“GO YE!” Can you feel the burden, the call, the excitement and the marching orders that are declared in these two words? These words have been the heartbeat of our Fellowship for more than 30 years. This vision is what connects the hearts of men and women across the world.

Fifty years ago, in 1973, the Prescott congregation launched its first couple, Ron and Susie Burrell, into the ministry. Their commission: to pioneer a church and carry out the same pattern that they learned from Prescott. In doing this, they saw that the same thing that worked in Prescott, worked for them - the Gospel was proclaimed, people were saved and lives were changed.

Church planting became the culture of our church, along with a passion to reach the lost, and a desire to touch the WORLD with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Fifty years later, in the 2023 July Bible conference these same words rang out - “Go Ye.” This was captured so evidently on our final night of conference, as Pastor Greg Mitchell preached a sermon entitled “Go Ye” followed by the announcements of churches being planted and couples being launched into the ministry.

After 50 years, our marching orders have not changed! The vision of our church and our fellowship is still: Changing lives, Making disciples and Reaching the World.

We had the exciting privilege of launching one of our own couples, Manny and Patty Vazquez, into Charlotte, North Carolina to pioneer a new work for God. Manny and Patty are the second couple to be launched out of our Spanish Congregation, which is a powerful milestone that we are celebrating. We look ahead with great anticipation for the men and couples that God will continue to raise up for the har-



vest field through this ministry.

“Fanning the Flame!” This is the theme that was declared at our July Bible Conference, and we are laying hold of that flame for our city.

A move of the Holy Spirit brings with it, power and boldness to proclaim the Gospel. This power has been evident in our weekly outreaches as disciples preach the word of God, and step out in faith to believe for the miraculous.

In our local concert ministry, our One80, we have been seeing God’s power demonstrated. People are being born again, bodies are being healed, Words of Knowledge are being given and deliverance from bondage is being declared!

This fire is being fanned through our congregation, and the Holy Spirit has stirred the hearts of men and women in the congregation to step out with fresh boldness and expectation. Many are not waiting for an organized outreach but instead in their daily lives they are making room for God to move through them. Some of them, finding the nearest Walmart or gas station, boldly begin witnessing, proclaiming the Gospel of Christ and praying for the sick. Through this one-on-one evangelism we have seen many decisions made for Jesus

and many notable miracles.

We are excited to bring Matt and Priscila Sanderlin onto our staff here in Prescott as our new youth pastors. For the last year Matt and Priscila have been serving our congregation in the role of concert directors. During this time God has used their ministry to make an impact in the youth of our church. We have seen young people saved and teenagers who have been raised in our church make personal decisions to commit their lives to Christ. This has been followed up with decisions to step out and witness to their peers and classmates in school.

Young people have come to church, one80 and outreaches at the invitations of their born again friends. Many of these kids have made decisions for Christ, and several have chosen to be faithful to church on their own accord even though their parents or family may not attend.

We are expectant for all that God is going to continue to do through Matt and Priscila’s ministry as they step into this new pastoral role.

As our summer outreach season continues, we are pressing in taking ground and proclaiming victory in our city.

Greetings from Austin Texas ya'll!

We have been having a great summer in South Austin as we have seen God's hand move upon our Believer's South Texas Bootcamp, various summer outreaches, invasion teams and summer revival.

Our church sent 17 teens to our 29th Annual South Texas Believer's Bootcamp in Yorktown, TX. And it was "Bootcamp, bootcamp...all the way," as Jesus had His way into the hearts of our teens. We saw a great return in repentant and changed hearts in our teenagers!

Many of our young people have brought that fire back to our home church and have helped ignite our summer outreaches for souls.

Our Bible Studies have been outreaching predominantly at a park close to our church (Dove Springs), where through rap and spanish music, puppet shows, free hotdogs/hamburgers, and lots of work in the hot Texas sun, we have seen many visitors come and hear the Good News. Many have gotten saved at this great fishing pond!

At our latest outreach at Dove Springs (which had about 150 present), our Young Adult Bible Study conducted a healing crusade that saw more than 20 people saved and four people healed. A woman and her family drove by, asked for prayer, and she got healed instantly in her car from numbness in her back and arm (and got a free burger) - all paid for by Jesus and the good South Austin saints.

We also just completed a summer revival with Pastor Tony Chase, and we saw an excellent response in visitors, healings, and words in due season!

