These signs will follow those who believe!

Inspired by headship and empowered by the Holy Ghost, Prescott disciples take healing to the hurting. With outreach season in full swing, disciple-led open-air healing crusades are impacting the tri-city area.

Pastor Greg Mitchell's recent book "Healing Power" has stirred, challenged, and directed the faith of many to lay hands on the sick. This book provides Step-by-step instructions that lay out a practical approach to hosting healing services and praying for the sick. Hope and healing are preached in neighborhood outreaches by men in the congregation, and God's power is on display.

Two healing crusades took place in May, with nine saved and 11 healed. One visitor was a veteran who suffered knee pain for more than 10 years and was healed. A woman arrived with the aid of oxygen and left without needing it. Another was set free from long-term back pain. An older woman had her ear drum punctured at age five and suffered pain and deafness for 60 years; after prayer, the pain was gone, and she could hear. A young man with flat feet and scoliosis received a miracle, and arches formed. Jesus Christ is alive! Jesus Christ is still the same yesterday, today, and forever!

In April, we launched our first outdoor outreach of the season with a Family Fun Festival. Face paintings, jump castles, food trucks, and games drew more than 300 visitors from the community. Like most of our summer outreaches, this event was planned, organized, and executed by a disciple in the church with a burden to see souls saved.

While the Children's Church song service team played live music, saints shared personal testimonies, and aspiring young men took turns pulling altar calls. Hundreds received the Gospel through one-on-one evangelism that day, and 28 people were born again.

The next morning we had people in the church as a direct result of these labors.

The play "Premonition" has been on the road taking the Gospel with a theatrical flair to Farmington, NM; Mesa and Casa Grande, AZ; Las Vegas, NV and Redlands, CA. After each production, an appeal is given, and the altar call has drawn many to receive Jesus as Lord and Savior.

Over the course of these performances, 135 souls have responded for salvation. Future dates are currently scheduled for Chinle, AZ; Gallup, NM and Wickenburg, AZ. For more than four decades, Louie Paulino has been writing and directing evangelistic drama; perhaps his next theater presentation will be coming to a city near you.

Another production we put on was called "Pais De Riquezas," The Land of Riches. After the performance entirely in Spanish, eight people made decisions after the outreach, which was hosted outdoors in a park.

Every summer opportunity arrives in the form of a good old-fashioned street meeting, complete with songs and street preaching. We draw crowds through events and advertisements, but summer is a great time to take the Gospel to the streets. Armed with banners, bullhorns, and Biblical truth, the Prescott congregation has been taking street corners by storm, preaching Jesus and sharing personal testimonies of lives changed.

Street meetings are held downtown after our concert, on Saturday afternoons at busy intersections, and occasionally on Tuesday nights after our youth prayer meetings. Groups as large as 65 people show up to hold signs, pass out tracts and declare the power of Jesus Christ. During one such event, the own-

er of a local downtown bar came out to where we were preaching and prayed the sinner's prayer to receive Jesus as Lord and Savior!

Hundreds of teens came together for our bi-annual Youth Extreme to hear from God and evangelize the Prescott area. Pastor Martin Klok preached a challenging sermon titled "No, Not the Easy Way" and gave timely words to many of our youth. That night we presented the musical "Hope for Evan" at Prescott High School, where 17 responded to the altar call, and four people received miracle healing from pain and injuries.

We are seeing incredible growth and development in our new converts' classes. Foundations for the Faith lessons take place every Sunday before our evening service. New believers are given fundamental Biblical guidelines to help grow their faith and give them an understanding of what it means to be a Christian.

Pastor Greg Mitchell has been teaching a compelling Sunday School series, "Memorial Stones – Lessons From Our History." To know where we are going, we must know, remember and rehearse where we have come from. Memorial Stones provide us with so much more than a walk down memory lane; these lessons are crucial to understanding who we are and why we do what we do.

This insightful look at our Fellowship's beginnings will inspire, encourage, and calibrate our journey in the faith. We were blessed to have revival with Frankie Chi. His unique style of preaching was very much needed and welcomed during these times of difficulty. The last time Frankie Chi did a revival

in Chinle, we had to stop that revival short because of the Covid 19 outbreak. Now that we are able to assemble, his preaching of God's word went forth and we were greatly encouraged. We saw many visitors from the community and backsliders return.

Because our congregation has increased, we have had to build an addition to the old sanctuary (see attached pictures below). God is continuing to do great things with our congregation here in Chinle, Arizona. We continue to press forward in reaching the Indigenous peoples of America!

Hello from Los Angeles, California. We are in an area called Eagle Rock between Glendale and Pasadena.

We have been given a great group of young people, stirred for the Harvest and willing to put feet to their faith.

Last September we sent an invasion team into Cucuta, Columbia, right on the border of Venezuela, for Pastor German and sister Dora Gustelum and had a wonderful time. He had us outreaching, doing outdoor crusades and a revival. It was non-stop.

We saw many saved and healed during this time and it gave an opportunity for everyone to minister on some level and engage one-on-one with some very needy people.

