What an exhilarating and delightful time we live in seeing our very own go into all the world and preaching the good news! We are looking forward with anticipation for what God is going to do in these start-up works. We will miss the Lopezes and the Sanderlins, but we're so grateful they answered the call.

Our church has seen a remarkable and fruitful season of evangelism. We kicked off the summer movie park outreaches at Prescott's downtown courthouse plaza. This is one of our outreaches that has continued to bring fruit, going back to the 1970s. To this day, we have faithful people in church that were saved at one of these outreaches. This season, we saw 50 precious souls respond to the Gospel!

Another area in which we've experienced an increase in evangelism is in our youth. A group of teens meet on Friday nights, and take the Gospel to our local entertainment district and local stores.

The youth of our church are praying with their peers and seeing God use their testimonies in a powerful way!

For example, one teen was able to pray with many teens using card tricks as a tool for evangelism! In

those outreaches, 17 young people have prayed for salvation. This led our youth to want to take the spirit of soul-winning, outside of our city, and into West Las Vegas.

We joined Pastor Scott Lamb's church, along with other local area churches, for their annual youth rally.

Pastor Roman Gutierrez preached a tremendous message. The teens caught that spirit and took it to the streets. Throughout the day they saw 20 souls saved. Then, our youth band, California Stop, ministered at the end of the night. They saw another three souls added to the kingdom!

We also were able to do a Country Music theme night at our One80 Event Center. A special band ministered and a video testimony, of a real life cowboy was presented. At the end of the night, we had a total of 25 visitors with eight of them responding to the Gospel. Following

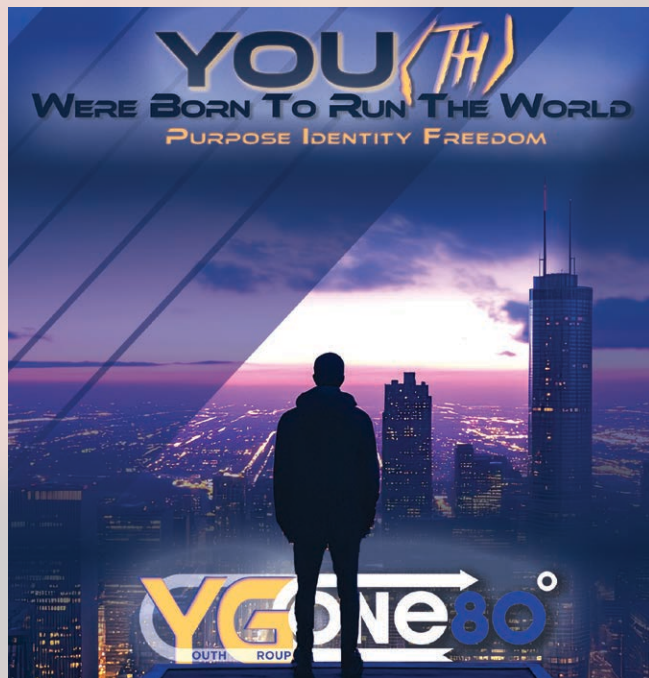

The next day, flyers were handed out to any and everyone, people were witnessed to, and hearts were encouraged. Large groups then set out to cultivate the mission through street preaching. The fruit during this was unbelievable! Many people, especially youth, from all different churches came forward and boldly declared their faith on the pier. People stopped to listen or grab a flyer, and some even prayed on the side. That night, many flooded the altar and even more were healed!

The importance of these bold declarations for God is quickly becoming apparent! Public revelation helps the

Life Transformed: Baltazar Morales

I was born in 1957, in Tijuana, Baja California, Mexico - the second of seven children. We were a large family living in a small world: a two-room shack with a dirt floor, patched walls, and a kitchen just big enough to cook tortillas over an open flame. My siblings and I slept like sardines in one room while my parents took the other. We didn't have much, but we had each other.

My father was a builder by trade, and I remember the day he began stacking bricks next to our little shack, starting work on a home he hoped we would one day live in. But in Tijuana, money was a stubborn stranger. So he made the hard decision to leave for the United States to work as a bracero - a laborer with a temporary visa.

He went alone, chasing a dream that we couldn't yet see. When he left, I was seven years old. And when a boy loses his father's presence at that age, it leaves more than just an absence, it leaves a wound. No dad at school programs. No dad on the sidelines at sports. No dad to show me what it meant to be a man. My mother was left to raise seven children on her own. She did her best - more than her best - but it was hard. With the money my father sent back,

things improved a little. But it couldn't buy what we really needed.