Testimony Randy Thomley

I was saved before, as an adult, but I went back into the world. I started drinking again, smoking, using marijuana.

I worked in a cigarette shop, and when I retired I worked in a liquor store. I smoked for 18 years before I finally quit. I kept saying "God I need to quit smoking." One morning I got up and lit a cigarette and it tasted really nasty - I said well, maybe it's a bad pack and I opened another one and it tasted even worse. So I told God "Alright, I quit, I'm done. I asked you to help me stop and they taste really nasty, I quit."

During that time, I would run into Pastor Haynes and no matter what, he'd come up and say "Hi, how you doing? We miss you." Every time that happened, I felt something. Later on, I thought of the parable of the seed - grown onto the stony ground,

and grown onto good soil. This went on for 25 years. God never really left me because every once in a while I would feel the Holy Spirit. Even years ago, when I was in church, my mom was prophesied over. She was told her kids

would be saved, so I always hung onto that, and God lived up to it.

In November 2022, I started reading my grandmother's Bible again. All these years, I had my grandmother's Bible by my bed, so I started reading it a little bit, and watching the series "The Chosen." I'd watch it, and cry, and finally, on December 16, 2022, I finished watching The Chosen, and was reading my Bible, and it's like something kicked me in the chest. It was conviction, and I knew what it was. I felt this stirring in my soul. It was real light at first, then it started building and building, and I thought, "I gotta call (my brother) Tony. I've gotta call him now." So I tried to call him, and he didn't answer. So I said "Well, I'm gonna send him a text." All I sent was "Are you free?" Well, he didn't answer the text, and I thought, "Ok, I'll call him next day or whatever," and I knew the minute it went through my head, that came from Satan, because Satan didn't want me to call him. But right then, Tony called me. And I started to cry and told him about the conviction, and he goes "You wanna pray?" I said "YES, yes I do." So Tony led me through a prayer.

That was on a Friday night. On Saturday, I called Pastor Haynes. We talked for a few minutes, and he said "Will you be in church tomorrow?" I said "Yes I will." I didn't know that that was also the Christmas services, so that night, they had the altar call, and I went up to Pastor Haynes and said "I want to be filled with the Holy Ghost." I can't remember who prayed with me, but I got filled with the Holy

Ghost that night as well.

The morning after I got saved, I had 12 bottles of brand new whiskey sitting in the kitchen. I dumped every single one of those down the drain. I threw all my weed away, all my cigarettes, all my pipes, all my bongos, every paraphernalia I had went in the trash, and I haven't looked back since. I've had people come up and say "do you remember when..." and I say "yes, I do, but Jesus doesn't". Now I'm happy all the time: I've always got a smile on my face. I've got a supervisor at FedEx who'll say "Have you got a good word today?" I'll say "yes, I do", and we'll talk for a minute, and other people will come up and say "you're smiling all the time". I say "I've got something to smile about. Jesus set me free." Before, if I was high, I'd be smiling, but I don't need to be high to be smiling now.

If you know anyone who needs to be saved: pray. That's the strongest weapon we've got in our arsenal. It took Tony and (his wife) Dion years of praying, and Pastor Haynes, and who knows who else. Sometimes it takes years, but God's faithful, and his time is perfect.

To keep the fires of evangelism alive in our fellowship, the Chandler church hosted a Missions Rally for all the local churches in the Phoenix metro area. "The Nations Are Calling" featured Joe Rice, Scott Lamb, Garrett King, Ashgar

Ghafoor and Pastor Campbell. Messages included God's personal call to deliverance and ensuring that not only do we hold on to God's calling, but that we be able to pass this calling on to others. It was a

great time of ministry and fellowship.

Shortly after moving here to Denver, I addicted to Fentanyl, and was smoking about 15-20 pills a day when

I could afford it. It got to the point where I was about to lose my apartment and everything that God had blessed me with. The amazing part was that God was with me the whole time and He knew exactly what I needed, a family.

God had placed me at the The Door Church, where he gave me a family to lean on. I have been sober since April 23, and was baptized, rededicating my life to the Lord.

Recently the Lord has blessed me with a leading position at a restaurant that I desired to work at and He

has helped me to learn to evangelize, which is out of my comfort zone.

The direction my life has turned the past couple of months has me very excited about the future and what God has planned for my life!

The Lord is definitely moving in my life and I know He is moving in your life as well. We all just need to cling to our faith and stay committed.

Hello this is Isaac from Gilroy, HCA. We are a pioneer work church.

