To reach this generation, we teach this generation to preach to this generation!

The youth group in Prescott has been making an impact by organizing teen takeovers of the regular Saturday night one80 concert scenes. This outreach platform allows youth between the ages of 13 and 19 to take the stage and present the Gospel through drama, music, testimony, and video.

At one such event in May of 2024, Preston Ball (age 16) preached his first altar call. The bold declaration of a young disciple from this generation was exciting. These milestones are not just reminders of our church's path but also a testament to the power of our fellowship vision - changing lives, making disciples, and planting churches.

A youth rally with Pastor Jesse Cluck in April drew nearly 400 teenagers. Many Fellowship churches across the state, as well as Nevada and New Mexico, partnered together to street preach and witness; that day, we saw 36 saved.

We believe that children must also be permitted to come and know Jesus. That's why we host our annual family fun day and Easter egg hunt, a joyous event that draws children and our community. It was quite the eggstravaganza! Pictures with the easter bunny, face painting, games, and music make for a

great venue that never fails to bring the Prescott community together. This year, we had 300 visitors come out to enjoy the day and hear the Gospel declared. This was the kick-off of our summer outreach season, and it was a blessing to see the first fruits of our labors as people gave their hearts to Christ.

The play "El Milagro" was a spectacular musical performance that drew many families and fans. Many little ones came and brought their parents out to see and experience a live production put on by their favorite Madrigals! Pictures with the cast after the event were advertised, and 65 visitors came out. We preached and had an altar call, and we saw 16 people pray for salvation. Theater continues to be an excellent venue to share the Gospel.

Pastor Kris Hart has a heart for our native tribal lands. As he continues to bless the Prescott congregation in his pastoral role, his eye remains fixed on the harvest, and his pioneering spirit lives on as he reaches the surrounding Indian reservations for Jesus. This summer marks the 3rd satellite church that Pastor Hart has pioneered and transitioned to an ongoing work. Middle Verde, Payson, and now Whiteriver, Arizona, are carrying on the Fellowship vision.

After success in Middle Verde and Payson, Pastor Hart tested the waters with a miracle healing crusade on the McNary Reservation in March 2024. A gentleman who owned a 25,000 acre parcel in the neighboring Whiteriver reservation was invited to the service. God

moved upon his heart, and he offered to make his land available for a tent crusade. Seeing God's guiding hand, Pastor Hart wasted no time clearing the land and organizing the event. Prescott partnered with Chinle church to set up a tent, and on April 27th, they held their first meeting. God's favor was so evident that the services had to be extended twice, first with Pastor Artie Aragon and then with evangelist JW Ballinger.

During the tent meeting, a lady received prayer from Pastor Hart. She was completely deaf; after the tent meeting, her grandson contacted Pastor Hart to inform him that her hearing had been restored! After the nine-day tent meeting, Pastor Hart, along with a few disciples, would make the four-hour drive every Saturday to host a weekly service in a flea market on the tribal land. In doing so, a lady offered her 10-acre parcel of land as a place where the new church could be established. More than 100 decisions were made for salvation on the Whiteriver reservation in just under two months.

Then, 6,500 miles away on the island of Guam, Pastor Jesse Cluck hosted their annual Bible conference. At the conclusion of the conference, one of the exciting announcements was they would be sending a couple from Guam to Whiteriver, Arizona! We are happy to welcome Vince and Joy Mendola as they pioneer this work.

It is fascinating to see God at work and a blessing to be part of a Fellowship that partners together to support the work that God is doing.

Pastor Greg Mitchell's new book, *Uprooting Rejection*, now available

Pastor Greg Mitchell has followed his book, *Healing Power*, with another life-changing book, *Uprooting Rejection*. This book came out of a Sunday School series he taught in Prescott, that literally changed the lives of people who had been dealing with rejection and its impact on their minds, health, and their relationships with God and others. These led directly into special services with Alvin Smith in which he declared that God was bringing a "flood of men," to the kingdom for God's purposes. Many souls were saved and delivered.

The Annual Pioneer rally served to remind the local churches of our calling and our roots. Pastor Greg Mitchell reminded us of our need for radical Christianity in reaching the world and a willingness to respond to God's call.

