Prescott, Arizona Potter's House Pastor Greg Mitchell Corres: Matt Sanderlin

In Psalms, we find the repeated instructions to "give thanks to the Lord." Why? Because His mercy, goodness, and love endure forever! The year 2024 was a fruitful season. We must stop to reflect and thank God for the harvest and His willingness to use our lives to reach the lost. As we entered the fall season and temperatures dropped, we watched in wonder as the number of visitors increased and hands continued to rise in response to the Gospel.

In September, we hosted our bi-annual Youth Extreme. Young people from all over Arizona, Nevada, and New Mexico came together for a day of encouragement and evangelism. Pastor Martin Klok from the Netherlands ministered and then followed up with a week of revival. One of the exciting highlights was a musical theater production titled Hopewell High. The play consisted of a cast and crew of nearly 40 teens! These young people produced an impactful tool for evangelism. Many were saved, and teenaged youth began attending youth services and regular services as a result of the production.

Leading up to Halloween, we hosted a Trunk-Or-Treat outreach in the parking lot of our One80° concert venue. Members of the Prescott congregation decorated the back of their vehicles, set up games and family-friendly activities, and prepared to give out candy. However, we weren't prepared for what happened next. Visitors began to arrive an hour before the event. We were amazed when the event drew 500 visitors in just a short amount of time. The Gospel was preached and shared through one-onone evangelism. The message of truth was readily received by those who attended. In less than two hours, 70 people had prayed to receive salvation. That evening, we held a Halloween-themed concert with drama and music, and the altars were filled as another 30 people responded to the Gospel!

For nearly 40 years, our annual Haunted House has proved to be an ef-



fective means of evangelism. People line up in the cold and wait for hours to have "The Heaven" scared into them. This year's Haunted House was the "AwakenIng." Horror seekers were taken into a robotics research laboratory, and they stepped into a nightmare. All that is human, all that is evil. wicked, and sinful, was placed into the cognitive faculties of AI robots. The infected bots portraved the corruption of human nature as the creation turned on its creator. The Awakening

drew over 300 visitors and resulted in 135 decisions for salvation. After the event, new converts and families who were saved at the haunted house were in church the following Sunday.

Evangelism, preaching the Gospel, and seeing people saved are at the heart of everything we do. However, conversions are not the only benefit of the work we give ourselves to. Scriptures like Hebrews 10:24, 1 Thessalonians 5:11, Proverbs 27:17, and 2 Timothy 2:2 remind us why we do what we do. Yes, the Gospel works to save souls, but it also brings the family and body of Christ together, enabling us to be of one accord (Philippians 2:2).

Plays, impact teams, and outreaches are massive undertakings. Our Haunted House this year included more than 70 cast and crew, 20 set builders, 10 costume designers, eight makeup artists, 10 security personnel, 20 in follow-up, four in food and refreshments, and eight disciples preaching alter calls. That's more than 150 people between the ages of 11

> and 71, all involved in a single event with a unified vision - each of them contributing, learning, teaching, growing, evangelizing, and being discipled. This collaborative harmony is a beautiful thing to witness.

Decades later, his dedication remains unwavering. This year, he took on the lead role in our latest Haunted House production, "Awaken-Ing." Alongside Dennis Halverson, our special effects coordinator (age also undisclosed), worked tirelessly well past midnight each night to ensure the show's success, creating an unforgettable experience for all.




Gour cherished Fellowship of brothers and sisters! We at Door Church have had a busy summer and fall season.

These revival services have not only brought timely words and encouraging sermons that built up our regular members but have also brought in new visitors who until now have continued to attend.


In August we had an impact team and concert from one of our Fellowship Spanish churches in Taylorsville, NC. During that outreach, 11 were

Greetings from the Eden Park Potter's House where Jesus is still radically changing lives.

This past year has been a testimony of God's faithfulness to His church during turbulent times.

With the resilient spirit within our pastor, his wife Cheryl and within our congregation, we followed a 2023 September 6 church robbery attack (which also claimed the life of a dear brother) with a "back in the arena" major street preaching, sharing testimonies, and prayer for the sick. Many in our community were least expecting to see our church outreaching in the streets after the attack.

Pastor Shanin Jukskei came and preached a Holy Ghost message that brought both comfort and understanding to our church of why the enemy viciously attacks any church that is making impact for Christ.

We had our Southern Africa leader Pastor Jonathan Heimberg from the Eldorado Park church come preach a revival for us in December which served as a rocket launch for our church into the 2024 year, not with a limp but a giant leap. Despite the decline in seeing visitors our pastor persistently launched revival services.

We had pastor Lain Iwanga from Cape Town come in February to preach four Holy Ghost messages that accelerated faith in the saints with timely words given to many and notable healings with visitors steadily coming out and getting saved. It left our church refreshed!

One of the "great and effective doors

opened for us" is the nearby Substance Abuse Community-Based Day Clinic known as Palm Ridge SANCA where our church has disciples going once every month on a Wednesday to minister to the drug and alcohol help seeking men and women who are receiving rehabilitation help there.

The rehab center manager has also granted our outreach team full permission to hold our "Potter's House style concerts" after unsuccessful past attempts to have such.

Our disciples faithfully minister the Gospel at this rehab center, pulling altar calls, leading them in the deliverance prayers from anger, regrets, guilt, sleep torments, and restoration of their broken relationships with families. They get filled with the Holy Spirit in these spiritual sessions that form part of their recovery journey.

In June our children's Sunday School with their teachers did a marvelous play depicting the Freedom Day youth struggle against the Apartheid regime. They put a beautiful spin on it with a theme "True freedom is found in Jesus Christ alone."