Before getting to the city we had a hard time finding a home here in Gilroy. Everyone had better resumes than we have, having people that work in big tech companies here in the Silicone Valley. We paid background check after background check, spending hundreds of dollars out of our pockets and nobody was giving us a chance. We saw one home that we saw fit for services. We asked the man for an application and never turned it in because we were so discouraged. The man called us back and said we were the ones he wanted in his unit. He told us he liked the reason why we were coming to the city and he wanted to help out. God opened a door for us.

My wife and I moved here about four months ago. God has been moving in the city since we have arrived. People are hungry for the Word of God and want to get back on track. The night of my farewell service I preached, and in the crowd was a backslidden woman who was fighting God. She said she prayed for a church and a pastor and God brought her to the service. We only live seven minutes from each other. She is now coming with her two kids faithfully and is delivered from her past.

One night as I was contending for souls, a close relative called me crying, telling me she was having thoughts of suicide, wanting to end her life. We prayed a prayer of deliverance, rebuking any demonic assault or stronghold on her life. She was set free in that moment, I also asked her if there was anything she needed. She said she needed a miracle with finding a job. She's been out of work for five months and couldn't get an opportunity. We prayed for a supernatural job, reading in the Matthew where it says "Ask and you will receive."

We said goodbye and 30 minutes later she got a phone call for an interview

He was instrumental in gaining permission from the base commander to hold a weekly Bible study in the barracks. Every Monday night since January, we've been able to pack out the barracks lounge. In every Bible Study meeting, we provide a free home cooked meal to honor and thank our active duty members for their service. We have seen as many as 25 first time visitors come in one night, with many of them coming out to our church services. Since January, we have seen 40 military men and women give their lives to Christ.

The Lifeline Teen Ministry is also seeing a great move of God. These young men and women are catching a vision to reach their generation. The Friday night teen services continue to see multiple visitors every time they meet. We are currently gearing up for an upcoming Youth Rally and pre-

Greetings from Katy, Texas! Enjoy these updates from Texas, USA and Bagamoyo, Tanzania!

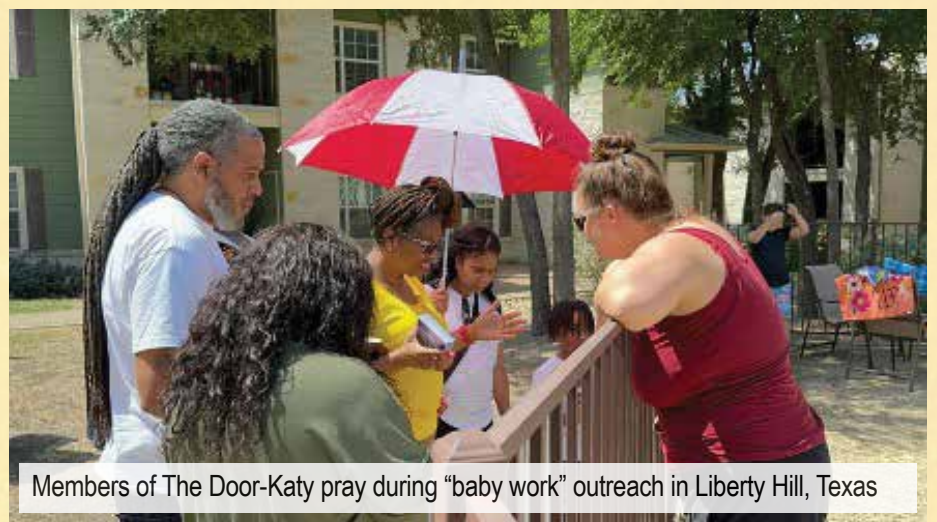
Pastor Adam and Beth Stephens were launched from the Chandler, Arizona Bible Conference in August 2013. Two "baby" works were then launched from The Door-Katy: The Door-Bagamoyo, Tanzania in 2021 and The Door-Austin, Texas in 2022.

Those baby works are under the leadership of Pastor Curtis and Mary Carter and Pastor Douglas and Tatum Montoya, respectively.

After months of fervent prayer, the Bagamoyo Fellowship has finally been blessed with a Swahili interpreter. Sister Mary Carter grew up in nearby Dar Es Salaam, Tanzania and speaks Swahili fluently. Nevertheless, the presence of a male interpreter will enable better one-on-one ministering to the men of the group. The Austin fellowship has obtained a perfect space for Sunday evening services at the Liberty Hill Event Center, in Liberty Hill, Texas near Austin.

