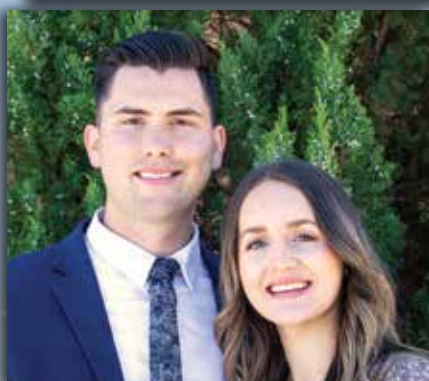

We are so grateful for the last several months that have been both busy and filled with impact and fruitfulness.

We had an amazing opportunity to hold a three-night healing crusade with Pastor Kris Hart on the Yavapai-Apache tribe in Middle Verde - about 45 minutes outside of Prescott.

An amazing door was opened for us; a woman offered the use of her land for the healing crusade. With help from the Chinle church we were able to put up a tent, and have a good-old-fashioned healing crusade.

This was a tremendous time, as each night we saw families from across the reservation show up. There was an attitude of expectancy for the miraculous that was met with the awesome grace of God. Throughout the three nights there were many timely words of encouragement and breakthrough given, along with intense words that ministered on addiction and suicide and the grace of God to set the captive free.

One dear lady came out on the first night with her hand in a brace. After prayer Pastor Hart challenged her to take off the brace and believe God for the miracle. Right then and there she took the brace off, and came back the next night saying that before she had not been able to lift anything heavier than a coffee cup, and now she was able

to lift it without a problem. She threw the brace away - completely healed!

Throughout the crusade many lives were touched both physically, emotionally and spiritually. Over the course of the three nights we saw more than 24 notable miracles, a total of 137 visitors and 32 precious souls gave their lives to Christ.

We had our semi-annual Youth Extreme and revival in October with Evangelist Jerry Fussell from Tucson. This was the largest Youth Extreme we have had since Covid hit, with more than 200 young people showing up to help with outreach and evangelism and taking our town for Jesus.

We evangelized for the Chandler Church's production of Hamilton, which did a tremendous job of portraying the Gospel. That night we saw many first-time visitors come out and stay throughout the performance. At the conclusion of the night we saw a total of 32 people saved, and we are praising God for the impact made on our city.

After the youth rally we dove straight into a powerful week of revival with Evangelist Fussell. It really was a week of impact and breakthrough. We saw many miracles of healing and timely words of encouragement and direction.

Immediately following our week of revival we dove straight into our Haunted House production. This is something we were unable to hold last year due to Covid-19 restrictions, so there was such a fresh excitement for this outreach. We were so grateful for the amount of people who invested

their time to help this production run smoothly, from actors and makeup, lights and sound, set builders, our altar call preachers, follow-up room and refreshments. There was such a spirit of unity as we all joined together to present the Gospel. The theme of our Haunted House was Purge21, based on the known horror movies which depict a world where all crime would be legal for a time.

We used this idea to portray a place where there was lawlessness, and all crime including murder would be legal. The final scene depicts a bloody and beaten Jesus who gets nailed to the cross as a final act of lawlessness.

At this point of the night, as group after group walked through, the group became soberingly quiet. Our altar call preachers pointed the group's attention to the fact that most of us as humans may not be murderers, but we are living in lawlessness and slaves to our sin. It was our sin, the lawlessness in our hearts that put Jesus on the cross. And although it was our sin that put Him there, he bled to purge that sin from us and give us a new life.

We saw a great response as many people gave their lives to Christ throughout the three nights. Over 600 visitors went through the Haunted House over the three nights, and we had a response of 278 souls giving their lives to Christ.

We are so excited for all that God has done throughout these last few months, and we are looking forward expectantly to the lasting fruit from these labors.

One exciting thing that happened in the past few months was the start of IGNITE. Immediately after the July Prescott Conference, a young couple returned inspired with a vision to impact the youth in our community. They decided to organize a weekly youth-gearred music scene with the added draw of interactive games for a six week run. And with that, our IGNITE ministry began.