In 1975, our family finally came to America. We settled in East Los Angeles, a city of concrete and dreams, noise and struggle. I had just completed a diploma in accounting and bilingual studies in Tijuana, and I wanted to keep studying. I had ambition. But real life had other plans. I left college to work full time and help my family. That decision started a slow drift, a current that pulled me away from the values I had known and into a lifestyle that promised excitement but delivered emptiness.

It began with parties and drinking. Then came drugs. My younger brother Nick had joined a lowrider car club called "New Trend" and eventually became its president. I got swept up in that world - beautiful cars, long nights, loud music. We'd cruise through cities like kings, with polished chrome and roaring engines. But behind the shine, my soul was cracking. I started selling drugs. It was easy money, fast money. But sin always gives with one hand and takes with the other. I was soon hooked, lost, and spiraling.

Addiction chained me. I wanted to stop but couldn't. The bottle and the

needle became my masters. My mind was fraying. My peace was gone. I found myself in constant conflict with others, with the law, with myself. Eventually, I learned there was a warrant for my arrest.

That's when I met Martha.

It was my 24th birthday. The car club threw me a big party with drugs, alcohol, loud music, and chaos. And in the middle of it all stood Martha, the calm in the storm. The moment I saw her, something shifted. She was beautiful, yes, but more than that, there was a quiet strength in her. We started a relationship. But I was still running from the law, from my past, from myself. We tried to make things work, but the weight of my life was too heavy.

So we ran. In 1984, we left California and moved to Prescott, Arizona. I even used an alias, thinking a new name would mean a new beginning. But no matter how far I went, I couldn't outrun my sin. It followed me like a shadow. Our relationship was unraveling. We were close to breaking apart.

Then, one day, in the center of town, everything changed.

Greetings from Carlsbad, New Mexico where Jesus Christ is still changing lives and hearts.

This year on Valentine's Day, we had our very first Marriage Conference. Evangelist Mike Gomez delivered a powerful message on marriage for the couples. A total of 10 couples were in attendance.

God spoke life into these marriages, bringing understanding and an opportunity for these couples to spend the evening with God, celebrating love for each other.

Also on this day, a family who has been seeking God in our church, Jacob and Nicole Medina, were married in the church.

All this was followed by an encouraging revival with Evangelist Mike Gomez who delivered five services where God moved tremendously upon hearts and lives. We saw 345 people throughout the week attend services, with 71 visitors and 44 decisions for Christ! Then we ended the month baptizing six people.

The month of March for our One80 Saturday night event was very exciting. We introduced a puppet ministry which has had a positive impact for the event and especially the children.

At the end of March we welcomed Pastor Joseph Lujan for a life-changing revival. Throughout the week we had 328 people come out, with 83 visitors, 14 decisions for Christ, and 25 recommitting their lives to Jesus. We prayed for 12 people for healing with several notable miracles. Many words of encouragement were given during this revival.

We started street preaching before every Sunday evening service, which has become something we do every Sunday!

In April we hosted a new convert

dinner. We had a very joyous and fruitful time. It was awesome to see 42 people in attendance where God ministered and we fellowshiped.

In May we welcomed Evangelist Roderick Gonzales for a very spirited and uplifting revival. Evangelist Gonzales preached a Mother's Day message about "The true power of Love" for our Sunday morning service. Five blessed services followed. We had 271 people in attendance, with 62 visitors and more than 12 decisions for Jesus. Many words were given, and since, once family has locked in to the church.

We started the month of June off with a water baptism, with seven people baptized. On the 14th of June we had our One80 Outreach "Bandshell Bash" at our local park. We had many visitors during the concert and 12 decisions for Jesus throughout the day.

The following day we began revival with Evangelist Adrian Farley, who preached seven enthusiastic services for that week. We had 144 visitors and 33 decisions for salvation during the revival.

July brought an exciting opportunity for four couples to attend the Prescott Conference in Arizona. The couples all enjoyed the experience and came back stirred and ready to step out in faith to do something for God. One couple, Bazani and Jeanette St. Augustine, had their two sons dedicated after returning from conference.