In July we had five Holy Ghost powered revival services with the Holland Evangelist Jan-Willem Van Dam. His multifaceted ministry brought another element into our church!

Right away after our SA Bible Conference we had a newly launched Evangelist Jonathan Mphake come do his first service at our church. This couple was raised, discipled and first launched from the Eden Park church prior to them now evangelizing. Jonathan gave words of knowledge, encouragement to many and notable healings took place.

Another door of opportunity we have also is a nearby Youth Center which is a feeding scheme with many unemployed young and older people, some who are alcohol and drug addicted going there daily. Our disciples have been permitted to come whenever they wish to minister the Gospel and bring hope to these men and women. We've had victory reports of notable healings from this center with. injured legs getting healed, a half blind man had his eye sight restored.

We have a 39-year-old convert who came from a life of alcoholism for years. She was hospitalized for extreme depression and put on antidepressants but she didn't see any change and went back to alcohol. Then she heard one of our disciples who was an alcoholic testifying at the Youth Center about how Jesus set him free from alcohol. She decided to come on one very cold Monday morning in September to seek help from our church. She came back, got saved, water baptized and transformed by the power of Jesus and the Gospel truth.

In October we had the Eldorado Park impact team come help us prepare for our revival with our former pastor Chris Aulson and saw 70 decisions for Christ from that outreach. Late October pastor Chris Aulson came bringing very in seasonal messages for our entire congregation, with words of encouragement given to many and to our pastor.

Greetings from the Potter's House in Juba, South Sudan! God has been doing amazing things since we officially opened the church in January 2023.

We have been seeing a lot of fruit from our weekly outreaches and street preaching, as well as many souls saved during our Friday movie nights and Saturday concerts. People are getting stirred to be involved in ministry. We have recently been able to start a drama team which has added a great dimension to our Saturday night music scenes.

In October we had our first healing crusade and revival with Pastor Mitch Connors from Troy, NY and saw God move powerfully every single night. Throughout the week we saw 167 new decisions for Christ, as well as 42 notable healings. Many people also experienced personal breakthrough in their lives during this impactful week. We also had a testimony from a man named Mario who brought a childhood friend to the crusade. His friend had been sick for several years and reported instant change as soon as he was prayed for. Immediately following the revival, Mario also experienced personal breakthrough in his employment and finances. He gave the glory to God and also presented Pastor Mitch with a handmade South Sudanese "honor stick" to show his appreciation.

ello and God Bless, from the great city of Hyderabad, India! Jesus is ALIVE and moving powerfully in this nation, and we are grateful to be part of the Harvest!

We opened the church on Easter Sunday, March 31st, 2024. In the past months God has been pouring out last days revival just as He promised!

About a month after opening, a young man told me he needed to confess something. I braced myself he was our most

faithful fruit at that point. He told me "when you preached about God's healing power a few weeks ago, I thought you were lying." I asked him why and he said "Because I saw a Bollywood movie where they were faking healings, so I thought all healings were fake." I asked him "So ... what changed?" He replied "you prayed for me after the service and God healed me of pain in my stomach."

Greetings from Mandaluyong City, Philippines!

God is moving with increasing intensity, much like the birth pains described in Scripture – growing more intense as we eagerly anticipate what God is about to accomplish.

On August 24, we held our ONE80 Jam Concert outside the church. Time and again, we've seen that the methods God used in the past remain effective today. The Holy Spirit moved powerfully that night, resulting in 45 souls surrendering their lives to Christ. Through music and preaching, many others heard the life-transforming message of the Gospel.

On October 26, we cast our nets once more with a Halloween full-length Drama presentation. This thought-provoking performance spoke directly to today's generation, highlighting the inner struggles and battles that often lead to depression and the alarming rise in suicides. Give are grateful to share some highlights of the recent events in our church.

We have continued with our regular outreach programs on Saturdays and God has given us fruit every time. Over the past few months new people

have come into our church and remained due to our neighborhood outreach programs.

One guy by the name of Vorster, who has been coming to our church for the past few months, recently invited his mother, sister and brother for service. His brother,

Twalumba, got saved during the morning service and got baptized during the afternoon service together with his sister Diana.

In October, we had a special outreach dubbed Summer Slam where we had music, drama, and a wrestling match. The turnout was amazing as we saw about 300 people in attendance. At the end of the concert we had 58 people give their lives to Jesus Christ!

Two weeks after this event, we held our annual soccer tournament outreach. Pastor George Karabassis invited Pastor Chikonde Malindima to be our guest preacher during the two-day five-aside soccer sensation, where we saw a great number of youths attend. We witnessed 100 decisions made for Christ.

strategized a unique follow-up program which was conducted by making phone calls to new converts as we had multiple decision cards from our previous outreach programs.

Toward the end of October, Pastor Simon Kakumbi ministered powerfully to the youths during Crossfire Youth and at the end, we had four people give their lives to Jesus.

We have continued supporting our baby churches by sending impact teams. We recently had a Jah Night concert in Matero where we saw 11 adults and 12 children respond to the Gospel, and we had a Club One80 outdoor concert in the newly established Meanwood Ndeke church where Charles and Sandra Kakoma are pastoring, and 39 people gave their lives to Jesus.

In the evening, we did a play titled Richard's Story and 23 people surrendered their lives to Christ after the play, totaling 62 souls out of that day's outreach.

In mid-November, our impact team went to Chilanga, located south of the central business district, where our baby church, pastored by Samuel and Doreen Ndhlovu is situated. We had an all-day outreach. During the day, the team witnessed while inviting people for the evening concert. There were 34 decisions from the morning and afternoon outreach. During the Club One80 concert in the evening, 26 people gave their lives to Jesus. A total of 60 people got saved out of the Chilanga outreach.