This time had a lasting impact on our

people to believe for and invest in World Evangelism. We have been able to send several invasion teams to help nearby churches locally as well, always seeing people saved and impacted for Christ. We have some incredible pioneer Pastors and congregations here in Southern California and this has given our people and music groups expression in these cities outside of L.A.

Here in our own city, we have been able to outreach in some unique settings. We did a concert at a 13-vendor food hall with lots of people coming and going on a Friday night as we were able to testify and preach the Gospel. The good news is we have been invited back to do it again.

We had a couple impromptu rap concerts in Glendale in a seating area between some popular restaurants with a captive audience. We have been outreaching at a couple of our local colleges recently wanting to see some students saved.

During a Revival with Evangelist David Ajala we saw several visitors come out from Occidental College, including the president of the Black Lives Matter group on campus. This is a very liberal college and we have not seen much response until his revival. Evangelist Ajala ministers very well and his Nigerian background draws foreign students especially.

Glendale Community College has been a good place to reach out to Armenians and some middle eastern students who are Muslim. We just baptized our first Armenian convert. Praise God!

While preparing for our own mini-healing crusade Evangelist Charlie Foreman challenged us to pray for healing as we outreach. That day we prayed for a 43-year-old man in a local sports park who had severe arthritis for four years. He can no longer work and uses a walker. After prayer he began to move freely and walk completely unassisted. He walked up a small hill all the way back to his vehicle. His wife was thrilled and said he hadn't been able to walk like that for years.

Finally, Evangelist Joaquin Orozco preached a timely revival for us in February. During that revival his older brother, who he had never met in person, came to the meeting and prayed

I had a lot of hatred in my heart so I would find reasons to release that anger through fighting and getting involved in a gang. I didn't know how to deal with the normal way of life. Much of this was caused from the way I grew up, feeling abandoned and rejected and the envi-

ronment I lived in.

My wife grew up surrounded by family in Pocatello, Idaho but still was neglected by her mother throughout her life being raised by her grandmother. Her home was filled with uncles and cousins who were addicted to drugs. As we got older our addictions got worse. I started off selling weed and quickly moved to selling meth and heroin. I sold to anyone who had the money, including my wife's family and mine. I was very selfish and violent.

I was 20 years old before my wife and I got really heavy in using the drugs I was selling. We had three children that were all taken away by the state because of our lifestyle.

I was in and out of jail. I shot up heroin and dope for years while my wife smoked it. Even though we had everything we wanted, like material things, a house, cars, money, and drugs, we still felt empty inside. It never felt like it was enough when we weren't high. All we did was argue, and I always thought about getting more.

In the end we lost everything and ended up homeless, on the run from the law, sleeping in my mom's kitchen with a sheet over the entrance for a door. After living like this for a year, we both

got locked up and this time I found myself going to the state prison.

For a year and half my wife stayed in the county jail but during this time I found myself in my cell talking to God, asking what my purpose was in this life. I remember saying if this is who I was created to

be, then alright, because I knew I could do time and all I ever knew was a life of crime. But if God had a purpose for me, I asked Him to show me.

I got out on a program after I did the time and quickly started going back to what I knew best. One day I was in my apartment with my wife. We were about to get high when someone knocked on

my door. I saw it wasn't my probation officer through the door so I answered it, and it was a man inviting me to church services at the Potter's House. He told me about the Gospel of Jesus Christ and all that he had delivered him from. That man is now my pastor. The first thing that came to my mind while he was witnessing to me was me talking to God in my cell. I knew it was from God so I went to service and during that service, God met with me and I knelt at the altar, repented of my sins, and asked Jesus Christ into my heart.

I was delivered from drugs, cigarettes, alcohol, the way I used to think, the way I dressed and even the way I would speak. I have truly been transformed by the power of God.

A couple of months later my wife, who was my girlfriend at the time, came in and got powerfully delivered from everything as well. A month later we both got baptized, and three months after that we were married in our church here in Pocatello, Idaho. We are now the Door directors.

God has given us so much peace and demonstrates his love and faithfulness in our lives more and more everyday. He has restored our family and the relationships that were broken. We are both just so excited about his plan for our lives we thank God everyday for the Fellowship he has placed us in. He has answered my prayers and has truly given me purpose.

Greetings from Ciudad Victoria, Tamaulipas, México.

We were announced out of the January 2022 Prescott Conference. We have seen so much in our first year here. A month after arriving we got in contact with a lady whose sister (that is in our Fellowship in another city) had been praying for 10 years that God would send a Fellowship church to this city.

This lady had a hunger to get closer to God. A woman pastor told her she would have to make a pact with God to do that. Although confused about that and not knowing what that entailed, she was willing. The Wednesday she was to

make that pact she found that the church was closed due to a neighborhood fire. She left that place defeated and thought, "I guess you don't want me, God."

That Friday we got in touch with her. We met at Burger King and talked for a couple hours forgetting that they were closing for the night. We shared the hope of Jesus and led her in a prayer. She said she never felt anything like the peace she had and felt like she had known us for years.