Pastor Paul Stevens brought to life a reaffirmation that God is a God of abundance who can meet every need of the kingdom. It was a time of refreshing and renewed direction.

Everyone knows that all "good" Christians come to church at least twice a year on Christmas and Easter. Easter Sunday found the house

of God full to overflowing. Pastor Campbell seized on the opportunity to bring Jesus to those in attendance. As a result, the altars were flooded with sinners and saints alike, crying out for mercy and forgiveness. What a glorious time!

Testimony Francisco Salazar East Las Vegas, Nevada

My name is Francisco Salazar. On August 2, 2023, my life forever changed.

I want to share my testimony with you in hopes that I can remind you of the power of prayer and patience in God's timing.

At work, on August 2nd 2023, I leaned over to pick up a rock to allow my coworker to pass by with the industrial mower. I slipped and my foot got caught under the mower. My co-workers tried hard to lift the machine up enough for me to slide my foot out. Then I remember looking down and seeing half my boot gone - cut straight down the side. I thought I lost all my toes, but God is good and He had bigger plans for my life.

As the ambulance rushed me to the Trauma ER the medic reassured me that my toes were all intact. So from that news, I at least rejoiced through the agonizing pain, with the help of my family. That small victory was a challenge, but the surgeon told

us that he was unable to seal up the wound. He said I was at risk of a severe infection, and they thought I might lose my foot after all.

The mower did so much damage to my nerves and had taken so much of my skin, that I couldn't feel half my foot for weeks. I was placed on a "wound vac" to grow enough skin and

tissue back for reconstructive surgery.

Doctors said my skin and tissue would take months and months to grow back enough to attempt surgery, but God did it in two months.

Doctors said after the surgery I wouldn't walk for over a year and possibly would never walk right again. But I prayed, our congregation prayed, my family prayed, and we stayed faithful to God. I was standing on my own two feet in three months.

There were so many trials along the way, and the devil tried to mentally take me out, but God is a very big God, and my faith glorified Him throughout my recovery. The power of prayer and faith in my Lord and Savior is what brought me through the fire.

I want to just say thank you to all my brothers and sisters in Christ for lifting me up before God in prayer. The Lord answered, and now I am here to share all that he has done for me.

Our teens lead various annual outreaches, such as a 3-on-3 Basketball Tournament and a Skateboarding competition. These outreaches have effectively brought the Gospel to other teenagers, which developed a need for a ministry focused on teens.

In March, our pastor announced that Darius and Juana Esfandi would lead our new youth ministry, focusing on ages 13-19! We are so thankful that we have a generation of young people witnessing and growing in their love for Jesus, and we are contending for a fruitful ministry!

In addition to what God is doing in our youth, He has opened doors in other areas that we have been praying for! For years there has been a burden on the heart of a disciple in our church to start a Bible study in a rehab facility. The burden motivated him to reach out to every facility in town, but he continued to encounter various obstacles and closed doors.

Late last year, God supernaturally drew in a man who was recently released from one of the newer facilities,

and as we watched him become a convert, Jeremy was stirred to try again. One night, he went home and emailed the facility inquiring about possibly doing a Bible study, but never got a response. God didn't let that stop Him, a few weeks later a backslider walked into a Wednesday night service and while catching up with her, one of the ladies in the church learned that she worked at the same facility that God put on Jeremy's heart - and that week she connected Jeremy with her manager!

In February, they had their first Bible study which had four people in attendance, and now runs on average 18-20 people!

Some of the notable miracles we've experienced include watching these people grow into converts, raw sinners starting to get the vision of our Fellowship! Recently a man who has come

to every Bible study since the first said, "I don't know what my calling is, but if God's calling, I'm going to answer!" Greetings from Murray, Utah! Our church had been in the Salt Lake City area for more than 30 years, but we had never been able to buy a building. I sincerely believed God was leading us to purchase property despite having little savings.

In September 2019, I preached a

message called “Man of God, God wants to Confirm You” about how I believe God wants His prophets to request big things in front of the congregation. He wants His people to witness the miracle. So, I told my church that God wanted to give us a building.