For the start up, God gave us favor with the city, along with support of local law enforcement and the city's social media accounts, which helped us publicize IGNITE events. Our strategy was to hit parks with outreaches and "rap attacks" immediately before the event.

Every week, we were joined by a rotating list of local pastors and their youth helping us outreach and perform. We had live music, testimonies, and a game night with ping-pong tables and foosball that consistently drew a young and increasingly desperate generation.

From this we saw over 100 visitors

during those six weeks, with 21 precious souls responding during the altar calls. Many of those who came stayed for more than an hour after the end of each night playing games -

which gave us a chance to speak with them and for them to get to know us.

One young man, who got saved after our first event and is now baptized and filled with the Holy Ghost, was able to be a part of a special IGNITE for Halloween. This event again drew more youths. The live drama with a Twilight Zone twist about a young woman who loses her friend to drugs captured their hearts and minds. We had 27 young visitors and saw 11 respond for salvation.

We're grateful for all that God has been doing and the strong support from surrounding churches here in the Northeast (and the prayers from all across the Fellowship). A big thanks to everyone!

Greetings from Chinle, Arizona (Navajo Nation).

The Chinle church has been very busy meeting the needs of our community and our nation because of the pandemic.

We are still dealing with high numbers of Covid-19 cases within our congregation, but we are committed to following through with the vision of our fellowship. Even with the restrictions in place, we are still preaching the Gospel!

One restriction that we are currently dealing with, during the writing of this letter, is that we are still not able to physically meet within our church building. Regardless, church members and visitors still attend services by

parking in the church parking lot and tuning into the radio station, FM 89.1. From our vehicles, we are still able to worship, sing, and hear the preaching of God's Word.

For the time being, we are giving God "honk offerings" as we praise Him and honk the horns of our vehicles. The phrase, "Give God a honk offering" has become our way of giving God praise as the thunderous honking of truck horns wake up nearby neighbors and businesses.

Our Navajo choir got the opportunity to sing in Chandler for their Native American Day in October. Once again, we were blessed to be able to be able to minister in music using our Navajo language. Covid-19 restrictions on the

A recent One80 run almost completely by young men and women saw over 100 visitors and 22 people saved by the end of the night.

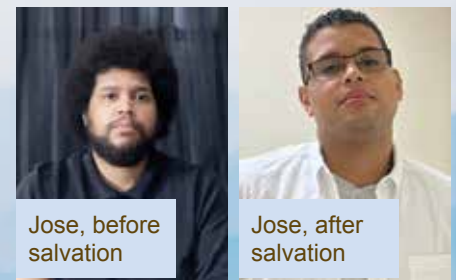
Our new follow-up ministry run by Anthony Arellano and his wife Alicia has proven very effective with many new families connecting with the church and coming more regularly.