That Sunday we had our first service in our living room with her and a niece she invited. They both responded to the altar call and got saved.

Because of her we began doing Bible studies at her mother's house where we met another sister of hers. This sister had become addicted to meds due to depression. Her son and daughter in law suddenly disappeared 13 years ago and had never heard from them again. When we met her, you could tell there was a heaviness in her soul. We led her to Jesus; she later threw her meds away and was set free.

Because of these two women we have had opportunities to minister to their entire families. They have been faithful to our church ever since. One night we had 22 people in an evening service, all from their family. (Mexicans really do have big families!).

We found a building in September right next to the governor's mansion. We have been able to minister to so many people during our outreaches. Flea markets are a big thing here and we are taking advantage of that to speak with folks. Our services right now are running about 10-13 people.

In May, we did an outdoor service in what is considered one of the most dan-

gerous colonies in the city. We lifted up the name of Jesus and had 16 in attendance with six visitors and one saved.

Please pray for Ciudad Victoria. As far as I know we are the first Fellowship church in this city, so we are beginning to break ground. There is a lot of false religion and many of the people we have spoken to feel like they have been ripped off by churches here. We get the sense that people are hungry for truth, and we intend on giving it to them.

Victoria is the capitol of the state and only three hours from the border with Texas, so a lot of cartel activity crosses through here as they make their way to the U.S. God has protected us and we are seeing his favor. I praise God for the vision of our Fellowship to reach the lost. God bless from Ciudad Victoria, Tamaulipas.

I was disciplined under Fellowship ministry standard and later in 2015, I took over the church from Pastor Gordon Porter and became the first nationalized pastor here in Lalitpur church. I've been faithfully serving Christ and reaching out to the lost ones since.

If Prescott has not sent out a missionary pastor and had not launched a church here in Nepal, I doubt if I ever would have come to know Jesus and got saved and be pastoring a church.

To this date, my dad doesn't speak to me and treats me as I am already dead to him. My family and I have not been accepted in the village. I had to make

a really bold decision to live for Christ and for my marriage. But, we serve a good God! Today, my mom loves my wife and my daughter and I am still praying for my dad and for my parents' salvation.

Da Nang, Vietnam

My name is TJ Horta. My wife Christina and I have been in Da Nang Vietnam since September 1, 2022 after being in Ho Chi Minh City for three and a half years.

English language classes in Da Nang, Vietnam introduces students to the Bible



We tried a different strategy than what we used in Ho Chi Minh City. Down there we started right away with Wednesday and Sunday services and a Tuesday night English club outreach.

Here in Da Nang we only started doing English club outreach on Tuesday evening and another on Saturday we called Super Saturday. These outreaches have been really fruitful averaging 25-30 people at each one. The hook to get them to come out is we offer free English lessons. We cannot street evangelize, knock on doors, street preach or hand out fliers, so we offer free English classes.

We put the building together and arranged it like a classroom on the first floor. The second floor is where our sanctuary is. The place looks very professional and put together well because of the mentality that if something is free it has to be second rate or not as good. We have categories in the lessons we give. Game time, tongue twisters, story time, rewrite and repeat, life tips. Towards the end of each lesson we do what is called rewrite and repeat. I display a scripture, they write it on their worksheets, repeat it to learn how to say it correctly and then I go into life tips and I take the liberty to teach them what the verse they had just written means.

I am trusting that God's word will get into their souls and not return void, but accomplish what God pleases. They are hungry for truth and keep coming. We

are working with at least eight different families and many singles. We take this time to build relationships, friendships and gain their trust.

We started having Sunday night Bible study and at our very first one we had 10 adults and six children with six adults praying and asking God for forgiveness.

During April we prayed with 12 first time believers. At our Easter picnic in the park we had 25 souls come out for our evening Bible study. We sang worship songs, preached the Bible and loudly declared that Jesus Christ is risen from the dead. We have given each one of them a Bible and keep close contact with them to encourage them to grow in God.

We are in outreach mode doing game night, movie night, Vietnam's got talent show, craft time, potluck dinners. Recently I started a midweek service on Thursday night. It is for men only and we had three men attend the first one. The midweek service will turn into a full church service for all but I really wanted to work with the men specifically and see them become disciples. One man, 18 years old said, "This is the first time I have ever read the Bible."

Selecting topics and lessons has taught me to develop a strategy to make sure they are learning the basics. What a privilege it is to share the truth with a nation who knows nothing about the Gospel. It blows my mind. Our last Bible study we went through Mark chapter 5. Afterwards we prayed for deliverance from demonic strongholds and for miracles. Please pray for the work here in Da Nang Vietnam.

Testimony Marissa

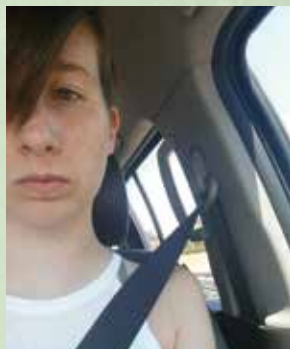
My name is Marissa, and I've been in the Potter's House Hurstville church for almost six years.