The Door-Liberty Hill hosted a 30-member impact team from Katy, Texas on July 22, 2023. The group covered several apartment complexes and subdivisions distributing flyers at homes and on cars. The temperature exceeded 100 degrees, but many residents chatted with the group, asked for prayer and promised to visit. Pastor Douglas reported that the effort bore fruit when new visitors attended the 6 p.m. service the following day.

Hello, all the way from Ogden Utah! Our church has been seeing the Spirit of God move in a new dimension bringing many precious souls to salvation. Through this time, we have stayed true to the vision of our Fellowship in evangelizing, discipling, and planting churches.

Heading into the summer seasons our aim is to bring hot dogs and the message of Jesus Christ to the streets and parks. This gives disciples an opportunity to preach, pull altar calls and bring people to a decision to accept Christ.

Men are rising up and there is growth in our weekly Serious Men class. In September of 2022 we had our biggest Harvester's Homecoming to date with over 500 people in attendance.

It was a great turnout where we saw many souls receive the Gospel. Riding that momentum, we entered January 2023

where Ogden was announced to be a conference center.

The summer of 2023 has seen the church come together with the goal in mind of hosting our first conference.

Our congregation has seen an influx of young people getting married and new couples wanting to preach and do something for God.

In June we had our Bible Conference and the Holy ghost fell upon us. Our theme was, "A Heart For The Harvest," and we sent out four international churches and three nationally. Since our conference we have had record breaking services with visitors getting saved and locking in. We can't wait to see what God is going to do in the time to come!

It is a tremendous blessing to serve God here in Ogden and to be a part of

some crazy things and eventually got to the point where I couldn't sleep. The only thing that I could find that allowed me to sleep was alcohol.

So, I kept drinking alcohol more and more and it progressed to the point where I was full-blown addicted alcoholic. I was literally drinking a liter of alcohol a day during work. On the way home, I would stop and grab two more liters, one for that night and one for the morning work. That was my daily routine.

On Saturdays I would grab a gallon, so I had enough for Saturday night and all day Sunday, and then enough for work on Monday night. I was doing that for eight to 10 years, drinking that much on a regular basis. Eventually one day I went to work and passed out. I woke up in the hospital and they told me I had cirrhosis of the liver. They told me I would

have only two to three years to live if I didn't stop drinking.

I got released from the hospital and of course, I didn't stop drinking, so I ended up in the hospital again in summer 2022.

While I was there, I was strapped to the bed for about 10 days. I was there a total of 27 days. When I got out, my daughter asked me if I was going to die from alcohol. I told her probably so.

One day I felt I just had to get some-

when something stopped me and told me to go back, but I kept continuing to the liquor store. The closer I got to the liquor store, the stronger that feeling of going back kept speaking to me.

On my way back home, I stopped and picked up my head and realized I was right in front of the church I used to attend years ago, The Potters House. I went in that Wednesday night and surrendered my life to Jesus and got saved. Since then, I continued to pray to take the edge off alcoholism. It took several weeks before it fully went away. It was at the point where I fully broke down and gave it, prayed with my heart, not my words and my mind but I prayed with my heart and at that point I literally felt all the weight just lift off me, the entire world.

Since that day I have not had any alcohol or any cravings for alcohol. The miracles of God just kept coming. God gave me the ability to go back to work because when I was in the hospital, I had to learn how to do everything over. I had to learn how to walk a straight line, relearn hand and eye coordination because of the chemical imbalance in my head that alcohol had caused in my brain. And so, I kept praying. God gave me the ability to work and gave me a job full time.

I chose to only commit myself to church. And within that time, I have been blessed financially. I have been promoted to the foreman of the company. I was supposed to be dead last October 2022. It is now July 2023 and I'm still here, still alive. I've kept going without a transplant and healthy as I've been in a decade at least. I've also been blessed with being able to see my daughter much more.

I've also recently been dealing with court because I got in trouble before I got saved and they wanted to give me a felony charge for three DUIs. Pastor Martinez and Pastor Berry wrote a note to the judge explaining how I was when I first got here and how I am now. With their help and the power of God, the judge reduced my sentence of three years in jail to a misdemeanor, which was only 10 days in jail!

I am truly blessed financially, physically, mentally, and definitely spiritually. I give my Savior Jesus all the praise!