On July 19th we were able to go and support our mother church in Hobbs for their One80 Concert event. It was nice to be able to support our mother church as we street preached, outreached and enjoyed an outdoor concert they put on for their community. We ended July with a water baptism, with two people baptized.

We started August with a concert in the park where we had six decisions for Jesus throughout the day. We had our own Edgar and Amanda Muro who rapped some songs to start it off. We ended with rapper Tony out of El Paso.

We began our revival with Evangelist Mel Montoya the following day.

The revival with Pastor Montoya taught us a lot of things, but most of all that obedience to God brings blessings, and disobedience to God brings curses. It was an eye-opening revival. We had 63 visitors and nine decisions for salvation.

We thank God for everything He is doing in our congregation and our ministries, and we are excited to see what else He will do here in Carlsbad. God bless and let's win the world for Jesus!

"JESUS CHRIST HAS RISEN FROM THE DEAD!" was the repeated proclamation of our late Pastor Wayman Mitchell at every healing crusade he would preach.

We can still see it today in our mind's eye, with both arms extended out toward the audience he would declare it, and hanging above him the banner, "EXPECT A MIRACLE."

Not merely a statement, but the spirit of that is being demonstrated in young men all across our Fellowship. One of our disciples was moved on by God to do his second healing crusade last month. About 30 men, with the help of our ministry known as SOT (Sons of Thunder) 1000, rallied together to set up 100 chairs in front of a stage on an 18-wheeled trailer in the parking lot of Chandler High School. In traditional healing crusade fashion, bands ministered before the preaching/prayer to establish dominion and a Holy Ghost atmosphere. Shortly thereafter, our brother took the stage and began declaring the healing virtue and power of Jesus Christ.

One notable miracle involved a particular gentleman who was invited to the crusade by a longtime member of our church. He not only brought along his fiancé, but gave His life to Jesus, and then proceeded to the stage to be prayed for. He had pain in his foot due to it being broken, but as we began to pray,

we declared healing in Jesus' name, and within seconds he was pain free. The gentleman and his fiancé are in the church today, taking steps toward marriage, and making grand strides for God!

Another memorable moment this summer draws its roots to a couple years back.

It was in the spring of 2023 when a man, who, at the time of attending our church, worked in a deli. This man began to witness to his deliveryman that he saw once or twice a week. Unbeknownst to him, this deliveryman, then 28 years old, had spent the better half of the last decade a pothead, an alcoholic, and living totally given over to the pursuit of sin.

For about three months this young deliveryman named Justin Francis would be told about the Gospel, the Bible, and the love of Jesus, until on July 9, 2023, when in our Sunday evening service, he was **RADICALLY** converted. At the time of his conversion, he had also been in a two-year-long relationship with his then girlfriend named Michaela. It was a relationship which he knew would either have to end, or would have to quickly become centered around his new-found Lord and Savior.

As time went on, he put forth a proposition to her about becoming born again like he had, or they would inevitably have to face the hard truth of parting ways. The reality was that she was a church kid, and was familiar with what it was to serve God. For about two months they were broken up until she decided to finally attend a service. A sermon on the prodigal son powerfully preached by Pastor Campbell could not have been more timely. Pastor Campbell also gave her a word, specifically about God calling her back home.

Last month on July 20 Justin Francis and Michaela Marin were joined together in marriage. For 10 months they had separated, dated in church, and lived right before God until their wedding day. And there is no validation like the presence of God at Jesus People Wedding to remind us that He honors

Greetings from Gallup, New Mexico! Jesus Christ is changing lives and moving in our city. We are excited to report some highlights from our summer season.

We began the season in revival with Pastor Artie Aragon. Our first night of revival drew a record attendance of over 400 people. We had testimonies and a performance from the Chinle Choir, as well as a fellowship of frybread, spam, and green chile. Throughout the week, we had over 100 visitors, with more than 30 who responded for salvation. God also touched and healed many people in our congregation.