Our lease was set to expire in September 2021. I had two real estate agents looking for buildings, and they couldn’t find a reasonably priced building the size we needed. We were willing to double what we had been paying in rent, but still nothing. I believe it was simply not God’s will for us to sign a lease. He wanted us to buy a building and be unhindered when the time came.

I talked to my pastor, Bill Neil, about renting a hotel conference room for our services while we prepared to buy, and we both believed it was God’s will. I spoke to my council and other pastors who have done similar things; everyone thought it was a good idea.

So, in the summer of 2021, I told my church that we were letting our lease go to be ready when God gave us a building.

Leading up to this step of faith, I preached to my congregation about us being modern-day Levites. When Israel was in the wilderness, the Levites broke down the tabernacle components, carried them to the next stop, and set up the tabernacle again. My church wholeheartedly bought into the concept. We dispersed the equipment so no one would have to handle it all. One person brings the piano, one brings the computer, another brings the projector, another brings the drums, etc. They are responsible for bringing the items

to church, setting them up, and then taking them down and storing them at their homes. Because of this partnership, we can set up in 15-20 minutes! My people are more needed than ever, and it has brought

us closer together. We lost no members through that process; we even saw people added to the congregation.

We were being strategic, but we also knew we needed a miracle. We were saving money, but not enough to raise a down payment of 25 percent in a year or two. We were doing this because we needed a miracle. I told my church, “We’re wrestling the angel, and we’re not going to let go until he blesses us.”

As of October 2021, we had no building of our own; we had stepped out in faith, believing that God would give us one. In November 2021, we discovered that our church was named in the will of Ezekiel Contreras, a friend who had passed away. He genuinely loved our church and left us enough money to buy a building. We got our miracle!

We bought a building in March of 2023 and have been in the process of renovating it. Please pray for favor with the city of Murray that they will release us and give us the needed permits.

Hello from Rochester, New York! We are excited to report all that God has been doing here in Rochester this year so far.

We kicked off the year with an ice skating outreach at the most popular rink in Rochester right in the heart of the city. We told testimonies, played music, and preached the Gospel to as many as twenty visitors and many more passers by. This outreach was led by a disciple and it has been encouraging to see men step into leadership roles.

March brought evangelist Steve Bowman with his powerful words and gifting. Forty responded for salvation that week.

