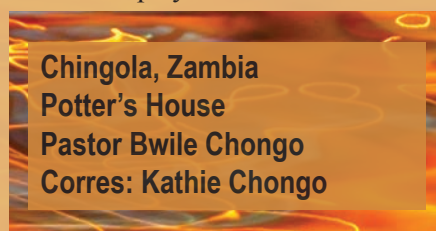
sold it, who then took us to the people that bought it where we were then able to retrieve our generator. The damage to the building far exceeded the amount