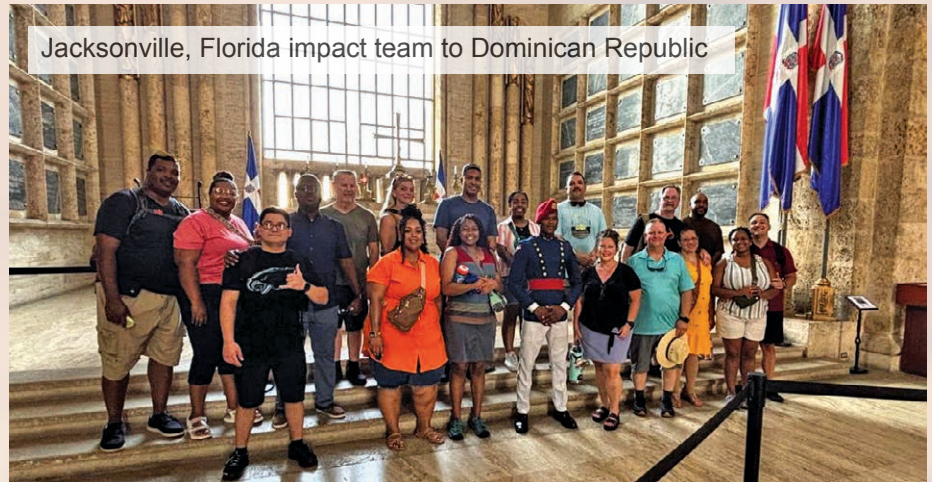
Greetings from the thriving city of Jacksonville, Florida - where the harvest field is growing before our very eyes!

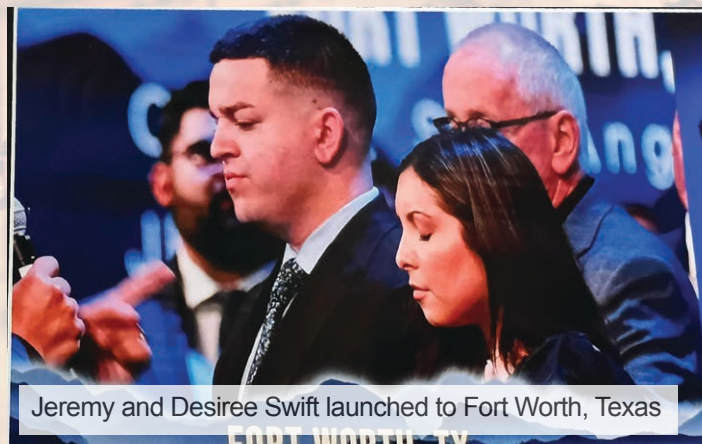

Greetings! It's always a great privilege to share the things God continues to do in and through our lives. God has been gracious to us and we are excited to tell it.

In May, we had a family movie night and we showed a movie titled "The Forge" plus we served popcorn and coffee for the people in attendance. The movie was clear cut Gospel with a powerful message

on discipleship. It was good to see a number of families in attendance. In the first 20 minutes, we had 243 people in attendance and more people were still walking in. We had a great response as people responded positively. At the conclusion of the movie, there was an altar call for salvation, and we recorded 19 adults and 54 children saved.

In mid-May, we had our annual Harvesters' Rally, and Pastor Patrick Nyamai from Nairobi, Kenya

was the main preacher. It was indeed a homecoming encounter as couples in the harvest field were refreshed.

Thereafter, we had the Southern Campaign that ran for about two weeks in six different towns. The campaign kicked off in Kazungula (which borders Botswana and Zambia) and it ran for two nights. God healed and saved many people in those two nights - 51 children and 68 adults responded to the Gospel.

The next stop was Livingstone, where the miracle healing crusade was held for three nights - 183 children, and 160 adults gave their lives to Christ and many people were healed.

The team then proceeded to Choma, where the crusade lasted for two nights. In the two nights, the sick were healed and sinners came to Christ. A total number of 125 children, and 128 adults got saved in Choma.

From Choma, the crusade was held in Monze for two nights. God moved in Monze too, as 92 children and 80 adults gave their lives to Christ.

Thereafter, the crusade was held in Mazabuka for two nights and there, 300 children and 125 adults responded to the call for salvation.

Finally, the Southern Campaign was concluded in Kafue where it was held for two nights. Some 185 children and 148 adults got saved in Kafue.

The sum of the people who got saved out of the Southern Campaign totalled 936 children and 709 adults!

In June, we had a Club One80 concert dubbed Stone Cold Stunner. Prior to the concert, we went out on outreach inviting people for the same and nine people got saved in that outreach. We then had the concert in the evening and we had a very good number of visitors in attendance. At the end of the concert, an appeal for salvation was made and 21 children and six adults got saved, plus one boy who had pain in his chest was prayed for by the disciple who pulled the altar call and the boy was instantly healed.