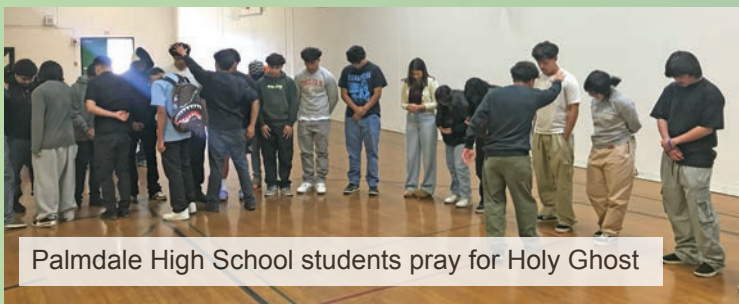

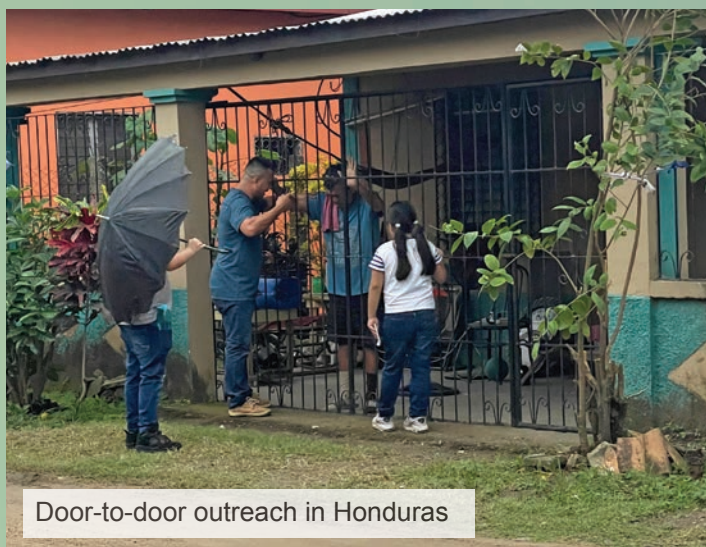

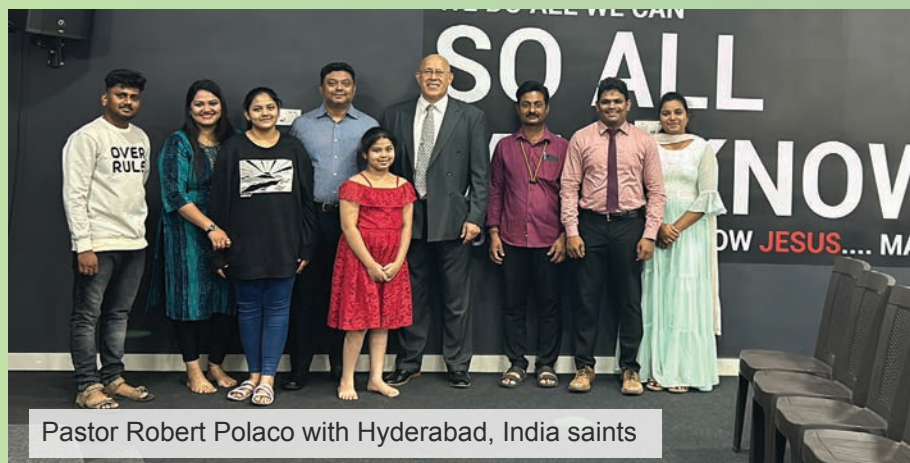

He works right next to the church, about 30 feet away, in the same IT Consulting office.

We met and I began to explain to him God's view on money and God's plan of salvation. I asked him if he had ever heard that Jesus died for his sins? He said he had never heard that. So I told him in the same way that you are in debt to these people you owe money to, we were all in debt, and that Jesus paid that debt He did not owe, the

debt that we cannot pay.

I asked this man if he was Hindu and he said yes, and I told him "obviously it hasn't really worked for you. That's why you're sitting across from me today. All the

All of this has led to high numbers of crime and homelessness.

People struggle to overcome "island life" and are absorbed by all

of its pulls. Religious tradition and witchcraft causes people to be less open to the Gospel, and people get close, but only long enough to get what they want, and then bail.

God recently asked me, "Son, are you doing everything possible to make the difference in this place?" I believe so. How?

We're doing daily one-on-one evangelism, and this is proving to be the most effective. We do weekly street preaching and sport outreaches, playing pick-up games and then witnessing. We are building rapport with teens, and God is opening their hearts to us. God is allowing me to integrate with different social classes on the island as well. We hold English classes and recently moved to a new location.

Hello, my name is Talahiva Mafile’o, and I attend the Pot- ters House Church in Fairfield, Syd- ney, Australia.

I’ve been saved for five years now and the journey, so far, has been noth-

ing short of a blessing. I’ve seen God move in many areas in my life. In saying that, I cannot deny my share of doubt and unbelief.

Three years in to my salvation, we’re in our second wave of COV- ID. We’re isolated in our homes and there is a high volume of cases arising within my local area. I am at the peak of my walk with Christ that I knew no matter what was going on around me, I was at peace knowing my God is in control. “Satan has nothing on me” was the attitude I held then, and it is the attitude I will continue with today.

At this peak, I felt sick, nauseous, and weak. Being the Tongan that I am, I tried to hack it. Three days in, and I kept throwing up, leaving me dehydrated. My doctor advised I go to the emergency room immediately as my sugar level was at a 22. Mind you, your average would be 4-5, so 22 is skyrocketing.

What went from being admitted to the emergency room, lead to resusci- tation area, to the intensive care unit. All I could think about at the time was Jesus. What was going on in my heart did not hinder the sense of peace I had felt in Christ. I couldn’t be more grateful for my relationship with Him. Days passed and I final- ly was discharged from the hospital with a diagnosis of type 1 diabetes.

As 2024 approached, I decided to take dominion over my health and lifestyle choices. A few sisters in Christ were gathering for a mini prayer night for the new year. That night, I was prayed over. Since then, I began to pray with an increased faith for healing. A week ago, I went to see my diabetes specialist.