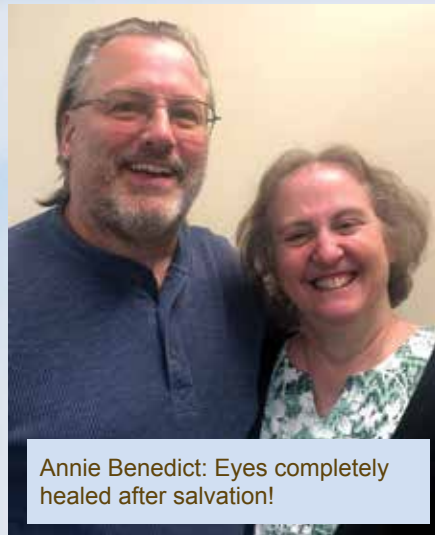

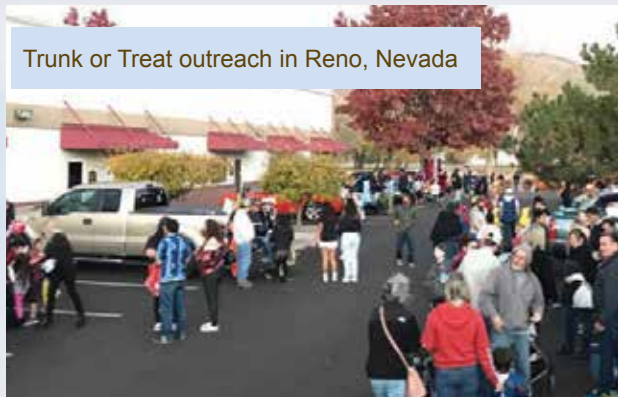

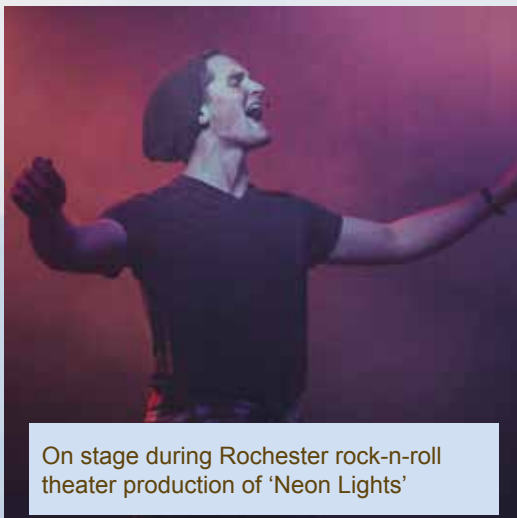

In October new converts who had never been to the South Texas Bible Conference were able to attend. They caught the vision of our Fellowship.

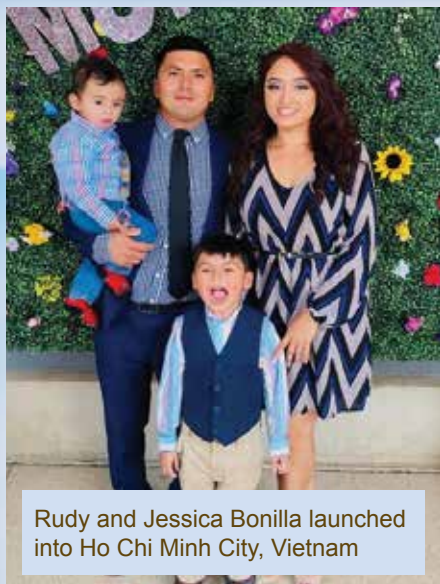

Greetings from Door Church in Tucson.

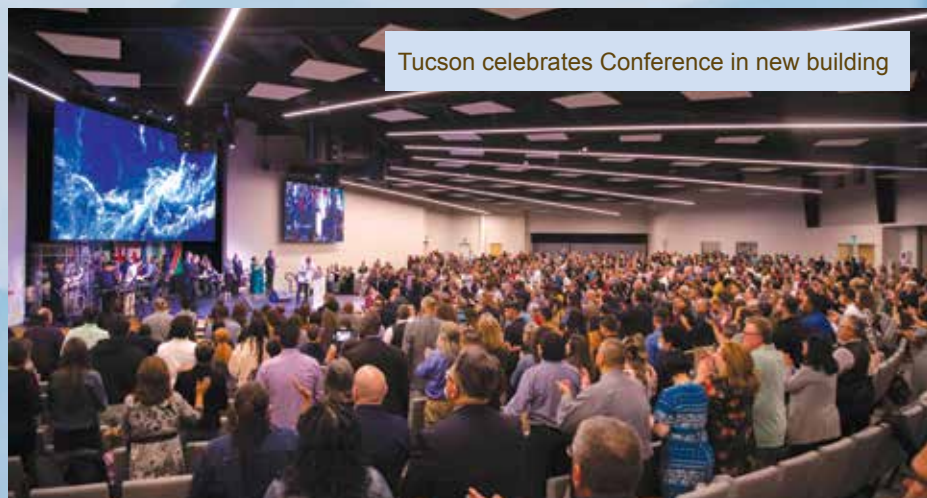

My name is Jaden Faatoia-Muaiava.

I was born and raised in New Zealand and come from a massive Samoan family. Culture is something that as Polynesians, we were forced to do and there's no way out!

I was going through a phase where I knew who God was, but I was forced to go to church. After every service, my cousins and I would go to the park too play footy while all the adults went smoking and drinking. That was not setting a good example for the younger generation.