In July, Club One80 held a music concert titled Reggae Fest. Our Outreach Director, Austin Phiri, being a former Bob Marley enthusiast, did a number of songs together with a team from our baby church in Avondale. At the end of the Reggae Fest concert, 23 children and 16 adults gave their lives to Christ, amounting to 39 souls saved.

Toward the end of July, and in the early days of August, Pastor Simon

Kakumbi had a marathon of outdoor crusades targeted at helping our baby churches in the areas they serve. During these miracle healing crusades, the Gospel was preached, the sick were prayed for and they received healing in Jesus' name.

In Avondale, the crusade lasted three nights and a total of 91 souls gave their lives to Jesus. The crusade was then held in Ten Miles for four nights, and a total number of 153 children and 72 adults gave their lives to Christ. In Chilanga, which was the final stop of the crusades, God touched and healed many as we recorded 145 children and 53 adults saved.

We were walking through the Courthouse Plaza when we heard a group of believers sharing the Gospel. They weren't shouting. They weren't judging. They were offering something we didn't know we were starving for - hope. They spoke of forgiveness, of redemption, of a second birth. We didn't know it then, but Pastor Wayman Mitchell had been praying for revival, for souls just like ours to find Jesus.

It wasn't instant. But slowly, something began to stir. God was drawing us. Months passed, and then one day, we surrendered. We gave our lives to Jesus Christ, and everything changed.

It was as if the chains I had carried for years, the addiction, guilt, and shame, began to fall off. I felt washed. Forgiven. Clean. The lies, the alias, the past, I couldn't carry it anymore. God had rescued me, and it was time to walk in truth.

When Pastor Mitchell returned from Australia, Martha and I met with him. He married us, and I told him everything about my past, a warrant for my arrest, my fear. He looked me in the eye and said something I'll never forget:

"Baltazar, you've got to take the bull by the horns. Even if you go to prison - serve God. Live clean. Read your Bible. Come to church. And pray for God's intervention."

A few years later, I was arrested. The past caught up to me, and I was taken to Camp Verde Jail. I signed the extradition papers. But in that cell, I made a covenant with God: "Whatever happens, I will serve You. Just take care of my family."

During those 17 days in jail, I led Bible studies. I shared the Gospel. Sixteen men gave their lives to Jesus. On the 17th day, the word came: "California doesn't want to extradite. Let

him go."

I walked out of that place a free man in every way.

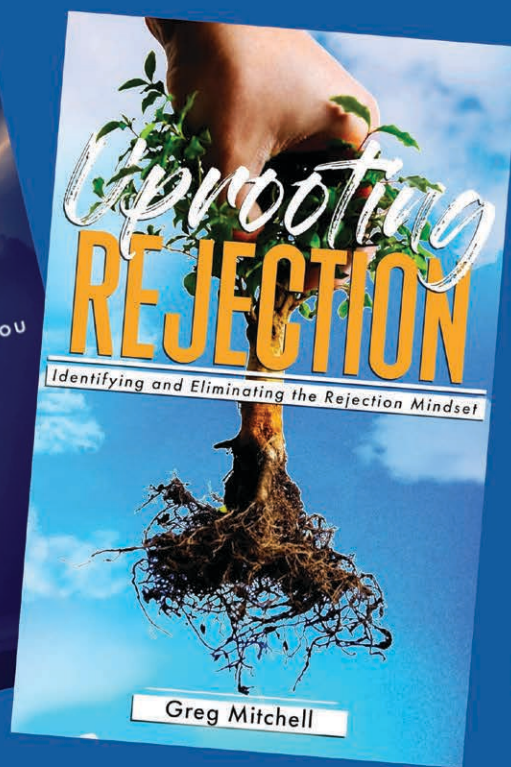
Since that day, God has done more than I ever dreamed. He restored my marriage. He gave me six beautiful children and 21 grandchildren. He healed my mind and body. Two of my sons, Angel and Jesse, are now pastors. My daughter Yesenia and her husband Tim are missionaries in Kathmandu, Nepal.

This is what God does. He takes broken lives and writes new stories. He takes ashes and gives beauty. He takes out the heart of stone and replaces it with a heart that beats for Him.

I stand here today not because I'm good, but because He is. Not because I was strong, but because He saved me.

True riches don't come from the world. They come from knowing the living God. I am a citizen of heaven, and I wait eagerly for Christ's return.