I kept moving from church to church and not really having a deep relationship with God. It was hard for me to seek the truth because my family didn't stick too long in one church.



Eventually, I got sick and tired of church and decided not to go at all. I wanted to get away from my religious upbringing and start a career in rugby.

I moved to Australia in 2016 to have a better life and found more excuses not to go to church. My rugby career started at a club that my uncle had recommended. At the age of 16, I got a contract to play for the St. George Dragons team. Being selected to be the captain of the team, getting ready to lead my team, I felt like I was a superstar in the making, but I was just a kid trying to fulfill his dream. I was going through depression and asking myself, "Who is there to impress?"

My parents were still in New Zealand and my extended family here in Australia had their own families to look after. Yet I was still trying to get the attention that I wanted as young boy. Later, I got a new contract to play country footy in 2019. This tournament was the entry level towards NSW cup. But over time, the void in me was getting bigger. I was trying my best to fill it with footy, but the love that I had for the sport was starting to fade away.

One day, I was on my way to training and I bumped into a group of Christians from the Hurstville Potter's House. I attended a revival service at the church, and the person speaking was Luke Munzone who was sharing his testimony. It was like what I was going through. Luke then read one of the scriptures that really got me hard, a scripture that helped me with the void that I was try-

This doctor said that "nothing is wrong, you can continue your pregnancy." I did another thyroid checkup and it came out normal. Now I am at 19 weeks. God is doing such powerful things in my life.

As the Covid-19 pandemic was speaking in early 2020, the Malaysian government introduced the Movement Control Order (MCO) and a very strict lockdown (punishable by a monetary fine or imprisonment) was imposed. Everyone was ordered to stay at home. Schools, businesses and churches were ordered to be closed. A cloud of doom hung over the nation.

While everyone hunkered down depressed, God had other plans. He decided to rally and inspire His children. Taking a cue from the Bible, TPFC chose not to remain silent. Immediately, initiatives were implemented to move services online and the church kept in close contact with its members to maintain, as much as possible, a sense of normalcy. God had other ideas though.

Online, the church didn't merely contend with services. The Sunday school (who was even able to celebrate Father's Day and Mother's Day with an online presentation), the monthly Men's Discipleship and Women of Prayer meetings were moved online. It didn't stop there. A weekly End Times Bible Study and later on Casual Conversations webinars were held. Even the 180° Youth Ministry and regular weekly bible studies were held online. During this time however, it was sad to see numerous other churches flounder and eventually close down.

The church took the opportunity to pray and during this time of setbacks,

The Potter's Fellowship Academy was born. This school, built upon the foundation of Christian principles, was launched in April 2020 after one month of intense renovation and preparation. It was an eventful first year with the school going both online and on-site for a period of time. We are pleased to say that the school not only survived her first year's 'baptism of fire' but grew from strength to strength.

During this time, the church was also able to, during lulls in the lockdown, have its annual baptism where several people who chose to make that all important public decision got baptised. The church building also went through a period of refreshing. Repairs and upgrades which include the installation of new air-conditioning units, the laying of new carpets in the sanctuary and the upgrading of the sound system was carried.

At this time, a very important social work was carried out. The "TPFC Food Aid Initiative 2020 & 2021" was launched. Raw food items such as rice (a staple food in south-east Asia), vegetables and canned food were supplied to over 1800 people (which included Malaysians, migrants and refugees) in 2020 and 2021.

Recently, the Malaysian government announced the revocation of the MCO and TPFC hit the ground running. At our first evangelistic concert, which saw over 30 members and visitors in attendance, we saw one soul surrender his life to Jesus. Pastor Joel Stephen, newly announced at the Chandler Conference had the honor of leading this young soul to Christ.

Looking back, the hand of God was present in every situation. The church not only survived this period of testing but emerged better, stronger and closer. God supplied all our needs, be it financially, spiritually, emotionally, physically and He also gave us much needed wisdom and patience. If God can do this much for one small 'isolated' outpost in a small nation in 2020 and 2021, imagine what He can do for a united Fellowship worldwide in 2022.
